THE OPENING TIP

Fairfield University Men's Basketball returns to non-conference play and continues its three-game road swing on Wednesday, Dec. 6 at Yale. Opening tip-off from John J. Lee Amphitheater inside Payne Whitney Gymnasium in New Haven is set for 7 p.m. on ESPN+.

LAST TIME OUT

Five players scored in double figures to guide Fairfield to an 88-81 win on Sunday against MAAC preseason favorite Rider. Jalen Leach paced the scoring with 22 points, while Peyton Smith notched his first career double-double.

Leach carried the Stags' scoring load in the first half, amassing 16 of his 22 before halftime. He shot 7-for-11 from the floor and was perfect on both of his three-point attempts and all six of his free throw tries.

Matched up primarily with MAAC Preseason Player of the Year Mervin James, Smith matched his career high with 16 points and set a pair of new career standards with 10 rebounds and five blocked shots.

Jasper Floyd added 15 points, Caleb Fields scored 11, and Brycen Goodine led the bench scoring with 10.

As a unit, Fairfield shot 26-for-50 (52%) from the field, 9-for-19 (47.4%) from distance and 27-for-32 (84.4%) from the free throw line.

In addition to Smith's 10 rebounds, Fields collected six and Bleechmore hauled in five. The Stags were edged on the glass, 44-33, with Rider collecting 24 offensive rebounds en route to 23 second chance points.

COACH CASEY ON THE RIDER GAME

"We've been right there in the last few games and come up short, so it's great to finish one off – especially a MAAC road game against a talented and experienced team like Rider. Every guy that checked in today contributed a big shot or a big board or a big stop. That's what we need and that's what we're capable of going forward."

THE MATCHUP

FAIRFIELD VS. YALE

THE YALE UNIVERSITY BULLDOGS

Yale enters the week with a 5-4 record coming off of a 66-65 loss at Vermont on an improbable four-point play by former Stag TJ Long. The Bulldogs have also lost to Gonzaga, Weber State and Rhode Island while earning wins over Vassar, Loyola Marymount, Colgate, Gardner-Webb and Stony Brook.

Bez Mbeng leads four Bulldogs averaging double figures with 15.0 points per game. Mbeng is also Yale's top facilitator with 3.0 assists per contest. Danny Wolf is nearly averaging a double-double with 13.1 points and a team-best 9.0 rebounds per outing.

LAST MEETING

After limiting defending Ivy League Champion Yale to just 24 points in the first half of the Dec. 12, 2022 meeting at Leo D. Mahoney Arena, Fairfield saw the visiting Bulldogs pour in 53 points after the break as the Stags fell in the non-conference clash, 77-64. Supreme Cook led Fairfield with 17 points and eight rebounds, and Allan Jeanne-Rose added 16 points.

In addition, James Johns Jr. added eight points and TJ Long scored seven. Cook's eight rebounds led the Stags as the squad was edged, 35-30, on the board. Both teams committed 15 turnovers, with Yale netting 20 points off miscues to Fairfield's 17.

ALL-TIME SERIES

The Stags are 13-11 all-time against Yale in a series that dates back to 1977. The ledger includes one postseason clash - a 68-56 win for the Stags at Webster Bank Arena in the 2012 CIT First Round.

Nine of the all-time meetings in the series have been decided by one possession and/or in overtime, with Fairfield holding a 5-4 edge in those contests.

STAGS VS. NEW ENGLAND

The Stags are 163-182 all-time against the current Division I basketball programs in New England.

Fairfield has never lost to regional foes Dartmouth (4-0), Merrimack (4-0) and Sacred Heart (9-0). The only two Division I teams in New England that the Stags have never defeated both reside in the Ocean State. Fairfield is 0-6 against Rhode Island and has never played Bryant, which joined the Division I ranks in 2008.

PEYTON'S PLACE

Peyton Smith recorded his first career double-double on Sunday with 16 points and 10 rebounds, also adding five blocks in the win at Rider. Smith is the only true freshman in the nation to post a double-double plus five blocks in a game this season.

FIVE IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Jalen Leach's 22 points on Sunday at Rider led five Stags scoring in double figures. Peyton Smith (16), Jasper Floyd (15), Caleb Fields (11) and Brycen Goodine (10) all joined Leach in double figures in the victory.

Prior to this past Sunday, the last time the Stags had five scorers in double figures was on Nov. 16, 2021, when seven players reached 10 or more points in the 110-55 rout of Medgar Evers. Five Stags had not scored in double figures in the same game against a Division I opponent since Jan. 27, 2019 in an 80-68 win over Iona at Alumni Hall.

FREE IS FOR ME

Fairfield shot 27-for-32 from the free throw line (.844) in Sunday's win at Rider. The performance marked season highs in free throws made, attempted, and in free throw percentage (min. 10 attempts).

Fairfield exceeded an .844 free throw percentage with at least 20 attempts twice last season, going 25-for-29 (.862) against Niagara on Jan. 6 and 24-for-28 (.857) in the Feb. 12 overtime win over The Mount.

The Stags last met that standard with at least 30 attempts from the charity stripe on Dec. 14, 2004, when they posted the same 27-for-32 line in a 68-53 win over Harvard.

STUFFED STAT SHEETS

Jasper Floyd had the best game of his young Fairfield career on Nov. 24 against New Hampshire, posting 23 points, five rebounds, five assists and six steals. Floyd is the only player in the nation to tally 20+ points and 5+ rebounds, assists and steals in a game against a Division I opponent this season.

