THE OPENING TIP

Fairfield University Men's Basketball hits the road to start the home-and-home MAAC series with Manhattan on Sunday, Jan. 21. Opening tip-off from Draddy Gymnasium is slated for 2 p.m. with all of the action airing live on ESPN+.

LAST TIME OUT

Jalen Leach poured in a career-high 29 points to lead Fairfield to a 76-67 win over visiting Saint Peter's in front of 3,382 fans on Friday at Leo D. Mahoney Arena. Brycen Goodine added 16 points as the Stags handed the Peacocks their first MAAC loss, 76-67.

Leach's 29 points came on 9-for-13 shooting from the floor and 11-for-12 at the free throw line. He also hauled in a team-leading eight rebounds and shared the team high of four assists with Caleb Fields.

Goodine canned four three-pointers on six attempts en route to his 16 points. He entered the day ranked third in the nation in three-point percentage, which sits at .489 after this evening's effort. Peyton Smith was the third Stag in double figures with 10 points.

Rounding out the Fairfield scoring, James Johns Jr. had six points, Fields added five, Louis Bleechmore scored four and the duo of Jasper Floyd and Birima Seck chipped in three apiece. Floyd also hauled in seven rebounds and dished out three assists. Fields filled out his statline with six boards and four helpers.

Fairfield's 76 points represent the most allowed by Saint Peter's in a game this season, and their 50 percent shooting from the floor is the best by a MAAC team against the Peacocks in 2023-24.

THE MATCHUP

FAIRFIELD VS. MANHATTAN

THE MANHATTAN COLLEGE JASPERS

Manhattan, which was idle on Friday evening, welcomes the Stags with a record of 4-11 overall and 1-4 in the MAAC. The Jaspers are looking to weather an eight-game losing streak dating back to Dec. 3. Manhattan three Division I wins (Bryant, CCSU and The Mount) have come by a total of just seven points. The Jaspers' challenging non-conference slate included visits to Kansas and UConn.

LAST MEETING

A hectic final sequence saw Fairfield nearly pull off an improbable comeback against Manhattan on Feb. 19 at Leo D. Mahoney Arena, but a missed free throw with 0.3 seconds on the clock made up the difference as the Stags fell, 73-72. TJ Long reached the 20-point mark for the third straight game with a team-best 23 points.

The game's final sequence started with Long connecting on the last of his four three-pointers to tie the game at 66-66 with 2:41 remaining. The Jaspers' Nelson answered with a layup, then made two free throws to push the lead back to four at 70-66 as the clock crept below one minute to play. Jalen Leach cut the deficit in half with a jumper off an Allan Jeanne-Rose offensive board. Fairfield then got the miss needed on the front-end of a 1-and-1, but a foul on the rebound put Manhattan back on the stripe, where Samir Stewart knocked down a pair.

A free throw each way kept the margin at four points, 73-69, as the Stags regained possession with under 10 seconds to go. A loose ball gave Fairfield an in-bounds play with 2.7 seconds on the clock, and Leach was fouled shooting a three-pointer. The junior knocked down the first two, then intentionally missed the third. The ball rattled to Supreme Cook for his 17th rebound of the afternoon. Cook was fouled on the putback to go to the free throw line with just 0.3 seconds remaining. Cook sank the first but - after Manhattan called a full timeout - could not convert the second as time expired on the 73-72 final.

Cook posted his eighth double-double of the season with 17 points and a game-high 17 rebounds. Jeanne-Rose nearly had a double-double as well with 10 points and nine boards.

Long's 23 points came on 7-for-12 shooting from the floor, 4-for-8 from three-point range and 5-for-6 from the free throw line. Long is the first Stag to net 20 points in three straight games since all-time leading scorer Tyler Nelson had 23 points in the last game of the 2017-18 regular season, then went for 28 and 27 points, respectively, in the first two games of the Stags' run to the MAAC Championship Game.

Ant Nelson led Manhattan with 24 points and five assists, including 16 points in the second half. Marques Watson added 12 for the visitors, and Josh Roberts neared a double-double with eight points and 11 rebounds.

ALL-TIME SERIES

Manhattan's sweep last season moved the all-time series to 60-54 in favor of the Jaspers dating back to 1954. Last season, the Stags were swept in the series for the first time since 2017-18.

FRESH FOES

The Manhattan game marks the second time in the last three MAAC weekends that Fairfield's Sunday opponent had a bye on the preceding Friday night. The tables will turn next Sunday, when the Stags will be idle while Quinnipiac hosts Mount Saint's Marys (on Thursday evening) before Fairfield hosts the Bobcats on Jan. 28.

