Fans are allowed inside Ram Stadium.

Stream: Fans can watch the broadcast on the PSAC Sports Digital Network. The PSAC Sports Digital Network is available on the web, along with streaming applications for television and mobile devices for Android TV, Apple TV, Amazon Fire, Roku (TV), iOS, Android (mobile) and Amazon Fire Tablet. Search "PSAC Sports Digital Network" to download the app. All ESU broadcasts are archived on the PSAC Sports Digital Network and can be watched on-demand.

Radio: Bigfoot Country 103.1 FM 840 AM enters its 56th year broadcasting Warriors' football. Chuck Seese and Bob Brittain are on the call for every home and away game on the radio dials and online.

The Series: Shepherd leads 4-3 in the all-time series, with a 76-34 victory over ESU in the lone PSAC matchup between the two schools. The Warriors have won three of the last five meetings, with the teams meeting for six consecutive seasons from 1998 to 2003.

Last Time Out: Despite, 277 all-purpose yards from Rece Bender, the East Stroudsburg University football could not prevent a late Shippensburg comeback, falling to the Raiders by 24-23 mark on Saturday afternoon at Eiler-Martin Stadium. ESU held a 23-14 halftime lead, but the Warriors were unable to score any points in the second half, with drives ending on a missed field goal, two turnover on downs, two punts, an interception and lost a fumble. Ship was able to score a touchdown after a long interception return, and Jaxson Montross would kick the eventual game-winning field goal with 1:27 left in regulation. The ESU offense was held to just 1-7 on 3rd down conversions after halftime.

Big Play Rece: From a 99-yard program record kickoff return for a touchdown to a 96-yard completion that is tied for the longest pass play in Division II this season with Bowie State's Darious Bowman, Rece Bender's explosive plays have become regular. Along with the 96-yard reception, Bender has pulled in receptions of 79 yards (Pace), 64 and 53 yards against West Chester, and 40 yards against Bloomsburg and a total of 10 catches of 20-yards or more through nine weeks. The Lancaster native registered a career-best 188 yards receiving on just five catches, reeling in a 66-yard touchdown and explosive receptions of 47, 39, and 31 and five yards against Shippensburg. On returns, Bender registered 67 yards off kick returns and 22 on punt returns for the 277 all-purpose yard mark. It's the second highest of career, with 312 all-purpose yards and Shepherd in 2019. 277 all-purpose yards ranks 10th most by a Warrior since 1974. After the big week, Bender ranks second in the PSAC in all-purpose yards, third in combined kick returns, fourth in the receiving touchdowns, second in receiving yards, fourth in receiving yards per game, and second in yards per reception.

McCarthy The Menace: Deshawn McCarthy continues to be an elite pass rusher at the Division II level, tied for the national lead with Tylen Coleman from Western New Mexico with 12 sacks through nine games. McCarthy also ranks in the top-15 in the country in tackles for loss, averaging 1.7 per contest. McCarthy is four sacks away from tying the ESU school record of 15 in a single season with two games remaining. McCarthy and Andre Eldridge (6.5) lead the ESU defense that ranks 10th in the country in total sacks (3.56 per game). McCarthy's 12 sacks in a single season are tied with Johnny Lee Davis (1991), Bob Heumann (1988), and NFL Draft Pick Ray Yakavonis (1978) for the fourth most sacks in a single season.

D-Fence: With the regular season winding down, the Warrior defense has put together one of its best seasons in recent memory. The Warrior defense ranks 27th in the country and fifth in the conference by allowing just 19.1 points per game. 19.1 points allowed per game would be the lowest in a single season mark for ESU since the Warriors posted an 18.5 opponent points per game mark in 2002.

GAME NOTES

The Swiss Army Knife: Tyler Watson has continued to impress this season. In the PSAC, he ranks in the top-10 in forced fumbles (10th), interceptions per game (5th) and passes defended (5th), making a case for all-conference honors. He leads ESU in interceptions (t-1st, 3), pass breakups (6), forced fumbles (t-1st, 2), fumbles recovered (t-1st, 1) and ranks third in tackles (40).

Runnin' and Gunnin': Gunner Anglovich currently ranks third in the conference in rushing yards (823), tied for second in touchdowns (8). With two games left, he looks to become just the eighth Warrior to rush for over 1,000 yards in a season joining Robert Healy (2x, 2016, 2013), Andre Castiglioni (2x, 2001, 2000), Stewart Ford (1997), Jaymar Anderson (2017), Pete Radocha (1976), Derek Lucas (2005) and Andre Myers (1998).

Red and Black Zone: The Warriors rank in the top-25 nationally in both redzone defense (17th) and redzone offense (19th).

Scouting #11 Shepherd:

Entering the contest with an 8-1 record, Shepherd boasts the one of the top offenses and quarterbacks in Division II in Tyson Bagent.

Bagent leads the nation in passing yards (3,030), passing touchdowns (36), second in completion percentage (71.9 percent) and points responsible for (230). He is a potential Harlon Hill award winner for the most outstanding player in Division II.

The Rams also lead the nation in scoring offense, averaging 48.1 points per game and also lead the nation in total offense with 521.9 yards per contest.

Ryan Beach (730 yards, 11 touchdowns) and Josh Gontarek (528 yards, 5 touchdowns) are top targets for Bagent.

The Rams also rush the ball successfully, with four running backs with four-plus rushing touchdowns and have two top-10 backs in terms of rushing yards in the PSAC in Ronnie Brown (607 yards) and Chantz Swartz (436 yards).

Ranked Foes: Warriors look to snap a 20-game losing streak against ranked AFCA Coaches Poll ranked foes. A win would be the first over a nationally ranked squad since 2008, when ESU opened the season with a 14-11 victory over No. 25 Virginia Union in the inaugural game on the Eiler-Martin Stadium turf surface. ESU has not won against a ranked opponent on the road since now Warriors head coach Jimmy Terwilliger led the No. 7 Warriors to a 52-39 thrilling victory over No. 2 Bloomsburg on Nov. 19, 2005 in the NCAA playoffs. ESU fell to then No. 8 Slippery Rock in week two in its other ranked contest this season.

Up Next: ESU closes the 2021 campaign against Gannon in a PSAC crossover matchup at Eiler-Martin Stadium. Kickoff is set for 1:05 p.m. in the Poconos.

ESU Head Coach Jimmy Terwilliger • 2nd Full Season • Career Record: 12-10 2005 Harlon Hill Award Winner



Jimmy Terwilliger, ESU's record-setting quarterback and the 2005 Harlon Hill Award winner as the most outstanding player in Division II football, was promoted to head coach in February of 2019. The 2021 campaign marks his second full season as head coach and his sixth overall as part of the Warriors' coaching staff. He served as Interim Head Coach for the final two games of the 2018 season after the retirement of legendary coach Denny Douds.

Terwilliger led ESU to a 6-5 overall record in 2019, which marked the team's first winning season since 2015. In the season opener, the Warriors topped Division I FCS opponent Wagner for the program's first win over a DI opponent since 1994. The victory sparked a win streak of five straight for the Warriors to open the season. Terwilliger guided the Warriors to the fifth most improved team in terms of win total in Division II in 2019, increasing the Warriors wins from two in 2018 to six in 2019.

