GRADUATION SATURDAY

The #23 Lady Hornets take on Truman following ESU's Winter Commencement in White Auditorium. This is the Lady Hornets third straight game against a team receiving votes in the WBCA National Top 25. This will be the last game action for both teams before the NCAA mandated break between Dec. 20-26.

LAST TIME OUT

Heather Robben scored a career high 31 points to lead the Emporia State Lady Hornets to an 80-66 victory over #22 Central Missouri on Saturday night in White Auditorium. The win was ESU's second straight over a nationally ranked opponent following their 60-54 win over #13 Northeastern State on Tuesday. The Lady Hornets jumped out to a 9-4 lead and never trailed in the game. Robben was joined in double figures by Rachel Hanf with 14 points and six assists. Merissa Quick had ten rebounds to lead the Lady Hornets. ESU shot a blistering .560 from the field including .526 from behind the three-point line.

THE COACHES

Jory Collins is 27-10 in his second year as the head coach of the Lady Hornets and is 4-2 vs. Top 25 teams. This is his 11th season on the Lady Hornet coaching staff and ESU has advanced to the NCAA tournament in eight of his ten previous seasons. He is 2-0 against TSU.

Michael Smith is 39-51 in his fourth year at Truman and was 102-34 in four seasons at Moberly Area CC. He is 0-6 against ESU.

SCOUTING THE BULLDOGS

Truman is 8-1 overall and 3-1 in the MIAA after their 68-66 win at Washburn on Saturday. It was their second win over a Top 25 team this season. Jennifer Conway and Becka McHenry both average 13.4 points per game to lead four Bulldogs in double figures. TSU leads the MIAA in assist/turnover ratio.

THE SERIES

The Lady Hornets lead the all-time series 40-6 and has won 19 of the last 20 meetings. ESU has won 19 straight games against TSU in White Auditorium dating back to the 1993-94 season. The Lady Hornets and Bulldogs played for the 1999 NCAA South Central Regional championship with the Lady Hornets winning 110-93 in White Auditorium. ESU is 303-79 and TSU is 142-191 since then.

LAST TIME VS. TRUMAN

Alli Volkens scored six of the final nine points for the #14 Lady Hornets in ESU's 69-67 victory over Truman in White Auditorium. Volkens ended the game with 23 points, 11 rebounds and four blocked shots for the Lady Hornets. ESU used a 16-2 run capped by Rachel Hanf's three-pointer to take a 60-55 lead with 6:28 remaining. Volkens gave ESU the lead at 67-65 with 40.2 seconds left. TSU tied it on a lay-up with 8.3 seconds left. Volkens was fouled with 2.0 second left. She hit both to give the Lady Hornets the 69-67 win. Rachel Hanf added 13 points on four three pointers for ESU.

UP NEXT

The Lady Hornets will not play again until a New Year's Eve contest at Southwest Baptist. Tip-off in Bolivar, Mo. is set for 1:30 p.m.

HOME COOKIN'

ESU has won 195 of the last 211 games at home. They have only lost ten games to unranked NCAA teams in White Auditorium since 1997. ESU has not lost consecutive home games since Feb. 7-10, 1996. The Lady Hornets are 347-85 (.803) overall since 1979 at home and hold the MIAA record for consecutive home wins with 62 set from 1997-2001.

BRING IT ON

The Lady Hornets are 49-32 (.605) against Top 25 teams since 1997-98 and 4-2 under Jory Collins. ESU is 19-7 (.731) at home against Top 25 teams since 1997. The Lady Hornets have 14 wins against Top 10 teams, including four against #1 teams in the last six seasons. ESU is 17-11 (.607) in neutral site games with top 25 foes since 1997.

