IN CASE YOU MISSED IT:

♦ Fairfield is coming off their third straight loss, dropping a 76-63 decision to Iowa State. It is their longest losing streak since the 2012-13 campaign when the squad lost four straight.

♦ The Stag played perhaps their best game against one of their more difficult opponent in Iowa State. Fairfield trailed by just six with nine minutes to go in the game but could not complete the comeback.

♦ The Stags shot 43 percent in the contest, their third highest shooting percentage in any non-conference game this season. Fairfield also had the same assist-turnover ratio as Iowa State. The Cyclones had come into the game leading the country in that category. Fairfield had 14 assists to nine turnovers compared to the home team's 16 assists and 10 giveaways.

♦ The difference of the game came on the boards, with the Cyclones winning the rebounding battle 44-30. Iowa State also had 18 offensive boards, 10 more than the Stags. Fairfield is giving up 14.3 offensive boards a game this season.

♦ Kristin Schatzlein led the Stags for the seventh time this season, scoring 19 points in the contest. Helena Orts tied a career-high with 12 points, the second time in three games that she has reached that feat. Lizzy Ball and Macey Hollenshead also hit their first career 3-pointer in the defeat.

FAIRFIELD VS. LA SALLE

♦ This will be the fourth straight season that these two teams will meet, and the 27th time in their history.

JOE FRAGER HEAD COACH

RECORD AT FAIRFIELD: 143-91 (EIGHT SEASONS)
MAAC RECORD: 92-52 (EIGHT SEASONS)
OVERALL RECORD: 332-174 (17 SEASONS)

The 2014-15 campaign marks the eighth season that Joe Frager has been at the helm of the Fairfield University women's basketball program. Under his tutelage the Stags have averaged 20 wins per season (141 overall), earned 17 All-MAAC and five All-Met Team recognitions, advanced to the MAAC Championship Final in two of the last four seasons, appeared in the WNIT in 2012, and advanced to the semifinals of the Women's Basketball Invitational.

All told, Frager has been a head coach at the collegiate level for 17 years, with nine seasons at Southern Connecticut State University. His resume includes the 2007 NCAA Division II National Championships and six Coach of the Year awards. Outside of being honored for an individual season's accomplishments, Frager has also been honored for the breadth of his achievements. In 2008 he was inducted into the Connecticut Women's Basketball Hall of Fame and in October 2009 was inducted into the New England Basketball Hall of Fame.

Frager's first seven seasons at the helm have rekindled the spirit and tradition of Fairfield University women's basketball. The Stags have won 63 percent of their games during that time, with four 20-win seasons in the books. Along the way, the Stags have appeared in three MAAC Championship semifinal games, two MAAC Championship finals, a berth in the WNIT, and finished in the top-third of the conference standings each season.

The 2011-12 campaign was one of the best in program history. The Stags went 24-9 overall and 16-2 in the MAAC to secure its first berth in the WNIT in more than a decade. Fairfield hosted their first-ever WNIT game at Alumni Hall where they were tipped by the Dragons, 57-41, to end the season. The Stags finished the year ranked fifth nationally in scoring defense, allowing 52.0 points per game, and 18th in the nation in turnovers per game, committing just 13.9 per contest. In addition, three Stags recorded their 1,000th career points during the campaign.

Individual accomplishments have also followed Fairfield since Frager's arrival. A Stag has earned First-Team All-MAAC honors in each of Frager's seasons with the program and Fairfield has received a total of 17 All-MAAC selections in that time. The Stags have also received one MAAC Defensive Player of the Year, one MAAC Sixth Player of the Year, and 19 All-MAAC Academic Team selections. Additionally, in all seven seasons with Frager at the helm, a player has been honored by the Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association with All-Met accolades.

Frager's first season at the helm of the Stags, the 2007-08 campaign, can only be considered a rousing success. Fairfield won 22 games, including five straight to start the season, and knocked off ACC member Boston College and earned strong consideration for an at-large berth to the WNIT. The win total was the fourth-most victories in a single-season in the program's history. It also marked the seventh-time in program history that the Stags had won 20 or more games, and the first time since the 2000-01 squad earned an at-large berth to the NCAA Tournament. The squad fulfilled Frager's goal of playing well down the stretch, winning 12 of the final 16 games, including five of six to finish the regular season.

♦ Fairfield is 2-1 against the Explorers in the Joe Frager era and also holds a 14-12 advantage in the all-time series. The Stags are 4-7 against the Explorers on the road and will be traveling to Philadelphia for the second time during Frager's campaign.