Terwilliger coached and mentored seven student-athletes who went on to earn PSAC East All-Conference honors during his first full season in 2019, including First Team selections Jordan Walters, Andre Eldridge and Jameer Brooks. Walters was also named an All-American by four different organizations (AFCA, AP, D2CCA and D2Football.com), while Levi Murphy was named a CoSIDA Academic All-American.

Prior to taking the reins, Terwilliger served as associate head coach during the 2018 season and led the program in an interim capacity for the final two games after legendary head coach Denny Douds stepped aside following 45 years at the helm.

He was ESU's defensive backs coach his first three years, from 2015-17, which included mentoring cornerback Teron Dobbs to All-PSAC East honors his first season. Most recently, free safety Billy Inge III and safety Justin Johnson finished 1st and 2nd in DII in forced fumbles in 2017.

Terwilliger, a four-time Harlon Hill candidate and three-time finalist, graduated with 18 NCAA Division II records and two NCAA all-division records as part of his All-America career at ESU (2003-06). He was inducted to the ESU Athletic Hall of Fame in fall 2017.

Terwilliger led the Warriors to two NCAA DII Playoff appearances (2004 and 2005) and won the Northeast Region title in 2005, advancing to the national semifinals. ESU won the PSAC East regular season title in 2003.

He tied the NCAA all-division record for touchdown passes (148) and set DII career records for total offense (16,064 yards), passing yards (14,350), pass efficiency (170.7), touchdowns responsible for (161) and points responsible for (966).

In his record-setting 2005 season, Terwilliger threw for 4,571 yards and 50 touchdowns, and ran for 389 yards and four TD for 4,960 yards of total offense, leading the Warriors to an 11-3 record.

He was the first quarterback in DII history with 3,000 yards of total offense in each of his four seasons. He was a three-time All-America selection, and was twice named to the AP Little All-America second team (2005 and 2006).

Terwilliger was a three-time first team Daktronics All-Region selection (2004-06) and a three-time PSAC East Offensive Player of the Year (2003-04, 2006). He is the only QB in PSAC East history to be named first team in each of his four seasons.

Terwilliger graduated from ESU in 2007 with a bachelor's degree in Health and Physical Education. He was named to the PSAC Top 10 in 2005 and 2006 and was an Academic All-District selection in 2004.

He was a health and physical education teacher for eight years in the East Stroudsburg, Pleasant Valley and Parkland school districts.

Terwilliger helped Parkland to the District 11 championship in 2014 after leading Pleasant Valley to the District playoffs three times (2010, 2012, 2013) in five years as head coach. He coached PV to the Mountain Valley Conference championship in 2010 and was named the MVC Coach of the Year.

EAST STROUDSBURG – The East Stroudsburg University football team dropped a 35-10 decision at the hands of Shippensburg on Saturday night at Eiler-Martin Stadium.

Rece Bender led the Warriors in receiving for the third straight game, hauling in four catches for 80 yards and a touchdown. Bender has now found the end zone in three straight games and has five total touchdowns on the year.

Quarterback Jake Cirillo went 11-of-21 in the game with 85 yards passing and led the team in rushing with 54 yards on nine carries. Ben Moser took over under center late in the contest and went 5-of-6 for 70 yards and a touchdown.

On the defensive side for the Warriors, Justin Johnson posted a team-high eight tackles and pulled down an interception for ESU's lone forced turnover of the game. Deshawn McCarthy added seven tackles and two sacks.

For Shippensburg, Brycen Mussina went 21-for-33 in the air with 350 yards and three touchdowns. Sean Judge pulled down all three of Mussina's touchdown throws, and registered 93 yards receiving on six catches. David Balint led the team with eight receptions and 115 yards. On the ground, Luke Durkin tallied 93 yards and a pair of touchdowns on 16 carries.

The Red Raiders tallied the lone score of the opening quarter as Mussina hooked up with Judge for the first of three scores that the duo would connect on in the game. Mussina hit Judge with a 13-yard pass to cap off a nine-play, 62-yard drive.

Mussina found Judge once again early in the second quarter, this time on a 12-yard score, to make it 14-0 Shippensburg with 14:54 on the clock in the second.

The Warriors responded with their first points of the game on the next drive, as they drove 57 yards on nine plays before kicker Jordan Walters knocked one through the uprights for a 36-yard field goal to make it a 14-3 game.

Shippensburg added to its advantage early in the third quarter as Durkin punched in his first of two touchdowns from three yards out, padding the lead to 21-3 at the 10:43 mark of the third.

The Red Raiders notched two more touchdowns in the fourth quarter, a six-yard pass from Mussina to Judge and a three-yard run from Durkin, to grab their largest lead of the game at 35-3.

ESU got the final score of the game with 7:05 remaining as Moser found Bender in the corner of the end zone for a 21-yard touchdown.

Shippensburg improved to 4-6 on the year and 4-3 in conference play with the win, while ESU evened up to 5-5 overall and 2-5 in the PSAC East.

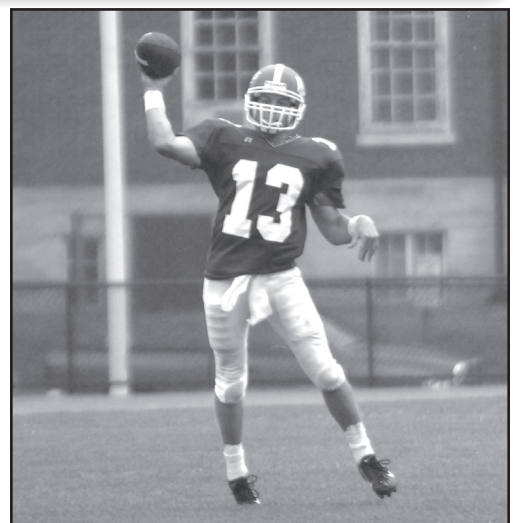
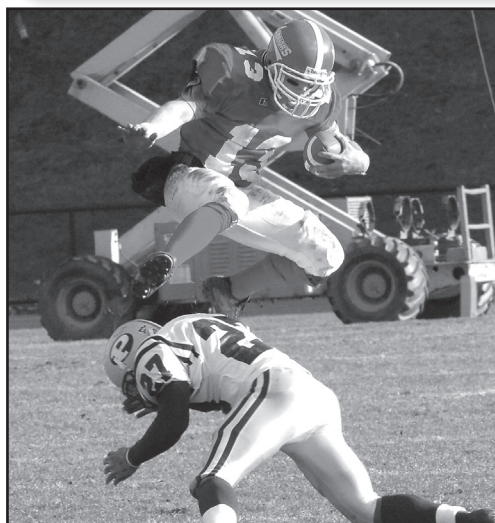

WEEK ONE

Thurs., Sept. 2

ESU 35, PACE 14

In its first game in 653 days due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the East Stroudsburg University football team opened up the 2021 season with an impressive 35-14 victory over Pace at Eiler-Martin Stadium on Thursday night.

The Warriors (1-0) owned the line scrimmage, rushing for 319 yards and two touchdowns. It's the most rushing yards for the Warriors in a single game since putting up 334 yards against Cheyney in 2012. Overall Thursday's 319 rushing yard output ranks 10th all-time in school history.

