Fairfield University Men's Basketball returns to Leo D. Mahoney Arena to host in-state MAAC foe Quinnipiac on Sunday, Jan. 28. Bob Heussler and Joe DeSantis '79 will call all of the action for the Stags Sports Network on ESPN+ beginning at 2 p.m.

LAST TIME OUT

Fairfield knocked down 15 three-pointers on a season-best .556 shooting from beyond the arc to outlast host Manhattan, 82-75, last Sunday at Draddy Gymnasium. Caleb Fields had five of the Stags' 15 triples en route to a gamehigh 25 points.

In addition to five three-pointers, Fields also went 4-for-4 from the stripe in the game's final 36 seconds to help ice the win as Manhattan climbed back to within two points down the stretch.

Two days after scoring a career-high 29 points in Friday's win over Saint Peter's, Jalen Leach hit four treys and shot 9-for-18 from the field overall to pour in 23 in the victory. Brycen Goodine was the third Stag in double figures, canning his third and final triple as a dagger in the closing seconds en route to 13 points.

A total of eight Stags chipped into the scoring as Peyton Smith had seven points, Jasper Floyd scored five, Birima Seck netted four, Jack Brown tallied three points on his first career trey, and James Johns Jr. had two. Floyd also dished out a game-best eight assists as Fairfield assisted on 21 of its 30 field goals.

COACH CASEY ON THE MANHATTAN GAME

"Winning on the road is the hardest thing to do in college basketball. Manhattan kept coming at us, but we never lost our confidence or composure. We made big shots, we got the stops and rebounds that we needed, and Caleb and Jasper made their free throws to close it out. Just like any other game, we'll take away some things from today that we can improve upon. But I'm proud of our guys for coming into a tough place to play and heading back home with a win."

THE MATCHUP

FAIRFIELD VS. QUINNIPIAC

THE QUINNIPIAC UNIVERSITY BOBCATS

Quinnipiac claimed sole possession of first place in the MAAC on Thursday with a home win over the Mount coupled with Saint Peter's dropping a home contest to Rider. The Bobcats have reeled off seven consecutive MAAC wins since losing their conference opener at Canisius, and have won six straight games overall to move to 15-4 on the season and 7-1 in league play.

Outside of conference foes, Fairfield and Quinnipiac only shared one opponent this season. The Stags defeated Yale on Dec. 6 in New Haven, with the Bobcats hosting and falling to the Bulldogs five days later in Hamden.

LAST MEETING

Supreme Cook scored a career-high 26 points and Caleb Fields knocked down five three-pointers en route to 21 as Fairfield defeated visiting Quinnipiac, 92-82, on Senior Night at Leo D. Mahoney Arena on March 2, 2023. Allan Jeanne-Rose added 18 points and nine rebounds to help lock up the win.

In addition to a season best in points, the Stags shot a season-high .552 from the field (32-for-58). Fairfield was 8-for-24 (.333) from three-point range and 20-for-24 (.833) from the charity stripe. Quinnipiac was 27-for-57 (.474) from the floor, 9-for-22 (.409) from deep and 19-for-24 (.792) from the stripe.

Cook's 26 points were on 12-of-15 shooting from the floor. Fields' 21 points were highlighted by 5-for-8 shooting from distance to go along with three rebounds, four assists and two steals. Jeanne-Rose neared a double-double with 18 points and a pair of career highs with nine rebounds and five assists. He was 3-for-4 from the field and 12-for-14 from the free throw line.

The fourth Stag in double figures with TJ Long with 10 points. Jake Wojcik added seven, Makai Willis scored six and Jalen Leach pitched in four clutch points down the stretch.

ALL-TIME SERIES

The win last March ended a 3-0 run in the all-time series that ha2 Quinnipiac on top, 13-8, in the 21 all-time meetings between the two programs. In addition to annual MAAC regular season series since 2013-14, the clubs met once as non-conference foes at the 2011 Connecticut 6 -- a 72-60 Fairfield victory in Uncasville. The Stags and Bobcats also clashed in the semifinal round of the 2018 MAAC Championship with Fairfield taking a 74-64 decision to advance to the finals.

