EASTERN OREGON (7-2, 7-2 FRONTIER) AT CARROLL (4-5, 4-5 FRONTIER)

• EOU concludes the 2016 regular season by traveling to Carroll to face the Fighting Saints on Saturday, November 12 at noon MT. Fans can listen to the game on NewsTalk 103.1 (myeasternoregon.com). Live video is available at www.youtube.com/user/carrollathletics/feed?activity_view=6.

• EOU collected its fifth straight win on Nov. 5 by holding off Rocky Mountain, 19-16. The Mountaineers notched a five game winning streak for the first time since the 1980 season.

• With the triumph over the Battlin' Bears, the Blue and Gold notched its best start since the 1980 campaign when the team finished with an 8-1 overall record.

• Saturday marks the 30th meeting between EOU and Carroll. The Fighting Saints lead the all-time series, 18-11.

• In the last meeting between EOU and Carroll, the Mountaineers mustered a 28-21 upset victory over the Fighting Saints, who were ranked fourth in the NAIA at the time.

• Between 1952 and 1975, the Blue and Gold recorded a 6-1 record against Carroll.

• EOU is seeking its first postseason appearance in program history. A win on Saturday would certainly help that cause.

• Under Tim Camp, EOU is 3-9 vs. Carroll, including 2-4 in Helena, Mont.

• Carroll is coming off a 35-28 setback at Montana Western. After defeating Montana Tech in their season opener, the Fighting Saints lost four of their next five.

• EOU improved to 4-0 this season in games decided by 10 or less.

• The Mountaineers have posted a 7-1 record when leading at the half during the 2016 campaign. The squad is 39-6 all-time under Tim Camp when holding an advantage after 30 minutes of play.

• EOU's No. 9 ranking is the highest of the 2016 campaign and best mark since 2011, when the squad entered the top 10 for the first time in 31 years.

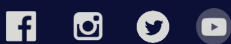
EOU'S LAST TIME OUT

While the second half wasn't pretty, EOU pulled off a three-point (19-16) win over Rocky Mountain on Nov. 5 in La Grande. Joshua Richards snagged a 34-yard touchdown from Zach Bartlow to put the Mountaineers up 19-0, but the Battlin' Bears responded with 16 straight, including two tallies in the fourth quarter to make it a ball game. Griff Amies attempted a 36-yard field goal in the winding moments to send the game into overtime, but his launch went wide left, resulting in a thrilling victory for the Blue and Gold. Alfred Gross rushed for 72 yards and one touchdown, while Richards snagged four receptions for 61 yards and a tally. Michal Arenas and Tucker Stanley logged 12 and 11 tackles, respectively.

CARROLL'S LAST TIME OUT

Carroll dropped a 35-28 decision to Montana Western in heartbreaking fashion, as the Bulldogs recovered a fumble late in the fourth quarter and returned it for a touchdown to take the lead for good. The Fighting Saints notched 325 of offense compared to 373 for the Bulldogs. Carroll had three turnovers to none for Montana Western. Major Ali recorded 120 yards on 22 attempts to lead the Carroll rushing attack. Conner Fohn posted four catches for 40 yards, while Troy Arntson had three catches for 55 yards. JT Linder completed nine passes for 81 yards and one score. It's been an up-and-down year for the Fighting Saints. After starting the 2016 campaign with a win over first-place Montana Tech, Carroll dropped three straight, including a 14-point decision to MSU-Northern. The Fighting Saints, however, have won three of their last five, including home wins against Rocky Mountain (28-14) and MSU-Northern (49-14).

ABOUT THE FRONTIER CONFERENCE

The Frontier Conference was organized in 1935 with four of the eight existing teams as charter members (Montana Tech, Montana Western, MSU-Northern and Rocky Mountain College). Carroll College joined in 1938. For a 10-year period, from 1974 - 1984, the University of Great Falls competed in the conference and rejoined in 1999.

The conference added Lewis-Clark State College of Lewiston, Idaho, and Westminster College of Salt Lake City, Utah, in 1998. Eastern Oregon University of La Grande, Ore., joined in 2008 as an associate member for football only. In 2012, the league welcomed Dickinson State University as a full member. Dickinson left after the 2013-14 season to join the North Star Conference. Southern Oregon University joined as an associate member for football only in 2012. College of Idaho joined the conference in the Fall of 2014 as an associate member in football only. Westminster College moved to NCAA Division II status and left the conference after the 2014-15 season.

