THE OPENING TIP

Fairfield University Men's Basketball returns to campus and to the Leo D. Mahoney Arena to challenge the University of New Hampshire. Opening tip on Black Friday is slated for 7 p.m. All of the action will be broadcast live by the Stags Sports Network on ESPN+ with Bob Heussler and Joe DeSantis '79 on the call.

LAST TIME OUT

Fairfield erased a 13-point deficit in the second half of Saturday's first-ever meeting with Queens University to take a 53-51 lead with 6:15 to go. But the Royals made the game's last run to come away with a 69-63 decision at the Market Street Challenge hosted by Drexel. Peyton Smith led the Fairfield scoring effort with a career-best 16 points.

Smith's 16 points came on 7-for-11 shooting from down low. He also pulled down a team-leading six rebounds in his 36 minutes of action. Caleb Fields and Brycen Goodine joined him in double figures with 13 and 11 points, respectively.

In total, seven Stags contributed to their 63 points. Jalen Leach added eight points, Jasper Floyd had seven, Louis Bleechmore chipped in five and Michael Rogan knocked down a key three-pointer in the second half.

Floyd also dished out a team-best five assists and Leach passed off three dimes.

Queens was led by 17 points from AJ McKee as well as a stuffed statsheet by Deyton Albury, who finished with 12 points, seven rebounds and seven assists.

COACH CASEY ON THE QUEENS GAME

"I'm proud of the way we fought back in the second half tonight. We need to learn how to finish games like this one, but every close game we play in this part of the season will ultimately help us when we get into the MAAC schedule."

THE MATCHUP

FAIRFIELD VS. NEW HAMPSHIRE

THE UNIVERSITY OF NEW HAMPSHIRE WILDCATS

The University of New Hampshire Wildcats come to Fairfield with a record of 3-2. The Wildcats most recently dispatched Marist, 74-71, on Tuesday evening in Durham.

Clarence Daniels leads UNH with 21.2 points and 8.2 rebounds per game. Daniels was an All-America East First Team selection as the conference's leading rebounder and fourth-ranked scorer. Ahmad Robinson adds 15.2 points per outing.

LAST MEETING

Thirteen three-pointers for host New Hampshire kept Fairfield at arm's length for much of last season's clash in Durham. Despite climbing back to within six points early in the second half, the Stags could not overcome the hot shooting Wildcats in an 83-71 decision. New Hampshire shot 13-for-24 (54.2%) from distance, draining eight triples in the first half to build an early lead.

Fairfield was led by 19 points for Caleb Fields. Fields buried three three-pointers and also hauled in seven rebounds with a trio of steals in 33 minutes at the point guard spot.

ALL-TIME SERIES

Fairfield is 10-3 all-time against New Hampshire in a series that dates back to 1978. The Stags are 6-1 at home all-time against the Wildcats and 4-1 in games played on campus.

STAGS VS. NEW ENGLAND

The Stags are 163-181 all-time against the current Division I basketball programs in New England.

Fairfield has never lost to regional foes Dartmouth (4-0), Merrimack (4-0) and Sacred Heart (9-0). The only two Division I teams in New England that the Stags have never defeated both reside in the Ocean State. Fairfield is 0-6 against Rhode Island and has never played Bryant, which joined the Division I ranks in 2008.

PEYTON SMITH: MAAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

After scoring in double figures in all three games this past week, Peyton Smith has been selected as the MAAC Rookie of the Week.

Smith averaged 13.0 points per game in the Stags' three contests, shooting .692 from the floor. He also knocked down one of two three-point attempts and made both of his tries from the free throw line. The 6-10 freshman filled out his statline with 5.7 rebounds per contest.

On the season, Smith is averaging 11.2 points and 5.6 rebounds per game. He has started all five games to date for the Stags, playing 30.0 minutes per contest. Smith's .533 field goal percentage (24-for-45) is tied for 11th in the MAAC overall and ranks fourth among those with more than 40 attempts from the floor.

A HIGH SCORING HALF

The 56 points scored after the intermission by the Stags at URI marked the highest scoring half for Fairfield against a Division I opponent since netting 58 en route to a 104-85 win over Niagara during the 2017-18 campaign.

Fairfield knocked down 10 of its 13 three-pointers after the break and committed only four second-half turnovers at URI.

OPENING STATEMENTS

The 22 points for Brycen Goodine on Nov. 6 at Boston College marked the most for a Stag in a season opener since Tyler Nelson poured in 30 in a win over Penn to begin the 2017-18 season. Michael Rogan's 18 points against the Eagles were the most points by a Stag in their collegiate debut since that same Penn game, with Wassef Methnani scoring 20 in his first action in a Fairfield uniform.

Finally, Peyton Smith's 12 points were the most for a true freshman in his Fairfield debut since James Johns Jr. netted 13 last season at New Hampshire.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW

Seven of the nine Stags to take the court in the season opener at Boston College were making their Fairfield debuts: Michael Rogan, Peyton Smith, Louis Bleechmore, Jasper Floyd, Matt Curtis, Anthony Davis Jr. and Luke Davidson. All except for the Saint Joseph's transfer Bleechmore were playing in their first-ever Division I game.

THE 2023-24 STAGS

The 2023-24 roster features seven returners and 10 newcomers. The ledger of Fairfield returners is highlighted by Preseason All-MAAC Second Team selection Caleb Fields, who is the Stags' leading returning scorer with 11.7 points per game in 2022-23. Including redshirt freshmen Michael Rogan and Anthony Davis Jr., 12 of the 17 student-athletes on the roster did not check into a game for the Stags last season.

