THE OPENING TIP

Fairfield University Men's Basketball rings in 2023 at Leo D. Mahoney Arena with a New Year's Day visit from Siena. The Stags and Saints tip off the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference clash at 2 p.m. with Bob Heussler and Joe DeSantis calling the action for the Stags Sports Network on ESPN3.

LAST TIME OUT: FAIRFIELD 73, MARIST 54

TJ Long set a new career high with 25 points to lead Fairfield to a 73-54 win over visiting Marist on Friday night at Mahoney Arena. **Supreme Cook** added 15 points and eight rebounds in the league victory.

Long's 25 points – besting his 23 scored in last season's home win over Rider – included five of the Stags' nine three-pointers. He scored 19 in the second half as the Stags grew their lead as large as 29 points over the Red Foxes.

For Cook, seven of his 15 points came at the free throw line as he shot 7-for-10 on charity tosses. Cook tops the MAAC and is among the nation's leaders in free throw attempts, going to the stripe 92 times in 13 games this season.

The Stags' defensive performance was bolstered by 34 points off 20 Marist turnovers. That number included 11 Fairfield steals, many of which factored into the Stags' 15 fast break points. Long and **Caleb Fields** had three swipes apiece. The MAAC's toughest defense has now allowed 60 or fewer points in seven of their last eight games, lowering their average to 63.9 points per game allowed.

FAST FIVE

TJ Long's five three-pointers against Marist came in a span of six attempts and just 5:58 of game time as the Stags pulled away from the Red Foxes. His fifth triple extended the margin to 60-36 with 8:51 to go. With five made two-point field goals, Long had a career-high 10 buckets from the field on his way to 25 points.

THE MATCHUP

FAIRFIELD VS. SIENA

THE SIENA COLLEGE SAINTS

Siena began its trip to the Nutmeg State with a come-from-behind 83-76 win at Quinnipiac on Friday, rattling of its third straight win and improving to 8-5 overall and 2-0 in the MAAC. The Saints also hold a conference win over Canisius as well as signature non-conference triumphs over Florida State and Seton Hall. Siena and Fairfield did not play any common opponents in the non-league season nor within the MAAC thus far.

Siena has been led by Javian McCollum, who ranks second in the MAAC with 17.9 points per game and also slots fourth in the league with 4.1 assists per contest. Jackson Stormo adds 13.1 points per game and Andrew Platek is the third Saint in double figures with 10.8 per outing.

Jared Billups and Stormo head the effort on the glass with 6.2 and 6.0 rebounds per game, respectively.

LAST MEETING

After trailing visiting Siena for a span of more than 34 minutes in the Feb. 6, 2022 meeting at Webster Bank Arena, Fairfield pulled even with the Saints on a **Taj Benning** bucket with 4:11 to play. However, the Saints scored the game's next four points and the Stags never leveled the score again as the visitors made their free throws and time ticked away on a 62-56 final. Benning was the lone Stag to net double figures with 10 points.

Supreme Cook was just shy of double figures with nine points and pulled down a team-best seven rebounds. **Jake Wojcik** collected six rebounds for the Stags to go along with his seven points and two assists.

ALL-TIME SERIES

Siena has won eight straight and 11 of the last 13 meetings to hold a 46-32 lead in an all-time series that dates back to 1959. Fairfield's best run in the series came from 1995-98, winning seven of eight encounters. The Stags' last win came in Albany in 2018 as a part of a home-and-home series sweep for Fairfield. With the majority of home meetings being held in Bridgeport over the past 20 seasons, the Stags have not defeated the Saints on campus since 1998.

Aside from conference newcomer Mount St. Mary's, Siena is the only MAAC team that Head Coach Jay Young has never defeated as leader of the Stags.

PRESEASON ALL-MAAC

Supreme Cook and **Jake Wojcik** have been named to the 2022-23 Preseason All-MAAC Team, as voted upon by the league's 11 head coaches. Cook was tabbed for the Preseason All-MAAC First Team with Wojcik nabbing Third Team laurels for the second straight season.

Cook collects a First Team nod after scoring 10.1 points and ranking second in the MAAC – and first among MAAC returners – with 8.3 rebounds per contest last season. Cook was also among the conference's top 10 with a .508 field goal percentage. He racked up seven double-doubles, scoring in double figures in 20 of 33 games and hauling in 10 or more rebounds in nine contests.

