#### THE OPENING TIP

Fairfield University Men's Basketball tips off its 43rd season of Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference play on Friday, Dec. 1 at Leo D. Mahoney Arena against defending league champion Iona. Opening tip-off is set for 7 p.m. with Bob Heussler and Joe DeSantis calling the action for the Stags Sports Network on ESPN+.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

It took more than 37 minutes for Fairfield to take a lead in the Nov. 24 clash with New Hampshire at Mahoney Arena. After trailing by as many as 14 points in the second half, the Stags finally erased that deficit with 2:23 to play. But unfortunately, the advantage would flip three more times over the final 153 seconds, with the visiting Wildcats striking last to head back to Durham with an 83-80 decision. Jalen Leach and Jasper Floyd netted 25 and 23 points, respectively, for the Stags as each set a new career high.

Leach's 25 points came on 10-for-16 shooting from the field, including a three-pointer, and a 4-for-5 performance at the free throw line. In addition to Floyd's 23 points, the first-year Stag also had six steals.

Joining Leach and Floyd with a career high was Jack Brown, who came off the pine to net seven points and also pull down a career-best six rebounds.

James Johns Jr. scored 11 points on a 5-of-9 day from the floor, Peyton Smith added eight points and Louis Bleechmore scored six. Bleechmore also hauled in a team-best seven rebounds, as the Stags were edged on the glass, 37-34.

The Stags also turned defense into offense with 15 forced turnovers - including 13 steals - that led to 27 points. Fairfield only committed six giveaways leading to seven UNH tallies.

### **FAIRFIELD VS. IONA**

#### THE IONA UNIVERSITY GAELS

Reigning MAAC Champion Iona comes to Mahoney Arena with a record of 2-5. The Gaels are 0-1 in the MAAC after dropping a 68-64 decision to Marist in New Rochelle on Wednesday in a rematch of last season's MAAC Championship Game. The Gaels return just one scholarship player (the reportedly injured Osborn Shema) from last season's club and boast a new head coach in Tobin Anderson.

Thus far in 2023-24, Idan Tretout leads Iona and ranks fourth in the MAAC with 16.6 points per game. Greg Gordon and Wheza Panzo are also netting double figures with 12.9 and 10.6 points per outing, respectively. Gordon is also Iona's top rebounder with 6.3 boards per game.

#### **LAST MEETING**

Trailing by 21 points to visiting Iona midway through the second half, Fairfield cut the deficit as low as five points late in the Feb. 5 clash before a sold-out crowd at Mahoney Arena. However, the Gaels shot 10-for-11 from the free throw line in the final three minutes to keep the Stags at bay and hold on for a 70-61 decision.

Supreme Cook led the Stags offensively with 16 points, shooting 7-for-10 from the field and 2-for-4 from the free throw line. Cook also hauled in four rebounds and recorded a pair of blocked shots. Allan Jeanne-Rose joined Cook in double figures with 10 points, and James Johns Jr. added nine.

TJ Long headed up a team effort on the boards with six rebounds. The Stags outrebounded the Gaels, 39-32, including 13 from the offensive glass.

### **ALL-TIME SERIES**

After 121 meetings, Iona leads the all-time series by a count of 75-46. Fairfield has lost the last five against the Gaels dating back to the 2021 MAAC Championship Game.

#### STARTING THE MAAC-TION

The Stags are 4-6 in their last 10 MAAC openers and 5-5 in their last 10 MAAC home openers, including a 2-2 mark when those two events are the same game.

# **FACTS, FIGURES AND MORE**

#### STUFFED STAT SHEETS

Jasper Floyd had the best game of his young Fairfield career last Friday against New Hampshire, posting 23 points, five rebounds, five assists and six steals. Floyd is the only player in the nation to tally 20+ points and 5+ rebounds, assists and steals in a game against a Division I opponent this season.

Floyd's six steals are also the most by a Stag since Colin Nickerson had six swipes at Milwaukee on Feb. 18, 2012. He currently shares the MAAC lead and ranks 14th nationally with 2.83 steals per game.

#### **PEYTON SMITH: MAAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK**

After scoring in double figures in all three games on the week of Nov. 13, Peyton Smith was selected as the MAAC Rookie of the Week.

Smith averaged 13.0 points per game in the Stags' three contests against MSMC, Drexel and Queens, shooting .692 from the floor. He also knocked down one of two three-point attempts and made both of his tries from the free throw line. The 6-10 freshman filled out his statline with 5.7 rebounds per contest.

#### A HIGH SCORING HALF

The 56 points scored after the intermission by the Stags at URI marked the highest scoring half for Fairfield against a Division I opponent since netting 58 en route to a 104-85 win over Niagara during the 2017-18 campaign.

