WEEKLY HONORS



OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

LEAH DANIEL, ELON

Senior | Outside Hitter | Zionsville, Ind./Zionsville HS

Daniel led Elon to a 2-1 week and a 2-0 start in CAA play. The senior outside hitter averaged 4.82 kills per set and recorded double-digit kills in all three matches throughout the week. The reigning CAA Player of the Year started conference play in style, leading the Phoenix to a pair of four-set wins over Charleston. Daniel had a season-high 22 kills in the opening match against the Cougars and followed it with a match-high 19 kills to conclude the weekend. The back-to-back wins mark the first time ever that Elon has defeated Charleston twice in the same season. Daniel's 53 kills throughout the week also allowed her to eclipse 1,000 kills in her career. Daniel leads the CAA with 4.18 kills per set this season.



CO-DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

SOPHIA DAVIS, JAMES MADISON

Junior | Middle Blocker | Fort Lauderdale, Fla./Saint Thomas Aquinas

Davis helped James Madison begin CAA play 2-0 for the eighth straight season, with a pair of five-set victories over Delaware. Davis tallied 18 total blocks, averaging 1.80 per set, to help the Dukes hold Delaware to a .172 hitting percentage over the weekend. In the first match, Davis had nine blocks and one dig along with nine kills, hitting .375 to make her impact. In the weekend finale it was another all-around performance, recording nine blocks, four of them solo while chipping in 13 kills on a .440 attacking percentage and three service aces. The nine blocks in back-to-back matches mark a season-high for Davis, and she has now recorded more than five blocks in five straight contests.

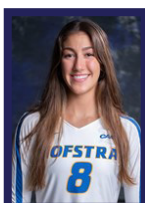


CO-DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

SARAH PIERRE, HOFSTRA

Junior | Middle Blocker | Bloomfield, N.J./Bloomfield HS

Pierre was a defensive force, averaging 2.00 blocks per set to open conference play. The junior made her biggest impact with a career-high 12 blocks in Hofstra's upset of the Towson, ending the Tigers' 36-match regular-season winning streak. Pierre had a solid effort in the weekend finale, tallying six blocks and seven kills in another competitive match between Hofstra and Towson. Pierre leads the CAA in total blocks (60) and blocks per set (1.50) this fall.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

FLORENCIA WOLKOWYSKI, HOFSTRA

Freshman | Outside Hitter | Calahonda-Mijas, Spain/IES Virgen de Valme

Wolkowyski had the best week of her young career, averaging 3.00 kills per set and 1.00 blocks per set in a weekend split with Towson. In Hofstra's five-set victory over Towson, the freshman contributed 12 kills and six blocks to help the Pride down the defending CAA Champions. She followed the performance tying her season-high with 15 kills and chipping in six digs and three blocks in the weekend finale. After the weekend, Wolkowyski has now recorded double-digit kills in four of her last five matches.

WEEK 4 IN REVIEW

■ **Charleston** (7-6, 0-2 CAA) dropped a pair of matches to Elon in four sets in its first weekend of CAA play. Gabi Bailey led Charleston, averaging 3.38 kills per set. Bailey tallied a team-high 15 kills in match one and recorded her sixth double-double of the season, with 12 kills and 10 digs in match two. Lexi Wierzbicki also recorded double-digit kills in both matches, tallying 12 in both days. Sammy Campion led both matches in digs, averaging 6.00 digs per set over the two matches. Campion had 22 digs on Friday, followed by 26 on Saturday. The Cougars will continue conference play, heading on the road this weekend. Charleston will face James Madison for back-to-back matches Saturday and Sunday.

■ **Delaware** (5-6, 0-2 CAA) fell in back-to-back competitive, five-set matches to James Madison to open conference play. Lani Mason and Savannah Seemans led Delaware with 29 and 27 kills, respectively. Mason also picked up a pair of double-doubles, and Seemans recorded a double-double in the final match of the weekend. Ezgi Basaranlar had a solid weekend facilitating the Blue Hen's attack. Basaranlar averaged 9.50 assists per set, including 43 assists in the first match and 52 in the weekend finale. After the weekend, Basaranlar leads the CAA with 9.48 assists per set this season. Seemans remains atop the league, now with 26 service aces, while the Blue Hens led the league averaging 2.19 service aces per set. Delaware will look to get back on track, traveling to Elon for a pair of matches Saturday and Sunday.

■ **Elon** (7-5, 2-0 CAA) dropped a midweek matchup to North Carolina before starting CAA play 2-0 with a pair of wins over Charleston. It marks the first time that the Phoenix has defeated Charleston twice in one season. Leah Daniel led the way with 4.82 kills per set throughout the week. Daniel reached double-figure kills in all three matches, including a team-high 12 against North Carolina, a match-high 22 in game one versus Charleston, and a match-high 19 in her final action of the week. Daniel leads the CAA with 4.18 kills per set, and Elon ranks second in the league with 12.48 kills per set this season. The Phoenix will host Delaware to continue CAA play this weekend.

■ **Hofstra** (7-6, 1-1 CAA) did what no other had done in 36 straight regular-season matches, defeat Towson. The Pride split the weekend series, winning a five-set thriller on Saturday before dropping a closely contested four-set match on Sunday. Ana Martinovic showed her veteran leadership tallying 30 kills (3.33 per set) over the weekend, including a match-high 16 in the Pride's victory. Sarah Pierre was stout defensively, blocking 18 total attacks (2.00 per set) between the two matches. Pierre set a new career-high with 12 blocks in the Hofstra victory. Florencia Wolkowyski had the best weekend of her young career as the freshman recorded 3.00 kills per set and 1.00 blocks per set throughout her action. Wolkowyski had 12 kills in the first match and tied a season-high with 15 in the finale. Hofstra will head on the road but continue CAA play as the Pride travel to Northeastern for a pair of matches this weekend.