The purpose of the Frontier Conference is to encourage, promote, sponsor and control athletic competition among participating colleges as an integral part of the total educational process. With their motto, "Promoting Academic & Athletic Excellence," members compete for conference championships in: men's & women's basketball, men's & women's cross country, football, men's & women's golf, men's & women's indoor/outdoor track & field, women's soccer & volleyball.

Any contest between two Frontier Conference schools will always provide spectators with the excitement and thrills that can be experienced through intercollegiate athletic conference. Many of our games are broadcast through local radio and via school webcasts.



ABOUT THE NAIA



The National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA), headquartered in Kansas City, Mo., is a governing body of small athletics programs that are dedicated to character-driven intercollegiate athletics.

RECAP

EOU Football Stuns No. 4 Carroll, 28-21, On the Road

HELENA, Mont. – From ending the Saints' 44-game Frontier Conference winning streak in 2011 to scoring 21 unanswered to defeat Carroll in 2013, the Eastern Oregon University football team has booked quite a few memorable moments against the Saints.

Now, the Mountaineers can add to that collection, as the Navy and Gold overcame a seven-point first-half deficit to knock off No. 4 Carroll for the third time in the past five seasons, 28-21.

"Great day to be a Mountie," said head football coach Tim Camp. "I want to thank the fans for their belief and support of our players and coaches. They played and coached at a high level today and Eastern Oregon University was rewarded with a win over the fourth-ranked Carroll College Fighting Saints."

KEY PERFORMANCES

Junior quarterback Zach Bartlow completed 13 of 20 passes and amassed a season-high 105 rushing yards, including two touchdowns on the ground for EOU.

Senior wide receiver Jace Billingsley rushed 71 yards on 19 carries and caught eight passes for EOU, while sophomore wide receiver Calvin Connors caught four kickoffs for a career-high 104 return yards.

EOU's defense was all over the place, with junior linebacker Tucker Stanley and senior linebacker Gary Posten tallying eight tackles apiece.

Both senior linebacker JT Capers and senior defensive back Byron Benson had an interception in the win, and Benson also broke up a career-high three passes.

"We were able to create opportunities in every phase of the game today," said Camp. "It was not perfect, but I am so proud of the players and coaching staff for their efforts and ability to continue to believe and build this program. The credit goes to them. Carroll College is a very good football team. Very proud to be a Mountie!"

THE STORYLINE

EOU got on the board with 9:32 left in the first quarter, as Bartlow found his way into the end zone on a 10-yard carry.

The Saints, however, showed why they are the second-best passing team in the league, as senior quarterback Mac Roche responded with a pair of touchdown passes in a span of five minutes to give the Saints a 14-7 advantage going into the second quarter.

With 5:12 left in the second stanza, the Navy and Gold tied the contest at 14 apiece, as Bartlow capped a 4-play, 59-yard drive with a 21-yard rush for a touchdown.

On Carroll's next possession, EOU's defense came up with a huge defense stop, as Posten and junior defensive lineman Dalton Morgan came in for the assisted tackle on 3rd-and-16, and then the Mountaineers forced a fumble and recovered it at the Saints' 3-yard line.

EOU forced Carroll to punt on its first three possessions of the third quarter before the Navy and Gold registered the go-ahead touchdown. After Barlow rushed 10 yards to Carroll's 1-yard

line, junior wide receiver TJ Esekielu brought it in for the touchdown to give EOU a 21-14 lead with 19 ticks on the clock.

Once again, the Mountaineer defense made game-changing plays at critical times, as Capers forced a fumble and recovered it 25 yards for the touchdown to jumpstart the fourth quarter and put EOU ahead, 28-14.

The Saints fired back on their next possession with a 13-play, 71-yard drive capped by a 16-yard touchdown pass from Roche to sophomore running back Ryan Walsh with 7:40 remaining in the contest, but Carroll never got past its own 28-yard line for the remainder of the game, and the Navy and Gold upset the Saints (3-2, 3-2 Frontier) for the third time in the last five seasons.