ROSS AND RACHEL

Rachel Hanf (Jr./Paola, Kan.) scored 14 points with a team high six assists against then #22 Central Missouri. She now has 110 career three pointers to rank tenth on the Lady Hornets all-time list. **She is ranked fourth in the nation in three-point percentage, 27th in field goal percentage, 39th in made threes, and 47th in assist to turnover ratio. She is ranked eighth in the MIAA in scoring, fourth in made three-pointers and three-point percentage, fifth in field goal percentage and assist to turnover margin, 11th in assists and is 12th in steals.** She was a perfect five of five from behind the three-point line and finished with 17 points at Northeastern State. She was eight of 11 from the field for 18 points at Missouri Western and dished a team high six assists. She led ESU with 18 points on seven of ten shooting at Northwest Missouri. She scored 15 points with three assists and three steals against West Florida. She had her second career double-double with 15 points and 11 rebounds against Ala.-Huntsville. She scored 11 points with two steals and a pair of three-pointers against Rockhurst. Last season she hit back to back threes to give ESU a ten point lead against Washburn in the semifinals of the MIAA Tournament. She scored 17 points on seven of nine shooting from the field with three three-pointers against Pittsburg State. She had a career high six assists at Missouri Western last season. She had her first career double-double with 12 points and 11 rebounds at Pittsburg State last season. She had a career high 20 points against Southwest Baptist, with four made three-pointers. She scored 11 points with seven rebounds and five assists at Tulsa with three three-pointers. **She scored 15 points on three of three shooting from behind the arc against Ft. Lewis in the national championship game. She was named the 2010 MIAA Freshman of the Year.**

ROCKIN' ROBBEN

Heather Robben (Sr./Maize, Kan.) was named MIAA Player of the Week after scoring a career high 31 points against #22 Central Missouri, following 15 points and four assists at #13 Northeastern State. **She is ranked 30th in the nation in free throw percentage and is ranked 11th in the MIAA in scoring, second in free throw percentage, and is seventh in made threes.** She has hit nine straight from the free throw line over her last three games. She scored ten points with six rebounds at Northwest Missouri. She scored 13 points with three three pointers at West Florida. She had two blocks and two steals against Ala.-Huntsville. She had five points and five rebounds against Rockhurst. She scored 21 points with four assists at Newman. She scored 19 points with four steals and three rebounds against Evangel in exhibition play. She was three of four from behind the arc against the Crusaders. She had nine points and two assists at Kansas in exhibition play. She started seven games and played in 32 for Wichita State last season. She was a two-time NJCAA All-American at Hutchinson CC, earning third-team honors as a sophomore. She set Blue Dragon records with 1,072 points and an .853 free throw percentage in her two years.

CUMMINGS AND GOINGS

Jocelyn Cummings (Jr./Overland Park, Kan.) was three of three from the field against Central Missouri. **She is ranked eighth in the nation in assist to turnover ratio and is ranked third in the MIAA in assists and second in assist to turnover ratio.** She has led ESU in assists in five of the last seven games after dishing four against Northeastern State. She is routinely given the defensive assignment on the opponent's leading scorer. She led ESU with four assists at Northwest Missouri. She had ten points on four of six shooting with five assists at West Florida. She scored 12 points with a team high four assists against Ala.-Huntsville. She had five points and a career high seven assists against Rockhurst. She scored eight points with five rebounds against Newman in the opener. Last year she tied her career high with 17 points against Central Missouri in the first round of the MIAA Tournament. She had 13 points and six boards at Washburn. She scored ten points including a go ahead, coast to coast drive with 15 seconds left against Pittsburg State. She was five for five with two three-pointers for 12 points at Neb.-Omaha. She had a then career high six assists against Truman. She had 11 points with a career high three made three-pointers against Washburn in White Auditorium. She scored a career high 17 points at Lincoln and added seven rebounds, three assists and two steals. She had a game high eight rebounds in the regional final against Northeastern State as a freshman. She had 13 points and 11 rebounds against in the 2009-10 season opener against Benedictine to become the first Lady Hornet freshman to record a double-double in her first game since Emily Bloss did it in 1997-98.

