Game Summary

Eastern Washington opened the 2026 season on the road against No. 24/25 Northern Arizona. NAU defeated Eastern, 34-27, in a hard-hitting battle.

EWU scored first by way of a 3-yard touchdown pass from Nate Bell to Wesley Garrett. The pass initially went to Ryan Johnson, but it was bobbled and Garrett was in the right spot for the catch. The Eagles would go up 24-3 on the Lumberjacks in the second quarter, after a 12-yard TD run from Bell, followed by a 14-yard TD throw to Jaxon Branch, set up by a Jaylon Jenkins interception. Soren McKee connected on a 53-yard field goal as well. NAU then responded with 24-straight points from the second to fourth quarter to swing momentum back to the home team. Eastern trailed 27-24 in the fourth. McKee tied the game up at 27 on a 37-yard field goal. The 'Jacks managed to organize an 11-play, 75-yard drive to score the go-ahead touchdown. Despite a late drive from EWU, the team could not tie the game and fell on the road. Eastern had the advantage in total yards at 429 to 365.

AARON BEST

Head Coach (10th Season / 26th on staff)

Aaron Best bleeds Eagle red. 2026 will be his 30th season with Eastern Washington football after stepping on campus as a freshman offensive lineman in 1996. After four years as a student-athlete, including two years as the team's starting center, the Tacoma native was hired as a student assistant in 2000 and steadily worked his way to the top,

serving as an assistant coach under Paul Wulff and Beau Baldwin for 16 years before taking over in 2017.

Best earned the Big Sky Conference co-Coach of the Year in 2018 after guiding Eastern to a league co-championship and an appearance in the NCAA Division I Championship Game. He was also voted by fans nationwide as the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) Coach of the Year by Hero Sports.

In his nine seasons as head coach, he has compiled a 57-47 record overall (.548) and 42-28 mark in the Big Sky (.600). His Big Sky winning percentages ranked second in program history since joining the FCS level (formerly Division I-AA) in 1984.

Eastern ranked in the top five in total offense in the FCS in five of his first six seasons at the helm, including ranking 1st in 2019 (524.8 yards per game), 2021 (554.5), 3rd in the 2021 spring season, and 4th in the 2023 season (417.6). The Eagles also ranked 2nd in overall scoring in 2021, 3rd in passing (399.4) and earned a 6-0 record on the road during the regular season, the best such mark since 1967. Although a 20-game winning streak at home on "The Inferno" came to an end in 2021. Best boasts an outstanding seven-year record at Roos Field of 30-13 (.698).

Best has coached 27 offensive linemen to All-America honors, 60 to All-Big Sky honors, 10 to senior bowl or all-star game appearances and two hear their name called in the NFL Draft. As a head coach, nine Eagles have received All-America recognition, including QB Eric Barriere, who was a two-time finalist for the Walter Payton Award, given annually to the most outstanding offensive player in the FCS. Barriere was twice named the Big Sky MVP and the team has earned 102 total All-Big Sky honors with Best at the helm, adding 30 Big Sky Player of the Week awards.

As a player, Best was a four-year contributor for the Eagles from 1996-99, serving as the long snapper for all four and starting center for his junior and senior seasons. He earned Big Sky First Team and All-America Honorable Mention honors as a senior, and All-Big Sky Honorable Mention recognition as a junior. A standout in the classroom himself, Best was twice named to the Big Sky All-Academic team and once to both the CoSIDA Academic All-District VIII Team and FCS Athletic Directors Academic All-Star Team (both in 1999). He earned his bachelor's in Social Science from Eastern in 2001.

MARC ANDERSON

Assistant Head Coach / Offensive Coordinator / QBs (2nd season as OC / 12th Season)

Anderson takes over the offensive coordinator job after being promoted by head coach Aaron Best in January of 2025. He is also entering his 4th season for 2025 as Associate Head Coach and 11th overall at Eastern. A two-time Eagle grad – earning his bachelor's and master's degrees in Cheney – he originally started with the program

as a student assistant.

Over the last two seasons, Eagle tight ends have combined to bring down 64 catches for 715 yards and 12 touchdowns, highlighted by the duo of Blake Gobel and Dylan Ingram scoring 4 TDs each in 2022.

Anderson provides a variety of administrative support services for head coach Aaron Best and the program, including recruiting, budget, staffing organization/hiring, head coach media obligations and other duties. Eastern's recruiting class in 2019 was ranked No. 1 in the Big Sky and No. 2 in FCS. Anderson also assists with roster management, coordinating team meals and camps, but now on lesser scale with the addition of his tight ends coaching duties.