The defensive line brought the pressure, sacking FCS transfer Carlton Aiken seven times. The offensive line protected quarterback Jake Cirillo, who avoided getting sacked. Overall, ESU outgained Pace 524 yards to 279.

ESU's consistent rushing attack from running back Gunner Anglovich (career-high 140 yards on 23 carries, avg. 6.1, 1 touchdown), fullback David Akinwande (91 yards on 9 carries), Cirillo (72 yards on 6 carries, 1 TD) and running back Tyriq Lewis (20 yards, 5 carries) combined for 319 yards from the ground.

Cirillo finished with a line of 11-18 for 205 yards and three passing touchdowns without throwing an interception. A 79-yard touchdown strike to wide receiver Rece Bender in the fourth quarter ended a potential threat for Pace to comeback from a 21-point deficit with 11:31 to go.

Deshawn McCarthy led the ESU pass rush with an impressive four sacks, which is the most in a single game since Brian Holkovic recorded four quarterback takedowns against Kutztown in 2001. Aiden Hayward added 1.5 sacks., while Andre Eldridge (1.0 sacks) and Ryan Hieber (0.5) each frequented the backfield. McCarthy finished with six of ESU's 14 tackles for a loss.

The Warriors came out of the gate on fire, scoring the game's first 21 points in the first quarter. Anglovich and Akinwande combined for 73 yards of rushing, including a 50-yard scamper from Akinwande. Anglovich would find paydirt from 19 yards out to give ESU's first touchdown the campaign.

The Warrior defense did not disappoint, forcing a three and out in its first action.

Again, ESU's three-headed rushing attack of Anglovich, Cirillo and Akinwande would drive down the field. A nine-yard drive was capped with a one-yd sneak by Cirillo on fourth and goal to extend the ESU advantage to 14-0.

A roughing the punter penalty on ESU would lead to Pace's first, first down of the evening. The ESU defense buckled down the next three plays to force its second of seven punts of the day.

On the next Warrior drive, Cirillo's first completion of the season would land in Clifford Brinkley's hands for a 35-yard completion, which set up ESU in the redzone on the Pace 18-yd line. The next play, Cirillo found Syracuse transfer James Cherry in the end zone, as the Warriors lengthened its lead to 21-0 in the first quarter. The Red and Black outgained the opposition 192-19 during the opening quarter of the season.

Pace could not gain any momentum yet on its next offensive drive, with Hayward forcing a fumble that was recovered by Darn Blackwell.

After a few punts back and forth from the Warriors and Setters, Aiken completed a 38-yd touchdown pass to Ramir Tann-Davis to put Pace on the scoreboard at 21-7.

A big drive was up next for ESU, with 4:59 left in the first half and Pace receiving the second half kickoff. An 11-play, drive with Cirillo finding Bender for an 8-yd score would put the Warriors on top 28-7 at the half.

After the intermission, Tann-Davis returned the second-half kickoff to the house, to cut the ESU lead to just 14 points. The Warrior defense would prevent the Setters to get closer, with two punts and a turnover-on-downs on their final three drives of the game.

ESU would put an exclamation mark on the game with a 79-yd toss from Cirillo to Bender to make it a 35-14 contest.

Bender finished with 86 yards on two catches, with both receptions being touchdowns. Brinkley would lead ESU with four catches and would finish with 75 yards receiving.

Linebacker Paul Carreras added six tackles in his Warrior debut. Defensive back Shavar Hussett and linebacker Jacob Keane each added five take downs.

Freshman Nate Reed averaged 42 yards on four punts with three landing inside the 20-yard line. Devin Bartholomew would convert all five extra points to wrap up the scoring.

#8 Slippery Rock 22, ESU 7

The East Stroudsburg University football team fell at No. 8 Slippery Rock, 22-7, on Saturday night at Mihalik-Thompson Stadium. The Rock (2-0) built a 15-0 lead through three quarters and thwarted a potential Warriors (1-1) comeback early on in the fourth quarter.

Gunner Anglovich led the Warriors in rushing and receiving on the day, rushing for 76 yards, while collecting 71 yards of receiving.

Defensively, Paul Carreras and Andre Eldridge each totaled six tackles, while Khalil Scott and Shavar Hussett each tallied five. Hussett and Tyler Watson each snagged an interception. Watson also broke up a pair of passes.

Albert Gayle (1.0) along with Deshawn McCarthy and Ade-wale Obayanju each registered half of a sack.

Jake Cirillo completed 13-26 passes for 109 yards. Matt DeLaurentis took over duties under center with 6:19 remaining in the third, completing 7-15 passes for 75 yards and his first career touchdown pass. The East Norriton, Pa. native found Ezequiel Lopez with 10:19 remaining in the fourth quarter to put the Warriors on the scoreboard.

ESU gained momentum early in the fourth quarter, as safety Shavar Hussett would pick off Andrew Koester. Hussett returned the ball to SRU's 16-yd line. Within reach of making it a one-possession game, the Rock forced a turnover on downs.

Nate Reed was forced to punt nine times, drilling three inside the 20. The Warriors were plagued by penalties, being charged 12 times for 95 yards. On its 13 drives, ESU was forced to punt nine times, with three turnover on downs, along with the touchdown drive.

It took nearly the entire first half for either offense to get going. After a pair of punts to begin the game, SRU would miss a 38-yd field goal on its second drive after moving the ball 77 yards.

On its next drive, the Warriors were able to move the ball consistently on a 10-play 51 yard drive, but ESU would ultimately turn the ball over on downs on an incompletion on 4th and 2 from the SRU 28-yd line.

Both teams finished the opening quarter with punts.

A 21-yd ESU punt would setup SRU with good field position on the Warriors 34-yd line. After gaining a first down via a pass interference call, SRU would attempt and make a 29-yd field goal to grab the first lead.

ESU was forced to punt on its next drive, as Slippery Rock would gain possession with 1:05 remaining in the first half. SRU would quickly embark on a 79-yard drive, with Andrew Koester completing a 33-yd completion to Cinque Sweeting with just four seconds remaining. SRU missed the two-point conversion attempt, taking a 9-0 into the halftime intermission.

ESU start the second half strong with three third down conversions, but a holding penalty, followed by a false start would set the Warriors back to a 3rd and 25. The Warriors would have to punt after an incompletion.

ESU's defense kept the Warriors in the contest, forcing yet another punt.

On DeLaurentis' first drive, ESU moved the ball, as Anglovich would find room on a 23-yd rush before recovering his own fumble. A sack and delay of game penalty would setup the Warriors for another 3rd and long, ESU would punt again.

SRU took control of the game on its first play of the next drive, as Koester found Chris D'Or for 81 yards to extend the Rock lead to 15-0. The Rock added an additional touchdown with a rushing touchdown a yard out by Koester on SRU's next drive.

ESU put together its touchdown drive next, as the nine-play drive saw four first downs. The Warriors took advantage of a pair of SRU penalties, with a pass interference and a face mask each resulting in first downs. In the red zone, Anglovich would rush for 11 yards to setup up DeLaurentis with the 9-yd touchdown pass to Lopez.

Hussett's interception came three plays later, setting up ESU with the potential comeback attempt. With 10:13 remaining and the chance to make it a one-possession game on SRU's 16-yd line, the Warriors failed to gain a first down, turning the ball over on downs.