START UP

Kelsey Balcom (So./Olathe, Kan.) had a string of five straight games in double figures snapped when she was held to five points with six rebounds at Northeastern State. **She is ranked 26th in the MIAA in scoring, is 15th in free throw percentage, and 18th in rebounding.** She scored 12 points at Missouri Western. She scored ten points with five rebounds, three assists and two steals at Northwest Missouri. She was named MIAA Player of the Week after averaging 19.5 points and 5.0 rebounds per game last week. She had 13 points and six rebounds at West Florida. She tied her career high with 26 points on ten of 14 shooting from the field against Ala.-Huntsville. She scored 11 points with nine rebounds, three steals and two blocks against Rockhurst. She had just four points and four rebounds at Newman. **She was named the MIAA Freshman of the Year last season, making her the fifth Lady Hornet in the last ten years to win the award.** She also earned honorable mention All-MIAA honors. She recorded a double double with ten points and then rebounds against Northwest Missouri in the 2011 MIAA Championship game. She had 16 points, 12 in the first half, and nine rebounds against Washburn in the semifinals. She had her third double-double in four games with 16 points and 11 rebounds against Ft. Hays State. She scored 14 points and had a team high three assists and two steals at Washburn. She had her first career double-double with 11 points and 12 rebounds against Pittsburg State. She scored 20 points at Missouri Southern. She was named MIAA Player of the Week for her efforts against Washburn and Lincoln. She had 13 points and nine rebounds against the Lady Blues in White Auditorium. She led ESU with a career high 26 points on ten of 12 shooting from the field with eight rebounds at Lincoln. She scored 21 points against Missouri Southern. She scored 15 points with a team high three assists against Northwest Missouri in White Auditorium. She scored 11 points with eight rebounds at Tulsa in her Lady Hornet debut. She scored 335 points to finish seventh in freshman scoring at ESU.

QUICKEN

Merissa Quick (Fr./Cheney, Kan.) had a career high five blocked shots against Central Missouri and her second straight ten rebound game. **She is ranked 49th in the nation in blocked shots and is 28th in the MIAA in scoring, sixth in rebounding, and fourth in blocked shots.** She is shooting .574 from the field on the year. She was one point shy of a double-double with nine points and ten rebounds at Northeastern State. She tied for the team lead with seven rebounds at Missouri Western. She recorded her first career double double with 15 points and 11 rebounds at Northwest Missouri. She scored 11 points with seven rebounds against West Florida. She had 12 points and nine rebounds against Ala.-Huntsville. She scored a team high 16 points on five of nine shooting with eight rebounds against Rockhurst. She went four of four from the field with four rebounds and two blocks in 14 minutes at Newman. She was three for three from the field for nine points with five rebounds against Evangel in exhibition action. She had eight points, nine rebounds and two blocks at Kansas in exhibition action. She earned first-team All-Kansas honors as well as first-team All-Class 4A. She averaged 19.3 points and 10.2 rebounds as she led the Cardinals to a 52 game winning streak, including a state championship as a junior.

FLOTTASTIC

Kathryn Flott (Fr./Olpe, Kan.) scored eight points on three of three shooting from the field and two of two from the free throw line against Central Missouri. She played a season high 20 minutes at Northeastern State. She scored seven points with a career high seven rebounds at Missouri Western. She had nine points and six rebounds at West Florida. She scored seven points and went five of six from the free throw line against Ala.-Huntsville. She scored ten points with four rebounds and three steals against Evangel in exhibition play. She was first-team All-Kansas, scored over 2,000 career points and led Olpe HS to back to back undefeated seasons.

EGG HER ON

Rheanna Egli (So./Ankeny, Iowa) had five points and three assists at Missouri Western. She scored six points on two of two shooting from behind the three point line at West Florida. Last year she had ten points and six assists in the MIAA Championship Game against Northwest Missouri. She scored nine points on three of five shooting against Washburn in the semifinals. She scored 13 points with five assists against Lincoln. She tied her career high with 14 points against Central Missouri last season in White Auditorium. She had a career high four three pointers at Missouri Western to finish with 12 points. She dished a career high six assists at Lincoln after giving out a previous career high five assists at Pittsburg State. She scored a career high 14 points against Southwest Baptist. **She was three of three from behind the three-point line at Truman.** She scored 11 points and dished three assists against Concordia-St. Paul. She scored seven points on three of five shooting with a three pointer and three assists at Tulsa.

DO IT AGAIN

Haley Parker (So./Lawrence, Kan.) hit her first three-pointer of the season against Central Missouri. She had two rebounds at Northeastern State. She did not play in Florida with a foot injury. She scored seven points with two steals against Evangel in exhibition play. She was six of six from the line and scored eight points at Kansas. Last season she scored a career high 14 points on six of ten shooting from the field at Missouri Southern in her first start in MIAA play. **She was three of four from the field against Truman.** She scored nine points against Washburn. She scored six points at Lincoln and was four of four from the free throw line. She had six points on three of four shooting against Concordia-St. Paul.

SAWING WOOD

Sarah Wood (Fr./Superior, Neb.) is shooting .619 from the field this season. She scored four points with three rebounds at West Florida. She had five rebounds against Ala.-Huntsville. She was four of six from the field and finished with 13 points against Rockhurst. She scored five points on two of three shooting from the field with a team high seven rebounds at Newman. She averaged 20.2 points per game as a senior on her way to all-state honors in Nebraska.