After assisting the program for nearly three seasons as a student intern, he was hired as a student operations assistant and video coordinator in 2014. Anderson took on more responsibility in 2016, when he was promoted to Director of Football Operations. He added recruiting coordinator duties in 2020 and was named Associate Head Coach in 2022.

He earned a Bachelor of Arts and Education in English in 2014 and a Master of Arts degree in English in 2016.



ZACH BRUCE

Defensive Coordinator / LBs (1st season as DC / 7th on staff)

Bruce enters his 7th season as coach of Eastern after a prolific playing career as an Eagle from 2012-16. He added defensive pass game coordinator duties this season.

Bruce helped Derek Ganter Jr. earn All-Big Sky second team honors in the 2024 season, along with earning a spot on the Jerry Rice Award watchlist. Ganter Jr. led the team with 95.0 tackles, adding one sack and a force fumble. In 2022, Bruce coached Marlon Jones Jr. to Third Team All-Big Sky Honors after recording 52 tackles in 11 games (9 starts), leading the team with 4 pass deflections and 3 interceptions. The Eagles ranked 4th in the conference in passing yards allowed per game (215.2). They ranked 3rd in interceptions (13) and 19th nationally.

Bruce coached Calin Criner to Third Team All-Big Sky honors in 2021 after he ranked 3rd on the team with 83 total tackles, 2 INTs and 9 breakups. The Eagle defense held opponents to 23 points-or-less 7 times and ranked 18th in the nation with 14 INTs. He coached safety Anthony Smith to First Team All-Big Sky honors in the abbreviated 2020-21 season as Smith had had a team-leading 44 tackles, adding 2 INTs (one for a 71-yard TD).

As a player Bruce played four years and ranks in the top 50 in EWU history in games played (50; t-42nd) and total tackles (227; 27th). He earned First Team All-Big Sky honors as a senior when he served as team co-captain. He also earned Honorable Mention All-Big Sky in 2014, and in 2015 and 2016 he was selected to the Big Sky All-Academic team. He made 14 tackles in a single game twice and 115 total during his senior year (13th in program history). Eastern went 41-13 (.759) in the four seasons he played, including 28-4 in Big Sky play (.875). The team won the Big Sky Conference title and advanced to the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision Playoffs in 2013, 2014 and 2016. Bruce received his bachelor's degree in history from Eastern in 2018. He earned a minor in coaching and a secondary minor in social studies education. Bruce is married to Delaney Hodgins, who is the all-time leading scorer in EWU women's basketball history (2,120; 2015-18). While he was in Finland, Bruce wrote a book about football called "Dumb Jocks" which takes a deep look into the understanding of defensive football.

Quick Recap of '25

Eastern Washington finished 5-7 overall in the 2025 season and 4-4 in the Big Sky, tying for sixth in the final conference standings. The Eagles defended Roos Field well last season, going 4-1 at home. Starting off last season, Eastern had three-straight road games to start off the '25 slate. EWU faced a top-10 ranked Incarnate Word team on the road, falling 31-21. The team then faced Boise State, falling 51-14 to the Broncos. The Eagles nearly had their first win the next week against Northern Iowa, but came up short, 17-14 against the Panthers. Eastern returned to Roos for the season opener the following week against Western Illinois, delivering a 52-31 win for the home fans. EWU went back on the road to face eventual FCS national champion, Montana State, with the Bobcats dominating, 57-3.

The Eagles then ripped off three-straight wins, including an upset of No. 24 Idaho, 21-14 at home. The winning streak also included a 35-27 victory over Portland State at home and a 23-20 road win over Weber State. The three-game winning streak was the team's first since the 2021 season. The win streak ended the next week against Sacramento State, with the Hornets knocking off the Eagles, 35-13 at Roos. With the team's record at 4-5, EWU traveled to Missoula, Mont. to face the second-ranked Grizzlies. Redshirt-freshman Jake Schakel made his first career start against the Griz, and played ahead of his years with 451 passing yards and two touchdowns in his first collegiate start. Despite the effort, the Griz held on for a 29-24 win. Back home, Eastern hosted Northern Colorado on senior, controlling the game against the Bears and tallying five interceptions. The Eagles sent the seniors off with a 27-7 win. In the 2025 season finale, EWU faced Cal Poly. The teams battled back-and-forth, but the Mustangs secured a home win, defeating Eastern 43-34.

Two-Straight Against the Panthers

Eastern Washington plays the second part of the home-and-home series with Northern Iowa on Saturday. The teams played in Cedar Falls last year, with the Panthers topping the Eagles, 17-14. EWU trailed 17-0 going to the fourth quarter, but rallied to pull within three late. Nate Bell rushed for 89 yards in the game and scored two touchdowns. Bryce Smith had a blocked punt that set up one of Bell's touchdowns and Jaylon Jenkins notched his first career interception, making the pick while UNI was in the redzone.

