#### THE OPENING TIP

Fairfield University Men's Basketball looks to keep rolling as the Stags bring a four-game winning streak to FDU. Opening tip-off from Stratis Arena on Thursday, Dec. 21 is slated for 7 p.m. live on the YES Network and NEC Front Row.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

Fairfield scored the first seven points of Sunday's visit from Wagner and never looked back en route to a 63-51 win at Mahoney Arena. Jalen Leach posted 20 points and Louis Bleechmore put up 11 points and nine rebounds in the Stags' fourth consecutive victory.

Leach's game-high 20 points marked his third 20+ point scoring game of the season. He has scored in double figures in six straight games and netted at least 15 points in all four outings on the Stags' current four-game winning streak.

Brycen Goodine came off the bench to add 15 points, including three of Fairfield's seven three-pointers. Along with Bleechmore's 11 points, Caleb Fields just missed joining them in double figures with nine.

Jasper Floyd chipped in four points and was the Stags' top facilitator with six assists, while Peyton Smith and James Johns Jr. rounded out the scoring effort with two apiece.

Fueled by Bleechmore's nine rebounds, the Stags had a 37-35 edge on the glass. Leach and Fields pitched in six apiece and Birima Seck hauled in five boards in 13 minutes of work.

### **COACH CASEY ON THE WAGNER GAME**

"I'm happy with the way we came out and took a big lead. We knew Wagner was going to fight back - they're a tough and well-coached team - but we responded every time they started to come back. Every game is won in a different way, and finding what you need to win on any given day is a big part of what makes a good basketball team."

### THE MATCHUP

### **FAIRFIELD VS. FDU**

#### THE FDU KNIGHTS

An 87-83 home loss to Columbia on Dec. 11 dropped FDU to an even 6-6 on the year. Excluding a pair of routs against Division III PSU Brandywine (W, 107-63) and PSU Schuylkill (W, 124-66), the Knights' four Division I wins have come by a total of 15 points. FDU is 2-0 against MAAC foes with a 71-70 win over Saint Peter's and a 76-71 win at Manhattan on the ledger.

### **LAST MEETING**

Fairfield scored the first 14 points of the Dec. 15, 2021 clash at Fairleigh Dickinson en route to a 72-54 road victory. Chris Maidoh led all players with 13 points as the Stags ran off their fifth straight win.

Taj Benning joined Maidoh in double figures with 12 points and Jake Wojcik added 11. Maidoh and Wojcik's points came in a reserve role, pacing the Stags to 41 total bench points.

Ten different Stags scored for the second straight game, with Allan Jeanne-Rose netting eight points, TJ Long scoring seven, Supreme Cook and Jesus Cruz each putting in six, Caleb Green adding five, and Makai Willis and Jason Edokpayi both contributing two.

Cook also pulled down seven rebounds, while Benning and Green each hauled in six to lead Fairfield to a 43-34 advantage on the glass. The Stags' total included 14 offensive boards that led to 18 second-chance points.

In addition to his five points and six rebounds, Green was Fairfield's top facilitator as he tied his season high with seven assists.

### **ALL-TIME SERIES**

Fairfield leads 17-7 in the all-time series with the Knighs. The Stags have won seven of the last eight games in the series and have not lost back-to-back encounters since the first two meetings against their former Tri-State Conference foe, both in 1956.

### **EYES ON FIVE**

Fairfield is seeking its first five-game winning streak since the 2021-22 season. The fifth game in that streak was the aforementioned 72-54 win at FDU on Dec. 15, 2021, which also marked the last time that the Stags won four straight true road games.

#### **AN NEC STRETCH**

FDU is the third of four straight Northeast Conference opponents on the docket to round out Fairfield's non-league slate. The run concludes with a visit from Le Moyne on Dec. 30.

### **FACTS, FIGURES AND MORE**

#### **WIRE-TO-WIRE**

The Stags scored the first seven points of Sunday's win over Wagner and maintained that lead for the duration of the 63-51 victory. The triumph marked Fairfield's first wire-to-wire win since a 73-53 win over Niagara on Feb. 12. 2022.

#### **STREAK STATS**

The Stags are outscoring opponents by a +8.3 margin on their current four-game winning streak. Fairfield is shooting .368 (32-for-87) from three-point range and has converted its free throws at .811 (73-for-90) at the stripe in the quartet of wins.

Individually, Jalen Leach is averaging 18.0 points per game during the run, reaching at least 15 points in all four encounters. Jasper Floyd fills out his recent statsheet with 13.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 2.3 steals per game.