GAME ONE: EOU VS. SOUTHERN OREGON (9/3/16)

(RV) EOU FOOTBALL KNOCKS OFF NO. 2 SOUTHERN OREGON IN SEASON OPENER, 45-40

LA GRANDE, Ore. – Southern Oregon has a knack for making second-half comebacks in its heated rivalry with the Blue and Gold. After robbing the EOU football team last season with a late comeback in Ashland, it almost seemed like the Raiders were bound to repeat history, except this time at Community Stadium.

But the Mountaineers (1-0) stood slightly taller than their southern rival when the final whistle blew, as (RV) EOU held on to muster a thrilling 45-40 upset over second-ranked Southern Oregon on Saturday night.

"I'm very proud of this team and the coaches," said head coach Tim Camp. "This is one of those games that both teams played their hearts out, and we were able to come out with a big win over the No. 2 ranked team in the country. Give credit to Southern Oregon and their coaches, as they were playing to win."

Senior quarterback Zach Bartlow was solid from the get-go, completing 23 of 31 passes for 292 yards and two touchdowns. He also recorded 70 yards on 13 carries for two rushing touchdowns.

In addition to grabbing six passes for a team-high 103 receiving yards, junior wide receiver Calvin Connors posted a 65-yard punt return for a critical touchdown in the third quarter. Junior wide receiver Joshua Richards snagged a team-high nine catches for 96 yards and a touchdown, while senior running back Alfred Gross paced the ground attack with 82 yards on 10 carries.

On the defensive end, junior linebacker Michal Arenas was all over the place, registering a career-high 16 tackles (five solo) and one pass breakup. Junior defensive back Justin Hughes added a career-high nine tackles, while freshman linebacker Eli Teuteu forced one fumble to go along with four tackles.

THE RUNDOWN

After Southern Oregon (0-1) scored on its first possession of the contest, EOU fired back with a seven-yard touchdown pass from Bartlow to Richards to launch a back-and-forth pattern for the remainder of the affair.

Trailing by four (14-10) with just over 20 seconds left in the first half, EOU took the lead for good after Bartlow found Gross for a one-yard touchdown to cap the stanza.

The back-and-forth nature only carried over to the start of the second half. On EOU's first possession, Bartlow tossed passes to junior wide receiver Brenden Kelly (13 yards) and senior wide receiver TJ Esekiele (10 yards) to anchor an 8-play, 56-yard drive that ultimately led to a 17-yard rushing touchdown by Bartlow to push the advantage to double digits. (24-14).

With a 24-21 lead in the third, EOU forced the Raider offense to punt on its second possession of the quarter. That's when Connors showed why he's one of the best returners in the country, as he wheeled his way through traffic to post a 70-yard touchdown return to put the Mountaineers back up by 10 (31-21) with 4:47 left in the third.

On the very next play, EOU's special teams again delivered for the Mountie faithful, as senior running back AJ Prom recovered Southern Oregon's muffed kick return in the end zone for another touchdown.

While a 17-point, fourth-quarter edge may have seemed reassuring to some, it was the Raiders who erased EOU's 21-point lead nearly a year ago in Ashland. Staying true to its comeback fashion, Southern Oregon responded with two touchdowns in a 39-second span to open the fourth. Tanner Trosin heaved a touchdown pass to Matt Retzlaff, and then Mylz Blake recovered Bartlow's fumble and returned it for another tally to make it a four-point (38-34) contest with 13:48 on the clock.

A tight scoreboard sparked even greater tension on the field. During an EOU punt midway through the fourth, the referees whistled two penalties on Southern Oregon's block in the back, as well as a targeting penalty on Bronson Ader, leading to his ejection.

Despite those two penalties, Trosin and the Raiders continued to march into EOU territory until sophomore defensive lineman Zach Lacey recovered a muffed handoff at EOU's 14-yard line.

From there, Bartlow issued two carries for 15 yards to spark a 7-play, 84-yard drive into the end zone. Gross broke out a 57-yard carry to Southern Oregon's 6-yard line, and then Bartlow concluded the drive with a 10-yard rush for a touchdown, which for many fans sealed the victory.