Wojcik ranked third on the Stags with 9.5 points per game, burying a team-high 60 three-pointers. His average of just under two triples per game tied for sixth in the MAAC overall and third among players returning to the conference this season. Wojcik shot 34.5 percent from beyond the arc, which slotted 18th in the MAAC but jumps up to fourth among players with as many as his 174 attempts (or more) from downtown.

Cook is Fairfield's first Preseason All-MAAC First Team pick since Tyler Nelson was named MAAC Preseason Player of the Year prior to the 2017-18 campaign. The Stags last placed multiple players on the Preseason All-MAAC Team in 2011-12, when Derek Needham and Ryan Olander both grabbed First Team accolades and Rakim Sanders was voted to the Second Team.

Manhattan's Jose Perez, who had not yet transferred to West Virginia, was named the Preseason Player of the Year after leading the MAAC and ranking in the top 50 nationally with 18.9 points per game last season.

In the Preseason Poll, the Stags were tabbed for fifth place with 77 points, just three points behind Quinnipiac for the fourth spot. Last season's regular season champion Iona was the near-unanimous favorite with 10 of 11 first-place votes and 119 points, while Manhattan garnered the remaining first-place tally to claim second place at 104. Rider grabbed 101 points to round out the top three.

After Quinnipiac and Fairfield, Siena's sixth-place position marks the midway point on the ledger. The bottom half consists of Marist, Niagara and Saint Peter's (tied), newcomer Mount St. Mary's and Canisius.

WHAT OTHER PEOPLE THINK

Fairfield has been picked fourth by the Blue Ribbon College Basketball Yearbook, which tabbed **Supreme Cook** for Preseason All-MAAC and projected **Caleb Fields** as the MAAC Newcomer of the Year.

The Almanac named **Brycen Goodine** as MAAC Newcomer of the Year with Cook on its preseason First Team and Goodine on its Second Team. The Stags were slotted fourth by that publication.

Lindy's had the Stags in seventh place on the ledger.

Tri-state outlet Daly Dose of Hoops chose Cook for the Second Team and **TJ Long** on the Third Team, with the Stags landing fourth in the preseason poll.

Sam Federman's exhaustive MAAC preview has Fairfield at third behind Iona and Rider.

All outlets selected Iona as the favorite in their prognostications and selected either Iona big man Nelly Junior Joseph or then-Manhattan standout Jose Perez as Preseason Player of the Year.

STAGS ON THE RUN

The turning point in Friday's win came just before halftime when Marist took a 24-21 lead on a Patrick Gardner layup with 4:02 remaining. That bucket marked the last Red Fox points for a span 8:55, as the Stags scored the last seven of the half and continued to roll out of the intermission. The run grew to 16-0 with five different Stags contributing to the scoring as Fairfield claimed a 37-24 lead with 15:36 to go before Marist would score again.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

Fairfield leads the MAAC with 63.9 points per game allowed. The Stags have allowed 60 points or fewer in seven of their last eight games.

The Stags' defensive performance against Marist was bolstered by 34 points off 20 Marist turnovers. That number included 11 Fairfield steals, many of which factored into the Stags' 15 fast break points. **TJ Long** and **Caleb Fields** had three swipes apiece. Fairfield scored 20 of its 28 first-half points off of Marist miscues to help generate offense before the Stags' shooters heated up after halftime.

JACK JOINS THE FOLD

Jack Brown played 14 minutes on Friday, a career-high against a Division I opponent for the junior walk-on.

"I wanted energy. We got off to a slow start, and he's been on my mind a lot," said Head Coach Jay Young in his postgame press conference. "He deserves to play. This wasn't a message, this wasn't anything. This was about a kid who comes in, works hard and deserves to play."

SETTLE FOR SEVEN

With the Dec. 22 game against Drexel postponed and not currently rescheduled, Fairfield no longer has a program-record eight-game homestand on the slate. A seven-game stretch of home contests would tie the program standard established in the 1986-87 MAAC Championship season. That run saw Fairfield host La Salle, Lehigh, Fordham, Saint Peter's, Manhattan, Iona and Yale all in succession. However, only six of those games were played to completion at Alumni Hall, as the Jan. 10 meeting with Fordham was suspended and then finished in the Bronx on Feb. 7.