LEADING THE NATION

After knocking down four of his six three-point attempts in Friday's win over Saint Peter's, Brycen Goodine is the nation's most accurate three-point shooter at .489 (44-90).

EVERYTHING YOU WANT TO KNOW ABOUT BG SCORING 40

Brycen Goodine's 40 points in the Jan. 5 win at Siena marked the fourth 40-point game in Fairfield history. His effort came exactly seven years after Curtis Cobb's record-breaking 46 points at Manhattan.

NOT TO BE OUTDONE

Two days after Goodine's 40-point game, Caleb Fields made headlines by tying the Fairfield program record with 10 three-pointers in the Stags' 82-61 win over Marist at Mahoney Arena. Fields, who netted a career-high 33 points in the game including the 1,000th of his career, was the sixth Division I player to hit 10 treys in a game this season and only the second to do so against a Division I opponent.

He tied the record set by Landon Taliaferro, who had 10 treys en route to 34 points in the Stags' upset win over Texas A&M on Dec. 1, 2019.

FACTS, FIGURES AND MORE

NOTABLE NETS

Fairfield owns one of the MAAC's top non-conference wins per the most recent NET rankings. The Stags hold a "Quad 2" win at #105 Yale to go along with Rider's overtime victory at #129 Delaware.

Canisius leads that category with a "Quad 1" triumph at #73 St. Bonaventure.

TRUCKIN' UP TO BUFFALO

This season marked Fairfield's 25th proper version of the MAAC "Buffalo trip" – playing both Niagara and Canisius on the same visit to Western New York.

Including this year, Fairfield has gone 1-1 on the trip in nine seasons and earned the elusive sweep of the Purple Eagles and Golden Griffs on six occasions, most recently in the 2021-22 campaign. The Stags have come home on the short side of both ends of the Buffalo trip on 10 occasions.

STREAK STATS

Fairfield's eight-game winning streak was its first since 2010-11, when the Stags won 11 in a row.

The Stags also won five consecutive road games during streak, matching a similar run from 2021-22. Fairfield's last six-game road winning streak came when the Stags won 13 in a row from 1985-87, including a perfect 12-0 in true road contests during the 1985-86 MAAC Championship season.

Brycen Goodine (40 pts. at Siena) and Caleb Fields (33 vs. Marist) posted back-to-back 30-point games for Fairfield for the first time since Marcus Gilbert had 32 points at UMES on Nov. 24, 2015 and went for 33 three days later in a win over Columbia.

The last time two different Stags had 30 in back-to-back games was in 1982, when Tony George netted 31 against Saint Joseph's (12/11/82) and Pete DeBisschop dropped 39 on Hofstra (12/18/82).

DeBisschop had 30 points in the next game as well (12/21/82 at Boston College), which is the last time Fairfield had a 30-point scorer in three straight contests.

BRYCEN GOODINE: MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

On the heels of his historic 40-point performance on Jan. 5 at Siena, Brycen Goodine was named the MAAC Player of the Week. For the week as a whole, averaged 27.0 points in 29.5 minutes per game off the bench. Goodine's 40-point showing came on 13-for-18 shooting from the field, including an 8-for-12 outing from beyond the arc, and a 6-for-8 day at the free throw line. In the Jan. 7 win over Marist, Goodine added 14 points on an efficient 5-for-8 shooting day to round out his week at 27.0 points per game firing at .692 (18-26) from the floor, .647 (11-17) from distance and .778 (7-9) at the free throw line.

A NEW YEAR'S NOTE

Fairfield began the calendar year against Siena for the second straight season. And Siena began its calendar year against Fairfield for the third straight year. The Jan. 5, 2024 win in Albany was Fairfield's first win in the first game of January since defeating Iona at Webster Bank Arena on Jan. 2, 2017.

AN NEC STRETCH

Le Moyne was the last of four straight Northeast Conference opponents on the docket to round out Fairfield's non-league slate. The run featured wins over Sacred Heart, Wagner, FDU and the Dolphins.

CALEB FIELDS: MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

After netting a then-career-high 27 points in the Dec. 30 win over Le Moyne, Caleb Fields was named the MAAC Player of the Week for the first time as a Stag. Fields knocked down four three-pointers and canned all seven of his free throw attempts to fuel his 27-point day against Le Moyne. He also tallied five rebounds, four assists and three steals.

FIVE YEARS IN THE MAKING

Fields' 27 points on Dec. 30, 2023 surpassed his previous career high of 24 points established exactly five years prior on Dec. 30, 2018 at UT Martin in his freshman season at Bowling Green. He has since upped his

career standard to 33 points as a part of his 10 three-pointer performance against Marist on Jan. 7, 2024.