But EOU couldn't celebrate just yet, as the Raiders issued a 10-play, 73-yard drive to cut the Blue and Gold's lead to five (45-40) with 1:34 left to go after a failed two-point conversion.

In a matter of seconds, the Mountie faithful went from exuberant to silent, as Southern Oregon executed an onside kick at EOU's 48-yard line and then a 28-yard pass to inch to the Blue and Gold's 20. With the Mountaineers' backs against the end zone and seconds left to play, a pair of senior defensive backs in John Payne and Jesus Retano broke up potential touchdown receptions on third and fourth downs, and EOU's sideline erupted to celebrate the wild victory.

GAME TWO: EOU AT MONTANA WESTERN (9/10/16)

CAMP MAKES HISTORY, (RV) EOU FOOTBALL UPENDS NO. 25 MONTANA WESTERN

DILLON, Mont. – A year ago, the EOU football team couldn't pull out a close game to save its life.

But nothing in 2016 could be further from last year's trend, as head football coach Tim Camp celebrated his school-record 49th career victory after the (RV) Mountaineers mustered another remarkable triumph, ousting No. 25 Montana Western, 35-23.

It was the defense that got it done in the second half, as EOU strung together critical 3-and-outs in the fourth quarter to keep the Bulldogs at bay.

"Today we faced a tough [Montana] Western team," said Camp. "They are flat-out good. We were fortunate to make a few more plays and a couple more stops in the second half. We have work to do in every phase, and that's what makes Mountie football so exciting."

In his ninth year at the helm, Camp improved to 49-40 to surpass Bob Quinn, who led the charge from 1929-49 with a 48-66-5 mark.

"Past and present players and assistant coaches of mine make my job very easy," said Camp. "I am so proud of them. They deserve the credit. I just have the opportunity to watch them develop and mature."

And boy did Camp watch a beaut on Saturday afternoon, as EOU pulled off its first win over Montana Western since 2013. The win also avenged last season's 30-23 defeat when the Bulldogs stunned the Mountaineers on Homecoming Weekend with a late touchdown.

Senior quarterback Zach Bartlow was 15-for-26 for 335 yards and a quartet of touchdowns, while junior wide receiver Calvin Connors caught five passes for 143 receiving yards and two touchdowns. On the ground, senior running back Alfred Gross ran for 64 yards on 16 carries, while Bartlow tallied 62 on 13 rushing attempts.

While EOU logged a solid defensive effort in many facets, both junior defensive back Justin Hughes and senior linebacker Tucker Stanley stood out the most, recording 11 tackles apiece for the Blue and Gold.

THE RUNDOWN

Bartlow sparked EOU's scoring with 6:55 remaining in the first quarter, finding junior wide receiver Skylar Williams for the 75-yard touchdown to knot the game at seven apiece.

With just over a minute remaining in the second quarter, Connors capped a 12-play, 84-yard drive with a 11-yard touchdown reception to give EOU the lead (21-20) going into the locker room.

Perhaps something it couldn't brag about last season, EOU's defense remained steady in the second half, yielding only one field goal to keep Montana Western (2-1, 1-1 Frontier) at bay.

Bartlow completed a 45-yarder to Gross to put the Mountaineers up five (28-23), and then senior running back AJ Prom capped the Blue and Gold's scoring with a 12-yard carry with 1:19 left to play.

EOU improved to 2-0 on the season for the first time since 2012 and scooted its way to first place in the Frontier Conference.

NO. 10 EOU FOOTBALL TRIPPED UP BY COLLEGE OF IDAHO, 20-7

LA GRANDE, Ore. – Junior wide receiver Skylar Williams snagged a tremendous touchdown grab on the Blue and Gold's first drive of the game, but things quickly turned south for the 10th-ranked EOU football team.

As the rain continued to pour at Community Stadium, College of Idaho remained persistent, outscoring EOU 14-0 in the second half en route to pulling away with a 20-7 upset in La Grande.

Senior quarterback Zach Bartlow completed 13 passes for 190 yards and one passing touchdown, while senior running back Alfred Gross posted a career-best 150 yards on 27 carries. Leading EOU's air attack, senior wide receiver TJ Esekieleu added 80 yards on four receptions.