NIGHTMARE ON COMMERCIAL STREET

Kayla Krueger (Sr./Olpe, Kan.) is the only four year player on the Lady Hornets roster this season. She scored three points with four rebounds in eight minutes at West Florida. She pulled down six rebounds against Central Missouri last year. She matched her season high for the second straight game with five points against Missouri Southern. She scored five points with a put back and three pointer to give ESU the lead for good against Southwest Baptist. She had five points and three rebounds against Neb.-Omaha. She redshirted ESU's 2010 National Championship season. She had a career high eight rebounds against Tabor as a sophomore. She scored a career high six points with a career high four assists against Avila.

CAPTAIN'S LOG

Dava Logsdon (Sr./Wichita, Kan.) had two points, a rebound, an assist, a block and a steal against Evangel in exhibition action. She scored a career high five points with a career high four rebounds against Truman. She scored four points with a three-pointer, rebound, assist and steal against Missouri Southern. She was a red-shirt on the Lady Hornets 2010 National Championship team after transferring from Newman. She was an all-conference pick at Rose Hill HS before missing her senior season with a knee injury.

SHAQ ATTACK

Shandelyn Stewart (Fr./Kansas City, Mo.) injured her knee in practice last week and her status is doubtful for the rest of the year. She had a steal against Newman. She hit a three pointer and had three steals at Kansas in exhibition play. She was named second-team all-state as a senior after earning first-team all-state honors as a junior for Bishop Miege HS.

SUSTAINED EXCELLENCE

Emporia State won their first national championship in 2010, 12 years after making their first appearance in the national title game. The Lady Hornets received votes in this year's preseason ranking in the USA Today/WBCA Coaches Poll, the first time in eight years ESU has not opened the season in the top 15. Eleven times in the last 14 years the Lady Hornets have opened the season in the top 15 nationally. ESU has been ranked in the WBCA Top 25 at some point in each of the last 14 seasons. **The Lady Hornets have a streak of 15 straight winning seasons, the longest active streak in the MIAA.** The Lady Hornets have won seven MIAA regular season championships in the last 14 years. They have made 13 trips to the NCAA Tournament in the last 15 years. ESU has made five Elite Eight appearances in that time, tied with Delta State, Northern Kentucky and North Dakota for the most since 1997.

RANKINGS

The Lady Hornets returned to the ESPN/USA Today/WBCA Coaches Poll this week with a #22 national ranking. ESU has received votes in 210 of the last 214 polls. The Lady Hornets have been in the Coaches Top 25 193 weeks since first appearing in the 1997-98 preseason poll. ESU ended the 2009-10 season ranked #1 after winning the national championship. The Lady Hornets were first ranked #1 in the Jan. 11, 2005 poll. ESU was last ranked #1 in the regular season in the Nov. 28, 2006 poll after opening at #3 in the 2006-07 Preseason Poll. There are currently four MIAA teams in the WBCA Top 25 with three other MIAA schools receiving votes. **ESU will play 15 games against teams currently ranked or receiving votes in the WBCA Poll and are presently 4-1 in those games.**

EXCELLENCE

Since the incoming freshman class of 1994-95, every four year player at ESU has won at least a share of an MIAA regular season championship, a regional championship, or played in the MIAA Tournament Championship game. The Lady Hornets ended 2009-10 ranked #1 in the ESPN/USA Today/WBCA Coaches Poll after winning the national championship. The Lady Hornets have spent 130 polls in the top ten since 1997-98. Prior to the Jan. 24, 2007 poll, when they dropped to #11, the Lady Hornets had been in the top ten for 36 straight polls over three years. After advancing to the Elite Eight for the fourth time in eight years in 2006, ESU opened the 2006-07 season with a #3 preseason ranking in the USA Today/WBCA Coaches Poll. It was the highest preseason ranking ever for the Lady Hornets by the WBCA. The Lady Hornets have been ranked in the WBCA Top 25 in each of the last 15 seasons and have received votes in 210 of 214 polls during that time.