STUFFED STAT SHEETS

Jasper Floyd has posted a pair of rare statlines this season. On Nov. 24 against New Hampshire, posting 23 points, five rebounds, five assists and six steals. Floyd is one of only 13 players in the nation to tally 20+ points and 5+ rebounds, assists and steals in a game against a Division I opponent this season.

In the Dec. 30 win over Le Moyne, Floyd had his first career double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds along with five assists and five steals. He is one of only four players in the country with a "point-rebounds" double-double and 5+ assists and steals in the same game.

SETTING THE TONE... AND THEN SOME

Fairfield's 56-26 lead at halftime of the eventual 92-69 win at FDU on Dec. 21 marked the Stags' largest halftime lead over a Division I opponent since taking a 47-14 advantage into the break against Canisius on Jan. 28, 2005. The Stags closed out that game at Webster Bank Arena by a final tally of 82-65.

A HIGH SCORING HALF

The FDU win also featured the Stags' second 56-point half of the campaign. The Stags previously netted 56 points in the second half of the Nov. 9 outing at Rhode Island. Fairfield last scored more than 56 points in a half (against a Division I opponent) in 2018 when they poured in 58 points before the break en route to a 104-85 win over Niagara.

NON-CONFERENCE NOTABLES

Fairfield's 11-game non-conference schedule included members of eight different conferences. With the exception of the Division III Skyline Conference, the longest drought that the Stags ended this season was against the Atlantic Sun when they tangled with Queens on Nov. 18. Fairfield had not played an A-Sun opponent since meeting Jacksonville during the 2017-18 campaign.

WIRE-TO-WIRE

The Stags scored the first seven points of the Dec. 17 win over Wagner and maintained that lead for the duration of the 63-51 victory. The triumph marked Fairfield's first wire-to-wire win against a Division I opponent since a 73-53 win over Niagara on Feb. 12, 2022.

LOW SCORING WINS

The 63-51 win over Wagner marked Fairfield's lowest scoring total in a victory this season, surpassing the 67-57 triumph at Sacred Heart just eight days prior. Not coincidentally, Fairfield posted its two best defensive efforts against Division I competition in those back-to-back wins.

FACTS, FIGURES AND MORE

PLAYING FAVORITES

The Dec. 9 win at Sacred Heart marked the third straight road victory for Fairfield against a team that was tabbed by to win its conference in the preseason. The Stags dispatched MAAC preseason favorite Rider (88-81), Ivy League presumptive favorite Yale (75-71) and the NEC preseason #1 Pioneers (67-57).

THE HEARTBREAK KIDS

With the Dec. 9 win at the Pitt Center, Fairfield improved to 10-0 all-time against Sacred Heart.

LAST RUN, FAST RUN

Trailing 61-51 with 5:42 to play at Yale, Fairfield embarked on a 19-3 run over the ensuing 5:15 to flip the score to 70-64 with just 27 seconds remaining. The Stags converted their free throws down the stretch to ice the comeback in a 75-71 victory.

HOME 'DOGS

Prior to Fairfield's Dec. 6 win at Yale, the Bulldogs had won 12 consecutive games against Connecticut opponents. The Stags' victory also concluded a 100-game stretch in which Yale owned an 83-17 record in games played at the John J. Lee Amphitheater.

STAGS VS. NEW ENGLAND

The Stags are 165-182 all-time against the current Division I basketball programs in New England. Fairfield has never lost to regional foes Dartmouth (4-0), Merrimack (4-0) and Sacred Heart (10-0). The only two Division I teams in New England that the Stags have never defeated both reside in the Ocean State. Fairfield is 0-6 against Rhode Island and has never played Bryant, which joined the Division I ranks in 2008.

PEYTON'S PLACE

Peyton Smith recorded his first career double-double on Dec. 3 with 16 points and 10 rebounds, also adding five blocks in the win at Rider. Smith is one of only two true freshmen in the nation to post a double-double plus five blocks in a game this season.

FIVE IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Jalen Leach's 22 points on Dec. 3 at Rider led five Stags scoring in double figures. Peyton Smith (16), Jasper Floyd (15), Caleb Fields (11) and Brycen Goodine (10) all joined Leach in double figures in the victory. Prior to that game, the last time the Stags had five scorers in double figures was on Nov. 16, 2021, when seven players reached 10 or more points in the 110-55 rout of Medgar Evers. Five Stags had not scored in double figures in the same game against a Division I opponent since Jan. 27, 2019 in an 80-68 win over Iona at Alumni Hall.