ESU forced its sixth punt of the game defensively, but ESU could not capitalize. SRU would run the time out on the final drive of the game.

ESU 17, Mercyhurst 7

After building a 17-0 halftime lead, the East Stroudsburg University football team prevented a comeback attempt late to down Mercyhurst, 17-7, on Saturday afternoon at Eiler-Martin Stadium.

ESU's defense stymied the Lakers offense the majority of the game, holding Mercyhurst to less than 100 yards of offense through three quarters. Mercyhurst was able to gain rhythm in the fourth quarter with a touchdown drive with 9:29 remaining, but the stout Warrior defense would force a turnover on downs the next possession and ESU would run out the clock to take its second victory of the season.

Gunner Anglovich, the PSAC's leading rusher entering the day, rushed for 89 yards and a touchdown, averaging 4.2 yards per rush. Fullback David Akinwande finished with 42 yards including an impressive 20-yd scamper to put the game on ice.

Under center, Matt DeLaurentis filled in for Jake Cirillo - who was scratched due to injury - and completed 14-25 passes for 165 yards and a touchdown to James Cherry.

Clifford Brinkley led ESU with 49 yards receiving on a pair of receptions, including an impressive 43-yd catch. Anglovich and Ezequiel Lopez both brought in four receptions for 47 yards. Anglovich finished the day with 136 yards of all-purpose yards. Rece Bender added three catches on 14 yards, while Cherry's one catch went for an 8-yd touchdown.

Defensively, Tyler Watson and Paul Carreras led the way in tackles with seven each. Watson forced a fumble and broke-up a pair of Laker passes. Carreras also tallied a fumble recovery and a pass breakup. Jahmere Crumpton added six tackles, while Jacob Keane and Khalil Scott each added five takedowns.

Aidan Hayward also forced a fumble on the day, while Andre Eldridge and Keane registered a sack each. Devon Banks also jumped on a Laker fumble.

After ESU forced Mercyhurst to punt for first of five times on its first drive, the Warriors started strong offensively with a 13-play 91 yard drive that took 6:29 off the clock. A 31-yd c78ompletion from DeLaurentis to Anglovich set up Anglovich for six consecutive carries before he found the end zone. In total, Anglovich tallied 78 all-purpose yards on the Warriors first drive of the game.

Following the touchdown, ESU would obtain possession on Mercyhurst's 37-yd line on a fumble that was recovered by Devin Banks. The Warriors could not capitalize and would have to punt.

Hayward would force a fumble on the Lakers' next drive, with the recovery by Carreras, setting up the Warriors with possession in the red zone. ESU would extend its lead on a 36-yd field goal by Devin Bartholomew, his first of the season and first in his Warrior career.

After the two foes traded punts in the second quarter, ESU would string together a nine-play 74-yd drive, taking up just a 1:08 of game clock to grab a 17-0 advantage with 21 seconds left in the half. Cherry's 8-yd touchdown was setup by Brinkley's 43-yd reception to the Lakers' eight-yard line. After a pair of incompletions, DeLaurentis found Cherry open in the back of the end zone for the second touchdown drive of the first half.

After 30 minutes, ESU outgained Mercyhurst 194-32, with the Warrior defense allowing just four first downs (1-of-5 3rd down conversions).

ESU forced another Laker punt on its first drive of its possession. The Warriors looked to extend its advantage, after taking over possession at the 50-yd line, but a 48-yd field goal attempt would go wide left.

After the teams traded punts, ESU forced a turnover on downs to end the third quarter with a 17-0 lead.

Mercyhurst would put together its lone scoring drive after forcing ESU to punt. The Lakers found rhythm on the six-play, 65 yard drive. A 20-yd touchdown connection from Michael Lowery to Cameron Barmore would put Mercyhurst on the scoreboard.

The Warriors would move the ball on its next drive, going 50 yards. Unfortunately for ESU, the field goal attempt went wide left.

With the Lakers looking to make it a one-possession game, ESU allowed a 33-yd gain on a completion. However, ESU buckled down and forced a five-yd run and three incompletions for the turnover on downs.

ESU would run out the final 2:28 of clock, featuring a 20-yd highlight run from Akinwande for a first down to put the game on ice. After the teams traded punts, ESU forced a turnover on downs to end the third quarter with a 17-0 lead.

Sat., Sept. 25

ESU 45, LOCK HAVEN 21

Holding a 31-21 lead heading into the fourth quarter, the East Stroudsburg University football team put the game away with a pair of touchdown drives in the final quarter to pick up a 45-21 win in the PSAC East opener against Lock Haven on Saturday night at Hubert Jack Stadium.

ESU improves to 3-1 and 1-0 during PSAC East play, while the Bald Eagles fall to 1-4 and 0-1 in league action.

In his second career start, quarterback Matt DeLaurentis completed 19-26 passes for 276 yards and four touchdowns. His four touchdowns went to four different receivers, finding Elie Lavarin (31-yd touchdown), fullback David Akinwande (6-yd touchdown), tight end Dawson Stuart (14-yd touchdown) and Clifford Brinkley (8-yd touchdown) for scores. He completed passes to eight different Warriors and extended ESU's interception-less streak to 175 pass attempts and six full games.

PSAC leading rusher entering the day, Gunner Anglovich rushed for 87 yards and a touchdown, averaging 5.4 yards per carry on 16 carries. Tyriq Lewis supplemented the rushing attack with 56 yards on nine carries.

Rece Bender set an ESU program-record with a 99-yard kickoff return touchdown during the first quarter, posting 206 all-purpose yards with six catches for 81 yards and a total of 125 kick-return yards.

James Cherry led the Warriors with 83 receiving yards on four catches including a 27-yard reception. Lavarin pulled in a pair of passes including the impressive 31-yard touchdown.

Defensively, free safety Tyler Watson continued to wreak havoc, forcing and recovering a fumble which helped spark the ESU offense. He totaled six tackles and also broke up a pass.

Linebacker Paul Carreras led the Warriors with eight tackles, a half sack and 1.5 tackles for loss. Deshawn McCarthy got home on 1.5 sacks. The Philadelphia native now has 6 sacks on the season and 12 sacks for his career. Jesse White and Albert Gayle also contributed a sack each.

The Warriors began the contest strong on both ends of the field, forcing a three-and-out and capitalized on good field position. ESU converted a 3rd and 16 on the opening drive, with DeLaurentis finding Bender for the first connection of the day for 17 yards. Anglovich would pick up the remaining 19 yards on three rushes, finding the end zone from two yards out.

After a second quick LHU drive, ESU would quickly extend its lead. DeLaurentis would find Akinwande for a gain of 19 before connecting with Lavarin for a 31-yard touchdown for his first career touchdown.

The Bald Eagles would string together an 11-play, 75-yard drive with QB Ethan Persa finding the end zone on a two-yard rush to put LHU on the scoreboard and cutting the ESU lead to 14-7.

Bender's school record 99-yard kickoff would follow, as the Lancaster native would find space on the impressive return. The return broke the previous ESU record of 98 yards, set by Dick Merring against Mansfield in 1956 and matched in 1998 by Matt Kacanda against Bloomsburg. The kickoff return is the second of the career, previously bringing back a 95-yard touchdown against Clarion in the 2019 finale. He is now the owner of two of the five longest kickoff returns in Warrior history.

