THE OPENING TIP

Fairfield University Men's Basketball rounds out a three-game road swing with the shortest trip possible, a quick jaunt across town to meet Sacred Heart at the Pitt Center. Opening tip-off the other side of Fairfield is slated for 6 p.m. and will air live on SNY and NEC Front Row.

LAST TIME OUT

A 19-3 run late in the second half erased a 10-point deficit and propelled Fairfield to a 75-71 win over Ivy League preseason favorite Yale on Wednesday evening at the John J. Lee Amphitheater in New Haven. Jasper Floyd scored a career-high 25 points in the in-state victory.

Floyd's 25 points came on 8-for-13 shooting from the field. The junior point guard knocked down all three of his three-pointers and was 6-for-7 from the free throw line. Caleb Fields joined him in double figures with 16, and Jalen Leach added 15.

In the post, Peyton Smith tallied eight points with a team-best six rebounds. James Johns Jr. contributed five points, Louis Bleechmore had four and Brycen Goodine capped the scoring with a pair.

As a unit, the Stags shot 27-for-59(45.8%) from the field, 8-for-24 (33.3%) from three-point range and 13-for-18 (72.2%) from the free throw line.

Floyd was also the Stags' top facilitator with four assists and had three steals as the Stags pressured the Bulldogs into 14 turnovers.

Yale was led by 14 points from Matt Knowling and 13 apiece by Bez Mbeng and John Poulakidas. Nick Townsend nearly registered a double-double for the Bulldogs with eight points and 10 rebounds.

COACH CASEY ON THE YALE GAME

"This was a really good road win and good step forward for us. Coach Jones's [Yale] teams are outstanding every year and always well-coached, and for us to comeback when we were down like that says a lot about the guys in our locker room. I will never doubt our fight for a second."

THE MATCHUP

FAIRFIELD VS. SACRED HEART

THE SACRED HEART UNIVERSITY PIONEERS

An 85-50 loss at St. John's on Wednesday dropped Sacred Heart to 4-6 overall. The Pioneers have lost four straight games after a 4-2 start featuring wins over Sarah Lawrence, Holy Cross, Loyola Maryland and Binghamton. In addition to the Red Storm, SHU has been on the short side against Iona, UMBC, Saint Joseph's, New Hampshire and Boston University.

Nico Galette does it all for Sacred Heart, leading the Pios with 15.1 points per game along with 7.1 rebounds, 2.3 assists, and 2.3 steals per contest. Reigning Division III Player of the Year Alex Sobel adds 10.0 points and a team-high 7.5 rebounds per game.

LAST MEETING

Caleb Fields hit the game-winning layup with 0.9 seconds to play to cap a 7-0 run over the final 3:13 and lift Fairfield to a 61-59 win over visiting Sacred Heart on Dec. 7, 2022 at Leo D. Mahoney Arena. Fields also netted the game-tying bucket as a part of his game-high 18 points.

In addition to the offense scoring the game's final seven points, the Fairfield defense made five consecutive stops to facilitate the rally.

Supreme Cook capped his second straight double-double, pulling down a game-high and personal season-best 13 rebounds to his 15 points. The Stags held a 47-34 advantage on the glass, including 16 offensive boards.

Chris Maidoh added nine points and five rebounds for Fairfield, with Jake Wojcik rounding out his box score with eight points, six rebounds and three assists. James Johns Jr. chipped in five points, TJ Long netted four and Zach Crisler scored two.

Mike Sixsmith and Bryce Johnson each scored 13 points for Sacred Heart while Nico Gallette, who entered the game averaging 17.7 points per contests, labored for his 10 points on 4-for-14 shooting.

ALL-TIME SERIES

The Stags are 9-0 all-time against Sacred Heart dating back to 2007. The last two meetings marked the first time that each squad had ventured to the other's campus (or met within the Town of Fairfield), as six of the prior meetings were held at Webster Bank Arena in addition to a neutral site contest at Mohegan Sun Arena in 2010.

Fairfield and Sacred Heart were slated to meet at Alumni Hall during the 2020-21 campaign, but the game was canceled due to Covid-19 protocols within the SHU program.

STAGS VS. THE STATE

Including this season's win at Yale, Fairfield is 117-75 all-time against Connecticut opponents.

PLAYING FAVORITES

Saturday's game at Sacred Heart marks the third straight road game for Fairfield against a team that was tabbed by the coaches and/or media to win its conference in the preseason. The Stags have recently dispatched MAAC preseason favorite Rider (88-81) and Ivy League presumptive favorite Yale (75-71) on their way to tangle with the NEC preseason #1 Pioneers at the Pitt Center.