♦ Schatzlein is averaging 9.5 points against the Explorers while shooting .500 from the floor and .571 from deep. **Felicia DaCruz** has eight assists and just one turnovers against LaSalle. **Kristine Miller** had six points and did not miss a shot (2-2 FG, 2-2 FT) in her only appearance against LaSalle.

SCOUTING THE EXPLORERS

♦ La Salle is coming into the game, winners of seven of their last nine games which includes a six-game winning streak. The winning streak was the longest for the program since the 2011-12 season.

♦ La Salle's statistics are basically a mirror image to their opponents. The Explorers have been outscored by just 15 points through their first 11 games. The Explorers are shooting .381 percent from the floor and have dished out 131 assists, both of those numbers are the exact same as their opponents. La Salle is much improved from long range, shooting over 36 percent from behind the arc. Last season, the Explorers shot just 28 percent from that distance.

♦ The Explorers are led by Micahya Owens who leads the team with 14.1 points per game and 22 3-pointers made. Owens is eighth in the A-10 in scoring. Alicia Cropper is the only other player averaging double figures, with 12.3 per contest. Cropper was the only player to be named to a Preseason All Atlantic-10 team.

FAIRFIELD VS. THE A-10

♦ The Stags are 49-29 against teams currently a part of the Atlantic 10

NOW THAT'S TOUGH

♦ The Stags have the 9th most difficult schedule in the country, with stats updated through games played on December 25th. Fairfield's past opponents have a record of 63-29, with a .685 winning percentage.

♦ Statistically Fairfield has a tougher early season schedule than schools such as UCONN, North Carolina, and South Carolina. Hampton has the toughest schedule in the country thus far.

♦ The Stags have played three games against a team that has received votes in the national polls at some point this season. Five of their non-conference opponents played in a national postseason last year.

ALL ABOUT SHOTS

♦ **Kristin Schatzlein** reached double figures in every game through the first six games, the second straight season a Stag has accomplished this feat. **Katie Cizynski** was the one who accomplished that last year.

♦ Schatzlein has led her team in scoring seven times during their first 10 games. That number ties for the most in the conference with Iona's Damika Martinez who has led the Gaels in seven of their nine outings.

♦ The junior is currently fourth in the league in scoring and has accounted for 25 percent of the team's points. Schatzlein is already halfway near her amount of points from last season and is on pace to score 450 this season.

HELENA OF TROY

♦ **Helena Orts** is starting to find her stride as of late, averaging 10.7 points and 3.7 rebounds per game in the last three contests. The 32 points in third on the team during that span.

♦ Orts is coming off a career-high 60 percent shooting from the floor and has tied her personal best with 12 points in two of the last three games. Orts has taken 34 shots which is tied for the second most on the team.

♦ Nine of her 11 rebounds has off the offensive glass during the last three contests.

ON THIS DATE IN STAGS HISTORY

♦ Fairfield is 3-5 all-time on games played on December 28.

♦ This is the first time since 2012 the Stags will be playing on this date and just the second time in the last four seasons.

♦ Fairfield held a four game losing streak on this date that lasted from 1982 until 1996.

CAN'T BEAT SMITTY

- ◊ Stags sophomore **Casey Smith** reached 14 points in three straight games before the game at Iowa State. Smith was shooting .472 from the floor over that span and was coming off a 6-10 shooting performance against Seton Hall.
- ◊ Smith is playing her first season in nearly three years. Smith was ineligible to play last year due to NCAA transfer rules. In her only season at Saint Joseph's, Smith was injured and did not see playing time.
- ◊ The 114 points scored in her first 10 games is the most by a Stag rookie in over 15 years

A FAST PACE

- ◊ With 25 3-pointers in the first 10 games, Kristin Schatzlein is on pace to hit 75 long range shots this season, which would be the fourth most by a Stag.
- ◊ Schatzlein hit 64 long-range shots last season. She would need to average 2.0 per contest to equal that mark.
- ◊ The junior is averaging 2.5 3-pointers per contest.

NEED TO HIT A THREE

- ◊ The Stags came into the game against Siena in the top-50 in the country in three-point field goals per game. However, the Stags would only hit one in the game going 1-8.
- ◊ The one three-pointer was the fewest since the Stags went 1-7 against Quinnipiac on Jan. 26, 2014 against Quinnipiac. Fairfield has now hit a three in exactly 303 straight games. The last time Fairfield has not hit a three-point field goal was December 2, 2004 against Saint Peter's.
- ◊ It marked the fifth three-pointer the Stags have scored in the final minute of a game this season. It was also the first time that **Samantha Cooper** had attempted a shot in the final minute this season.

