**HILL TIES FOR FOURTH AT PINEHURST**

**INTERCOLLEGIATE:** Junior **Graham Hill** fired a 69 in the final round of the Pinehurst Intercollegiate Tuesday afternoon to finish tied for fourth place with a total of 216 (75-72-69) here at Pinehurst No. 8. Hill's round of 69 was just the third sub-70 round of the tournament and the only turned in during the final 18 holes. Indiana's Jorge Campillo took home medalist honors with a three-under 213 (73-67-73).

As a team, the Eagles finished eighth with a team score of 903 (302-307-294) as the host Hoosiers ran away with the tournament title carding a 880 (297-293-290). Senior **Bryan Haase** followed with a 226 (73-76-77), while sophomore Chris Ross added a 228 (79-76-73). Freshman **Cam Burke** and senior **Clay Poff** rounded out the lineup with a 239 (76-88-75) and a 244 (78-83-83), respectively.

**MEN'S GOLF FINISHES MISSION INN COLLEGIATE INVITATIONAL IN 10TH PLACE:**

The EMU men's golf team finished in 10<sup>th</sup> place at the 16-team Mission Inn Collegiate Invitational Sunday when it ended the day with a team total of 891 (291-290-310). The University of Louisville won the tournament with a score of 860 (285-282-293).

Senior **Bryan Haase** was the Eagles' top finisher with a three round total of 220 (79-69-81), good for a tie for 22nd place. Junior **Graham Hill** also finished in the top 25, ending the day in a tie for 25th place with a final score of 221 (74-72-75). Other EMU scorers were Chris Ross with a 224 (73-75-76), Cam Burke with a 227 (74-75-78), and Joey Stimac, who ended the tournament with a 233 (78-74-81).

**HILL TIES FOR SIXTH AT WEXFORD PLANTATION INTERCOLLEGIATE:** **Graham Hill** fired a seven-over-par 223 (78-77-68) to finish in a tie for sixth place here at the Second Annual Wexford Plantation Intercollegiate hosted by Francis Marion University, Feb. 26-27. Marquette University's Mike Van Sickle took home medalist honors with a three-under 213 (73-69-71).

As a team, the Eagles finished fifth with a team score of 914 (311-307-296) as the University of Tennessee-Chattanooga claimed the tournament title carding with a 897 (300-303-294). Senior **Bryan Haase** followed with a 228 (79-77-72), while sophomore **Chris Ross** and junior **Joey Stimac** tied for 38th place with a 234. Freshman Cam Burke rounded out the lineup with a 236 (77-76-83). Playing as an individual, freshman **Marty Jeppesen** recorded rounds of 82, 82 and 81 to finish 65th.

**HILL SELECTED FOR CANADIAN AMATEUR TEAM:** The Royal Canadian Golf Association named their 2007 Amateur National Team today, Dec. 7. Among the list of eight is Eastern Michigan University's **Graham Hill**. Hill, a junior at EMU, was also selected to the National Team last year, playing an integral part in Canada winning the championship.

Hill and the rest of the Amateur National Team will look to defend their men's and overall team titles at the 2007 Copa de las Americas' hosted for the first time by Canada, June 18-23, at Beacon Hall Golf Club in Aurora, Ont. The men's team will then compete at the Four Nations Team Championships in Australia. The championships will feature six members of the team in a Ryder Cup formatted tournament.

Hill completed a stellar fall season competing in four tournaments, including two top ten finishes. Hill finished fifth at the Wolverine Intercollegiate and finished third at the Georgetown Hoya Invitational. Hill also fired a low round of 68 at the Xavier Invitational and had a scoring average of 72.30 for the fall season.

**MAHONEY QUALIFIES FOR LEVEL 2 OF PGA TOUR Q-SCHOOL:** Former Eastern Michigan University men's golfer **Korey Mahoney** completed the level one tournament at the PGA Tour Q-School Friday at



Bruce Cunningham is entering his 12th year at the helm of the Eastern Michigan men's golf program.

During his tenure, Eagle golfers have had some of their most successful years, finishing in the top five in the MAC Tournament for the past four years. The team stroke average has also improved each year since he took over the reins.

He has coached some of the best golfers in EMU history, including Jordan Young, Ed Maunder, Brent Goulding, Rob Couture, Jaysen Hansen and Jeff Mankiewicz, Brad Pemberton, as well as Korey Mahoney.

In addition to his duties as the head coach, he is also the Head PGA Golf Professional at Eagle Crest Golf Club. He has served on the Mid-American Conference Golf Coaches Advisory Council since 2001. Cunningham is also in his second season as a member of the NCAA District IV Golf Committee. He previously was the Chairman of the NCAA District IV Ethics Committee from 1997-2001.

The 41-year-old Cunningham came to EMU near the end of the 1994 spring season after serving as an assistant golf professional at Oakland Hills Country Club for five years. He is a Class-A PGA Golf Professional.

While at Oakland Hills Cunningham served as one of the teaching pros, responsible for giving lessons and clinics. He also assisted in the running of the 1991 U.S. Senior Open Championship. Also from 1989-93 Cunningham was the senior tournament director for the Junior Ping Tour presented by ESPN and Golfweek.

Prior to his five years at Oakland Hills, Cunningham was an assistant golf pro at Palm Aire Country Club for the winter seasons from 1987-89. He was the assistant pro at Marion (Ohio) Country Club from 1986-88.

A 1985 graduate of Wittenberg University, Cunningham was a two-time "Most Valuable Player" on the golf team and played in four national championships. He was also captain of the squad.

Cunningham is a native of Ashland, Ohio and attended Ashland High School where he was a three-time all-conference golfer, earning "Most Valuable Golfer" honors as well as serving as captain of the squad. He also played on the basketball team, and earned third team all-league honors in that sport.

Cunningham and his wife Marci have two children, Allegra (3-22-98) and Hagen (7-10-2000).
