STARKVILLE, Miss. (EMUEagles.com) - The Eastern Michigan University baseball team heads south once again, this time to Starkville, Miss. to take on No. 3-ranked Mississippi State. The series will run Friday-Sunday, March 12-14, with games at 6 p.m., 2 p.m., and 1 p.m., respectively. All game times are central time.

Fans can watch the action on SECN+, or listen along on the HailState Network. Live stats will also be available via StatBroadcast. Links to follow along can be found on the baseball schedule page of EMUEagles.com. In addition, updates will be posted on the team's Twitter account, @EMU_Baseball.

BEST START SINCE '74: After securing its best start to a season since 2005 with wins against Alabama State, Feb. 27-28, Eastern Michigan added two more "bests" at Bellarmine, March 5-6. With the Friday afternoon victory, March 5, the Eagles notched a 3-0 start to the season for the first time since 1989. In splitting the doubleheader games with the Knights, March 6, the Green and White recorded its best five-game start to a season (4-1) since 1974.

LAST TIME AGAINST A TOP-FIVE TEAM: EMU's matchup against No. 3 Mississippi State will mark the program's first meeting with a top-five ranked program in over five years. The last time the Eagles took on a top-ranked team was Feb. 23-24, 2016, against then-No. 1 Florida (L, 4-12, L, 7-8).

The last time EMU defeated a top-five ranked team was over a decade ago, Feb. 19, 2011, when it defeated then-No. 4 Clemson, 7-6. Eastern led 6-0 heading in to the seventh inning, but the Tigers managed to score six runs in the bottom of the seventh to tie the game. EMU scored the go-ahead run on a wild pitch in the eighth inning.

DINGER DERBY: Freshman **Mark Kattula's** home run, March 6, was not only the first in his career, but the first for EMU this season. By doing so, the Sterling Heights, Mich. native became the first freshman to hit the team's first home run of the season since **Ryan Goleski**, March 2, 2001, at the University of San Diego (L, 3-22).

Launching a long ball in back-to-back games for the Green and White, senior **Jeff Timko** became the first Eagle to hit a home run in back-to-back games since **Kolton Schenker** did so at Dayton and at Oklahoma State, March 6-9, 2018.

With Timko and Kattula each notching a home run, March 6, and Timko and **Gabe Denton** going yard, March 7, EMU hit 2+ home runs in back-to-back games for the first time since March 13-14, 2017 at Northern Illinois.

#EMUBATS STORYLINES, STREAKS & SIDEBARS

DERBY DAY IN LOUISVILLE: Traditionally, the first Saturday in May in the City of Louisville is Derby Day. However, Eastern Michigan and Bellarmine decided to make the first Saturday in March a Derby Day of their own in the River City, combining for seven home runs over the two-game day. The Knights recorded five of those seven, while Eastern saw blasts from **Mark Kattula** and **Jeff Timko**.

ONE COOL KAT(TULA): Coming off his impressive debut weekend at Alabama State, Feb. 27-28, true freshman **Mark Kattula** continued his strong showing as the team's designated hitter in Eastern's series at Bellarmine, March 5-7.

Posting second-best marks on the team in batting average (.333) runs scored (4), and total bases (9), Kattula tied for the team lead in hits (5), which included a double and his first home run in the Green and White, for a .600 slugging percentage.

FELDMAN'S FIRING: On the hill for his second start of 2021, veteran **Davis Feldman** turned in yet another impressive performance for the Green and White in the team's series opener against Bellarmine, March 5. Feldman tossed 6.0 innings of no run baseball, striking out five in the process, to keep his season ERA at a perfect 0.00 and earn his second consecutive win.

Feldman's two wins already tie his career-high, set in 2017, and with the victory, he has notched wins in consecutive appearances for the first time during his collegiate career.

TON OF TIMKO: Helping to lead the offensive effort for Eastern in its series against Bellarmine, March 5-7, was senior captain **Jeff Timko**, who led the team in home runs (2), RBIs (6), total bases (10), slugging percentage (.667), and tied for the team lead in runs scored (4). To go along with his four hits on the weekend, Timko also went 3-for-3 on stolen base attempts.

WHERE THERE'S A WILL: EMU transfer **Will Oberg** posted a .333 batting average over four games, recording four hits in 12 at-bats. The Heartland C.C. transfer tied for the team lead in runs scored (4), adding a double and triple for seven total bases on the weekend. The junior tallied five RBIs and totaled a .583 slugging percentage, and was able to draw three walks and two HBPs for a team-leading .529 on-base percentage. The Wayzata, Minn. native also went 4-for-4 on stolen base attempts.