BY THE NUMBERS

The Lady Hornets have topped the 100-point barrier 65 times and have eclipsed the 110 point mark 27 times in their history. Since 1997-98, the Lady Hornets are 224-2 when scoring at least 80 points. The first loss was to North Dakota, 87-81 in the 1999 Final Four and the second came at West Texas A&M, 86-83 in the 2009 NCAA South Central Regional Semifinals. ESU was 167-22 in the previous 23 seasons when scoring at least 80 points. ESU has led the MIAA in scoring in 12 of the last 15 seasons and were second last season. Conversely ESU is 122-1 all-time when holding opponents to 50 points or less.

HERE THEY COME

ESU has played in front of at least 1,000 fans in White Auditorium in every home game since January 2, 1999 - a span of 186 games. The Lady Hornets averaged 2,052 per game to lead the MIAA in attendance for the ninth time in 14 years and rank second nationally. The 3,863 against WU in White Auditorium was the largest crowd in the MIAA last season. The Lady Hornets averaged 2,118 per game and ranked third in the nation in 2009-10. ESU ranked fourth nationally in attendance in 2008-09 at 2,051 after finishing second in the nation in average attendance with 2,273 in 2007-08. The Lady Hornets averaged a school record 2,684 fans over 13 home dates in 2005-06 to finish third in the nation and led the nation with an average attendance of 2,348 fans for their 15 home dates in 2004-05. Emporia State has been in the top six of the nation in attendance in each of the last 14 years.

ON THE AIR

The Lady Hornets have been seen on national television four times in the last 14 years and are 3-1 in those games following their 65-53 national championship win over Ft. Lewis on ESPN2 in 2010. ESU's 97-94 overtime victory over then #1 Gannon was shown on ESPNU. The Lady Hornets 74-67 victory over Washburn in 2007 was televised nation wide on CSTV. It was the first time a basketball game was televised nationally from White Auditorium. It was the first time an MIAA regular season basketball game, men or women, had been telecast nationwide. The Lady Hornets national championship game against North Dakota in 1998 was seen nationwide on ESPN. Last year's Turnpike Tussle game against Washburn in White Auditorium on Jan. 15 was available to over 1.5 million homes across Mid-America on the MIAA Broadcasting Network. The MIAA has made AmericaOne the exclusive home for broadband broadcasts of all MIAA athletics. Games can be accessed through the league website, individual school sites or www.b2tv.com.

LET'S HANG SOME MORE

Aneta Kausaite, Jurgita Kausaite, Tara Holloway-Churchill, Emily Bloss-Carpenter and Michelle Stueve-Corpening have had their jerseys retired in White Auditorium for earning All-American honors at Emporia State, graduating and playing at least two years for the Lady Hornets. Cassondra Boston had her jersey retired at half time of the Lady Hornets game with Washburn on Jan. 15, 2011.

ALL-TIME ALL-MIAA TOURNAMENT TEAM

Lady Hornets Emily Bloss, Tara Holloway and Jurgita Kausaite were named to the ten person All-Time All-MIAA Tournament Team by a panel of past and current sports information directors and media members prior to the 2007 Tournament. Bloss averaged 17 points in her twelve tournament games, including a tournament record 76 points as a senior. Holloway scored 151 points in her career. Kausaite scored 120 points in six tournament games. Emporia State's is 24-11 all-time in MIAA Tournament play and the Lady Hornets are the last team to win four straight MIAA titles.

LADY HORNET SUCCESS ON THE COURT...

The Lady Hornets have the best record in MIAA play in the 21st century. ESU is 176-49 (.782) in MIAA play since the 2000 season and 303-79 (.793) overall in that time. The Lady Hornets dominance increases if you add two more years to the equation. Since the 1997-98 season, ESU is 207-50 (.805) in MIAA play and 366-83 (.815) overall. The Lady Hornets have been ranked in the top ten of the ESPN/USA Today/WBCA Coaches Poll 130 times, the most of any current NCAA Division II school. ESU has won seven MIAA Championships, have been to the Regional Championship, or "Sweet 16", eight times, have made four trips to the Elite Eight, three to the Final Four, two national title game appearances and won the 2010 NCAA Division II National Championship. The Lady Hornets are the only team to win four straight undisputed (untied regular season and tournament) MIAA Championships pulling the trick from 1998-2001. They have been in eight of the last 14 MIAA Tournament Championship Games with four tourney titles.