LAST RUN, FAST RUN

Trailing 61-51 with 5:42 to play at Yale, Fairfield embarked on a 19-3 run over the ensuing 5:15 to flip the score to 70-64 with just 27 seconds remaining. The Stags converted their free throws down the stretch to ice the comeback in a 75-71 victory.

SECOND HALF STAGS

Fairfield is outscoring its opponents by an average of 4.6 points per game after halftime. The Stags have outscored six of nine opponents to date in the second half. Most notably Fairfield outpaced Rhode Island, 56-44, on Nov. 9 at the Ryan Center and outscored Yale, 46-38, in a comeback win on Dec. 6 in New Haven.

Individually, Caleb Fields is averaging a team-best 8.4 points after the break, shooting 13-for-30 (.433) from distance in the second period.

HOME 'DOGS

Prior to Wednesday's 75-71 win at Yale, te Bulldogs had won 12 consecutive games against Connecticut opponents. The Stags' victory also concluded a 100-game stretch in which Yale owned an 83-17 record in games played at the John J. Lee Amphitheater.

STAGS VS. NEW ENGLAND

The Stags are 164-182 all-time against the current Division I basketball programs in New England.

Fairfield has never lost to regional foes Dartmouth (4-0), Merrimack (4-0) and Sacred Heart (9-0). The only two Division I teams in New England that the Stags have never defeated both reside in the Ocean State. Fairfield is 0-6 against Rhode Island and has never played Bryant, which joined the Division I ranks in 2008.

PEYTON'S PLACE

Peyton Smith recorded his first career double-double on Sunday with 16 points and 10 rebounds, also adding five blocks in the win at Rider.

Smith is the only true freshman in the nation to post a double-double plus five blocks in a game this season.

FIVE IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Jalen Leach's 22 points on Sunday at Rider led five Stags scoring in double figures. Peyton Smith (16), Jasper Floyd (15), Caleb Fields (11) and Brycen Goodine (10) all joined Leach in double figures in the victory.

FREE IS FOR ME

Fairfield shot 27-for-32 from the free throw line (.844) in Sunday's win at Rider. The performance marked season highs in free throws made, attempted, and in free throw percentage (min. 10 attempts).

Fairfield exceeded an .844 free throw percentage with at least 20 attempts twice last season, going 25-for-29 (.862) against Niagara on Jan. 6 and 24-for-28 (.857) in the Feb. 12 overtime win over The Mount.

The Stags last met that standard with at least 30 attempts from the charity stripe on Dec. 14, 2004, when they posted the same 27-for-32 line in a 68-53 win over Harvard.

STUFFED STAT SHEETS

Jasper Floyd had the best game of his young Fairfield career on Nov. 24 against New Hampshire, posting 23 points, five rebounds, five assists and six steals. Floyd is the only player in the nation to tally 20+ points and 5+ rebounds, assists and steals in a game against a Division I opponent this season.

Floyd's six steals are also the most by a Stag since Colin Nickerson had six swipes at Milwaukee on Feb. 18, 2012. He currently ranks second the MAAC lead and 12th nationally with 2.75 steals per game.

PEYTON SMITH: MAAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

After scoring in double figures in all three games on the week of Nov. 13, Peyton Smith was selected as the MAAC Rookie of the Week. Smith averaged 13.0 points per game in the Stags' three contests against MSMC, Drexel and Queens, shooting .692 from the floor. He also knocked down one of two three-point attempts and made both of his tries from the free throw line. The 6-10 freshman filled out his statline with 5.7 rebounds per contest.

A HIGH SCORING HALF

The 56 points scored after the intermission by the Stags at URI marked the highest scoring half for Fairfield against a Division I opponent since netting 58 en route to a 104-85 win over Niagara during the 2017-18 campaign.

OPENING STATEMENTS

The 22 points for Brycen Goodine on Nov. 6 at Boston College marked the most for a Stag in a season opener since Tyler Nelson poured in 30 in a win over Penn to begin the 2017-18 season. Michael Rogan's 18 points against the Eagles were the most points by a Stag in their collegiate debut since that same Penn game, with Wassef Methnani scoring 20 in his first action in a Fairfield uniform. Finally, Peyton Smith's 12 points were the most for a true freshman in his Fairfield debut since James Johns Jr. netted 13 last season at New Hampshire.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW

Seven of the nine Stags to take the court in the season opener at Boston College were making their Fairfield debuts: Michael Rogan, Peyton Smith, Louis Bleechmore, Jasper Floyd, Matt Curtis, Anthony Davis Jr. and Luke Davidson. All except for the Saint Joseph's transfer Bleechmore were playing in their first-ever Division I game.