LHU would be forced to punt on its next possession to open the second quarter. On 3rd and 16, DeLaurentis would find Dawson Stuart for a 15-yard gain. On 4th and 1, ESU used some trickery, with tight end and former ESU quarterback Stuart taking the snap and finding freshman John Siggins for a first down after a 16-yard gain. The completion and reception from Stuart and Siggins were both the first of their careers.

An Anglovich scamper of 24 yards and a Bender reception of 20 yards would setup the DeLaurentis-to-Akinwande connection for his first touchdown of the season from the six-yard line. The touchdown is the second of his career, with his first coming at Hubert Jack Stadium against Lock Have during the 2019 season.

With ESU leading 28-7, the Bald Eagles would battle back and gain momentum to end the first half. A 46-yard kickoff return from LHU would provide good field position, as a 17-yard and 22 yard rush from Dante Graham would cut the Warriors lead to 28-14.

ESU would punt on three-and-out on the following drive. The Warriors defense responded and forced a turnover on downs. Gaining possession in near midfield, DeLaurentis would find Cherry for a gain of 27 yards to set up a Devin Bartholomew 37-yard field goal attempt. The sophomore converted his second field goal of the season, to lift ESU to a 31-14 advantage.

Another solid LHU kickoff return would setup the Bald Eagles with good field position near midfield with 33 seconds remaining in the half. Ethan Persa would complete a 21-yard first down pass and would take advantage of three ESU penalties, as LHU would score a touchdown late to cut the ESU lead to just 10 at 31-21 to end the first half.

The third quarter would feature no points, and a combined four punts. ESU began its final drive of the quarter at the 2:51 mark and moved the ball with three first downs via accurate passing from DeLaurentis. DeLaurentis, a native of East Norriton, completed 6-6 passes on the drive which ended with a 12-yard strike to Stuart, who caught the ball in the back of the end zone and added style points with a hurdle over a barrier to extend the Warrior lead to 38-21.

ESU took full control on the following defensive drive, with Watson forcing and recovering a fumble on the second Bald Eagle play of the drive to setup the Warriors with short field position on ESU's 42-yard line.

DeLaurentis continued his hot streak, completing a 27-yard pass to Cherry. Lewis followed with an impressive rush of 23 yards. On the LHU 8-yard line, DeLaurentis completed his success night with an touchdown to Brinkley. He ended his night with eight consecutive completions. ESU grabbed a 45-21 lead with the score.

The next three drives of the contest would result in punts. With 4:58 remaining, sophomore Aaron Tobias took over duties under center. The local from nearby Centre Hall, Pa. was unable to complete his two attempts, as Lewis would run out the clock with 26 yards of rushing on the final drive of the game.

The Warriors close out the two-game road trip at Kutztown (3-1, 1-0 PSAC East) on Sat., October 2. Kickoff at Andre Reed Stadium is slated for 12:05 p.m. The Golden Bears are coming off a 37-29 upset of No. 10 Shepherd.

WEEK FIVE

Sat., Oct. 2

Kutztown 21, ESU 14

In a defensive battle, a Kutztown go-ahead touchdown with under a minute left proved to be the difference, as the East Stroudsburg University football team fell to Kutztown, 21-14 on Saturday afternoon at Andre Reed Stadium.

The Warriors fall to 3-2, 1-1 in PSAC East action, while the Golden Bears improve to 4-1, 2-0 in league play. Kutztown, the defending PSAC East champions, entered the game receiving votes in the AFCA Coaches Poll after defeating then No. 10 Shepherd last weekend.

After allowing two touchdowns on its first two drives, the ESU defense buckled down and held the Golden Bears off the scoreboard with seven consecutive stops. The defensive unit forced five punts, an interception and a turnover-on-downs during that span. A 76-yard completion setup the Golden Bears with the game-winning touchdown with 44 seconds remaining.

Tailback Gunner Anglovich reached the century mark for the second time this season, rushing for 108 yards and both of ESU's touchdowns. The PSAC's leading rusher averaged 6.0 yards per carry on 18 rushes.

Quarterback Jake Cirillo returned to the starting lineup, with Matt DeLaurentis scratched due to injury. The East Stroudsburg native completed 21-44 passes for 180 yards. Rece Bender led the Warriors with five receptions for 60 yards. David Akinwande pulled in two catches for 28 yards. Anglovich added 17 receiving yards on three catches, while Clifford Brinkley caught two passes for 12 yards.

Tyler Watson finished with a career-best 13 tackles to lead ESU. Jacob Keane added nine tackles. Jahmere Crompton would total eight tackles, along with a crucial interception during the fourth quarter.

Deshawn McCarthy caused havoc in the backfield all day, recording a pair of tackles for loss and a sack, for a total of seven tackles and two quarterback hits. Paul Carreras totaled seven tackles, while Ryan Hieber registered a sack.

ESU could not pick up a first down on its opening possession, sending a punt to KU territory. The Golden Bears would score touchdowns on each of its first possessions, with each drive lasting 10-plus plays. KU quarterback Eric Nickel would score on a three-yard rush on the team's first drive, while the Golden Bears' tailback Darryl Davis-McNeil would find the end zone from the one-yard line with 49 seconds left in the opening quarter.

The Warriors could not capitalize on its first offensive drive of the second quarter and were forced to punt. KU would gain a pair of first downs on its next drive, but the Warriors defense held strong at midfield and would force a punt from near midfield after the 13-play drive.

After a KU punt, ESU picked up a key first down on 3rd and 18 with a 26-yard connection from Cirillo to Akinwande. Later on in the drive, Anglovich grabbed a first down on 4th and 2 from the KU 21, finding space for 11 yards. After two incompletions, an unnecessary roughness penalty setup Anglovich for his first of two rushing touchdowns, to cut the deficit to 14-7. ESU would head to the locker room with a seven-point deficit.

The Warriors put together a promising drive to open the second half, going 18 plays and driving 79 yards. On the drive, ESU converted three third down chances and a fourth down conversion, but the drive would stall with a 21-yard missed field goal.

ESU's defense kept up the pace, with another stop to close the third frame.

After an ESU punt, Hieber would tally a sack on first down, as Crompton came up with the pivotal interception in Golden Bear territory on the next play. On the Warriors' first play from scrimmage, Anglovich found an opening and took the touchdown 30 yards into the end zone to tie the contest at 14-14.

The Warriors kept momentum defensively, forcing a turnover-on-down on the nine-play drive.

Looking to take its first lead of the contest, ESU faked a punt for the second consecutive week. Tight end Dawson Stuart took the direct snap and rushed for a gain of 11 on 4th and 3. Later on in the drive, the Warriors could not gain a first down on 3rd and 15 after a holding penalty. ESU's Nate Reed boomed a 54-yard punt to the Kutztown six-yard line.

KU would get a first down on a 3rd and 4 with less than two minutes on the clock to extend the drive.

A 67-yard completion from KU's Eric Nickel to Jerome Kapp would set up Darryl McNeil-Davis with a short rushing touchdown, as the Golden Bears grabbed a 21-14 lead with just 44 seconds to go.

