The Hornets will travel to the Southwest Baptist Thanksgiving Classic to be held in Bolivar, Mo.

LAST TIMEOUT

The Emporia State men's basketball team hit six three pointers and were five of six from the charity strip in the final 24 second to pull out a 72-67 win over Bethany. The six three points would prove to be the difference as both teams hit 24 shots from the field on the night. Taylor Euler led the Hornets with 16 points shooting .500 from behind the three-point line. Derrell Conner and Chris Sights each added 11 points for the Hornets.

THE COACHES

Shaun Vandiver is 2-1 in his first year at ESU. The former NBA round draft pick spent the last ten years as an assistant coach at the NCAA Division I level, most recently at Boise State University. As a player he led Hutchinson CC's to the 1988 NJCAA National Championship before earning first-team All-Big 8 honors at Colorado.

Terry Evans is 196-81 in his 10th season with Central Oklahoma. Evans and Vandiver met on the floor as players when Vandiver was playing for the Colorado Buffaloes and Evans for Oklahoma Sooners. The last time the two met was in the semi-finals of 1991 NIT.

Steve Jenkins is 544-388 in his 30th season with Evangel.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENTS

Central Oklahoma is 3-2 entering this week with losses to Southwestern Oklahoma and Tarleton State. They are led by Tyler Phillips who enters the week averaging 15.4 points and 5.8 rebounds per game.

Evangel is 7-1 on the season and have won five straight heading into this week. They are led by Zack Kleine and Jayme Donnelly who are both averaging 12.5 points per game.

SERIES HISTORY

This will be the 19th meeting between ESU and UCO with the series all knotted up at nine apiece.

This will be the third meeting between the Hornets and Evangel with ESU leading the series 2-0 overall.

LAST TIME VS. THE FIELD

Lamar Wilbern had 18 points and 11 rebounds for ESU as they fell 76-73 to #17 Central Oklahoma on Nov. 23, 2009.

Tyrell Sledge had 18 points and Shawn Herman added 15 as ESU knocked off Evangel 84-67 on Nov. 25, 2005.

ESU opens MIAA play on Dec. 30 when they travel to Northwest Missouri for a scheduled 7:30 p.m. tip-off.

FRIENDLY CONFINES

ESU is 2-0 at home this season. They went 11-3 at home last season and were 8-3 in the MIAA when playing at home. ESU has won 104 of their last 134 games in White Auditorium. Twenty-one of the 30 losses have been by less than ten points. The Hornets are 327-138 (.703) since 1979 in White Auditorium. ESU has had a winning home record for nine straight years in White Auditorium.

TOURNAMENT TALK

ESU is one of just three men's teams to make it to Kansas City every year the MIAA post-season tournament has been played in Municipal Auditorium. ESU is 5-14 overall in the MIAA Tournament, 4-10 in the first round, 1-3 in the semi-finals and 0-1 in championship games. Since the Tournament moved to Kansas City ESU is 5-9, 4-5 in the first round, 1-3 in the semi's and 0-1 in championships.

STEEL CITY

Forward **Antonio DiMaria** (Sr./Pittsburgh, Penn.) had five rebounds against Bethany. He had 12 points hitting four treys at Missouri State. He scored 11 points with a team high seven rebounds against Friends. He connected on three treys against the Falcons. He is averaging 8.7 points and 4.7 rebounds per game. He led ESU with nine points against Wichita State in exhibition play. **In 2010-11** played in 26 games for Utah. He was a first-team All-Region IX selection for Casper (Wyo.) CC before going to the Utes. He averaged 17.0 points and 6.0 rebounds per game with 77 made three-pointers at Casper. He spent a year at The Patterson School and averaged 10.0 points per game for a team that went 30-4 and was the second ranked prep school in the nation. He scored 1,572 points at Bishop Canevin HS in Pittsburgh.

TOE THE LAW

Guard **Tola Lawal** (Sr./Brooklyn, N.Y.) had seven points against Bethany. He scored a game high 14 points on the road at Missouri State. He scored eight points with two steals and two rebounds against Friends. He is tied for the team lead averaging 9.7 points per game. He had eight points against Wichita State. **In 2010-11** he averaged 2.6 points per game and started six games for Morgan State. He was a two-time NJCAA All-American at Erie CC where he scored 1,104 points. He was named freshman male athlete of the year by the Western New York Athletic Conference. He was an All-State athlete at Canarsie High School.

SET YOUR SIGHTS

Guard **Chris Sights** (Jr./Ft. Worth, Texas) had 11 points for the Hornets against Bethany. he had 12 points for the Hornets against Missouri State. He scored six points with five assists and five rebounds against Friends. He tied for the team lead averaging 9.7 points per game. He had six points against WSU. **In 2010-11** he started six of 29 games for Prairie View A&M. He was a two-time First-Team All-District performer for Mansfield Summit HS and averaged 8.0 assists as a senior.

