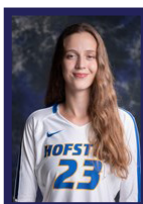


OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

LEAH DANIEL, ELON

Senior | Outside Hitter | Zionsville, Ind./Zionsville HS

Daniel continued her red-hot start to conference play leading Elon to a pair of victories over Delaware. The senior outside hitter averaged 4.75 kills per set while swinging at a .345 clip over the weekend. She led both matches in kills, racking up 22 in a five-set victory on Saturday, with five digs and three blocks. On Sunday, Daniel tallied 16 kills on a .467 hitting percentage and had eight digs in a straight-sets win. She has now reached double-figure kills in seven straight matches, and she continues to lead the CAA in kills per set (4.27). Daniel's effort helped Elon improve to 4-0 in the CAA, its best start to conference play in the program's Division I history.

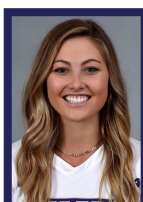


DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

DAMLA TOKMAN, HOFSTRA

Sophomore | Middle Blocker | Balikesir, Turkey/Okyanus Kolejeri

Tokman was a force to be reckoned with at the net, totaling 21 blocks in a pair of matches against Northeastern. Despite a five-set defeat on Saturday, Tokman had a career-high 11 blocks while also adding nine kills. Then in a five-set victory on Sunday, she posted another 10 blocks, becoming the first player to record back-to-back performances of ten or more blocks this season. Overall, Tokman averaged 2.10 blocks per set and 1.20 kills per set over the weekend to help Hofstra split with Northeastern.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

JAYDYN CLEMMER, JAMES MADISON

Freshman | Defensive Specialist | Lexington, Va./Rockbridge County HS

Clemmer pitched a solid effort defensively in a weekend split for the Dukes with Charleston. The freshman totaled 29 digs to average 3.22 per set over the two matches. Clemmer was tied for the team lead in digs both matches, recording 15 on Saturday followed by 14 in the finale. Clemmer has now recorded double-digit digs in three straight contests and has four in total this season.

WEEK 5 IN REVIEW

■ **Charleston** (8-7, 1-3 CAA) picked up its first conference win of the season, defeating James Madison in four sets on Saturday before falling to the Dukes in a five-set battle Sunday. The Cougars' win on Saturday snapped an eight-match losing streak to the Dukes. Gabi Bailey led the Charleston attack over the weekend with 29 kills (3.22 per set), while Emma Appleman had a team-high 62 assists (8.86 per set). In the Cougar's win, four different student-athletes reached double-digit kills. Bailey had a match-high 15 kills and added 10 digs for her seventh double-double of the season. Molly Russell (10), Anna Smith (13) and Lexi Wierzbicki (13) were the other Cougars to reach double-figure kills. Bailey, Smith (10) and Wierzbicki (11) also had double-digit kills in Charleston's defeat led by Bailey with 14. It marks the first two double-figure kill performances in Smith's young career. Charleston will remain on the road, traveling to William & Mary for a pair of matches this weekend.

■ **Delaware** (5-8, 0-4 CAA) dropped a pair of matches to Elon. First, falling in a back-and-forth five-set match before a defeat in straight sets. Savannah Seemans paced the Blue Hens offensively, racking up 27 kills (3.38 per set) over the weekend. Kirah Johnson also provided solid contributions for Delaware, recording 20 kills (2.50 per set) and eight blocks (1.00 per set). Delaware picked up 12 service aces in match one but failed to record one in the weekend finale. The Blue Hens lead the CAA with 2.08 service aces per set, behind Seemans conference-leading 27 service aces (0.54 per set). Delaware will look to get back on track as the Blue Hens host Hofstra for back-to-back matches on Saturday and Sunday.

■ **Elon** (9-5, 4-0 CAA) extended its winning streak to four matches following a pair of wins over Delaware. The 4-0 record in CAA play marks the best start to conference play in the program's Division I history. Leah Daniel continued to put up gaudy numbers, leading the Phoenix with 38 kills (4.75 per set) on a .345 hitting percentage. Daniel had a match-high 22 kills in Elon's five-set win before leading the Phoenix to a straight-sets victory with 16 kills and hitting .467. Freshman Sydney Love also contributed 18 kills (2.50 per set), including 12 in match one to tie her season-high. Elon's attack ranks second in the CAA in both hitting percentage (.241) and kills per set (12.50) after the weekend. The Phoenix will put its unblemished CAA record on the line, traveling to Towson for a pair of matches this weekend.

■ **Hofstra** (8-7, 2-2 CAA) split its weekend series with Northeastern, battling in back-to-back five-set matches. Beatriz Alves pitched an impressive effort from her setter position, averaging 8.90 assists per set and tallying more than 40 assists in each match. Zyare Abdul-Rahim led Hofstra's attack with 31 kills, averaging 3.10 per set. Defensively, it was a tall task to get an attack past Damla Tokman. Tokman recorded 21 blocks (2.10 per set) and had double-digit blocks in both matches. Additionally, Chiara Cucco increased her total matches with double-figure digs to 15 on the season, with 24 on Saturday and 19 on Sunday. The Pride will continue their road trip visiting Delaware for matches on Saturday and Sunday.