#### **LOW SCORING WINS**

Sunday's 63-51 win over Wagner marked Fairfield's lowest scoring total in a victory this season, surpassing the 67-57 triumph at Sacred Heart just eight days prior. Not coincidentally, the Fairfield defense posted its two best defensive efforts against Division I competition in those back-to-back wins.

#### **PLAYING FAVORITES**

The Dec. 9 win at Sacred Heart marked the third straight road victory for Fairfield against a team that was tabbed by the coaches and/or media to win its conference in the preseason. The Stags dispatched MAAC preseason favorite Rider (88-81), Ivy League presumptive favorite Yale (75-71) and the NEC preseason #1 Pioneers (67-57).

### THE HEARTBREAK KIDS

With the Dec. 9 win at the Pitt Center, Fairfield improved to 10-0 all-time against Sacred Heart.

#### **BIRIMA'S BACK**

Birima Seck made his Fairfield debut in the win at Sacred Heart. In six minutes, Seck scored one point with one rebounds, one assist and one block. Seck previously played at the University of New Mexico.

#### **LAST RUN, FAST RUN**

Trailing 61-51 with 5:42 to play at Yale, Fairfield embarked on a 19-3 run over the ensuing 5:15 to flip the score to 70-64 with just 27 seconds remaining. The Stags converted their free throws down the stretch to ice the comeback in a 75-71 victory.

### **FACTS, FIGURES AND MORE**

#### **SECOND HALF STAGS**

Fairfield is outscoring its opponents by an average of 5.2 points per game after halftime. The Stags have outscored eight of 11 opponents to date in the second half.

Individually, Caleb Fields is averaging a team-best 8.1 points after the break, shooting 14-for-36 (.389) from distance in the second period.

#### **HOME 'DOGS**

Prior to Fairfield's Dec. 6 win at Yale, the Bulldogs had won 12 consecutive games against Connecticut opponents. The Stags' victory also concluded a 100-game stretch in which Yale owned an 83-17 record in games played at the John J. Lee Amphitheater.

#### STAGS VS. NEW ENGLAND

The Stags are 165-182 all-time against the current Division I basketball programs in New England.

Fairfield has never lost to regional foes Dartmouth (4-0), Merrimack (4-0) and Sacred Heart (10-0). The only two Division I teams in New England that the Stags have never defeated both reside in the Ocean State. Fairfield is 0-6 against Rhode Island and has never played Bryant, which joined the Division I ranks in 2008.

### **PEYTON'S PLACE**

Peyton Smith recorded his first career double-double on Sunday with 16 points and 10 rebounds, also adding five blocks in the win at Rider.

Smith is the only true freshman in the nation to post a double-double plus five blocks in a game this season.

### **FIVE IN DOUBLE FIGURES**

Jalen Leach's 22 points on Dec. 3 at Rider led five Stags scoring in double figures. Peyton Smith (16), Jasper Floyd (15), Caleb Fields (11) and Brycen Goodine (10) all joined Leach in double figures in the victory.

Prior to that game, the last time the Stags had five scorers in double figures was on Nov. 16, 2021, when seven players reached 10 or more points in the 110-55 rout of Medgar Evers.

### **FREE IS FOR ME**

Fairfield shot 27-for-32 from the free throw line (.844) in the win at Rider. The performance marked season highs in free throws made, attempted, and in free throw percentage (min. 10 attempts).

Fairfield exceeded an .844 free throw percentage with at least 20 attempts twice last season, going 25-for-29 (.862) against Niagara on Jan. 6 and 24-for-28 (.857) in the Feb. 12 overtime win over The Mount.

The Stags last met that standard with at least 30 attempts from the charity stripe on Dec. 14, 2004, when they posted the same 27-for-32 line in a 68-53 win over Harvard.

#### **STUFFED STAT SHEETS**

Jasper Floyd had the best game of his young Fairfield career on Nov. 24 against New Hampshire, posting 23 points, five rebounds, five assists and six steals. Floyd is one of only three players in the nation to tally 20+ points and 5+ rebounds, assists and steals in a game against a Division I opponent this season.

Floyd's six steals are also the most by a Stag since Colin Nickerson had six swipes at Milwaukee on Feb. 18, 2012. He currently ranks second in the MAAC and 15th nationally with 2.55 steals per game.

### PEYTON SMITH: MAAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

After scoring in double figures in all three games on the week of Nov. 13, Peyton Smith

was selected as the MAAC Rookie of the Week. Smith averaged 13.0 points per game in the Stags' three contests against MSMC, Drexel and Queens, shooting .692 from the floor. He also knocked down one of two three-point attempts and made both of his tries from the free throw line. The 6-10 freshman filled out his statline with 5.7 rebounds per contest.