KELSEY CAREY-S THE STAGS

- ◊ **Kelsey Carey** had the game of her life against Siena. Carey nearly doubled her yearly output with 22 points against Siena in a career-high 32 minutes. Carey had 14 points at halftime which was already a personal-best. Carey set career highs in points (22), rebounds (eight), minutes (32), and field goals made (11).
- ◊ Carey also had a team-best six offensive boards against the Saints. The six offensive rebounds was the most since **Katie Cizynski** had seven against Bryant.
- ◊ The 22 points off the bench is the most by a Fairfield bench player since current assistant coach **Sabra Wrice** had a program record 36 against Siena.

STAGS IN MAAC OPENERS

- ◊ The Stags are now 23-11 all-time in the first game of the MAAC season
- ◊ Fairfield has started 1-0 in the MAAC slate in seven straight seasons and seven of eight years under Joe Frager. The Stags have not lost an opening MAAC game since Dec 7, 2007 against Saint Peter's.

FELICIA IS CRUZIN'

- ◊ Despite nursing an injury that she suffered in the preseason, Felicia DaCruz is picking up right where she let off last season.
- ◊ DaCruz currently has 30 assists with only 9 turnovers.
- ◊ DaCruz currently has 319 career assists and is 24 away from moving to the 13th spot in program history (Jessica Grossarth '98)
- ◊ DaCruz has 15 assists and four turnovers in her last three games. She is also second on the team with six offensive rebounds in the last three contests.

STAGS IN ALUMNI HALL

- ◊ Fairfield is coming off a season where they held a 7-2 mark at Alumni Hall
- ◊ The previous season, Fairfield went 10-4 at Alumni Hall, their most losses in the building since the 1998-98 campaign
- ◊ The Stags have played 324 games in Alumni Hall with a 249-79 record (.770). Fairfield is 54-15 in the building under Joe Frager

OFFENSIVE OUTPUT

- Through four games, the Stags scored 257 points, 14 more than they had at that time last season.
- This is the most that Fairfield has scored through the first four games of the season since 2004 when they scored 259 in the opening four contests.
- The 81 points that they scored against Butler, was the most at home since they tallied 81 against Niagara last season.

NOTHING'S FREE....YES IT IS!

- The Stags went 14-14 from the free throw line against East Carolina, it was the best showing from the charity stripe in program history.
- Fairfield has not missed a free throw in a game where they shot 10 or more on now six different occasions.
- Fairfield has gone perfect from the line on Feb. 23, 2003 against Canisius (13-13); Dec. 8, 2003 against Seton Hall (12-12); Jan 14, 1989 vs Fordham (12-12); Feb. 27, 1988 at Manhattan (12-12); and Dec. 30, 2006 at Long Beach State (10-10).

KEEP THE BALL

- Fairfield turned the ball over 32 times in the season opener against East Carolina, the most in a game in more than five years.
- The Stags had not had more than 28 turnovers in a game since 2009
- Fairfield cut down on their turnovers in the next game, only having 11 against Marshall.

SHOTS ON A LINE

- Kristin Schatzlein** shot a career-high 16 three-point field goal attempts in the game against Marshall. Schatzlein had only attempted 10 or more in a game twice in her career prior to the game.
- The five 3-pointers that she hit were a career-high and helped her post a personal-best 21 points in the game.
- The 16 3-pointers attempted was the second most in program history just one shy of **Jessica Grossarth's** record against Canisius on Feb 17, 1997.

WE'RE PLAYING LIZ-ZY BALLLL

- Lizzy Ball** had a career day on her birthday when she registered a career-high six assists and even picked up her second career block against Marshall.
- Ball also went 6-6 from the free-throw line against East Carolina and has made 13 of her first 14 free throw attempts for her career.
- The guard got her first two career starts in the URI Tipoff tournament and played in 52 minutes, 12 more than she did in her entire freshman season.
- Ball has 12 assists and four turnovers in the last seven games.

FAIRFIELD IN SEASON OPENERS

- Fairfield has now won six of the last eight season openers under Head Coach **Joe Frager**, after their loss to East Carolina
- The Stags are 16-18 in season openers in the Division I level and 19-22 at the varsity level.
- This is the fourth time in program history the season will open on November 14th. Fairfield opened on this day for three-straight seasons (2007-09). The Stags were 3-0 in those games.