Floyd's six steals are also the most by a Stag since Colin Nickerson had six swipes at Milwaukee on Feb. 18, 2012. He currently ranks second the MAAC lead and 12th nationally with 2.75 steals per game.

PEYTON SMITH: MAAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

After scoring in double figures in all three games on the week of Nov. 13, Peyton Smith was selected as the MAAC Rookie of the Week.

FACTS, FIGURES AND MORE

A HIGH SCORING HALF

The 56 points scored after the intermission by the Stags at URI marked the highest scoring half for Fairfield against a Division I opponent since netting 58 en route to a 104-85 win over Niagara during the 2017-18 campaign.

OPENING STATEMENTS

The 22 points for Brycen Goodine on Nov. 6 at Boston College marked the most for a Stag in a season opener since Tyler Nelson poured in 30 in a win over Penn to begin the 2017-18 season. Michael Rogan's 18 points against the Eagles were the most points by a Stag in their collegiate debut since that same Penn game, with Wassef Methnani scoring 20 in his first action in a Fairfield uniform.

Finally, Peyton Smith's 12 points were the most for a true freshman in his Fairfield debut since James Johns Jr. netted 13 last season at New Hampshire.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW

Seven of the nine Stags to take the court in the season opener at Boston College were making their Fairfield debuts: Michael Rogan, Peyton Smith, Louis Bleechmore, Jasper Floyd, Matt Curtis, Anthony Davis Jr. and Luke Davidson. All except for the Saint Joseph's transfer Bleechmore were playing in their first-ever Division I game.

In total, 12 of the 17 student-athletes on the 2023-24 roster did not check into a game for the Stags last season.

THE 2022-23 SEASON AT A GLANCE

Fairfield went 13-18 overall and 9-11 in the MAAC to claim the conference's seventh seed last season. The Stags were led by 13.1 points and 8.5 rebounds per game from Supreme Cook on his way to All-MAAC Third Team laurels. Caleb Fields also averaged double figures with 11.7 points per game and was the Stags' leading assist man with 2.4 helpers per contest.

BENCH MOB

In addition to Chris Casey assuming the role of Interim Head Coach, Fairfield has welcomed a

new roster of assistant coaches and support staff for 2023-24. Casey's new assistant coaches are Glenn Braica -- most recently the head coach at St. Francis Brooklyn -- and former Stags' standout Taj Benning. Rounding out the Fairfield staff are Director of Operations Matt Knezovic and Graduate Assistant Chuck Asetta.

ATLANTIC COAST CHALLENGES

Fairfield opened against an ACC foe for the second straight season, visiting Boston College this November after challenging Wake Forest in Winstom-Salem to begin last season. The Stags also played BC during the 2021-22 campaign, making it three consecutive years with ACC competition on the ledger.

The Stags are 1-21 all-time against ACC opponents. The lone victory was an 89-83 win over Boston College at Mohegan Sun Arena in 2016. Fairfield also earned a win over Miami in the 1985-86 campaign, but the Hurricanes were a Division I independent at that time.

NON-CONFERENCE NOTABLES

Fairfield's 11-game non-conference schedule includes members of eight different conferences. With the exception of the Division III Skyline Conference, the longest drought the Stags will end this season is against the Atlantic Sun when they tangle with Queens on Nov. 18. Fairfield has not played an A-Sun opponent since meeting Jacksonville during the 2017-18 campaign.

The Stags will also meet four members of the nine-team Northeast Conference -- playing Sacred Heart, Wagner, FDU and Le Moyne in succession to close out the non-conference schedule from Dec. 9-30.

Mount Saint Mary College and Queens are the only two first-time opponents on the Fairfield schedule. Additionally, the Stags will meet Division I newcomer Le Moyne for the first time since 1955.

UP NEXT

The three-game road trip ends with the shortest possible trip for the Stags, a jaunt across town to meet Sacred Heart on Saturday, Dec. 9 at 6 p.m.

Action returns to Mahoney Arena on Sunday, Dec. 17 against Wagner.



INTERIM HEAD COACH CHRIS CASEY

FIRST SEASON • WESTERN CONN. '86

College basketball veteran Chris Casey was named the interim head coach of Fairfield University Men's Basketball prior to the 2023-24 season. Casey most recently served as an assistant with the Stags for the last four campaigns and previously led the programs at Niagara, LIU Post and Rutgers-Newark.

As a head coach, Casey was a part of the MAAC for six years at Niagara from 2013-19. His tenure in Western New York included a 19-win campaign in 2017-18 that saw the Purple Eagles finish 12-6 in the MAAC as the third-seeded team in the conference. He joined Niagara after a three-year stretch at LIU Post highlighted by back-to-back East Coast Conference Championships and NCAA postseason appearances. Casey's first head-coaching stop was at Division III

Rutgers-Newark from 1998-2001.

Casey's assistant coaching career began as a part of the first two Division I seasons in Central Connecticut State history from 1986-88. After a return to his alma mater Western Connecticut State for one season, he reentered the Division I ranks with stops at St. Francis

and Saint Peter's.

Following his stint as head coach at Rutgers-Newark, Casey rejoined the staff at CCSU from 2001-06. He was a part of the Blue Devils' 2002 NEC Championship squad and was recognized as an AFLAC National Assistant Coach of the Year in 2003. In 2006, he moved on to Norm Roberts' staff at St. John's for a four-year tenure that included a trip to the 2010 National Invitation Tournament.

Casey graduated from Western Connecticut State in 1986 with a degree in Business Administration. He earned a Master's in Education Administration from Central Connecticut State in 1993.