SUPREME'S COURT

After racking up 15 points with eight rebounds against the Red Foxes, Supreme Cook is averaging a team-high 13.2 points per game and slots second in the MAAC with 8.4 boards per contest. Cook is also sixth in the MAAC in field goal percentage (.567) and 13th in free throw percentage (.663). He tops the MAAC in free throws made and attempted, ranking 16th nationally with 92 tosses from the charity stripe. Cook's three double-doubles are one behind Iona's Nelly Junior Joseph for the conference lead.

The Stags have utilized five different starting lineups this season featuring a total of eight different players garnering at least one start. Caleb Fields and Supreme Cook have all started every game to date this season. The Stags have used the same lineup in four of the last five games, with a one-game deviation on Dec. 7 against Sacred Heart, a game in which Allan Jeanne-Rose was unavailable due to illness.

The starters are accounting for 68.7% of Fairfield's points and 68.3% of the Stags' rebounds while playing 67% of the available minutes. At least one player outside of the starting lineup has played 20 minutes or more in every game except the Dec. 12 meeting with Yale.

JAMES JOHNS JR: MAAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

James Johns Jr. was named the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Rookie of the Week after averaging 9.5 points and 5.5 rebounds per game as the Stags split a pair at Mahoney Arena against in-state foes Yale and Coast Guard.

In the loss to reigning Ivy League Champion Yale, Johns scored eight points with three rebounds in 18 minutes of work off the bench. He again played 18 minutes as a reserve in the win over Coast Guard, reaching double figures with 11 points and corralling a career-high eight rebounds.

On the season, Johns is averaging 14.3 minutes per game in 11 games played and has contributed 4.8 points and 2.4 rebounds per contest. His MAAC Rookie of the Week nod is the first conference weekly award of his career and the first for the Stags overall in the 2022-23 season.

NET GAINS

In the Dec. 31 NET rankings, the Stag rank seventh in the MAAC and 253rd of 363 in the nation. Fairfield played the fourth-strongest non-conference schedule in the league (168th nationally).

ONE AT A TIME

Supreme Cook shot 13-for-16 from the free throw line on Dec. 12 against Yale on his way to a team-leading 17 points. The last Stag to make 13 free throws in a game was Jesus Cruz, who was a perfect 13-for-13 against Canisius on Jan. 26, 2020 en route to 21 points in a win at Alumni Hall.

Cook's 16 attempts from the stripe against the Bulldogs marked the most by a Stag since Marcus Gilbert went 14-for-16 on charity tosses to account for half of his 28 points against Saint Peter's on Feb. 7, 2015.

OUR TOWN

The Dec. 7 win over Sacred Heart moved the Stags to 9-0 all-time against their crosstown foe. The teams had never met within the town of Fairfield prior to last season's meeting at the Pitt Center, with the seven previous encounters all held at Webster Bank Arena or a neutral location as a part of the Connecticut 6.

THE FINAL COUNTDOWN

Caleb Fields' game-winner with 0.9 seconds left against Sacred Heart was the latest game-winning basket for the Stags when trailing or tied since **Allan Jeanne-Rose** sank the game-winning layup with 0.2 seconds to play in a 55-53 win over Monmouth on Feb. 4, 2020 at Webster Bank Arena.

BEATING THE ELITE

The Dec. 3 win over Saint Peter's marked the first time that the Stags defeated an Elite Eight team from the prior season. Fairfield had not challenged a reigning Elite Eight team since challenging defending National Champion Louisville, led by current Iona head coach Rick Pitino, in the 2013-14 campaign. With the Cardinals' tournament run from that season having since been vacated by the NCAA committee on infractions, Fairfield last "officially" played an Elite Eight team from the season prior in 2011-12 when they met defending National Champion UConn.

A LONG TIME COMING

Prior to their debut at Leo D. Mahoney Arena on Dec. 3, the Stags last played on campus AND in front of fans on March 1, 2020, which was a span of 1,004 days.

Fairfield played the entirety of the 2020-21 season on campus but with no fans permitted due to Covid-19 protocols and then played all of 2021-22 at Webster Bank Arena (now Total Mortgage Arena) in Bridgeport during the construction of Mahoney Arena.

ROAD WARRIORS

The Stags were among the last teams in the nation to tip-off in front of a friendly crowd when they made their debut at the new on-campus Leo D. Mahoney Arena on Dec. 3.

