WEEKLY HONORS



OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK FAY BAKODIMOU, TOWSON

Senior | Outside Hitter | Athens, Greece/3rd Senior HS

Bakodimou had a stellar weekend, helping Towson to an unblemished record at the Tiger Invitational. The Athens, Greece native averaged 4.00 kills per set while hitting a red hot .446 en route to MOP honors. Bakodimou recorded double-digit kills in all three of her performances, including 11 kills on 17 swings (.647) in a straight-set victory over Lehigh. She had a match-high 13 kills against Temple and was the only player in the match to reach double-figure kills. She finished the weekend with 12 kills, one service ace and three blocks, upending Norfolk State in three sets. Bakodimou has now eclipsed double-digit kills in seven of 10 matches this season.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK SOPHIA DAVIS, JAMES MADISON

Junior | Middle Blocker | Fort Lauderdale, Fla./Saint Thomas Aquinas

Davis had an impactful week at the net, helping the Dukes average a loss to VCU and battle with No. 4 Ohio State. The junior averaged 1.71 blocks throughout the two matches and contributed 2.57 kills per set offensively. In a four-set victory over VCU, Davis had a match-high six blocks, including three solos and added 10 kills on a .526 hitting percentage. Against No. 4 Ohio State, Davis again led the match with six blocks, stuffing four by herself. She also paced James Madison contributing eight kills. Davis has recorded six or more blocks in three straight matches and increased her season average to 1.07 blocks per set.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK EMMA APPLEMAN, CHARLESTON Freshman | Setter | Guilford, Conn./Guilford HS

Appleman helped Charleston to a 3-1 weekend at the CofC Classic, facilitating the attack as the primary setter. Over the weekend, the freshman averaged 10.13 assists per set, 2.50 digs per set and added 12 kills on a .370 hitting percentage. After a setback to start the weekend, Appleman tallied over 45 assists in three straight victories and recorded double-doubles in the final two matches. Appleman recorded 46 assists and 10 digs in a four-set victory over Florida A&M before a 47 assist and 14 dig performance to conclude the tournament with a win over Davidson in four sets.

WEEK 3 IN REVIEW

- Charleston (7-4, 0-0 CAA) went 3-1 at the CofC Classic. The Cougars dropped their opening match to Idaho State before three consecutive four-set victories over Campbell, Florida A&M and Davidson. Offensively Charleston was led by Molly Russell and Emma Appleman. Russell averaged 2.81 kills per set on a .434 hitting percentage and recorded double-figure kills in all three wins for the Cougars. Appleman averaged 10.13 assists per set and 2.50 digs per set, including back-to-back double-doubles to finish the weekend. Defensively, Sammy Campion contributed a solid effort, averaging 5.33 digs per set over three matches. Charleston will open conference play this weekend, welcoming Elon to TD Arena for a pair of matches.
- **Delaware** (5-4, 0-0 CAA) fell in three straight contests at the Kansas Invitational. The Blue Hens dropped their opener to Kanas in three sets before a pair of five-set battles with Kent State and Wichita State. Savannah Seemans was a bright spot for Delaware, leading the team with 35 kills and eight service aces. The sophomore averaged 2.69 kills per set and 2.00 digs per set over the three matches while picking up her first double-double (10K, 12DG) of the season against Kent State. Delaware will host James Madison for two matches this weekend to kick off CAA play.
- Elon (5-4, 0-0 CAA) fell in a mid-week matchup with Charlotte before winning back-to-back matches over UNC Ashville and Mercer over the weekend. Leah Daniel and Natalie Cummins earned all-tournament honors at the Aggie/Phoenix Volley for Unity Tournament. Daniel led the Phoenix with 31 kills (3.44 per set) and added a team-high four service aces. Cummins lead the team with 12 blocks (1.33 per set) while also contributing 22 kills (2.44 per set). Elon will visit North Carolina on Tuesday before heading to Charleston to begin conference play Friday and Saturday.
- Hofstra (6-5, 0-0 CAA) went 2-2 last week, defeating Stony Brook and Cleveland State in straight sets before setbacks to Princeton and Colgate. A pair of freshmen played well for the Pride. Chiara Cucco continued to impress, racking up doubledigit digs in all four matches and averaged 5.62 digs per set. Cucco has now eclipsed double-figure dig totals in all 11 games to begin her career and leads the CAA with 5.18 digs per set this season. Florencia Wolkowyski had the best week of her young career contributing 39 kills (3.00 per set) and 16 digs (1.23 per set) for the Pride. Wolkowyski earned all-tournament honors after nine or more kills in all three games at the Ellis Rowland Memorial Tournament. Hofstra will open CAA play this weekend by hosting the defending CAA Champions Towson.
- James Madison (6-2, 0-0 CAA) split a pair of matches avenging a loss to VCU before dropping a battle with No. 4 Ohio State. Sophia Davis shined over the weekend, making her presence at the net felt. Davis averaged 2.57 kills per set and 1.71 blocks per set between the two matches. Against VCU, she had 10 kills on 19 swings without an error (.526) while tallying a team-high six blocks. Versus Ohio State, she led the Dukes with eight kills and had a match-high six blocks. James Madison will travel to Delaware Saturday and Sunday to start conference play.
- **UNCW** (1-7, 0-0 CAA) dropped three matches at the Chanticleer Classic. The Seahawks faced East Carolina, Radford and host Coastal Carolina over the weekend. Katie Lanz led UNCW's attack with 2.70 kills per set over the three matches. She had a team-high eight kills in the matchups with East Carolina and Coastal Carolina. Lanz also tallied 11 kills versus Radford. UNCW is the lone team that will not begin CAA play this weekend. The Seahawks will host the UNCW Landfall Classic in a final tuneup before their CAA schedule gets underway. UNCW will square off with Jacksonville on Friday, followed by a pair of matches with Campbell and UNC Greensboro on Saturday.