■ **James Madison** (9-3, 3-1 CAA) split its weekend series with Charleston, losing a four-set match on Saturday but bouncing back for a five-set victory on Sunday. Miëtte Veldman led the Dukes in kills in both matches, totaling 28 (3.11 per set) for the weekend. Veldman also contributed 2.22 digs per set and picked up her third double-double (12K, 12DG) of the season in James Madison's setback. Caroline Dozier had a solid effort in her setter role, tallying 78 assists (8.67 per set) throughout the weekend. Dozier had back-to-back double-doubles, recording 38 assists and 12 digs in match one, followed by 40 assists and 13 digs in the Dukes' victory. Freshman Jaydyn Clemmer anchored the Dukes' defense, leading the team with 29 digs (3.22 per set), and recorded double-figure dig totals in back-to-back contests. James Madison will enjoy the week off before returning to action against Elon on October 9 and 10.

■ **UNCW** (1-12, 0-2 CAA) opened CAA play dropping a pair of matches to Towson. Katie Lanz continued to pace the Seahawks attack, recording 19 kills (3.17 per set). Lanz had a match-high 12 kills and was the only one in double-figures during the weekend finale. Quinn Manley had another solid effort with her libero duties. Manley recorded double-digit digs in both matches, totaling 28 (4.67 per set) over the weekend. Her 13 digs on Sunday marked a match-high for the freshman. The Seahawks will be looking to get back into the win column when they host Northeastern for back-to-back matches this weekend.

■ **Northeastern** (7-7, 3-1 CAA) battled Hofstra in a pair of five-set matches, splitting the weekend series with the Pride. In the Huskies' victory, four student-athletes recorded eight or more kills led by Nailah Jenkins and Erica Staunton with nine apiece. Jenkins paced Northeastern the following match as well, tallying 11 kills along with Evelyn Gonzalez. Kayla Martin provided solid production on defense, digging out 41 opponent attacks (4.10 per set). Martin has recorded double-digit digs in all 14 games for the Huskies this season. Northeastern will take the trip to Wilmington to face UNCW for a pair of matches this weekend.

■ **Towson** (15-1, 3-1 CAA) defeated UNCW back-to-back matches in straight sets. Twelve of Towson's 15 wins this fall have now come in three sets. Towson had a balanced offensive attack throughout the weekend. Five student-athletes recorded five or more kills in the first match, led by Nina Cajic with eight. In the following contest, four individuals tallied five or more kills with Fay Bakodimou and Irbe Lazda recording nine apiece. Rachel Hess continued her tear defensively, averaging 4.83 digs per set. Hess recorded eclipsed double-figure digs in both matches, including a match-high 19 on Sunday. Towson leads the CAA in several statistical categories. The Tigers pace the league in hitting percentage (.303), opponent hitting percentage (.107), assists per set (12.40), kills per set (13.36) and blocks per set (2.65). They are the only team to lead the conference in more than one statistical category. Towson will remain at home, welcoming Elon to SECU Arena for two matches over the weekend.

■ **William & Mary** (3-4, 0-2 CAA) had the week off, preparing to continue conference play this week. The Tribe ranks second in the CAA in assists per set (11.36) and third in kills per set (12.32). Julia Brown leads William & Mary in kills (80), kills per set (3.20) and hitting percentage (.371). Brown ranks third in the conference in both kills per set and hitting percentage this season. Amy Schwem has settled into the setter role for the Tribe in her freshman season. Schwem leads William & Mary in assists (197) and assists per set (7.88). Defensively, Anna Porter paces the Tribe in digs (99) and digs per set (3.96), while Sabrina Malcolm holds team-highs in blocks (22) and blocks per set (1.10). The Tribe will be back in action this weekend, hosting Charleston for matches Saturday and Sunday.

LAST TEAM STANDING

■ After two weeks of conference action, only one team remains unbeaten in CAA play. Elon has started the year 4-0, sweeping the season series with Charleston and Delaware to begin 2021.
■ Elon's 4-0 record marks the best start in conference play in its program's history.
■ Elon's opponent this weekend, Towson, is the last team to complete an undefeated CAA regular season. The Tigers went 16-0 in 2019, 12-0 in 2012, and 14-0 in 2003. No other team has conquered the feat since 1996.

MILESTONE MONDAY

■ Hofstra's Beatriz Alves surpassed 500 career assists in her young career. The freshman recorded 89 assists over the weekend to increase her career total to 530. Alves has posted more than 40 assists on six occasions this fall, highlighted by a career-high 55 against Central Connecticut State. Her 530 assists rank atop the CAA.
■ James Madison's Sophia Davis eclipsed 250 career blocks over the weekend. The junior tallied 16 blocks in two matches against Charleston to bring her career total to 253. Davis has 64 blocks on the season and ranks second in the league, averaging 1.36 blocks per set.