Only three Division I teams will play their home opener later than Fairfield's Dec. 3 game. South Carolina State plays its first home contest on Dec. 13 after 11 road games, Alcorn State begins the home slate on Jan. 2 after 13 games away from home, and Jackson State will play 14 straight road games before beginning its home schedule on Jan. 7 as the last Division I squad to host a regular season game in 2022-23.

Gardner Webb and Alabama State also played their home openers on Dec. 3, but both tipped off in the afternoon prior to Fairfield's 7 p.m. start.

NEWS & NOTES

FACTS, FIGURES AND MORE

SECOND CHANCE U.

Fairfield grabbed 22 offensive rebounds on Dec. 1 at Manhattan, the most since also collecting 22 from their own glass at Niagara on Jan. 4, 2010. Two days earlier, that Stags' team hauled in 27 offensive boards in a road triumph at Canisius.

SOME ENCHANTED MTE-VENING

Fairfield finished the Hostilo Hoops Community Classic multi-team event ("MTE") in Savannah with a 2-1 record. The Stags earned a win over previously unbeaten Towson on Nov. 25, took a two-point loss to Mercer on Nov. 26, and ended the slate with a win over Evansville on Nov. 27.

Fairfield, Towson, Mercer and South Alabama all went 2-1 at the event. Evansville went 1-2 in its three outings and Robert Morris was winless in Savannah at 0-3.

THE STAGS WENT DOWN TO GEORGIA

In 75 seasons of varsity basketball, Fairfield had played just one game in the state of Georgia prior to this season. Led by 15 points from Derek Needham, the Stags knocked off host Savannah State, 41-39, on Dec. 2, 2010. Including this Thanksgiving weekend in Savannah, in which the Stags defeated Towson and Evansville while falling to Mercer, Fairfield is now 3-1 all-time in the Peach State.

THE 2022-23 STAGS

Fairfield returns 11 student-athletes from 2021-22, including six players who appeared in 30 or more of the Stags' 33 games. The returners include Preseason All-MAAC First Team selection **Supreme Cook** and Third Team honoree **Jake Wojcik** as well as 2022 All-Rookie Team pick **TJ Long**.

Head Coach Jay Young's list of newcomers features freshmen **Anthony Davis Jr.**, **James Johns Jr.** and **Michael Rogan** as well as transfers **Caleb Fields** (Bowling Green) and **Brycen Goodine** (Providence).

2022 DEBUTS

Bowling Green transfer **Caleb Fields** scored a team-high 14 points in his Fairfield debut on Nov. 7 at Wake Forest. **Brycen Goodine**, a transfer most recently from Providence who began his career at Syracuse, also debuted against the Demon Deacons. Four days later, **James Johns Jr.** made his first appearance with the Stags at New Hampshire and poured in 13 points off the bench.

ALWAYS LOOKING FORWARD

Head Coach Jay Young has announced the signing of Matt Curtis to a National Letter of Intent to join Fairfield beginning in the fall of 2023.

A 6-3 guard from Ellington, Conn., Curtis is one of the top-ranked recruits in New England following a standout scholastic career at Northwest Catholic High School. The three-time All-State selection graduated as the program's all-time leading scorer with 1,911 career points, averaging 23.5 points, 4.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game as a senior for the Lions. Curtis, who led Northwest Catholic to the state championship game last season, is currently in a post-graduate year at Avon Old Farms and also played on the AAU circuit with Team Spartans, one of New England's top programs.

COUNT ON CRUZ

Jesus Cruz never missed a game during his Fairfield career from 2017-22. Cruz played in a Fairfield and MAAC record 156 contests beginning with a Nov. 11, 2017 win over Penn at Webster Bank Arena and wrapping up in the 2022 MAAC Championship Quarterfinals against Saint Peter's on March 9, 2022. While Cruz won't be checking in at the scorer's table for any additional contests, he will keep his streak alive in 2022-23 as Coach Young's Director of Basketball Operations.

As a student-athlete, Cruz poured in 1,476 points in his career to rank 11th all-time in program history and also totaled 611 rebounds, 217 assists and 158 steals. He was a member of both the 2017-18 and 2020-21 teams that advanced to the MAAC Championship Game.

Cruz began his professional career in the summer of 2022 in Baloncesto Superior Nacional – the first-tier pro league in Puerto Rico – playing 37 games and averaging 7.8 points per contest for his hometown Gigantes de Carolina squad.