THE 2022-23 SEASON AT A GLANCE

Fairfield went 13-18 overall and 9-11 in the MAAC to claim the conference's seventh seed last season. The Stags were led by 13.1 points and 8.5 rebounds per game from Supreme Cook on his way to All-MAAC Third Team laurels. Caleb Fields also averaged double figures with 11.7 points per game and was the Stags' leading assist man with 2.4 helpers per contest.

BENCH MOB

In addition to Chris Casey assuming the role of Interim Head Coach, Fairfield has welcomed a new roster of assistant coaches and support staff for 2023-24. Casey's new assistant coaches are Glenn Braica -- most recently the head coach at St. Francis Brooklyn -- and former Stags' standout Taj Benning. Rounding out the Fairfield staff are Director of Operations Matt Knezovic and Graduate Assistant Chuck Asetta.

FACTS, FIGURES AND MORE

ATLANTIC COAST CHALLENGES

Fairfield opened against an ACC foe for the second straight season after challenging Wake Forest in Winston-Salem to begin the 2022-23 regular season. The Stags also played Boston College during the 2021-22 campaign, making it three consecutive years with ACC competition on the ledger.

The Stags are 1-21 all-time against ACC opponents, past and present. The lone victory was an 89-83 win over Boston College at Mohegan Sun Arena in 2016. Fairfield also earned a win over Miami in the 1985-86 campaign, but the Hurricanes were a Division I independent at that time.

IN THE MAAC PRESEASON POLL

In the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll, Fairfield garnered 70 points to slot at sixth, just one point behind fifth-place Quinnipiac. The top of ledger saw Rider grab eight first-place votes and 117 total points. Reigning MAAC Champion Iona ranked second with 108 points and two first-place tallies. The final first-place vote went to Canisius, which ranked third with 89 points.

PRESEASON ALL-MAAC

Caleb Fields and Alexis Yetna were both named Preseason All-MAAC. Fields was selected for the Preseason All-MAAC Second Team after averaging 11.7 points per game in his first season with the Stags in 2022-23. Fields knocked down 50 three-pointers and was among the MAAC's top free throw shooters at 81.2 percent from the stripe. He ranked third in the MAAC with a team-best 36.1 minutes per contest.

A Preseason All-MAAC Third Team pick, Yetna comes to Fairfield from Seton Hall. In his last active campaign in 2021-22, Yetna ranked seventh in the Big East with a team-best 7.6 rebounds per contest to go along with 8.1 points per outing. Yetna recorded eight double-doubles while helping guide the Pirates to 21 wins and an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament. A native of Paris, France, Yetna began his career at USF. He was tabbed as the American Athletic Conference Freshman of the Year in 2019.

The MAAC Preseason Player of the Year was Mervin James from Rider. James is the only one of 15 All-MAAC First, Second or Third Team performers in 2022-23 to return to the MAAC this season.

NON-CONFERENCE NOTABLES

Fairfield's 11-game non-conference schedule includes members of eight different conferences. With the exception of the Division III Skyline Conference, the longest drought the Stags will end this season is against the Atlantic Sun when they tangle with Queens on Nov. 18. Fairfield has not played an A-Sun opponent since meeting Jacksonville during the 2017-18 campaign.

The Stags will also meet four members of the nine-team Northeast Conference -- playing Sacred Heart, Wagner, FDU and Le Moyne in succession to close out the non-conference schedule from Dec. 9-30.

Mount Saint Mary College and Queens are the only two first-time opponents on the Fairfield schedule. Additionally, the Stags will meet Division I newcomer Le Moyne for the first time since 1955.

UP NEXT

The opening weekend of MAAC play is on deck, beginning with a visit from defending MAAC Champion Iona on Friday, Dec. 1. Tip-off from Leo D. Mahoney Arena is set for 7 p.m.

The Stags will travel to Rider on Sunday, Dec. 3 to cap the opening weekend of conference action.



INTERIM HEAD COACH CHRIS CASEY

FIRST SEASON • WESTERN CONN. '86

College basketball veteran Chris Casey was named the interim head coach of Fairfield University Men's Basketball prior to the 2023-24 season. Casey most recently served as an assistant with the Stags for the last four campaigns and previously led the programs at Niagara, LIU Post and Rutgers-Newark.

As a head coach, Casey was a part of the MAAC for six years at Niagara from 2013-19. His tenure in Western New York included a 19-win campaign in 2017-18 that saw the Purple Eagles finish 12-6 in the MAAC as the third-seeded team in the conference. He joined Niagara after a three-year stretch at LIU Post highlighted by back-to-back East Coast Conference Championships and NCAA postseason appearances. Casey's first head-coaching stop was at Division III

Rutgers-Newark from 1998-2001.

Casey's assistant coaching career began as a part of the first two Division I seasons in Central Connecticut State history from 1986-88. After a return to his alma mater Western Connecticut State for one season, he reentered the Division I ranks with stops at St. Francis and Saint Peter's.

Following his stint as head coach at Rutgers-Newark, Casey rejoined the staff at CCSU from 2001-06. He was a part of the Blue Devils' 2002 NEC Championship squad and was recognized as an AFLAC National Assistant Coach of the Year in 2003. In 2006, he moved on to Norm Roberts' staff at St. John's for a four-year tenure that included a trip to the 2010 National Invitation Tournament.

Casey graduated from Western Connecticut State in 1986 with a degree in Business Administration. He earned a Master's in Education Administration from Central Connecticut State in 1993.