Defensively, junior linebacker Michal Arenas and senior linebacker Tucker Stanley paced the Mountaineers with 14 (seven solo) and 11 (six solo) tackles, respectively, and senior defensive back Kalliy Ceasay added four tackles and two pass breakups.

THE RUNDOWN

After Bartlow's touchdown pass to Williams put seven on the board for EOU with 12:25 left in the opening quarter, both squads traded defensive stops before the Yotes notched a 20-yard touchdown reception to make it a 7-6 contest.

The Mountaineers (2-1, 2-1 Frontier) almost added another six in the second stanza, as the Blue and Gold went for it on fourth down at College of Idaho's 3-yard line, but the Yotes came away with a huge defensive stop to keep it a one-point contest into the locker room.

In the third quarter, College of Idaho (2-1, 1-1 Frontier) reached EOU's 32 before senior defensive back John Payne picked off Tyler Cox's pass to maintain the edge. But a quick 3-and-out kept EOU at bay on the offensive end, and the Yotes capitalized with a 9-play, 29-yard drive into the end zone to take their first lead (12-7) with 8:37 left in the third quarter.

The fourth frame saw the two Frontier Conference foes trade interceptions before College of Idaho utilized the turnover with a rushing touchdown, and the Yotes found themselves with a 13-point (20-7) edge after the two-point conversion.

The Mountaineers got inside College of Idaho's 28 twice in the final 6:06, but the Blue and Gold couldn't get over the hump, yielding two turnovers on downs.

NO. 15 EOU FOOTBALL DROPS 37-24 DECISION TO NO. 10 MONTANA TECH

LA GRANDE, Ore. – The No. 15 EOU football team was held to its lowest rushing total since 2008, and the Mountaineers suffered a 37-24 defeat at the hands of No. 10 Montana Tech on Saturday afternoon at Community Stadium.

Without senior running back Alfred Gross, the Blue and Gold (2-2, 2-2 Frontier) couldn't get anything going on the ground, while Montana Tech posted 410 yards of total offense and eight sacks en route to leaving La Grande with a 'W.'

While EOU's ground attack was lacking, senior quarterback Zach Bartlow tossed a season-high 361 passing yards and two touchdowns, including a 53-yarder to junior wide receiver Brenden Kelly, who recorded a career-best 135 receiving yards.

Junior wide receiver Calvin Connors caught five passes for 90 yards and a touchdown, while senior running back AJ Prom rushed a team-best 28 yards and one touchdown.

Defensively, senior linebacker Tucker Stanley was outstanding, carding a career-high 17 tackles (nine solo), 1.5 tackles for loss, one sack, and his second career interception. In addition, junior defensive back Justin Hughes added 12 tackles (five solo).

THE RUNDOWN

For the second-straight contest, EOU struck immediately, as Bartlow's 53-yard beaut to Kelly capped a 4-play, 57-yard drive into the end zone. However, Montana Tech fired right back, logging a touchdown pass and then a rushing tally to take a 13-7 advantage into the second quarter.

The Orediggers (3-1, 3-1 Frontier) scored on their third-straight possession just over three minutes into the second stanza, as quarterback Quinn McQueary hauled it in three yards to finish a 10-play, 50-yard drive to extend the damage to 13 (20-7).

Facing a 20-point (27-7) deficit late in the first half, it looked as though the Mountaineers notched a much-needed touchdown pass to gain a little momentum into the locker room, but the tally was ultimately called back on a penalty, and the Blue and Gold had to settle with a field goal.

In the third, Montana Tech forced two 3-and-outs and a turnover on downs, and a 24-yard field goal granted the Orediggers a 30-10 margin going into the fourth stanza.

With just over eight minutes remaining in the contest, EOU gave itself a chance with Prom's one-yard carry for the score, but Montana Tech charged right back with a 100-yard kickoff return for a touchdown to go back up by 20 (37-17) with just over eight minutes remaining.

The Orediggers forced a turnover on downs before EOU put up one last seven via a 36-yard touchdown from Bartlow to Connors, but it was too little, too late for the Mountaineers.

GAME FIVE: EOU AT MSU-NORTHERN (10/8/16)

BALANCED OFFENSE POWERS NO. 16 EOU FOOTBALL PAST MSU-NORTHERN, 52-31

HAVRE, Mont. – Led by a veteran quarterback in senior Zach Bartlow, the No. 16 EOU football team tallied a season-high 548 yards of total offense on the way to toppling MSU-Northern, 52-31, on Saturday night at Blue Pony Stadium.