- Northeastern (4-6, 0-0 CAA) fell to Boston College 3-1 and dropped a tough match to Villanova in five sets but bounced back with a victory in straight sets over Bryant and a five-set win over Harvard. Nailah Jenkins paced the offense for the Huskies, racking up 44 kills (2.59 per set) on a .379 hitting percentage. She reached double-figure kills in three of the four matches, including a team-high 17 in the effort verse Boston College. Kayla Martin anchored the defense, totaling 75 digs (4.41 per set) and eclipsed 20 digs in both of the Huskies' wins. Northeastern will begin CAA play on the road, taking on William & Mary for a pair of matches Saturday and Sunday.
- **Towson** (12-0, 0-0 CAA) played 12 sets and won 12 this weekend, defeating Lehigh, FAU, Temple and Norfolk State. The Tigers have now won their last six matches in straight sets and won 10 of 12 matches this season in three sets. Fay Bakodimou led Towson offensively, averaging 4.00 kills per set on a .446 hitting percentage over three matches. Bakodimou had double-digit kills in all the matches she appeared in and led the match in kills versus Temple (13) and FAU (12). Lydia Wiers paced the team with 12 kills on 17 swings without an error (.706) against Norfolk State and had a match-high 12 kills against Lehigh. Wiers finished the weekend with 2.75 kills per set on a .473 attacking percentage. Towson will begin conference play this weekend traveling to Hofstra.
- William & Mary (3-2, 0-0 CAA) won its home opener over Hampton in straight sets. It was an all-around team effort for the Tribe in the victory. Maddie Meyers recorded a matchhigh 16 kills on a .344 hitting percentage, while Lauren Merrill converted 12 kills on 20 attempts without an error (.600). Freshman Amy Shwem notched the first double-double of her career, tallying 37 assists and 10 digs, while Anna Porter was all over the court defensively, racking up a match-high 18 digs Willaim & Mary will host Northeastern this weekend to kick off its fall 2021 CAA schedule.

CAA PLAY BEGINS FRIDAY

- Eight CAA teams begin conference play this weekend. The CAA has returned to a traditional 16-game conference slate this fall. Every team will face each other twice throughout the season, playing back-to-back matches either at home or on the road against a single opponent.
- The first CAA conference match on the schedule this fall will feature Charleston hosting Elon. Despite being the first conference match of the fall, it is not the first CAA match of 2021, nor will it be the first time Charleston and Elon square off in 2021. Charleston won both matches against Elon last spring.
- William & Mary will host Northeastern on Saturday and Sunday. It will be the first matchup between the programs since October 28, 2019. They did not play during the spring due to the divisional structure of the conference.
- Delaware and James Madison are set for a showdown in Newark over the weekend. The teams played a home-andhome series during the spring, but they were not considered conference matches because it was a cross-divisional matchup. They split the contests, each team winning on the road.
- Hofstra will host Towson, marking the first matchup between the teams since October 27, 2019. Despite both teams being in the north division during the spring, both matches between the Pride and Towson were canceled due to COVID.

EARN YOUR STRIPES

- Two-time defending CAA champion Towson has won its last 23 regular-season CAA conference matches dating back almost two years.
- Towson completed a 16-0 regular-season during its championship run in 2019, marking the first undefeated CAA regular-season since 2012. The Tigers played just two CAA regular-season matches during the shortened spring season, winning both before claiming their second straight title.
- Towson's last CAA regular-season loss came on October 27, 2018, in a five-set defeat at Charleston.