Fairfield knocked down 10 of its 13 three-pointers after the break and committed only four second-half turnovers at URI.

### **OPENING STATEMENTS**

The 22 points for Brycen Goodine on Nov. 6 at Boston College marked the most for a Stag in a season opener since Tyler Nelson poured in 30 in a win over Penn to begin the 2017-18 season. Michael Rogan's 18 points against the Eagles were the most points by a Stag in their collegiate debut since that same Penn game, with Wassef Methnani scoring 20 in his first action in a Fairfield uniform.

Finally, Peyton Smith's 12 points were the most for a true freshman in his Fairfield debut since James Johns Jr. netted 13 last season at New Hampshire.

#### **WELCOME TO THE SHOW**

Seven of the nine Stags to take the court in the season opener at Boston College were making their Fairfield debuts: Michael Rogan, Peyton Smith, Louis Bleechmore, Jasper Floyd, Matt Curtis, Anthony Davis Jr. and Luke Davidson. All except for the Saint Joseph's transfer Bleechmore were playing in their first-ever Division I game.

In total, 12 of the 17 student-athletes on the 2023-24 roster did not check into a game for the Stags last season.

### **FACTS, FIGURES AND MORE**

#### THE 2022-23 SEASON AT A GLANCE

Fairfield went 13-18 overall and 9-11 in the MAAC to claim the conference's seventh seed last season. The Stags were led by 13.1 points and 8.5 rebounds per game from Supreme Cook on his way to All-MAAC Third Team laurels. Caleb Fields also averaged double figures with 11.7 points per game and was the Stags' leading assist man with 2.4 helpers per contest.

#### **BENCH MOB**

In addition to Chris Casey assuming the role of Interim Head Coach, Fairfield has welcomed a new roster of assistant coaches and support staff for 2023-24. Casey's new assistant coaches are Glenn Braica -- most recently the head coach at St. Francis Brooklyn -- and former Stags' standout Taj Benning. Rounding out the Fairfield staff are Director of Operations Matt Knezovic and Graduate Assistant Chuck Asetta.

#### **ATLANTIC COAST CHALLENGES**

Fairfield opened against an ACC foe for the second straight season, visiting Boston College this November after challenging Wake Forest in Winstom-Salem to begin last season. The Stags also played BC during the 2021-22 campaign, making it three consecutive years with ACC competition on the ledger.

The Stags are 1-21 all-time against ACC opponents. The lone victory was an 89-83 win over Boston College at Mohegan Sun Arena in 2016. Fairfield also earned a win over Miami in the 1985-86 campaign, but the Hurricanes were a Division I independent at that time.

#### **NON-CONFERENCE NOTABLES**

Fairfield's 11-game non-conference schedule includes members of eight different conferences. With the exception of the Division III Skyline Conference, the longest drought the Stags will end this season is against the Atlantic Sun when they tangle with Queens on Nov. 18. Fairfield has not played an A-Sun opponent since meeting Jacksonville during the 2017-18 campaign.

# INTERIM HEAD COACH CHRIS CASEY

### FIRST SEASON • WESTERN CONN. '86

College basketball veteran Chris Casey was named the interim head coach of Fairfield University Men's Basketball prior to the 2023-24 season. Casey most recently served as an assistant with the Stags for the last four campaigns and previously led the programs at Niagara, LIU Post and Rutgers-Newark.

As a head coach, Casey was a part of the MAAC for six years at Niagara from 2013-19. His tenure in Western New York included a 19-win campaign in 2017-18 that saw the Purple Eagles finish 12-6 in the MAAC as the third-seeded team in the conference. He joined Niagara after a three-year stretch at LIU Post highlighted by back-to-back East Coast Conference Championships and NCAA postseason appearances. Casey's first head-coaching stop was at Division III

Rutgers-Newark from 1998-2001.

Casey's assistant coaching career began as a part of the first two Division I seasons in Central Connecticut State history from 1986-88. After a return to his alma mater Western Connecticut State for one season, he reentered the Division I ranks with stops at St. Francis

and Saint Peter's.

Following his stint as head coach at Rutgers-Newark, Casey rejoined the staff at CCSU from 2001-06. He was a part of the Blue Devils' 2002 NEC Championship squad and was recognized as an AFLAC National Assistant Coach of the Year in 2003. In 2006, he moved on to Norm Roberts' staff at St. John's for a four-year tenure that included a trip to the 2010 National Invitation Tournament.

Casey graduated from Western Connecticut State in 1986 with a degree in Business Administration. He earned a Master's in Education Administration from Central Connecticut State in 1993.