In total, 12 of the 17 student-athletes on the 2023-24 roster did not check into a game for the Stags last season.

BENCH MOB

In addition to Chris Casey assuming the role of Interim Head Coach, Fairfield has welcomed a new roster of assistant coaches and support staff for 2023-24. Casey's new assistant coaches are Glenn Braica -- most recently the head coach at St. Francis Brooklyn -- and former Stags' standout Taj Benning. Rounding out the Fairfield staff are Director of Operations Matt Knezovic and Graduate Assistant Chuck Asetta.

ATLANTIC COAST CHALLENGES

Fairfield opened against an ACC foe for the second straight season, visiting Boston College this November after challenging Wake Forest in Winston-Salem to begin last season. The Stags also

played BC during the 2021-22 campaign, making it three consecutive years with ACC competition on the ledger.

The Stags are 1-21 all-time against ACC opponents. The lone victory was an 89-83 win over Boston College at Mohegan Sun Arena in 2016. Fairfield also earned a win over Miami in the 1985-86 campaign, but the Hurricanes were a Division I independent at that time.

NON-CONFERENCE NOTABLES

Fairfield's 11-game non-conference schedule includes members of eight different conferences. With the exception of the Division III Skyline Conference, the longest drought the Stags will end this season is against the Atlantic Sun when they tangle with Queens on Nov. 18. Fairfield has not played an A-Sun opponent since meeting Jacksonville during the 2017-18 campaign.

The Stags will also meet four members of the nine-team Northeast Conference -- playing Sacred Heart, Wagner, FDU and Le Moyne in succession to close out the non-conference schedule from Dec. 9-30.

Mount Saint Mary College and Queens are the only two first-time opponents on the Fairfield schedule. Additionally, the Stags will meet Division I newcomer Le Moyne for the first time since 1955.

THE 2022-23 SEASON AT A GLANCE

Fairfield went 13-18 overall and 9-11 in the MAAC to claim the conference's seventh seed last season. The Stags were led by 13.1 points and 8.5 rebounds per game from Supreme Cook on his way to All-MAAC Third Team laurels. Caleb Fields also averaged double figures with 11.7 points per game and was the Stags' leading assist man with 2.4 helpers per contest.

UP NEXT

Action returns to Mahoney Arena on Sunday, Dec. 17 at 2 p.m. against Wagner. The Seahawks have posted back-to-back one-possession wins over Stony Brook and Coppin State to currently stand at 4-4. Wagner will host Boston University on Dec. 10 before visiting Fairfield on Dec. 17.



INTERIM HEAD COACH CHRIS CASEY

FIRST SEASON • WESTERN CONN. '86

College basketball veteran Chris Casey was named the interim head coach of Fairfield University Men's Basketball prior to the 2023-24 season. Casey most recently served as an assistant with the Stags for the last four campaigns and previously led the programs at Niagara, LIU Post and Rutgers-Newark.

As a head coach, Casey was a part of the MAAC for six years at Niagara from 2013-19. His tenure in Western New York included a 19-win campaign in 2017-18 that saw the Purple Eagles finish 12-6 in the MAAC as the third-seeded team in the conference. He joined Niagara after a three-year stretch at LIU Post highlighted by back-to-back East Coast Conference Championships and NCAA postseason appearances. Casey's first head-coaching stop was at Division III

Rutgers-Newark from 1998-2001.

Casey's assistant coaching career began as a part of the first two Division I seasons in Central Connecticut State history from 1986-88. After a return to his alma mater Western Connecticut State for one season, he reentered the Division I ranks with stops at St. Francis

and Saint Peter's.

Following his stint as head coach at Rutgers-Newark, Casey rejoined the staff at CCSU from 2001-06. He was a part of the Blue Devils' 2002 NEC Championship squad and was recognized as an AFLAC National Assistant Coach of the Year in 2003. In 2006, he moved on to Norm Roberts' staff at St. John's for a four-year tenure that included a trip to the 2010 National Invitation Tournament.

Casey graduated from Western Connecticut State in 1986 with a degree in Business Administration. He earned a Master's in Education Administration from Central Connecticut State in 1993.