HEAD COACH JAY YOUNG

FOURTH SEASON • MARIST '86

A respected veteran within college basketball, Jay Young became the 13th Head Coach of Fairfield University Men's Basketball on April 3, 2019. Young came to Fairfield after most recently spending three seasons as an assistant coach in the Big Ten at Rutgers University.

In 2021-22, the Stags finished 15-18 overall and 8-12 in the MAAC. The non-conference slate featured a win over Sacred Heart in the first-ever meeting played on the SHU campus, as well as a comeback victory over Stony Brook at Webster Bank Arena. During the MAAC portion of the schedule, the Stags swept the conference "Buffalo trip" for the sixth time in program history as a part of a season sweep of both Canisius and Niagara. Fairfield also swept the home-and-home from Rider and picked up road victories at Marist and Manhattan.

In the postseason, the Stags earned their third win of the campaign over Canisius to reach the quarterfinals, where the year came to a close at the hands of eventual MAAC Champion and NCAA Elite Eight squad Saint Peter's.

In the 2020-21 campaign, Young helped Fairfield navigate a unique schedule to split the final five conference series heading into the MAAC Championship. The Stags went on to win three games in Atlantic City, including back-to-back victories over second-seeded Monmouth and third-seeded Saint Peter's. During the regular season, Fairfield was one of just three MAAC teams to defeat eventual conference champion Iona. The 15-point victory for the Stags at Alumni Hall was the Gaels' largest margin of defeat during the league portion of the slate and second largest overall.

In his first season with the Stags, Fairfield established itself as the top defensive team in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC). The Stags led all 11 conference teams by yielding 62.9 points per game overall and 62.1 points per game in MAAC contests.

Young owns a 37-55 overall record and a 23-35 MAAC tally through his three seasons at the helm of the Stags.

While at Rutgers, Young helped lead the Scarlet Knights to their best-ever Big Ten finish in 2018-19, recording wins over nationally-ranked conference foes Ohio State and Iowa with one of the youngest rosters in the nation. Young, who coordinated the Rutgers defensive strategy for Head Coach Steve Pikiell, was also integral in bringing the highest-ranked freshman class in program history to Piscataway.

Rutgers set a new standard for Big Ten wins in each of Young's three seasons with the Scarlet Knights. The Scarlet Knights earned their first Big Ten postseason win in 2017 and then reached the Big Ten Tournament Quarterfinals for the first time in the 2018 campaign. KenPom.com ranked Rutgers as the most improved Power 6 conference program in the nation this year, jumping 71 positions since the beginning of the 2018-19 season.

Prior to patrolling the sidelines at Rutgers, Young rose to the role of Associate Head Coach at Stony Brook University, where he was a member of Coach Pikiell's staff for many of the most successful seasons in Seawolves history. Stony Brook reached the NCAA postseason for the first time in its Division I history in 2016 after winning the America East Tournament and Regular Season Championship. The Seawolves also received bids to the National Invitation Tournament (NIT) three times during Young's tenure as the America East Regular Season Champions.

Young also directed the recruiting efforts that brought Jameel Warney to Long Island. A three-time America East Player of the Year, Warney is Stony Brook's all-time leader in points, rebounds and blocked shots. He is currently a member of the Westchester Knicks of the NBA G League. Young recruited three of the top four all-time leading scorers at Stony Brook during his tenure with the Seawolves.

Previously a Head Coach at the University of New Haven, Young took the reins of a team that had just one winning season in the prior eight years and led them to back-to-back NCAA postseason bids in 2003-04, including the Chargers' first victory on the national stage since 1988. He went 78-66 (.542) in his five seasons at New Haven, wrapping up his tenure with four consecutive winning campaigns.

Young's first head coaching stop was in the junior college ranks at Newbury College, where he was a two-time NJCAA Regional Coach of the Year and 1995 NJCAA District VI Coach of the Year. Young guided his team to postseason play in three straight seasons, highlighted by a trip to the 1995 NJCAA Division III Final Four.

Young has also made assistant coaching stops at Northeastern, Salem State, and Fitchburg State in a collegiate coaching career that spans more than 30 years.

A 1986 graduate of Marist College with a Bachelor's Degree in Political Science, Young played three seasons of lacrosse for the Red Foxes. He earned First Team All-Conference honors in his senior campaign.