ESU with limited time to attempt to tie the game would throw an interception, ending a 219 pass attempts without an interception streak. The streak, which featured five different players attempting pass, breaks an ESU program record (175 attempts) set by Matt Soltes and Nate Daniels during the 2013 season. ESU was one of just six Division II teams entering Saturday that did not throw an interception in 2021.

The Golden Bears would run out the clock, to earn the victory.

WEEK SIX

Sat., Oct. 9

ESU 27, MILLERSVILLE 7

On Homecoming, the East Stroudsburg University football team dominated on the defensive end, posting eight sacks and held Millersville to under 100 yards passing in a 27-7 victory on Saturday afternoon at Eiler-Martin Stadium.

The Warriors got back to their winning ways and improve to 4-2, 2-1 in the PSAC East, while the Marauders drop to 2-4, 1-2 in conference play.

ESU's defensive rush onslaught of eight sacks are the most by the Warriors since reaching the eight-sack threshold in 2013 at Kutztown. The Marauders' 96 yards of passing is the fewest for an ESU opponent since the Warriors allowed 57 yards passing against Bloomsburg in 2018.

The Warriors' stout defense allowed just 2.3 yards per rush and 3.2 yards per play, forcing eight punts and allowed the Marauders to convert just 4-of-14 3rd down conversions. Millersville punted on all six first half drives, with the second half resulting in an interception, punt, a missed field goal, a turnover on downs and a punt, before the Marauders could punch in a touchdown on its final drive of the contest.

As he has done all season, defensive end Deshawn McCarthy caused chaos, totaling 3.5 sacks and seven total takeaways. Defensive tackle Andre Eldridge added 2.5 sacks and six tackles, while Ryan Hieber (1.0), Keanan Baines (0.5) and Daryn Blackwell (0.5) also registered sacks.

McCarthy entered the week ranked seventh in NCAA Division II and second in PSAC in sacks, prior to the dominant 3.5 sack performance. He now has 10.5 sacks on the season, just five sacks away from breaking Joe Ruedt (1992) and Des Hussey's (1991) single-season mark of 15 sacks.

ESU previously recorded eight sacks five times in a single game. The school record of 10 sacks was set in 1988 against Mansfield and matched in 1991 against Cheyney. ESU has also tallied nine sacks in a game five times, most recently in 2010 against Pace.

Paul Carreras led the Warriors with nine tackles. Keane (6 tackles) and Christian Weissman (5 tackles) also contributed five-plus tackles.

Safety Shavar Hussett came up with his second interception of the season.

PSAC leading rusher Gunner Anglovich ran for 139 yards on 21 carries (6.6 avg.) and two touchdowns, just two yards off his career-high that he set against Pace in the season opener. He scampered for a career-long rush of 55 yards on his second touchdown of the contest. Tyriq Lewis added a season-best 70 yards from scrimmage, while Jake Cirillo and David Akinwande each rushed for 24 yards for the Warriors' impressive ground performance of 257 yards rushing (6.3 avg.).

Jake Cirillo completed 9-17 passes over the afternoon for 143 yards with one touchdown and one interception. He connected on an impressive 96-yard strike to Rece Bender during the fourth quarter to put the game out of reach. Bender totaled 191 all-purpose yards, with 105 receiving, 37 kick return and 49 punt return yards in the contest.

On special teams, sophomore kicker Devin Bartholomew converted on both of his attempts, making a 27-yarder and a 35-yarder. Nate Reed booted four of his six kickoff for touchbacks and averaged 38.2 yards per punt on four attempts.

ESU would put points on its second drive of the contest, driving down the field on an 11-play 70 yard drive. Bartholomew would convert his 27-yard attempt for the 3-0 lead after one quarter at Eiler-Martin Stadium.

It was Bartholomew again that did the scoring on the Warriors' next drive. ESU continued to successfully rush the ball, with 48 of ESU's 52 yards on the drive coming via the rush. Bartholomew would strike from 35-yards to lift ESU to a 6-0 lead.

With the Warriors in good field position after a short MU punt on a 3-and-out, Cirillo would complete a pair of passes to Elie Lavarin for a total of 26 yards. On the next play, Anglovich broke a tackle at the line of scrimmage and would not be stopped, finding paydirt on an 11-yard touchdown.

Both teams would send punts the rest of the first half, with ESU taking a 13-0 lead into the locker room. The Warriors allowed just 59 yards on 27 first half played from Millersville, holding the Marauders to 1-of-7 on 3rd down conversions during the first 30 minutes of the game.

The Warriors received the second half kick, as Anglovich burst through the line of scrimmage on his second carry of the second half for his career-long run of 55 yards. His previous long rush was 52 yards against West Chester in 2019.

With ESU leading 20-0, the relentless defense forced a turnover on the second play of Millersville's drive, as Hussett snagged his second interception in three weeks.

The offense could not capitalize, turning the ball over on downs. After punts were traded, MU put together its most successful drive offensively of the contest, with help from an unsportsmanlike conduct penalty and targeting penalty. Fortunately for ESU, Millersville was unable to convert a 35-yard field goal attempt.

Cirillo would throw an interception on ESU's next possession for the Warriors' lone turnover of the game.

With MU's backup quarterback in due to injury, MU would rush the ball into the red zone. On 4th and 2, the Marauders' quarterback Anthony Butler would be stopped at the line of scrimmage, for a turnover on downs. A lengthy delay ensued on the play, after Butler was injured on the play.

After play resumed, Anglovich would have a pair of carries for a single yard, before Cirillo found Bender on the impressive 96-yard strike. The play is the longest play from scrimmage for ESU since Robert Bleier scored an ESU program-tying 99-yard completion from Matt Soltes in 2013 against Lock Haven. The 96-yard completion is tied for the fourth-longest touchdown in program history, matching Tim Roken's connection with Ed Kiser in 2008 against Millersville.

WEEK SEVEN

Sat., Oct. 16

West Chester 42, ESU 24

In a battle of the top two rushing offenses in the PSAC, it was West Chester that would come out on top with 326 yards rushing and held ESU to 88, defeating the Warriors, 42-24, on a warm fall Saturday afternoon at John A. Farrell Stadium.

The Warriors fall to 4-3, 2-2 in PSAC East play, while West Chester improves to 5-2, 3-2 in league action.

ESU's offense came alive just a little too late, posting a pair of 60-yard plus touchdown receptions in the fourth quarter.

Wide receiver Rece Bender highlighted the offense, recording a career-high 157 yards of receiving. He pulled in two 50-plus yard receptions, including a 64-yard touchdown. He now has four 50-plus yard receptions this season, including three over the past two weeks.

Elie Lavarin added an impressive 85-yard touchdown late in the fourth quarter for ESU's final touchdown of the afternoon. He posted his first career 100 yard receiving game with 103 yards.

Quarterback Jake Cirillo completed 12 of his 31 passes, for 273 yards and the two late touchdowns. Cirillo averaged 22.8 yards per completion with the three explosive plays. He added a one-yard rushing touchdown.

PSAC leading rusher Gunner Anglovich was injured during the first half and would not return. He finished with 21 rushing yards on nine carries. Tyrik Lewis, a native of nearby Downingtown, led the Warriors with 57 yards of rushing.

Linebackers Jacob Keane (10) and Paul Carreras (7) led ESU with a combined 17 tackles.