Bartlow went 19-for-27 passing for 325 yards and four touchdowns, and he also added 43 yards on the ground and one rushing touchdown to move into sole possession of second place all-time in program history for career rushing TDs.

EOU's receivers had a field day, as the Blue and Gold (3-2, 3-2 Frontier) issued a balanced air attack led by junior wide receiver Joshua Richards' four catches for 96 yards. Meanwhile, junior wide receivers Brenden Kelly and Calvin Connors combined for seven snags and 118 yards.

On the ground, the Blue and Gold was just as solid, as it bounced back from a dismal 32-yard performance against Montana Tech with 218 rushing yards. Senior running back Alfred Gross recorded 56 yards and two touchdowns on 14 carries, and senior running back AJ Prom added 54 rushing yards.

Sophomore kicker Nathan Harden drilled a 37-yard field goal and was a perfect 7-for-7 on PATs, while senior linebacker Tucker Stanley mustered 11 tackles (four solo). EOU's defensive line also garnered four sacks from junior Travis Jones, sophomore Nick De Alba, and senior Austin Brown.

THE RUNDOWN

While the Mountaineers were looking to rebound from two-straight defeats, MSU-Northern (1-4, 1-4 Frontier) aimed to knock off another top-25 opponent, as the Lights entered with an upset victory over then-ranked No. 21 Carroll.

EOU put the pressure on the Lights early, scoring on its first two drives of the contest to go up, 14-0. After MSU-Northern got on the board with a field goal, the Mountaineers responded with a 4-play, 37-yard drive into the end zone, as Bartlow found Gross for the touchdown to cap the opening quarter.

Gross hauled in another tally to put the Blue and Gold up by 25 (28-3), but MSU-Northern fired back with 14 straight to make it a ball game (28-17) with 9:12 left in the third.

Bartlow completed touchdown passes to Richards and senior wide receiver TJ Esekielu to regain the momentum and extend EOU's margin to 25 (42-17), and following a 37-yarder by Harden, Gross took a handoff for another six to grant the Mountaineers their largest lead (52-24) of the game with 7:59 remaining in the contest.

EOU's defense held MSU-Northern to only 291 yards of total offense – a season-best effort by the Blue and Gold.

NO. 16 EOU FOOTBALL COMPLETES SEASON SWEEP OVER NO. 8 SOUTHERN OREGON

ASHLAND, Ore. – A steady downpour of rain at Raider Stadium didn't faze the 16th-ranked EOU football team from its game plan, as the Mountaineers dominated on both ends en route to taking down No. 8 Southern Oregon, 39-29, on Saturday night.

With the sweep, EOU carded its first winning streak against Southern Oregon in 10 years, and ninth-year head coach Tim Camp won in Ashland for the third time in the last four years.

"It was a great team win," said Camp. "All four phases played up to standards tonight. I'm very proud of the coaches and players who coaches and played a very sound football game. It was a great day to be a Mountie."

Senior quarterback Zach Bartlow completed eight passes for 184 yards and two touchdowns, as well as 52 yards on the ground. Senior running backs Alfred Gross and Nicolas Slater combined for 133 rushing yards and two touchdowns, while junior wide receiver Calvin Connors snagged four passes for 94 receiving yards and one touchdown.

Seniors Tucker Stanley and Kyle Lanoue added 12 and 10 tackles, respectively, and senior defensive back John Payne tallied two key interceptions for the Blue and Gold.

EOU (4-2, 4-2 Frontier) forced six fumbles on the night, one of which was recovered by Southern Oregon for a safety late in the second quarter. The Mountaineers did not commit a turnover on the evening and registered 214 rushing yards.

THE RUNDOWN

The Mountaineers struck first as they've done many times this season, as Bartlow completed a 75-yard beaut to junior wide receiver Brenden Kelly on 2nd-and-12 to muster a 7-0 advantage with 6:50 left in the first quarter.

After the Raiders (4-3, 4-2 Frontier) responded with a score, the Blue and Gold regained the edge on its next possession when Slater muscled an 18-yard carry into the end zone to cap the opening stanza.