FREE IS FOR ME

Fairfield shot 27-for-32 from the free throw line (.844) in the win at Rider. The performance marked season highs in free throws made, attempted, and in free throw percentage (min. 10 attempts). Fairfield exceeded an .844 free throw percentage with at least 20 attempts twice last season, going 25-for-29 (.862) against Niagara on Jan. 6 and 24-for-28 (.857) in the Feb. 12 overtime win over The Mount. The Stags last met that standard with at least 30 attempts from the charity stripe on Dec. 14, 2004, when they posted the same 27-for-32 line in a 68-53 win over Harvard.

PEYTON SMITH: MAAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

After scoring in double figures in all three games on the week of Nov. 13, Peyton Smith was selected as the MAAC Rookie of the Week. Smith averaged 13.0 points per game in the Stags' three contests against MSMC, Drexel and Queens, shooting .692 from the floor. The 6-10 freshman filled out his statline with 5.7 rebounds per contest.

OPENING STATEMENTS

The 22 points for Brycen Goodine on Nov. 6 at Boston College marked the most for a Stag in a season opener since Tyler Nelson poured in 30 in a win over Penn to begin the 2017-18 season. Michael Rogan's 18 points against the Eagles were the most points by a Stag in their collegiate debut since that same Penn game, with Wassef Methnani scoring 20 in his first action in a Fairfield uniform. Finally, Peyton Smith's 12 points were the most for a true freshman in his Fairfield debut since James Johns Jr. netted 13 last season at New Hampshire.

BENCH MOB

In addition to Chris Casey assuming the role of Interim Head Coach, Fairfield has welcomed a new roster of assistant coaches and support staff for 2023-24. Casey's new assistant coaches are Glenn Braica -- most recently the head coach at St. Francis Brooklyn -- and former Stags' standout Taj Benning. Rounding out the Fairfield staff are Director of Operations Matt Knezovic and Graduate Assistant Chuck Asetta.

FACTS, FIGURES AND MORE

ATLANTIC COAST CHALLENGES

Fairfield opened against an ACC foe for the second straight season, visiting Boston College this November after challenging Wake Forest in Winston-Salem to begin last season. The Stags also played BC during the 2021-22 campaign, making it three consecutive years with ACC competition on the ledger.

The Stags are 1-21 all-time against the ACC. The lone victory was an 89-83 win over BC at Mohegan Sun Arena in 2016. Fairfield also earned a win over Miami in the 1985-86 campaign, but the Hurricanes were an independent at that time.

THE 2022-23 SEASON AT A GLANCE

Fairfield went 13-18 overall and 9-11 in the MAAC to claim the conference's seventh seed last season. The Stags were led by 13.1 points and 8.5 rebounds per game from Supreme Cook on his way to All-MAAC Third Team laurels. Caleb Fields also averaged double figures with 11.7 points per game and was the Stags' leading assist man with 2.4 per contest.



INTERIM HEAD COACH CHRIS CASEY

FIRST SEASON • WESTERN CONN. '86

College basketball veteran Chris Casey was named the interim head coach of Fairfield University Men's Basketball prior to the 2023-24 season. Casey most recently served as an assistant with the Stags for the last four campaigns and previously led the programs at Niagara, LIU Post and Rutgers-Newark.

As a head coach, Casey was a part of the MAAC for six years at Niagara from 2013-19. His tenure in Western New York included a 19-win campaign in 2017-18 that saw the Purple Eagles finish 12-6 in the MAAC as the third-seeded team in the conference. He joined Niagara after a three-year stretch at LIU Post highlighted by back-to-back East Coast Conference Championships and NCAA postseason appearances. Casey's first head-coaching stop was at Division III

Rutgers-Newark from 1998-2001.

Casey's assistant coaching career began as a part of the first two Division I seasons in Central Connecticut State history from 1986-88. After a return to his alma mater Western Connecticut State for one season, he reentered the Division I ranks with stops at St. Francis and Saint Peter's.

Following his stint as head coach at Rutgers-Newark, Casey rejoined the staff at CCSU from 2001-06. He was a part of the Blue Devils' 2002 NEC Championship squad and was recognized as an AFLAC National Assistant Coach of the Year in 2003. In 2006, he moved on to Norm Roberts' staff at St. John's for a four-year tenure that included a trip to the 2010 National Invitation Tournament.

Casey graduated from Western Connecticut State in 1986 with a degree in Business Administration. He earned a Master's in Education Administration from Central Connecticut State in 1993.