...AND IN THE CLASSROOM

The Lady Hornets posted a 3.18 combined GPA last year. Alli Volkens was named to the Capital One Academic All-District first team. Michelle Stueve was named to the ESPN The Magazine Academic All-America second-team in 2008-09 and was a three-time Academic All-District VII performer. Emily Bloss was a three-time Academic All-American and was named the Academic All-American of the Year in 2001.

ABOUT THE SOUTH CENTRAL REGION

South Central Region teams have advanced to the NCAA Division II Championship Game on nine occasions including five of the last 14 years. Five of the nine teams have come from the MIAA, including Emporia State who won the title with a 65-53 victory over Ft. Lewis in St. Joseph, Mo. in 2010 after falling in the 1998 title game to North Dakota 92-76 in Pine Bluff, Ark. ESU was the first team from the region to make the final four since 2005 and is the first to make multiple trips to the championship game since Central Missouri in 1984 and 1985. ESU joins two other MIAA teams that have won national championships, Central Missouri in 1984 and WU in 2005. ESU is 39-8 (.830) against the LSC and Heartland Conference since 1997-98. This year the Great American Conference has joined the South Central Region. Arkansas Tech is a member of the GAC and has been to the Elite Eight the last two seasons from the South Region.

ROAD WARRIORS

ESU is 177-66 (.728) away from home, 59-20 (.746) in neutral site games and 38-9 (.809) against non-MIAA teams at neutral sites since 1997-98 with four of the losses in the Elite Eight. The Lady Hornets have gone on the road to defeat the #1 ranked team in the nation twice in regional tournaments and have eliminated the host team in three tournaments. The win over Gannon in the 2010 Final Four was ESU's fourth against a #1 team in the nation since 2005. The Lady Hornets are 94-34 (.734) on the road in MIAA league play since 1997-98.

TOUGH ENOUGH

The MIAA is 49-13 against outside competition through Nov. 30 with seven of the losses on the road, including two to Division I schools. The MIAA was 38-18 against outside competition last season. The MIAA has produced two of the last seven National Champions and three schools have been to the Elite Eight since 2008. There are currently two MIAA schools in the WBCA Top 25 with four other teams receiving votes. Ten of the 11 teams in the league have a winning percentage of over .600 outside the league since the beginning of the 1999-2000 season, with the one school below .600 being Lincoln.

CHAMPIONSHIP EXPERIENCE

The Lady Hornets national championship in 2010 came in the school's second trip to the title game. ESU has made 13 trips to the NCAA Tournament in the last 15 years and they have reached the Sweet 16 eight times. They have won five NCAA South Central Regional Championships to advance to the Elite Eight and have been to three Final Fours. They have won seven MIAA regular season championships, four MIAA tournament championships and five NCAA South Central Regional championships since 1997. The Lady Hornets have played in eight NCAA Regional Championship Games and eight MIAA Tournament Championship Games in the last 14 years. In regular season action, ESU has finished in the top three of the MIAA in 13 of the last 14 years.

LOCK DOWN

Although the Lady Hornets have been among the national leaders in a number of offensive categories over the last 14 years, the Emporia State defense has been solid as well. ESU led the nation in scoring average during the 2000-01 season, allowing just 50.6 points per game to rank 20th all-time in single season defense in NCAA Division II. The Lady Hornets have not allowed a team to score 100 points against them since a 106-75 loss to West Texas A&M on Nov. 29, 1991 a streak of 611 games. ESU has held their last 49 opponents to under .500 shooting from the field and have only allowed a team to make half their shots once in the last 82 games.

END GAME

The Lady Hornets are 176-4 (.978) when leading at the 5:00 mark since the start of the 2004-05 season and are 343-10 (.972) since 1997 with a lead at the 5:00 mark.

STREAKS AND SUCH

- The Lady Hornets have hit a three pointer in 174 straight games dating back to a zero for 14 effort at Washburn on Feb. 15, 2006.
- The Lady Hornets have held their last 611 opponents to under 100 points dating back to a 106-75 loss to West Texas A&M in Hays, Kan. on Nov. 29, 1991.
- The Lady Hornets ended the longest winning streak in NCAA Division II history (51 games) with their 61-59 overtime victory over Washburn on March 13, 2006 in the South Central Regional final and the longest single season winning streak (37 games) with their 97-94 overtime victory over Gannon on March 24, 2010 in the national semifinals.
- Emporia State has gone to four national championship games in a sport in the last six years - softball in 2006 and 2008, baseball in 2009 and women's basketball in 2010.