Tyler Watson prevented a late first half touchdown by recording his second interception of the season, returning it to the end zone to WCU territory on a 54-yard return. He added six tackles.

Aidan Hayward would tally the lone sack of the afternoon for the Warriors.

ESU would receive the opening kickoff but would be forced to punt with 3-and-outs on its first two drives. A low punt would set the Golden Rams with good field position on its own 36-yard line. The Golden Rams would connect on a four-yard touchdown pass from Shane Dooley to Seth Degree to give WCU the lead.

After ESU's second punt, the Warriors defense would force a pair of Golden Rams punts. A 72-yard rush from WCU's Ja Den McKenzie would lead to a one-yard rush for Dooley, to lift the Golden Rams to a 14-0 advantage.

A personal foul call on WCU would setup the Warriors with possession near midline on its next possession. The 53-yard connection from Cirillo to Bender would give ESU possession on WCU's one-yard line. Cirillo would punch it in himself to cut the deficit to 14-7. Bender eclipsed 1,000 career receiving yards on his third 50-plus yard reception of the season.

ESU looked to halt WCU on its next drive, but a 4th-and-9 conversion would setup the Golden Rams with the ball on ESU's 11-yard line. McKenzie would find space on the following play, finding the end zone to give WCU a 21-7 lead.

A game-changing play would happen next, as the wind would aid West Chester in recovering the ensuing kickoff, with the high-kick bouncing just ahead of a diving Warrior and into the hands of a Golden Ram. With WCU holding possession at ESU's 36-yard line midway through the second quarter, the Golden Rams would score its fourth touchdown of the day with four consecutive rushes, with Phil Poqueie scoring from 11-yards out.

On its next drive, ESU looked to cut into the deficit prior to halftime. The Warriors converted a third down and a fourth down conversion on the 13-play drive. Devin Bartholomew would blast a 50-yard field goal through the up rights to trim the deficit to 28-10. The field goal was the ninth 50-plus yard field goal in program history and first since Jordan Walters' school-record setting 56-yard kick at Farrell Stadium in 2019.

On the following kickoff, ESU attempted a surprise onside kick that just barely went out-of-bounds prior to the Warriors from recovering it. Holding possession with a minute left in the first half with the ball near midfield, the Golden Rams would quickly move the ball to inside the ESU two-yard line.

Watson would snag his sixth interception of his career and second of the season in the end zone, which prevented WCU to extending its lead prior to halftime. The Warrington native would advance the ball to midfield after the 54-yard return. Bartholomew would attempt a 55-yard field goal with just seconds remaining in the half. The kick had the distance, but would just miss wide-left. As a result, the Warriors entered the locker room with a 28-10 deficit.

The teams traded punts to begin the second half.

On the Golden Rams' second possession, ESU nearly sacked WCU's Dooley on a 4th and 8, but Dooley would scramble for 22 yards and a first down to extend the drive. On the following play, Jacob Keane was able to force a fumble prior to Poqueie reaching the endzone, as the Warriors nearly recovered the fumble in the end zone. Unfortunately for ESU, Poqueie was able to recover his own fumble, extending WCU's advantage to 35-10.

ESU looked to respond on its next drive. After picking up a first down on a completion to Dawson Stuart, Cirillo nearly completed a pass to an open Elie Lavarin on 4th and 2, but the ball was just overthrown, as the Warriors turned the ball over on downs.

West Chester secured the game on the next play from scrimmage with 50-yard touchdown pass from Dooley to Rasheem James to take a 42-10 advantage in the third quarter.

ESU never gave up, with the Warriors adding a pair of long passing touchdowns from Cirillo - a 64-yard reception for Bender and a 85-yard strike to Lavarin to cut the deficit to 18 points at 42-24 with 5:26 remaining.

West Chester would run out the clock on its next possession to earn the 42-24 victory.

WEEK EIGHT

Sat., Oct. 23

ESU 35, BLOOMSBURG 14

After allowing a touchdown on the first drive of the game, the East Stroudsburg University football team made eight consecutive stops defensively and scored 35 unanswered points in a 35-14 victory over Bloomsburg on Saturday afternoon at Eiler-Martin Stadium.

The Warriors improve to 5-3, 3-2 in PSAC East play, while Bloomsburg falls to 2-6, 1-4 in conference action.

The win for ESU over Bloomsburg is the first since 2015 and is just the second in the last 13 seasons over Bloomsburg. Prior to the dramatic 35-34 win over the Huskies, the last time the Warriors last defeated Bloomsburg was in 2005 NCAA Playoffs with now ESU head coach Jimmy Terwilliger leading the victory at quarterback.

After conceding the opening 77-yard touchdown drive, the stingy Warrior defense allowed just 88 yards of offense over the following eight Husky drives. Three of those drives, all in the second quarter, ended in turnovers, as Tyler Watson and Ryan Hieber tallied interceptions and Deshawn McCarthy would grab a fumbled snap in mid-air. Hieber's first career interception resulted in a touchdown, while McCarthy's recovery would later result in points.

Offensively, the tailback duo of Tyrik Lewis (114 yards, 1 TD) and Gunner Anglovich (86 yards) combined for exactly 200 yards rushing. Along with scoring his first career touchdown, Lewis tallied his first 100-yard rushing game of his career. As a team, ESU rushed for a total of 256 with Jake Cirillo adding 25 net yards.

Cirillo completed 16-25 passes for two touchdowns and two interceptions. Both touchdown throws were thrown to Elie Lavarin, who has now scored three touchdowns over his last two games. Lavarin posted 40 yards on four receptions, while true freshman Chad Parton also tallied for catches for 32 yards.

ESU leading receiver Rece Bender collected three catches for 61 yards, including a 40-yard long completion.

Jacob Keane led ESU with six tackles, while Paul Carreras added five tackles with two tackles for loss.

Along with a fumble recovery, McCarthy added a sack and three tackles. The junior now has 11.5 sacks on the season. He entered the week ranked second nationally in the category. Andre Eldridge also registered a sack for the Warriors. The Warrior co-captain now has 5.5 sacks on the season.

On special teams, Devin Bartholomew converted both of his field goal attempts (32 yards and 36 yards) and all five point-after-attempts. Nate Reed had to punt just three times. He booted three of his seven kickoffs for touchbacks.

As previously mentioned, Bloomsburg would open the scoring with a 77-yard touchdown drive, capitalized by Kaleb Monaco's one-yard touchdown. The Pocono Mountain West graduate rushed for 103 yards on the day.

The Warriors looked to counter right away. Cirillo found Bender for a gain of 40 yards on 3rd and 5 to extend the drive. Anglovich and Lewis is combined for 26 yards of rushing the rest of the way, with Lewis finding paydirt from five yards out for his first career touchdown.

The Warriors defense forced its first of five punts on its next drive. Eldridge would takedown BU's LePoidevin for a sack on 3rd down to stall the drive.

After a short Bloomsburg punt setup ESU with good field position near midfield, the Warriors would take its first lead on a 33-yard field goal by Bartholomew.

Heading into the second quarter, the Warrior defense remained relentless, forcing a three-and-out.

ESU continued to run the ball successfully, before a sack on 3rd down would lead to Bartholomew field goal from 36 yards out to grab a 13-7 advantage.