MAKING A DENT(ON): Despite having just four at-bats in two games at Bellarmine, March 5-7, transfer **Gabe Denton** made the most of his opportunities, notching two hits, including his first home run in an EMU uniform, scoring two runs, and tallying two RBIs over the series. The junior finished the series with a 1.250 slugging percentage.

Stepping up to make an impact for Eastern Michigan in its sweep of Alabama State, Feb. 27-28, the Clare, Mich. native notched a hit and an RBI in each of the Eagles' first two games, including smacking the game-winner, Feb. 27.

MAKING IT REIN(KALL): In his first action of the 2021 season, March 5, senior **Justin Reinkall** kept Bellarmine hitless and scoreless over his 2.0 innings of work, striking out one and needing just 27 pitches (15 of which were strikes) to keep the Knights at bay. Reinkall also tossed a 1-2-3 inning in the seventh.

HOLT-ING IT DOWN: Taking the mound in relief, March 7, senior **John Holt** was impressive in his first innings for the Green and White in 2021. Throwing 2.0 innings, Holt allowed just one hit, striking out a career-high four batters in the process and keeping Bellarmine off the board.

MCGUIRE'S FIRE: Making his first start of the 2021 season, senior **Luke McGuire** picked up his first win since Opening Day of the 2020 season (Feb. 15), tossing 4.2 innings and striking out two against Bellarmine, March 6. For the second time this season, McGuire recorded consecutive 1-2-3 innings, doing so in the second and third, March 6, after accomplishing the same feat in the seventh and eighth innings at Alabama State, Feb. 27.

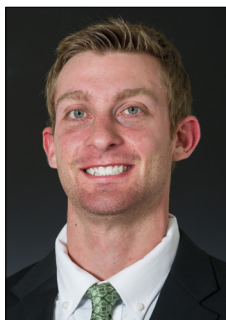

Head Coach ERIC ROOF

Third Year Head Coach • Michigan State, 2009

Eric Roof enters his second season at the helm of the Eastern Michigan University baseball program after being officially named the Head Coach of the EMU baseball team on June 4, 2018, after spending the 2018 campaign as the squad's interim head coach.

Navigating unprecedented times, Eastern Michigan only played 14 games during the 2020 campaign as a result of the cancellation of the rest of the season due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Eastern finished 1-13 overall, but its .973 fielding percentage was the best of any school in the Mid-American Conference in 2020, committing just 13 errors in 477 chances. In addition, the Eagles were one-of-two MAC teams that finished the year with no passed balls.

In 2019, Roof's squad finished with an 11-43-1 record, including a 6-21 finish in Mid-American Conference play. Although the team did not qualify for the MAC tournament (only the top-six regular season teams go), Roof's unit earned two conference sweeps over MAC West Division foes Bowling Green State University, and the University of Toledo, while also racking up numerous individual awards.

In the classroom, the team finished with a conference-best 3.515 cumulative GPA. Additionally, 12 different Eagles earned Academic All-MAC honors, the most in Roof's tenure, and the second most in the league, just one behind Western Michigan's 13 nods. The team GPA was the best across all mens sports at EMU, and ranked fourth-best among every men's team in the MAC in 2019. Individually, Zachary Owings was named a CoSIDA Academic All-District honoree for the consecutive year under Roof. Roof's team also earned MAC Scholar Athlete of the Week honors on three different occasions during the 2019 campaign.

Individually, Roof's guidance led to a slew of awards and accolades for his Eagles following the 2019 season. Most notably, Roof coaches Zachary Owings to his most successful season as an Eagles, where he led the team in batting (.345), slugging (.527), on-base percentage (.395), stolen bases (14), runs (38), doubles (18), as well as hits (76), and RBIs (34). Following the season, Owings was selected by the Miami Marlins in the 33rd round of the 2019 MLB Draft. With the selection, Roof has now led a student-athlete to the professional ranks in consecutive seasons, first helping Max Schuemann (drafted by the Oakland A's), and now Owings, reach their pro potential.

In 2018, Roof guided the Eagles to a 22-34 overall mark, including a 14-13 Mid-American Conference record and a sixth place finish in the conference standings. With the sixth place finish, EMU reached its third straight MAC Tournament, the first time they have gone to three consecutive since 2011-13. The non-conference schedule was highlighted by a 2-1 weekend series win over Oklahoma State, who, later on in the season, would become nationally ranked and receive an at-large selection to the NCAA Tournament.