STAGS VS. NEW ENGLAND

The Stags are 165-182 all-time against the current Division I basketball programs in New England. Fairfield has never lost to regional foes Dartmouth (4-0), Merrimack (4-0) and Sacred Heart (10-0). The only two Division I teams in New England that the Stags have never defeated both reside in the Ocean State. Fairfield is 0-6 against Rhode Island and has never played Bryant, which joined the Division I ranks in 2008.

FRESH FOES

Last Sunday's game at Manhattan marked the second time in the last three MAAC weekends that Fairfield's Sunday opponent had a bye on the preceding Friday night. The tables are turned this Sunday, as the Stags enjoyed their bye on Friday while Quinnipiac hosted Mount Saint Mary's on Thursday evening.

LEADING THE NATION

After knocking down three of his five three-point attempts in Sunday's win at Manhattan, Brycen Goodine is the nation's most accurate three-point shooter at .495 (47-95) entering Friday night's slate of games.

Caleb Fields ranks 61st on the list at .389 (49-126) as the second-ranked three-point shooter in the MAAC.

JALEN LEACH: MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

After averaging 22.0 points per game in a 3-0 week, Jalen Leach was named the MAAC Player of the Week. The senior added 3.7 rebounds and 4.7 assists per game in the Stags' trio of victories over Canisius, Saint Peter's and Manhattan.

Leach's 22.0 points per game came on 24-for-42 (.571) shooting from the floor, including five three-pointers. He was also 13-for-15 (.867) from the free throw line. After netting 14 points with six assists in the Monday win at Canisius, Leach went off for a career-best 29 points in Fairfield's 76-67 win over previously-unbeaten Saint Peter's. He also pulled down eight rebounds and dished out four assists against the Peacocks. Leach wrapped up the week on Sunday with 23 points, four assists and five steals in the 82-75 victory at Manhattan.

40 FOR THE FOURTH TIME

Brycen Goodine's 40 points in the Jan. 5 win at Siena marked the fourth 40-point game in Fairfield history.

NOT TO BE OUTDONE

Two days after Goodine's 40-point game, Caleb Fields made headlines by tying the Fairfield program record with 10 three-pointers in the Stags' 82-61 win over Marist at Mahoney Arena. Fields, who netted a career-high 33 points in the game including the 1,000th of his career, was the sixth Division I player to hit 10 treys in a game this season and only the second to do so against a Division I opponent.

He tied the record set by Landon Taliaferro, who had 10 treys en route to 34 points in the Stags' upset win over Texas A&M on Dec. 1, 2019.

NOTABLE NETS

Fairfield owns one of the MAAC's three "Quad 2" non-conference wins per the most recent NET rankings. The Stags hold a win at #95 Yale to go along Canisius's win at #80 St. Bonaventure and Rider's overtime victory at #133 Delaware.

Quinnpiac has the MAAC's best NET ranking at #162 followed by Fairfield at #165.

TRUCKIN' UP TO BUFFALO

This season marked Fairfield's 25th proper version of the MAAC "Buffalo trip" - playing both Niagara and Canisius on the same visit to Western New York. Including this year, Fairfield has gone 1-1 on the trip in nine seasons and earned the elusive sweep of the Purple Eagles and Golden Griffs on six occasions, most recently in the 2021-22 campaign. The Stags have come home on the short side of both ends of the Buffalo trip on 10 occasions.

STREAK STATS

Fairfield's eight-game winning streak was its first since 2010-11, when the Stags won 11 in a row.

The Stags also won five consecutive road games during streak, matching a similar run from 2021-22. Fairfield's last six-game road winning streak came when the Stags won 13 in a row from 1985-87, including a perfect 12-0 in true road contests during the 1985-86 MAAC Championship season.

Brycen Goodine (40 pts. at Siena) and Caleb Fields (33 vs. Marist) posted back-to-back 30-point games for Fairfield for the first time since Marcus Gilbert had 32 points at UMES on Nov. 24, 2015 and went for 33 three days later in a win over Columbia.