FAST START FRAGER

- In his 17 years of coaching, Joe Frager has gone 14-3 in his season openers, including a 6-2 mark at Fairfield
- Before the Stags' loss to Florida in 2012, Frager had won 12 straight opening day games.
- He is the only Fairfield coach in history to win his opening game each of his first five seasons at the helm of the team. Prior to Frager's tenure, Fairfield had gone 1-0 just ten times since 1981

WHO WE GET

- ◊ Fairfield welcomes six freshmen to this year's roster and also will have the pleasure of seeing **Casey Smith**, **Margeaux Dupuy**, and **Samantha Cooper** return to the lineup. Smith (St. Joseph) and Dupuy (Marquette) were ineligible to play last season due to NCAA transfer rules. Cooper missed all but three games with a season-ending injury.
- ◊ The Stags will also welcome two foreign players Helena Orts (Spain) and Sarah Stock (Germany) to Stag Country. In Frager's eight years at the helm, Fairfield has signed six players outside the United States (MacFarlane, Vetra, Grace, Akon-Akech)
- ◊ The six freshmen are the most in a season under Frager. Fairfield had seven freshmen combined from 2011-13.

FAIRFIELD IN TOURNAMENTS

- ◊ This marks the 18th straight season that Fairfield has taken part in a regular season tournament. Fairfield won all four games in their two tournaments last season, the second time in program history they were able to accomplish that.
- ◊ In their Division I history, Fairfield has played in a regular season tournament in 18 different states as well as other countries such as Bahamas and Aruba.
- ◊ Fairfield took part in the Brown Bear Classic, also in Rhode Island in 2011 and played in the East Carolina Lady Pirates Classic in 1983 and 2006.

WHAT WE LOSE

- ◊ The Stags will have to regroup after losing five seniors including three starters. The five players accounted for 66 percent of last year's scoring and 61 percent of their rebounding total.
- ◊ Katie Cizynski finished her career 18th all-time in points (18th), and 11th in rebounds (720). Shooter Alexys Vasquez was the all-time leader in three-point percentage (.402) and second in three-pointers made (237). Brittany Obi-Tabot was tied for 15th in career blocks (61).
- ◊ The Class of 2014 accounted for 79 wins and a national postseason appearance in three of their four seasons.

- ◊ Fairfield's last overtime game came on November 22, 2014 in the home opener against Butler. Prior to last season, the Stags had not played in an overtime game since February 4, 2011.

TELEVISION COVERAGE

Fairfield women's basketball will be broadcasted across the country on ESPN3 four times during the 2014-15 season. PRESEASON PICKS

- ♦ The Stags were picked to finish fourth in the conference for the second season in-a-row.
- ♦ For the first time since 2006, Marist is not the consensus pick to win the league. This season the Red Foxes tied with Quinnipiac with 112 points apiece. Iona finished third with 106 points, while Niagara (75), Rider (58), Manhattan (49), Canisius (44), Monmouth (43), Siena (34), and Saint Peter's (12) rounded out the rest of the league.
- ♦ Felicia DaCruz was named to the Preseason All-MAAC Second Team.

WELCOME BACK

- ♦ Fairfield welcomes back two starters and five players overall for this year's team.

A LOOK BACK AT 2013-14

- ♦ Fairfield went 22-11 overall and 15-5 in the MAAC last season. The Stags won 20 games for the fourth time in seven years under Head Coach Joe Frager and had their eighth straight winning season in the conference. The Stags had their longest run in program history in a national tournament as they advanced to the semifinals of the WBI before falling to UIC. It was the fourth time in the last five seasons that Fairfield has participated in a national postseason.
- ♦ Fairfield's biggest win of the season on February 8, as they upset Marist on the road during their "Pack the House" night. It was the first win for the Stags in the McCann Arena since 2008. At the time it was the third straight win for the Stags, who would extend that streak to a season-high seven straight.
- ♦ Katie Cizynski was named to the All-MAAC First Team after averaging 16.5 points and 8.4 rebounds per game. Alexys Vasquez made the All-Conference Third Team with 10.4 points per game and going 41.6 percent from behind the arc.
- ♦ The 22 wins was the was the fifth-most in single-season history. Alexys Vasquez broke the single-season mark with 92 three-point field goals. Vasquez shot 40.9 percent from long range, the sixth best effort in a year. Felicia DaCruz registered 177 assists, which was fourth most. Katie Cizynski's 544 points was the third-most in a single-season. As a team, Fairfield's 174 three-pointers were the third most on the single-season list.