At the end of the season, Zachary Owings, Luke DeVenney, and Max Schuemann were awarded All-MAC honors, the first time EMU has had three honorees in a single season since 2012. Owings was named to the first team after finishing in the top 10 in the MAC in six offensive categories, including a .350 batting average, the highest for an EMU player since 2014.

As a team, EMU had its best team batting average since Roof's arrival in 2015, batting .262, six points higher than the previous best mark of .257 in 2015. They also had the second most hits, runs, doubles, RBIs, on-base percentage points, and walks since 2015 as well. On the base paths, EMU once again finished in the top 20 in the country in stolen bases, ranking 20th in the nation and first in the MAC with 92 swipes.

On the pitching side, Roof's hire of pitching coach A.J. Achter proved fruitful, as EMU had the second-best conference only ERA with a 3.69 mark, 36 points better than the next best team. DeVenney finished with a 2.49 ERA, which was third in the MAC and 70th in the nation, while his 1.93 conference-only ERA was second. The 2.49 ERA was also the lowest for an EMU starter since 2007.

Roof completed his fourth year in Ypsilanti after spending the first three as an assistant coach working with the Eagles' hitters, outfielders and catchers. In 2015, the squad posted a record of 20-35 (9-18 MAC) before a MAC Tournament Semifinals appearance in 2016 when the Eagles went 23-36 (10-14 MAC). Last season, the Green and White posted a record of 27-35 (14-10 MAC) and a strong postseason run for its first MAC Tournament Championship game appearance since 2008.

Last season, the Eagles had five players drive in more than 25 runs led by Second Team All-MAC honoree John Montgomery. The left-handed slugger led Eastern in games (61), average (.289), hits (68), home runs (12), RBIs (49), total bases (117), and slugging (.498). He was one of the top home run hitting threats in the MAC, finishing tied for third. Additionally, outfielder Jordan Peterson had one of the best performances in EMU history against Northern Illinois, May 14, when he had four hits, including three home runs and nine RBIs. His efforts earned him not only MAC Player of the Week status, but also Collegiate Baseball News National Player of the Week accolades.

In 2016, the Eagle offense collected 19 more hits and scored 43 more runs in 2016 than in 2015. The team saw a power surge, slugging 35 points better this season, including clubbing 47 home runs, 28 better than 2015 and the most since 2010. The home run total ranked third in the MAC and 51st in the country. In his first season coaching the catchers in 2015, Roof helped Tony DiLeo throw out 43 percent of base stealers, which led the Mid-American Conference. As a team, the Eagles threw out the second most would-be base stealers in the Conference.

Before arriving at Eastern Michigan in 2015, Roof spent two years as a volunteer assistant baseball coach at Michigan State University.

At MSU with Roof coaching the catchers, the Spartan mask men threw out 39 baserunners on attempted steals throughout the 2014 campaign, leading the Big Ten Conference. Roof coached Joel Fisher, the Danny Litwhiler Defensive Player of the Year and Third Team All-Big Ten honoree, who was the conference leader in gunning down baserunners with 30. Following the season, Fisher was drafted by the Philadelphia Phillies in the 23rd round of the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft.

Returning to East Lansing as a coach in 2013, the MSU battery caught 27 stealing on the base path while Spartan sluggers hit at a .281 clip to rank fourth in the conference.

Roof played three seasons in the minor leagues (2009-11) for the Tigers organization. He began his professional career in 2009 with the Oneonta Tigers in the Class A New York-Penn League before playing in the New York-Penn League for the Connecticut Tigers in 2010 as well as the West Michigan Whitecaps in the Class A Midwest League. Wrapping up his playing career in 2011, Roof appeared in 40 games with the Lakeland Flying Tigers of the Class A Advanced Florida State League.

As a student-athlete at Michigan State from 2007-09, Roof was a three-year letterwinner and served as a captain his senior season. He compiled a .314 batting average in 136 career games, including 115 starts, to go along with 10 homers and 83 RBIs. Prior to arriving in East Lansing, the Paducah, Ky. native played his freshman season at St. Catherine (Ky.) College.

Roof batted .308 as a junior in 2008 and was rewarded by being selected in the 46th round of the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft by the Detroit Tigers; however, he elected to return to MSU for his senior year. The decision paid off as the team captain started all 54 games and led the Spartans in batting average (.345), hits (69), doubles (14), RBIs (41), slugging percentage (.525) and on-base percentage (.440). For his strong season, Roof was named Michigan State's Most Valuable Player and Offensive Player of the Year and jumped 28 rounds in the 2009 MLB Draft as the Tigers picked him up in the 18th round.