Following a rushing tally by Gross, EOU's defense sacked Raider quarterback Jack Singler, and the Raiders ultimately recovered a fumble to result in a safety, extending EOU's advantage to nine (23-14) with 4:46 left in the half.

Forced to punt on 4th-and-6, Southern Oregon caught a surprise when junior defensive back Justin Hughes dove for the block and junior Kai Turner recovered the failed attempt. With less than two minutes remaining in the second, Bartlow found Connors in the end zone to cap a 5-play, 16-yard drive to extend the margin to 15 (29-14).

The Mountaineer defense forced a 3-and-out to open the third before junior wider receiver Joshua Richards recovered an EOU fumble in the end zone for another tally to put the Blue and Gold up by 22 (36-14).

The Raiders scored to start the fourth quarter, but EOU milked another five minutes off the clock before sophomore kicker/punter Nathan Harden logged a 24-yard field goal to push the advantage back to 18 (39-21) with 14:10 left to play.

On the ensuing possession, Payne snagged a critical interception at EOU's 10, and Southern Oregon didn't get another shot until the 3:33 mark of the fourth quarter.

Despite a Raider touchdown, the Mountaineers earned two first downs on their next drive, and time eventually ran out in Ashland, as the Blue and Gold celebrated a hard-fought, 10-point triumph.

LA GRANDE, Ore. – The 12th-ranked EOU football team held No. 21 Montana Western to its worst offensive outing of the season, and the Mountaineers improved to 8-1 in Homecoming games under head coach Tim Camp after taking down the Bulldogs, 21-13, on Saturday at Community Stadium.

COACHING STAFF

HEAD COACH TIM CAMP 9TH SEASON

Tim Camp became the EOU head football coach in February 2008. During his time at the helm, Camp has compiled an overall record of 49-40 to become the all-time winningest coach in program history.

Prior to Camp's arrival, EOU went 1-10 during the 2007 campaign. In no time, Camp turned things around, recording a 5-6 record in his inaugural season. The Mountaineers followed that up with a 7-4 mark in 2009, including a third-place finish in a highly-competitive Frontier Conference.

Despite finishing 5-6 during the 2010 campaign, EOU took third in conference play and broke 18 school records. In both 2011 and 2014, Camp and the Mountaineers mustered a program-best eight wins, marking the fifth time in school history that EOU won seven or more games in a season.

In 2013, EOU broke five school records and won six of its final seven games, including wins over No. 3 Carroll, No. 21 Montana Western and No. 25 Southern Oregon.

The following year saw the Blue and Gold register an 8-3 record, including a 31-27 upset victory at Southern Oregon - a team that went on to win the national championship. EOU's triumph marked the Raiders' second home loss in four years - both of which came at the hands of the Mountaineers. EOU ultimately carded a No. 15 ranking in the final NAIA Coaches' Top 25 Poll and was the first team to miss out on the NAIA Football Championship Series.

At the conclusion of the 2014 campaign, Camp shared Frontier Conference Co-Coach of the Year honors with Carroll's Mike Van Diest.

Camp has produced 77 all-conference players, including the 2012 Frontier Conference Defensive Play-

er of the Year (Howard McDonald) and the 2009 Frontier Conference Co-Offensive Player of the Year (Chris Ware). On a national scale, 12 Mountaineers have earned NFCA-NAIA All-America recognition under Camp.

In 2015, EOU standout Jace Billingsley put the finishing touches on one of the most prolific careers in program history. After earning Second-Team NFCA-NAIA All-America honors, Billingsley was signed by the Detroit Lions as an undrafted free agent.

Prior to becoming the head coach at EOU, Camp served as an assistant coach for the Mountaineers for two seasons. In addition to being the offensive line coach, Camp was also the recruiting and camp coordinator.

Before making his way to La Grande, Camp served as the offensive coordinator at Bucknell University and the offensive line and tight ends coach at the University of Nebraska-Omaha.

From 1997-2002, Camp served as offensive line coach, recruiting coordinator, and strength & conditioning coordinator at the University of the South in Seawee, Tenn. In 2000, he was promoted to offensive coordinator.

Camp's collegiate coaching career began in 1996 at Western Oregon University, where he coached the offensive line, tight ends, and special teams.