After Bloomsburg completed a five-yard completion on its first play of its next drive, LePoidevin would throw an interception to Tyler Watson. The pick marked the second consecutive week that Watson grabbed an interception, as the Warrington, Pa. native now leads ESU with three INT's this season and seven in his career.

The Warriors could not take advantage after a seven-play drive resulted in a punt.

The turnover bug continued to haunt the Huskies, with McCarthy grabbing an errant snap out of the air. He would return the ball 11 yards on the recovery. With 3:21 remaining in the first half, ESU would find the end zone in just four plays, as Cirillo finding Lavarin for a 10-yard strike. ESU looked to take a 14-point lead, as Dawson Stuart was able to come up with a deflected pass for the two-point conversion. ESU led 21-7 with just 30 seconds remaining in the first half.

Instead of running out the clock, Bloomsburg attempted to pass on its own 20-yard line with 30 seconds left, BU's drive resulted in its third consecutive turnover, with LePoidevin's pass finding defensive end Ryan Hieber, who dropped back into coverage. Hieber grabbed his first career interception as was off to the races, returning the ball 22 yards into the end zone, as the Warriors would take a 28-7 lead into the halftime intermission.

The ESU Athletic Department honored Big Brothers Big Sisters of Northeastern Pennsylvania at halftime, presenting Certificates of Appreciation to BBBS NEPA's - Dr. Mark Wade (Governing Board Member) Brenna Courtright (Program Supervisor) and Dr. Doreen Tobin, retired ESU vice president of campus life and inclusive excellence, who is the Chair of the Monroe Advisory Board.

Big Brothers Big Sisters

After the intermission, the Warriors received the second half kick and would extend its lead to 28 points on a 12-play, 71 yard drive. On 3rd-and-2 from the Bloomsburg 17-yard line, Cirillo found Lavarin in the end zone for his second touchdown of the contest. The score was Lavarin's third in two weeks after finding the end zone on an 85-yard reception against West Chester.

With ESU in control, Bloomsburg would add its second touchdown of the game with 14:48 left in the contest on a 25-yard touchdown pass. That concluded the scoring, as ESU would drain an impressive 9:18 of clock on an 18-play drive.

Overall ESU led 22-10 on first downs, 235-90 on rushing yards, 402-229 on net offensive yards. The Warriors nearly doubled the Huskies time of possession (39:45 to 20:15). The Warriors held Bloomsburg to just 2-of-9 on 3rd down and allowed the Huskies to reach the red zone twice.

WEEK NINE

Sat., Oct. 30

Shippensburg 24, ESU 23

Despite, 277 all-purpose yards from Rece Bender, the East Stroudsburg University football could not prevent a late Shippensburg come-back, falling to the Raiders by 24-23 mark on Saturday afternoon at Eiler-Martin Stadium.

The Warriors' (5-4, 3-3 PSAC East) five-game winning streak at Eiler-Martin Stadium was snapped with the loss, while the Raiders improve to 7-2, 4-2 in conference action.

ESU held a 23-14 halftime lead, but the Warriors were unable to score any points in the second half, with drives ending on a missed field goal, two turnover on downs, two punts, an interception and lost a fumble. Ship was able to score a touchdown after a long interception return, and Jaxson Montross would kick the eventual game-winning field goal with 1:27 left in regulation. The ESU offense was held to just 1-7 on 3rd down conversions after halftime.

Bender registered a career-best 188 yards receiving on just five catches, reeling in a 66-yard touchdown and explosive receptions of 47, 39, and 31 and five yards. On returns, Bender registered 67 yards off kick returns and 22 on punt returns for the 277 all-purpose yard mark. It's the second highest of career, with 312 all-purpose yards and Shepherd in 2019. 277 all-purpose yards ranks 10th most by a Warrior since 1974.

Gunner Anglovich rushed for 73 yards with a touchdown on 28 carries.

Quarterback Jake Cirillo threw for a season-best 286 yards, completing 12-24 passes for a touchdown and two interceptions.

Defensively, Paul Carreras led the way with 10 tackles and a sack. The national-leader in sacks, Deshawn McCarthy finished with a half sack and six tackles. Jacob Keane posted six sacks with two tackles for loss including a clutch fourth down stop. Defending PSAC East Defensive Athlete of the Week Ryan Hieber and Andre Eldridge also recorded sacks for the Warriors.

Shavar Hussett posted his third interception of the season.

On special teams, Devin Bartholomew converted 3-4 field goal attempts, making field goals from 27, 33 and 42 yards in the first half, while missing a 42-yard try during the third quarter. Nate Reed booted three punts for an impressive average of 52.7, with two finding the inside of the 20-yard line. He posted a career-best mark with a 62-yard punt.

ESU built an early 10-0 lead. On the Warriors' first drive, Cirillo found Bender for a gain of 47-yards, to setup Bartholomew with his first field goal of the game.

On Ship's first drive, Keane would come up with a huge stop on 4th-and-1, blitzing through the line and registering a tackle for loss off of a handoff.

After taking over possession near midfield, a 39-yd reception from Bender would put ESU in the red zone. A defensive pass interference and four carries from Anglovich would lift ESU to its first touchdown of the game on a one-yard plunge from the Bethlehem native.

The Raiders would score on its next drive, with wide receiver Evan Morrill completing a pass to open quarterback Brycen Mussina on a 30-yard touchdown.

After a Warrior punt, the Raiders would take their first lead of the contest with a seven-play 65 yards drive which culminated with a one-yard rushing touchdown.

Cirillo would throw his first of two interceptions on ESU's next drive, but the Warrior defense held tough with by forcing a short punt.

Cirillo made up for the pick by finding Bender for 66-yards on his next attempt to retake the lead at 17-14. Bender now has touch-downs of 96 yards (tied for the longest play in Division II this season), 79 yards (vs. Pace), 64 and 53 yards receptions against West Chester and 40 yards against Bloomsburg. He now has 10 catches of 20-plus yards this season.

With the first half winding down, the Warrior defense forced a 3-and-out. Cirillo would lead ESU with completions of 16 yards to Clifford Brinkley, 10 yards to Elie Lavarin, and a 13-yard completion to Anglovich, before Bartholomew would convert a 33-yard field goal attempt. ESU to extend its lead to grab a 20-14 lead.

After another turnover on downs from Ship, ESU took over near midfield and advanced possession, with a big 28-yard catch by Chad Parton. Bartholomew made his third field goal of the game from 48 yards out as time expired.

ESU took a 23-14 lead into the locker room. Bender posted 152 yards receiving on just three catches in the first half.

Neither team was able to put points on the scoreboard during the third frame. Three combined punts, Hussett's interception, an ESU missed field goal and a Warrior turnover on downs were how the drives ended for both squads.

Shippensburg was able to get within reach of the Warriors with a 53-yard interception return to the ESU five-yard line. The Raiders would score two plays later to get within two points of ESU at 23-21.

Both team's traded punts. The Warriors had a promising 10-play drive that chewed up 5:30 of clock, but ultimately ended in a fumble, just the second lost fumble for ESU this season.

Taking over possession with 4:39 left in regulation, a 42-yard completion would Shippensburg to a 31-yard field goal to take the lead.

With just 1:27 left, ESU gained a first down on an 18-yard reception from Lavarin, but the drive would ultimately end with a sack on 4th down.