Roof is not the only one in his family that has been successful on all levels of baseball. His father, Gene, played for the St. Louis Cardinals and Montreal Expos in the 1980s, and is currently a coach in the Detroit Tigers organization as the baserunning coordinator. Eric's younger brother, Jonathan, was also a three-year letterwinner (2008-10) at MSU as a shortstop and was chosen in the eighth round of the 2010 MLB Draft by Texas. His older brother, Shawn, played at Illinois and was with the Frederick Keys, a High A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. He is now the manager for the Visalia Rawhide, the Class A Advanced affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks. His sister, Jacqueline, was a two-time All-American softball player at Campbellsville University.

PEGGED FOR MORE: EMU returner **Drake Peggs** had a great weekend for the Green and White at Bellarmine, March 5-7, finishing with a .286 batting average, .500 slugging percentage, four hits, two runs, three RBIs, and seven total bases. Two of those hits came in the form of a double and triple, marking the Knightstown, Ind. native's first extra-base hits since the 2018 season, and first triple since his freshman campaign (2017).

HOW ABOUT HOPKINS: At Bellarmine, March 5-7, junior **Taylor Hopkins** led all Eagles in batting average (.357) and hits (5), while adding three runs and drawing two walks in his four starts against the Knights.

ON THE HOUSE: Sophomore **Trevor House** recorded his first action of the young 2021 campaign, at Bellarmine, March 7. Coming in for the seventh and eighth, House twirled two perfect innings, sitting the Knights down in order both times, striking out two and allowing no hits or walks in his appearance.

YOU GET A RUN: Over the final two games of Eastern Michigan's series at Bellarmine, March 6-7, eight different players scored runs for EMU in each contest, the most in a game by EMU this season. The final two games were also the highest-scoring games Eastern has strung together this season, at 12 and 10 runs, respectively.

SAVING THE DAY: Each of Eastern Michigan's first two series have seen an Eagle record their first career save. Against Bellarmine, March 6, second-year righty **Cameron Wagoner** notched his first career save, striking out four over 2.1 innings pitched.

A week ago, Feb. 27, EMU newcomer **Zach Fruit** recorded his first career save in the Green & White in Eastern's 2-1 win over Alabama State. After walking the first batter he faced, the Dundee, Mich. native bounced back with back-to-back strikeouts, and forced the final Hornet hitter of the night into a 6-3 grounder to seal the win for EMU.

SERIES HISTORY: Eastern Michigan will face a brand new opponent for the third time in as many weeks when the Eagles and Mississippi State matchup for the first time, March 12-14.

WHAT'S MISSISSIPPI STATE BEEN UP TO?: The Bulldogs enter the weekend with a 9-3 record, capturing series wins over Tulane and Kent State, with wins additional wins over Texas, Texas Tech, Jackson State, Southern Miss, and Grambling. MSU and Louisiana will play Wednesday, March 10 prior to the Eagles coming to town.

AGAINST THE SEC: Teams from the SEC hold the advantage in all-time matchups with Eastern Michigan, 90-22. The Eagles have squared off with Kentucky the most, 27 times (4-23), and hold a winning record against Georgia (2-1). Along with Mississippi State, Eastern has never faced Alabama, LSU, or Ole Miss.

CLOSE CONNECTIONS: Eastern Michigan Vice President/Director of Athletics **Scott Wetherbee** spent four years at Mississippi State prior to arriving at EMU, serving as the Senior Associate Athletic Director of External Affairs from 2013-17, while also having stints as the Interim Director of Athletics (Oct.-Nov. 2016) and Deputy Director of Athletics (May-June 2017). In addition, Wetherbee was the administrator for the Bulldogs' baseball and volleyball teams during his time in Starkville.

THE SEASON AHEAD: The Eagles are scheduled to play 54 contests in 2021, with 21 games at Oestrike Stadium. EMU begins the season with a 10-game non-conference slate, visiting Alabama State, Bellarmine, and Mississippi State, before beginning Mid-American Conference play at Akron, March 19.

ON THE HORIZON: The Eagles will begin Mid-American Conference play next weekend, March 19-21, at Akron. The four-game series will feature a Friday matchup at 3 p.m., a Saturday doubleheader set for 12 p.m. and 3:30 p.m., and Sunday affair at 12 p.m.