The last time two different Stags had 30 in back-to-back games was in 1982, when Tony George netted 31 against Saint Joseph's (12/11/82) and Pete DeBisschop dropped 39 on Hofstra (12/18/82).

DeBisschop had 30 points in the next game as well (12/21/82 at Boston College), which is the last time Fairfield had a 30-point scorer in three straight contests.

On the heels of his historic 40-point performance on Jan. 5 at Siena, Brycen Goodine was named the MAAC Player of the Week. For the week as a whole, averaged 27.0 points in 29.5 minutes per game off the bench. Goodine's 40-point showing came on 13-for-18 shooting from the field, including an 8-for-12 outing from beyond the arc, and a 6-for-8 day at the free throw line. In the Jan. 7 win over Marist, Goodine added 14 points on an efficient 5-for-8 shooting day to round out his week at 27.0 points per game firing at .692 (18-26) from the floor, .647 (11-17) from distance and .778 (7-9) at the free throw line.

Fields knocked down four three-pointers and canned all seven of his free throw attempts to fuel his 27-point day against Le Moyne. He also tallied five rebounds, four assists and three steals.

FIVE YEARS IN THE MAKING

Fields' 27 points on Dec. 30, 2023 surpassed his previous career high of 24 points established exactly five years prior on Dec. 30, 2018 at UT Martin in his freshman season at Bowling Green. He has since upped his

career standard to 33 points as a part of his 10 three-pointer performance against Marist on Jan. 7, 2024.

STUFFED STAT SHEETS

Jasper Floyd has posted a pair of rare statlines this season. On Nov. 24 against New Hampshire, posting 23 points, five rebounds, five assists and six steals. Floyd is one of only 13 players in the nation to tally 20+ points and 5+ rebounds, assists and steals in a game against a Division I opponent this season.

In the Dec. 30 win over Le Moyne, Floyd had his first career double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds along with five assists and five steals. He is one of only four players in the country with a "point-rebounds" double-double and 5+ assists and steals in the same game.

SETTING THE TONE... AND THEN SOME

Fairfield's 56-26 lead at halftime of the eventual 92-69 win at FDU on Dec. 21 marked the Stags' largest halftime lead over a Division I opponent since taking a 47-14 advantage into the break against Canisius on Jan. 28, 2005. The Stags closed out that game at Webster Bank Arena by a final tally of 82-65.

A HIGH SCORING HALF

The FDU win also featured the Stags' second 56-point half of the campaign. The Stags previously netted 56 points in the second half of the Nov. 9 outing at Rhode Island. Fairfield last scored more than 56 points in a half (against a Division I opponent) in 2018 when they poured in 58 points before the break en route to a 104-85 win over Niagara.

NON-CONFERENCE NOTABLES

Fairfield's 11-game non-conference schedule included members of eight different conferences. With the exception of the Division III Skyline Conference, the longest drought that the Stags ended this season was against the Atlantic Sun when they tangled with Queens on Nov. 18. Fairfield had not played an A-Sun opponent since meeting Jacksonville during the 2017-18 campaign.

WIRE-TO-WIRE

The Stags scored the first seven points of the Dec. 17 win over Wagner and maintained that lead for the duration of the 63-51 victory. The triumph marked Fairfield's first wire-to-wire win against a Division I opponent since a 73-53 win over Niagara on Feb. 12, 2022.

LOW SCORING WINS

The 63-51 win over Wagner marked Fairfield's lowest scoring total in a victory this season, surpassing the 67-57 triumph at Sacred Heart just eight days prior. Not coincidentally, Fairfield posted its two best defensive efforts against Division I competition in those back-to-back wins.

NEWS & NOTES FACTS, FIGURES AND MORE

PLAYING FAVORITES

The Dec. 9 win at Sacred Heart marked the third straight road victory for Fairfield against a team that was tabbed by to win its conference in the preseason. The Stags dispatched MAAC preseason favorite Rider (88-81), Ivy League presumptive favorite Yale (75-71) and the NEC preseason #1 Pioneers (67-57).

THE HEARTBREAK KIDS

With the Dec. 9 win at the Pitt Center, Fairfield improved to 10-0 all-time against Sacred Heart.

