WEEKLY HONORS

CO-OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

LANI MASON, DELAWARE

Junior | Outside Hitter | Chester, Va./Matoaca

Mason led Delaware to three consecutive straight-set victories en route to earning MVP honors at the Delaware Invitational. The junior outside hitter averaged 3.89 kills per set, hitting .311, and she led all three matches in kills. Mason also recorded nine service aces (1.00 per set), including a career-high six versus Maryland Eastern Shore. Her weekend was highlighted by a 16-kill performance against Fordham in which she hit at a .414 clip and added nine digs, two assists and two blocks.



CO-OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

NINA CAJIC, TOWSON

Sophomore | Outside Hitter | Subotica, Serbia/Politehnicka Skola Subotica

Cajic led Towson offensively in a 4-0 weekend at the Towson Invitational. The sophomore outside hitter racked up 41 kills (2.93 per set) while hitting a red hot .437. Cajic also recorded 13 total blocks, contributing 3.60 points per set and earning all-tournament team honors. Cajic hit over .333 in all four matches over the weekend, including an outstanding .846 in the weekend finale versus Morgan State. She tallied a match-high 11 kills on 13 attempts without an error against the Bears. Cajic also posted a team-high 15 kills and five blocks in Towson's five-set victory over Loyola (Md.). The sophomore paces the Tigers in kills (77) and hitting percentage (.415) this fall.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

CHIARA CUCCO, HOFSTRA

Freshman | Libero | Buscate, Italy/Liceo Scientifico Donato Bramante

Cucco continued her stellar play this season by anchoring Hofstra's defense in a 3-1 week for the Pride. Cucco recorded double-digit digs in all four matches and averaged 5.38 digs per set throughout the week. The freshman also contributed 16 assists (1.00 per set) on the offensive end to show off her versatility. However, her defensive presence was unmatched, highlighted by a career-high 32 digs in a four-set victory over Kent State. It marked the first time since 2005 that a Hofstra individual tallied more than 30 digs in a four-set match. After the weekend, Cucco leads the CAA in digs (134) and digs per set (4.96) this season.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

BEATRIZ ALVES, HOFSTRA

Freshman | Setter | São José dos Campos, Brazil/Colégio Campos Salles

Alves helped Hofstra to a 3-1 week and earned all-tournament honors at the Fairfield Invitational. The freshman averaged 9.88 assists per set and 2.31 digs per set over the week. Alves recorded 158 assists, including more than 40 in three of her four matches. In a five-set victory over Fairfield, the freshman contributed 48 assists and 10 digs while adding two kills and two blocks. It marked her second consecutive double-double after picking up 24 assists and 14 digs in a three-set setback to Seton Hall. Alves now has three double-doubles and is averaging 9.59 assists per set this season.

WEEK 2 IN REVIEW

▪ **Charleston** (4-3, 0-0 CAA) went 1-2, defeating Howard in five sets after dropping a four-set match to Miami (OH) and before falling to host Duke in straight sets. Lexi Wierzbicki and Bailey Gabi paced the Cougars' offense. Gabi led the team with 2.75 kills per set and recorded a double-double with 16 kills and 16 digs in the victory over Howard. Wierzbicki averaged 2.50 kills per set over the weekend, highlighted by a match-high 17 kills versus Howard. Charleston will host the COFC Classic this weekend, welcoming the field of Idaho State, Campbell, Florida A&M and Davidson to TD Arena.

▪ **Delaware** (5-1, 0-0 CAA) won three consecutive matches, all in straight sets, at the Delaware Invitational. Lani Mason was named the tournament's MVP after averaging 3.89 kills per set on a .311 hitting percentage. Mason's biggest performance came against Fordham, tallying 16 kills and nine digs in a win. She also picked up a career-high six service aces in a victory over Maryland Eastern Shore. Mason totaled nine service aces (1.00 per set) over the weekend en route to 5.06 points per set. Defensively, Kirah Johnson was a force at the net, averaging 1.44 blocks per set. Johnson recorded at least four blocks in all three matches for a total of 14 throughout the weekend. Delaware travels to the Kansas Invitational Thursday through Saturday to face the field of Kent State, Wichita State and host Kansas.

▪ **Elon** (3-3, 0-0 CAA) started the week with a loss to Duke but bounced back with a pair of straight-set victories over Presbyterian and Furman. Leah Daniel continued to swing well, leading the Phoenix with 4.00 kills per set throughout the week. Daniel posted a match-high 13 kills against Duke, while she recorded 14 kills on a .467 hitting percentage against Furman. Daniel leads the CAA 4.15 kills per set this season. Jenn Krzeminski also had a solid week at the net for the Phoenix. Krzeminski posted 2.11 kills per set on a .529 hitting percentage and added 1.33 blocks per set. Krzeminski recorded seven kills along with seven blocks in a win over Furman. Elon returns home for three matches this week. The Phoenix will face Charlotte on Wednesday before hosting UNC Asheville and Mercer this weekend.