NO FREE BASES: In the first 18 innings of baseball for Eastern Michigan in 2021, EMU pitchers **Justin Meis**, **Luke McGuire** and **Cameron Wagoner** combined to throw 12 of those innings without giving up a walk. Meis and Wagoner combined for the complete game without a walk, Feb. 28, for the first time since **Jackson Shaver** and **Mitchell Sparks** did so in a 4-2 loss to Western Michigan, May 3, 2019.

MAKING A MARK: True freshman **Mark Kattula** had a debut weekend for the books in Eastern's opening weekend series at Alabama State, Feb. 27-28. As the designated hitter, the Sterling Heights, Mich. native finished the weekend as the team leader in hits (4), doubles (3), extra-base hits (3), and batting average (.571).

In Sunday's 4-3 win over the Hornets, Kattula put together the best outing of any Eagle in the series, going 3-for-4 with two doubles, an RBI, and one run scored.

OPENING DAY DUBS: Making the Opening Day start for the second straight season, **Davis Feldman** shined in his first outing of 2021, at Alabama State, Feb. 27. The right-hander tallied five strikeouts in five innings of scoreless baseball, and allowed just two hits in that time. Feldman earned the win for his outing, marking back-to-back season-opening wins and his fifth overall as an Eagle.

The Warren, Mich. native's five strikeouts are the most in a game for Feldman since he sat down the same number in a Mid-American Conference Tournament semifinal outing against Central Michigan on May 27, 2017.

WATCH OUT FOR WAGONER: Sophomore **Cameron Wagoner** had a career day against Alabama State, Feb. 28. Taking over at the start of the sixth inning, the Tecumseh, Mich. product tossed the final four innings of the game, setting new personal-bests in innings pitched (4.0) and strikeouts (5) in his relief appearance. In addition, Wagoner allowed only three hits while walking no batters in his first career win.

ONE RUN GAMES: Opening the season with 2-1 and 4-3 wins over Alabama State, Feb. 27-28, the Eagles marked the first time its opened its season with back-to-back one-run games since 1972, when the team split a two-game series with Eastern Kentucky, defeating the Colonels, 3-2, in game one, and falling, 4-3, in game two.

NEW YEAR, NEW FACES: With every year, a crop of new talent arrives in Ypsilanti. This season, the Eagles will welcome a total of nine new players to campus, consisting of six freshmen and three junior college transfers. In all, the Eagles have added four infielders, three right-handed pitchers, one left-handed pitcher, and one catcher. A total of 34 players will don the "Script E" in 2021.

PBR'S PICKS: Five of Eastern Michigan's newcomers earned prospect rankings from *Prep Baseball Report*. In Ohio, **Evan Sines** was rated the No. 2 second baseman. In Michigan, **Nick Chittum** was selected as the No. 1 RHP and No. 4 overall player in the state, while **Alex Forry** was picked as the No. 9 right-hander and No. 27 overall player in the state. **Jeremy Fuchs** was tabbed the No. 3 LHP in the mitten, and **Mark Kattula** was ranked the No. 1 first baseman and No. 10 overall player in the state.

All five were ranked in the top 10 positionally, and top 30 overall. In addition, Fuchs was selected as the No. 4 LHP and No. 29 overall player in Michigan by *Perfect Game*.

MAC PRESEASON POLL: Eastern was selected to finish ninth overall in the Mid-American Conference preseason poll, as announced by the league office, Feb. 17. EMU finished with 36 points, while Central Michigan finished in the top spot for the second consecutive season with 111 points and four first-place votes. Kent State garnered five first-place votes and finished just shy of CMU with 110 points.

Did You Know? Eastern Michigan Edition

- Since joining the Mid-American Conference in 1973, Eastern Michigan Athletics has won 152 team championships. This the most of the 12-member schools during that span.
- Since 1932, EMU has won 15 team and 55 individual national championships.
- EMU has had a track representative at the summer Olympic Games since **Hayes Jones** in 1960. The Eagles have had 18 representatives in 56 years, 15 men and three women.
- The 1976 EMU baseball team steamrolled its opponents to the tune of a 46-16 record and a College World Series runner-up finish. That season, the Green and White featured a lineup full of major-league talent including the pitching duo of **Bob Owchinko** and **Bob Welch**. Seven additional players from the team were eventually drafted. Prior to Eastern Michigan's runs to the College World Series in 1975 and 1976, only two other MAC schools (Ohio and Western Michigan) had ever advanced to the national tournament. Kent State's trip to college baseball's grand stage in 2012 was the first by a Mid-American Conference team since EMU.

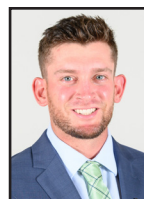