#### A HIGH SCORING HALF

The 56 points scored after the intermission by the Stags at URI marked the highest scoring half for Fairfield against a Division I opponent since netting 58 en route to a 104-85 win over Niagara during the 2017-18 campaign.

#### **OPENING STATEMENTS**

The 22 points for Brycen Goodine on Nov. 6 at Boston College marked the most for a Stag in a season opener since Tyler Nelson poured in 30 in a win over Penn to begin the 2017-18 season. Michael Rogan's 18 points against the Eagles were the most points by a Stag in their collegiate debut since that same Penn game, with Wassef Methnani scoring 20 in his first action in a Fairfield uniform. Finally, Peyton Smith's 12 points were the most for a true freshman in his Fairfield debut since James Johns Jr. netted 13 last season at New Hampshire.

#### **BENCH MOB**

In addition to Chris Casey assuming the role of Interim Head Coach, Fairfield has welcomed a new roster of assistant coaches and support staff for 2023-24. Casey's new assistant coaches are Glenn Braica -- most recently the head coach at St. Francis Brooklyn -- and former Stags' standout Taj Benning.

Rounding out the Fairfield staff are Director of Operations Matt Knezovic and Graduate Assistant Chuck Asetta.

#### ATLANTIC COAST CHALLENGES

Fairfield opened against an ACC foe for the second straight season, visiting Boston College this November after challenging Wake Forest in Winston-Salem to begin last season. The Stags also played BC during the 2021-22 campaign, making it three consecutive years with ACC competition on the ledger.

The Stags are 1-21 all-time against ACC opponents. The lone victory was an 89-83 win over Boston College at Mohegan Sun Arena in 2016. Fairfield also earned a win over Miami in the 1985-86 campaign, but the Hurricanes were a Division I independent at that time.

#### **NON-CONFERENCE NOTABLES**

Fairfield's 11-game non-conference schedule includes members of eight different conferences. With the exception of the Division III Skyline Conference, the longest drought that the Stags ended this season was against the Atlantic Sun when they tangled with Queens on Nov. 18. Fairfield had not played an A-Sun opponent since meeting Jacksonville during the 2017-18 campaign.

Mount Saint Mary College and Queens were the only two first-time opponents on the Fairfield schedule. Additionally, the Stags will meet Division I newcomer Le Moyne for the first time since 1955.

# **FACTS, FIGURES AND MORE**

### THE 2022-23 SEASON AT A GLANCE

Fairfield went 13-18 overall and 9-11 in the MAAC to claim the conference's seventh seed last season. The Stags were led by 13.1 points and 8.5 rebounds per game from Supreme Cook on his way to All-MAAC Third Team laurels. Caleb Fields also averaged double figures with 11.7 points per game and was the Stags' leading assist man with 2.4 helpers per contest.

# INTERIM HEAD COACH CHRIS CASEY

### FIRST SEASON • WESTERN CONN. '86

College basketball veteran Chris Casey was named the interim head coach of Fairfield University Men's Basketball prior to the 2023-24 season. Casey most recently served as an assistant with the Stags for the last four campaigns and previously led the programs at Niagara, LIU Post and Rutgers-Newark.

As a head coach, Casey was a part of the MAAC for six years at Niagara from 2013-19. His tenure in Western New York included a 19-win campaign in 2017-18 that saw the Purple Eagles finish 12-6 in the MAAC as the third-seeded team in the conference. He joined Niagara after a three-year stretch at LIU Post highlighted by back-to-back East Coast Conference Championships and NCAA postseason appearances. Casey's first head-coaching stop was at Division III

Casey's assistant coaching career began as a part of the first two Division I seasons in Central Connecticut State history from 1986-88. After a return to his alma mater Western Connecticut State for one season, he

reentered the Division I ranks with stops at St. Francis and Saint Peter's.

Following his stint as head coach at Rutgers-Newark, Casey rejoined the staff at CCSU from 2001-06. He was a part of the Blue Devils' 2002 NEC Championship squad and was recognized as an AFLAC National Assistant Coach of the Year in 2003. In 2006, he moved on to Norm Roberts' staff at St. John's for a four-year tenure that included a trip to the 2010 National Invitation Tournament.

Casey graduated from Western Connecticut State in 1986 with a degree in Business Administration. He earned a Master's in Education Administration from Central Connecticut State in 1993.