Eastern is 2-7 against UNI in program history, but is 2-0 at Roos Field. The teams met in the first round of the 2021 playoffs, with the Eagles winning 19-9. The teams also met in the 2005 playoffs, playing Cedar Falls. The Panthers won the matchup, 41-38. Saturday's game will be Northern Iowa's first of the season, as the team was idle during Week 0.

Defense on the Up Swing

Eastern's defense showed its growth last season and kept the team in multiple games. The growth was apparent in the season opener against Northern Arizona. Eastern held the Lumberjacks to 365 yards - 5.4 yards per play. They forced 1 turnover as Jaylon Jenkins snagged his 1st interception of the season and 6th of his career. EWU now has an interception in 10 of its last 13 games. The Eagle defense limited NAU quarterback Ty Pennington to 164 yards on 15-of-27 (55.6%), 58.7 yards below his career average and 9% below his career completion percentage. JoJo Maxey-Johnson notched his first career sack. As a whole, the defense had 85 tackles, the most for the team since they had 85 against Portland State last season. The secondary added 5 pass breakups, led by 2 from Bryce Smith, the most for the team since they had 7 against Idaho a year ago. The team also had 3 players (Mayovsky, Smith, Broussard) with 10+ tackles for the first time since last season against Idaho.

Backers Make the Difference

The Eagle defense has experience at all levels, but returns 2 of its 3 linebackers from the '25 team in Myles Mayovsky and Samarai Anderson. Mayovsky started all 12 games last season and ranked 2nd on the team with 80 tackles. The figure also ranked 13th in the Big Sky. He had 5 tackles for loss, including 1 sack, adding 5 pass breakups. Anderson played in all 12 games with 1 start. The redshirt-junior was 9th on the Eagles with 42 tackles, including 5 for a loss and 1 sack. Against Northern Arizona in Week 0, both Mayovsky and Anderson set career-bests in tackles, with Mayovsky registering 18 and Anderson finishing with 9.

QB Report

Eastern Washington started 4 different quarterbacks last season and three of them are back on the 2026 roster. redshirt-junior Nate Bell, redshirt-sophomore Jake Schakel and sophomore Kaden Rolfness return, while Jared Taylor, last year's season-opening starter, graduated. Bell started 5 games in 2025, with Schakel starting 2 and Rolfness starting the season finale against Cal Poly. Brady Annett joins the QB room after graduating from Corona Del Mar High School.

Bell got the call to start the 2026 season and showed poise in the Big Sky road matchup. Against the 'Jacks, Bell completed 30-of-47 (63.8%) passes for 307 yards, 2 touchdowns and 1 interception. Bell set career-bests in yards, completions and attempts, while matching his career-best in touchdown passes. Bell is the first Eagle to pass for 300+ yards since Gunner Talkington passed for 348 in the 2022 opener. The redshirt-junior also rushed for 18 yards on 6 attempts with 1 touchdown. Bell has 9 career passing touchdowns and 7 rushing.

Spreading it Around

Nate Bell completed passes to 6 different players against NAU, helping 2 receivers to career-bests and one matching. Jaxon Branch set career marks with 7 catches for 88 yards, and hauled in his 3rd career touchdown catch. Drew Carlson led the team with 9 catches for 75 yards, both career marks in his first career start. Wesley Garrett matched his career-best with 7 receptions and caught his 3rd career touchdown. He finished with 56 receiving yards. Jamai East made his Eagle debut, catching 2 passes for 42 yards.

TALKING POINTS (CONT.)

Preseason Hype for Two Defensive Eagles

Leading into the 2026 season, safety Jaylon Jenkins and defensive tackle Isaiah Perez are getting national attention. The two earned preseason All-American recognition from Stats Perform, with Jenkins on second team and Perez on the third. Jenkins and Perez earned the same recognition from Phil Steele's FCS All-American teams. The two were both named to the Big Sky preseason All-Conference team as well. Jenkins added a third preseason All-American honor from FCS Football Central, while also being listed on the Buck Buchanan watchlist, honoring the top defensive player in the nation.