Camp earned a bachelor's degree in sociology from Oregon State University in 1995. He was a four-year starter on the offensive line for the Beavers and received all-conference accolades. After graduating from OSU, Camp signed a free agent contract with the San Diego Chargers of the NFL.

Camp and his wife, Janet, have two sons, Willie and Walker, and one daughter, Kali.

ASSISTANT COACHES

TYLER PAOPAO - OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR (QB/RB)

Tyler Paopao joined the EOU football program's coaching staff in 2012 as the offensive coordinator.

Prior to becoming a Mountaineer, Paopao spent five seasons at Southeastern Louisiana University (SLU) in Hammond, La. During his time at SLU, Paopao mustered multiple all-conference performers while working with tight ends, running backs, and receivers.

In 2004, Paopao earned a bachelor's degree in sociology from Occidental College, where he was a two-time all-conference selection as a quarterback and led the team to a conference title in 2001. He later earned a master's degree in kinesiology from SLU in 2009.

Paopao was drafted by the Ottawa Renegades of the Canadian Football League in 2002. He began his coaching career in 2006, as he was the offensive coordinator for the Lazio Marines in Italy.

JEFF McNALLY - DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR (LB)

Jeff McNally joined the EOU football coaching staff in 2011 as a graduate assistant and running backs coach. In 2013, he became the defensive backs coach, and he currently serves as the defensive coordinator for the Mountaineers.

During his two years as a graduate assistant, McNally coached Kevin Sampson, who holds the career rushing yards mark at EOU.

Prior to coaching, McNally was a standout at EOU from 2006-09. He recorded a total of 253 tackles, 26 pass breakups, 15 interceptions, and three sacks. He was a two-time NAIA Honorable Mention All-American and a two-time, first-team all-conference defensive back selection. Off the field, McNally was a two-time academic All-American and a three-time academic all-conference selection.

McNally earned his bachelor's degree in business management from EOU and graduated with Cum Laude honors in 2010. Two years later, he graduated from EOU with a Master of Business Administration.

BRYAN MILLS - DEFENSIVE COACH (QB/DB)

Bryan Mills joined the EOU coaching staff in 2016 as the defensive backs coach. Prior to EOU, Mills was the safeties coach for his alma mater, Pacific University. During the 2015 campaign, Mills helped the Boxers split the Northwest Conference (NWC) regular season title.

On the gridiron, Mills was a safety for Pacific and took honorable mention honors twice before snagging second-team all-conference plaudits his senior year.

In 2014, Mills earned his bachelor's degree in education and learning. Born in Imbler, Ore., to Mike and Sandy Mills, he was one sister, Malia, who plays for the EOU volleyball team.

ANDREW WOODY - OFFENSIVE COACH (WR)

Andrew Woody joined the Mountaineer coaching staff in 2015 after starting for three seasons at tight end for the Blue and Gold. A three-time academic all-conference selection, Woody received his bachelor's degree in business administration from EOU before earning his Master of Business Administration in 2016.

Born in Springfield, Ore., to Max and Samantha Woody, he has two siblings, Lindsey, and Tanner. Woody enjoys outdoor activities and spending time with loved ones.

NATE CRESS - OFFENSIVE COACH (C/G)

Nate Cress joined the EOU coaching staff in 2015 as the offensive line and tight ends coach. From 2007-10, Cress started at guard and made 20 appearances on the Mountaineers' offensive line. He ultimately earned his liberal arts degree from EOU.

Born in Cathlamet, Wash., to Barry and Shelly Cress, he currently resides in La Grande and enjoys spending time with family and friends, coaching football, and barbecuing. He has one sister, Sam.

EMORY JONES - OFFENSIVE COACH (TE/OL)

Emory Jones became EOU's defensive line coach in 2014 and was later appointed the offensive coach (tackles/tight ends) in 2016. He also serves as the Mountaineers' strength and conditioning coach.

During his playing career at EOU, Jones earned second-team all-conference plaudits in 2013 for his play as an offensive lineman. A two-time team captain, Jones also succeeded off the field and was a three-time Frontier Conference Academic All-Conference selection.

In 2014, Jones earned his bachelor's degree in business administration from EOU.