▪ **Hofstra** (4-3, 0-0 CAA) went 3-1 last week, defeating St. Francis Brooklyn in a Tuesday matchup before competing in the Fairfield Invitational. During the weekend tournament, the Pride picked up wins over Kent State and Fairfield while they dropped a match to Seton Hall. Chiara Cucco continued her stellar play on defense, averaging 5.38 digs per set over the weekend. Cucco had double-digit digs in every match, including a career-high 32 in a four-set victory over Kent State. Beatriz Alves contributed to the Pride's success in facilitating the offense. Alves averaged 9.88 assists per set in addition to 2.31 digs per set and posted back-to-back double-doubles to conclude the weekend. Hofstra remains on the road for another four games this week. First, the Pride travel across Long Island to face Stony Brook Tuesday, then head to the Ellis Rowland Memorial Tournament. The tournament field consists of Princeton, Cleveland State and host Colgate.

▪ **James Madison** (5-1, 0-0 CAA) won all three matches in straight sets at the Campbell Invitational. The Dukes lead the CAA as a team in assists per set (12.48) and kills per set (13.29) this season. Miëtte Veldman returned to the court for the Dukes, starting her season on a good note. Veldman tallied 33 kills in just seven sets over the weekend to lead James Madison. Sophia David was named the tournament's MVP after hitting .391 with 28 kills while adding 13 blocks. James Madison travels to Richmond for the VCU invitational for a pair of games this weekend. The Dukes will face host VCU on Thursday before a big-time matchup with No. 4 Ohio State on Friday.

▪ **UNCW** (1-4, 0-0 CAA) fell in back-to-back matches to Jacksonville over the weekend. UNCW was originally scheduled to face Drake, New Orleans and Jacksonville; however, Drake and New Orleans failed to make the trip due to travel issues. Katie Lanz paced the Seahawks with 12 kills and added nine digs in a five-set loss in the first match. Brianna Haggerty also contributed nine kills and a team-high 16 digs. Claire Sawyer recorded her second career double-double in the second match, a four-set loss, with career-highs of 28 assists and 11 digs, while Haggerty continued her strong play with a team-high 15 kills. The Seahawks visit Coastal Carolina this weekend for the Chanticleer Classic. UNCW will face East Carolina, Radford and host Coastal Carolina.

▪ **Northeastern** (2-4, 0-0 CAA) picked up a win versus Mercer before falling in back-to-back matches against Denver and Northern Colorado. Evelyn Gonzalez posted double-doubles in the first and final matches of the weekend. First, picking up 11 kills and 11 digs against Mercer followed by 10 kills and 10 digs versus Northern Colorado. Gonzalez leads the CAA in double-doubles and has recorded five in six games this season. Kayla Martin pitched in a solid effort on defense, recording 55 digs (4.58 per set) in the three matches out west. Northeastern returns to the east coast this weekend as the Huskies host Villanova, Bryant and Harvard, after a mid-week matchup with Boston College on Tuesday.

▪ **Towson** (8-0, 0-0 CAA) continued its winning ways defeating four straight opponents this weekend. The Tigers picked up straight-set victories over Stony Brook, Princeton and Morgan State, while defeating Loyola (Md.) in a five-set bout. Nina Cajic led the charge, recording 41 kills (2.93 per set) on a .437 hitting percentage while tallying 13 blocks (0.93 per set). Cajic posted double-digit kills in three of the four matches and led Towson with a team-high 15 kills against Loyola (Md.). Defensively, Rachel Hess pitched in a great weekend, digging 73 opponent attacks (5.21 per set), including a career-high 35 digs in Towson's victory over Loyola (Md.). Cajic was named to the all-tournament team, while Hess was named the tournament's MOP. Towson will stay at SECU Arena to host the Tiger Invitational this upcoming weekend. The Tigers will square off with FAU, Lehigh, Temple and Norfolk State.

▪ **William & Mary** (2-2, 0-0 CAA) dropped a pair of matches at the UVA Tournament over the weekend. The Tribe fell to Winthrop in four sets for their first setback this season before falling to Akron in a five-set match the following day. Anne Louise Seekford posted a double-double against Winthrop with a team-high 11 kills and 12 digs. Against Akron, Julia Brown did all she could by recording 21 kills on a .606 hitting percentage while blocking eight attacks, but the Tribe would fall 15-12 in the fifth set. William & Mary will host Hampton on Friday for the team's home opener.

SHOOT ME STRAIGHT

- 10 of the 16 wins in CAA volleyball this week came in straight sets.
- Delaware earned three straight sweeps, defeating NJIT, Fordham and Maryland Eastern Shore. The Blue Hens have won four of their five matches this season in straight sets.
- Elon was victorious two matches in a row, defeating Presbyterian and Furman 3-0. It marks the first time since 2017 the Phoenix has earned back-to-back straight-set victories.
- James Madison won three consecutive matches in straight sets with victories over Alabama State, Campbell and North Carolina Central.
- Towson won three of its four matches this weekend in three sets. The Tigers have now won nine of the last 12 regular-season matches in straight sets dating back to last season.

ALL I DO IS WIN, WIN, WIN NO MATTER WHAT

▪ Two-time defending champion Towson improved to 8-0 this season, winning all four matches this weekend. The Tigers have now won 32 consecutive regular-season matches. Towson's last regular-season loss came on September 13, 2019, versus Coastal Carolina.