The preseason recognition stems from Big Sky All-Conference honors in 2025 for both Jenkins and Perez. Jenkins earned first team honors after intercepting 5 passes, ranking 5th in the FCS and 2nd in the conference. Adding to the interception haul, Jenkins tallied 8 pass breakups to give him 13 passes defended on the season, ranking 16th in the FCS. The redshirt-junior was fourth on the team with 52 total tackles, including 39 solo and 2 for a loss. Perez led EWU with 4.0 sacks - ranking 15th in the Big Sky - while posting 51 tackles (5th on team), 19 solo. The redshirt senior made his name on special teams, blocking 4 kicks - 3 field goals and 1 extra point - to tie for the national lead. The stat also set the EWU single-season record and Perez's 5 career blocked-kick mark is 2nd in program history, one behind Dylan Ledbetter (2016-19). He is also tied for 2nd with Jackie Kellogg with 4 blocked field goals.

One More Final Ride

2025 was supposed to be Malik Dotson's final season, but the Arlington, Wash. native's season ended in the first game due to injuries. Dotson returns to Eastern for his final season in 2026 and has 563 career rushing yards. He rushed for 505 of them in the 2024 season, scoring 4 touchdowns. Dotson had 12 receptions for 153 yards that season as well. Against NAU, Dotson tied for the team lead and rushed for 48 yards on 13 attempts - 3.5 yards per attempt.

Terrors of the Skies

Eastern Washington notched 15 interceptions last season, a figure that ranked 7th in the FCS and 2nd in the Big Sky. The 15 INTs helped the Eagles carry a +4 turnover margin last year, ranking 26th in the nation and 3rd in the conference. Jaylon Jenkins led the team with 5, while three players had 2 and four had 1. Ambrose Marsh grabbed the first 2 INTs of his career, while Dre Greeley returns with 1 to his name from last season. Marsh was thrown into the starting lineup last season and excelled, racking up 43 tackles - 33 solo - and 2 for a loss. He had 1.0 sack, 4 pass breakups and 1 forced fumble. True freshman Bryce Smith also found himself with more playing time than expected, making six starts and playing in 11 games. Smith was 6th on the team with 47 tackles, including 27 solo, while registering 2 for a loss. He had 0.5 sack and 3 pass breakups, adding one forced fumble. Greeley had 4 pass breakups and 11 solo tackles. Along with Jenkins interception, Smith and graduate student McKel Broussard set career-bests in tackles. Smith posted 14 tackles with 4 solo, while Broussard had 12 with 4 solo as well. Marsh had 6 total tackles - 4 solo - and 1 pass breakup.

Experience Across the O-Line

After entering the 2025 season with only one offensive lineman with starting experience, the 2026 offensive line is one of the most experienced units on the roster. Mark Johnson and Gavin Allen return after both starting all 12 games last season, with Johnson at center and Allen at guard. Allen is two seasons removed from switching positions from tight end. Additionally, Cole McGovern made 9 starts at guard last year, while Cole Abarca made 5 starts at guard. Kyle Stahlecker had 2 starts at guard before injuries, and Dane Gatterman started the team's final 3 games at guard. To begin the 2026 season, Johnson and Allen both started, making it 13-straight starts for the duo. Gabriel Rzany, Michael Gradle and Dylan Scott all notched their first career start in the season opener.

On Point McKee

Soren McKee is putting on the Eagle red for the final season in 2026, and he is continuing to move up the all-time EWU lists. Following the Week 0 matchup against the Lumberjacks, McKee is now 130-for-131 on extra points, with his made attempts now tying for 3rd on the all-time list with Seth Harrison and 4th in attempts. For his career, McKee has scored 226 points after accounting for 9 against NAU. McKee's 9 points included a career-long 53-yard field goal. He is now 8th on the program's all-time scoring list. McKee is 32-for-43 (74.2%) on field goals at EWU, placing him 4th on made attempts and tied for 7th in attempts, while ranking 5th all-time in percentage.

Blocked Effort

The Eagles' special teams were a disruptive force last season, blocking 6 kicks to rank 5th in the FCS and lead the Big Sky. Isaiah Perez led Eastern and tied for the national lead with 4 blocked kicks. Bryce Smith had one blocked punt and Jirah Leaupepetele had 1.

Big Sky Academic Champions

Eastern continued its tradition of academic excellence in 2025, earning the top team GPA among football programs in the Big Sky, carrying a 3.46 cumulative GPA. The team had 3 student-athletes with a 4.0 GPA and 52 with GPAs over 3.0. The tradition extended at the national level with seven student-athletes named to the NFF Hampshire Honor Society. The group included graduating seniors Dylan Conner, Landon Cooper, Aidan Corning, Noah Cronquist, Landon Ogles, Trevor Thurman and Nolan Ulm. Six Eagles also earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honors, with Conner, Cooper, Ogles, Thurman, Ulm and Jaylon Jenkins qualifying for the award. In addition, 37 student-athletes earned Big Sky All-Academic honors for the fall.