■ **James Madison** (8-2, 2-0 CAA) gutted out a pair of five-set victories over Delaware to begin CAA play 2-0 for the eighth consecutive season. Miëtte Veldman and Chole Wilmoth paced the Dukes' offense. Veldman had 19 kills on a .366 hitting percentage with 9 digs in match one. She followed it with 17 kills and 11 digs for her second double-double of the season. Wilmoth also had double-figure kills in both contests, with a season-high 16 in match one and 14 in the weekend finale. Sophia Davis impacted both matches for James Madison at the net, averaging 1.80 blocks per set and 2.20 kills per set. Davis had nine kills on a .375 hitting percentage and added nine blocks in match one. Then she swung .440 with 13 kills and nine blocks in the final match of the weekend. Davis is currently ranked second in the CAA in hitting percentage (.371) and blocks per set (1.26). James Madison will look to continue its early-season success when the Dukes host Charleston for back-to-back matches this weekend.

■ **UNCW** (1-10, 0-0 CAA) dropped three matches at the UNCW Landfall Classic in its final non-conference action of the season. The Seahawks suffered setbacks to Jacksonville, Campbell and UNC Greensboro in the event. Katie Lanz paced the UNCW attack averaging 3.20 kills per set over the weekend. Lanz had double-figure kills in two out of three matches, recording 15 against Jacksonville and 10 against Campbell. Quinn Manley contributed a solid effort in the libero role. The freshman averaged 4.60 digs per set and recorded double-digit digs in all three matches, including a season-high 20 against Campbell. UNCW will begin conference play this weekend as the Seahawks head on the road to face Towson on Saturday and Sunday.

■ **Northeastern** (6-6, 2-0 CAA) got off to a 2-0 start in conference play, defeating William & Mary twice. Erica Staunton and Nailah Jenkins paced the Huskies. In game one, Staunton had a match-high 16 kills while Jenkins added 11 kills and six blocks. Staunton and Jenkins both had five kills in the weekend finale, and Jenkins also recorded five blocks. Defne Arliel chipped in a team-high eight kills in match two. The Huskies have now started 2-0 in each of Coach Lenika Vasquez's first two seasons. Northeastern, riding a four-game win streak, will look to continue its success as the Huskies host Hofstra for a pair of matches this weekend.

■ **Towson** (13-1, 1-1 CAA) dropped an intense five-set match to Hofstra to begin the weekend but bounced back to defeat the Pride in four sets the following day. Fay Bakodimou led Towson, picking up back-to-back double-doubles. Bakodimou recorded a team-high 12 kills and 12 kills in match one while pacing Towson again with 15 kills and adding 10 digs in match two. Emily Jarome also recorded a pair of double-doubles, with 10 kills and 13 digs in each contest. Nina Cajic reached double-figure kills in both games, contributing 10 and 11 kills, respectively. Towson leads the CAA in multiple statistical categories, including hitting percentage (.305), opponent hitting percentage (.105), assists per set (12.47), kills per set (13.39) and blocks per set (2.61). Towson will return home to host UNCW on Saturday and Sunday.

■ **William & Mary** (3-4, 0-2 CAA) fell in back-to-back contests against Northeastern to open its CAA slate. The Tribe had three players reach double-figure kills in the first match despite being defeated in four sets. Lauren Merrill had a team-high 15 kills along with 13 from Julia Brown and 10 from Maddie Meyers. Merrill also paced the Tribe in the second match, recording a match-high 11 kills, but William & Mary fell in straight sets. Amy Schewm continued her impressive freshman campaign. Schewm tallied 70 assists (10.00 per set), including a season-best 47 in the opening match of conference play. William & Mary ranks second in the CAA in assists per set (11.36) and sits third in kills per set (12.32). William & Mary will take a break in the action before hosting Charleston for a pair of CAA matches on October 2 and 3.

STREAK SNAPPED

■ Hofstra defeated Towson in five sets during the team's CAA openers to snap multiple Towson winning streaks.
■ Towson's 12-game active winning streak, 36-match regular-season winning streak and 23-game regular-season CAA winning streak were all snapped.

MILESTONE MONDAY

■ Elon's Leah Daniel surpassed 1,000 career kills in the weekend finale versus Charleston. Daniel accumulated 53 kills over three matches last week to bring her career total to 1,016. Daniel leads the CAA with 167 kills this season, pacing the league with 4.18 kills per set.
■ Delaware's Ezgi Basaranlar eclipsed 1,500 career assists over the weekend. The Istanbul, Turkey native had 95 assists throughout the two matches to bring her career total to 1,581. Basaranlar has 294 assists this season and leads the CAA with 9.48 assists per set.
■ William & Mary's Lauren Merrill exceeded 500 career kills during the Tribe's matches this weekend. Merrill led the team with 26 kills over the two matches bringing her lifetime kills mark to 511. Merrill is second on the team with 61 kills this fall.
■ UNCW's Brooke Hanshumaker reached the 100 career block total over the weekend. Hanshumaker has 22 total blocks this fall, and her career total sits even at 100 total blocks.