TROY FROM SPARTA

Forward **Troy Pierce** (sr./Emporia, Kan.) led the team with nine rebounds against Bethany. He had a team leading seven rebounds against Missouri State. He had a team high three steals against Friends. He is leading the team averaging 6.0 rebounds per contest. He had six points and three boards at WSU. **In 2010-11** he played in 31 games for Charleston Southern. He shot .472 from the field and was fourth on the team in blocked shots. He averaged 9.9 points and 5.4 rebounds per game on .545 shooting from the field for Butler CC as he helped the Grizzlies win the Region VI championship and the Jayhawk Conference championship. He was an All-Centennial League Defensive team member for Emporia HS.

TAYLOR MADE

Guard **Taylor Euler** (Jr./Emporia, Kan.) had a team high 16 points against Bethany. He scored nine points on three of five shooting from behind the three-point line with six assists and five rebounds against Friends to open the season. He is averaging 8.3 points and 3.3 rebounds per game. **In 2010-11** he had a season high 18 points off the bench in ESU's White Auditorium finale win over Ft. Hays State. He scored 13 points at Washburn. He had 11 points at NWMSU.

I SEE THE DAY

Forward **Justin Ikhide** (Jr./Washington, D.C.) had eight points and six rebounds against Bethany. He scored a career high 20 points on seven of eight shooting from the field and six of seven shooting from the free throw line against Friends. Is averaging 9.3 points per game for ESU. **In 2010-11** he averaged 10.2 points and 6.3 rebounds for Pratt CC. He played 17 games at Montgomery-Rockville (Md.) CC as a freshman, averaging 11.0 points, 6.1 rebounds and 1.7 assists per game.

DC

Guard **Derrell Conner** (Sr./East Chicago, Ind.) had 11 points going seven of eight from the line against Bethany. He scored 17 points with five rebounds and four assists against Friends. He is averaging 9.3 points and 3.0 rebounds per game. He had five rebounds to lead ESU at Wichita State. In 2010-11 he played 32 games for Nevada. He averaged 4.5 points and 1.5 assists for the Wolfpack and reached double figures in scoring five times. He led Kankakee (Ill.) CC to a 54-12 record from 2008-10, including a Region IV championship as a sophomore. He averaged 12.3 points, 4.8 assists and 1.8 steals as a sophomore to lead Kankakee in all of those categories. He led East Chicago Central HS to a state championship as a junior.

BUCK-A-ROO

Forward **Andrew Bucholz** (Fr./Lone Tree, Colo.) had seven points and four rebounds against Bethany. He scored eight points on three of five shooting with a pair of three pointers against Friends. Averaging 6.0 points per game for ESU. He became the first Hornet freshman to start a season opener for ESU since Scott Harkness in 1995. In 2010-11 he led Highlands Ranch HS to the Colorado state semifinals.

ROCK AND ROLL ALL NIGHT

Forward **Chris Simmons** (Sr./St. Louis, Mo.) had six rebounds off the bench against Friends. He attended Northern Oklahoma Community College for two seasons. He averaged 9.2 points and 7.6 rebounds per game as a senior for Cardinal Ritter HS.

CAPTAIN TRAVIS

Guard **Travis Dykman** (So./Crandall, Texas) hit the only three-pointer he took against Friends. Averaging 1.5 points and 0.5 rebounds per game. He had a career high eight points and a career high eight rebounds against Pittsburg State last season. He had one rebound and one assist in his first career start against Nebraska-Omaha. He had four points against #5 Kansas State.

ANDRE THE GIANT

Guard **Andre Phillips** (Jr.Liberal, Kan.) averaged 1.4 points per game last season and 0.5 rebounds per game for Garden City CC after graduating from Liberal HS.

THE FROSH

Forward **Nick Mayes** (Fr./Laramie, Wyo.) averaged 12.7 points per game, 7.3 rebounds and 1.9 steals per game for Laramie HS.

Forward **Michael Harris** (Fr./Conway Springs, Kan.) will likely redshirt this season. He earned second-team all-state honors from the KBCA for Conway Springs HS. He averaged 13.0 points and 8.2 rebounds per game as he led the Cardinals to a 16-7 record.

ROAD WARRIORS

ESU is 0-1 on the road so far this season with their only loss coming to Division I Missouri State. The Hornets were 4-8 on the road last year with one of the losses to Kansas State while the Wildcats were ranked #5 in the nation and two to teams ranked in the top 15 of NCAA Division II at the time.

PLAYING WITH THE BIG BOYS

There have been 22 match-ups between Emporia State and an NCAA Division I team since 2000. Seventeen of the games have come in exhibition action. Six of the last seven matchups have come against teams ranked in Top 25 Coaches Poll.