LAST RUN, FAST RUN

Trailing 61-51 with 5:42 to play at Yale, Fairfield embarked on a 19-3 run over the ensuing 5:15 to flip the score to 70-64 with just 27 seconds remaining. The Stags converted their free throws down the stretch to ice the comeback in a 75-71 victory.

HOME 'DOGS

Prior to Fairfield's Dec. 6 win at Yale, the Bulldogs had won 12 consecutive games against Connecticut opponents. The Stags' victory also concluded a 100-game stretch in which Yale owned an 83-17 record in games played at the John J. Lee Amphitheater.

PEYTON'S PLACE

Peyton Smith recorded his first career double-double on Dec. 3 with 16 points and 10 rebounds, also adding five blocks in the win at Rider. Smith is one of only two true freshmen in the nation to post a double-double plus five blocks in a game this season.

FREE IS FOR ME

Fairfield shot 27-for-32 from the free throw line (.844) in the win at Rider. The performance marked season highs in free throws made, attempted, and in free throw percentage (min. 10 attempts). Fairfield exceeded an .844 free throw percentage with at least 20 attempts twice last season, going 25-for-29 (.862) against Niagara on Jan. 6 and 24-for-28 (.857) in the Feb. 12 overtime win over The Mount. The Stags last met that standard with at least 30 attempts from the charity stripe on Dec. 14, 2004, when they posted the same 27-for-32 line in a 68-53 win over Harvard.

PEYTON SMITH: MAAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

After scoring in double figures in all three games on the week of Nov. 13, Peyton Smith was selected as the MAAC Rookie of the Week. Smith averaged 13.0 points per game in the Stags' three contests against MSMC, Drexel and Queens, shooting .692 from the floor. The 6-10 freshman filled out his statline with 5.7 rebounds per contest.

OPENING STATEMENTS

The 22 points for Brycen Goodine on Nov. 6 at Boston College marked the most for a Stag in a season opener since Tyler Nelson poured in 30 in a win over Penn to begin the 2017-18 season. Michael Rogan's 18 points against the Eagles were the most points by a Stag in their collegiate debut since that same Penn game, with Wassef Methnani scoring 20 in his first action in a Fairfield uniform. Finally, Peyton Smith's 12 points were the most for a true freshman in his Fairfield debut since James Johns Jr. netted 13 last season at New Hampshire.

ATLANTIC COAST CHALLENGES

Fairfield opened against an ACC foe for the second straight season, visiting Boston College this November after challenging Wake Forest in Winston-Salem to begin last season. The Stags also played BC during the 2021-22 campaign, making it three consecutive years with ACC competition on the ledger.

The Stags are 1-21 all-time against the ACC. The lone victory was an 89-83 win over BC at Mohegan Sun Arena in 2016. Fairfield also earned a win over Miami in the 1985-86 campaign, but the Hurricanes were an independent at that time.

THE 2022-23 SEASON AT A GLANCE

Fairfield went 13-18 overall and 9-11 in the MAAC to claim the conference's seventh seed last season. The Stags were led by 13.1 points and 8.5 rebounds per game from Supreme Cook on his way to All-MAAC Third Team laurels. Caleb Fields also averaged double figures with 11.7 points per game and was the Stags' leading assist man with 2.4 per contest.



INTERIM HEAD COACH CHRIS CASEY

FIRST SEASON • WESTERN CONN. '86

College basketball veteran Chris Casey was named the interim head coach of Fairfield University Men's Basketball prior to the 2023-24 season. Casey most recently served as an assistant with the Stags for the last four campaigns and previously led the programs at Niagara, LIU Post and Rutgers-Newark.

As a head coach, Casey was a part of the MAAC for six years at Niagara from 2013-19. His tenure in Western New York included a 19-win campaign in 2017-18 that saw the Purple Eagles finish 12-6 in the MAAC as the third-seeded team in the conference. He joined Niagara after a three-year stretch at LIU Post highlighted by back-to-back East Coast Conference Championships and NCAA postseason appearances. Casey's first head-coaching stop was at Division III

Rutgers-Newark from 1998-2001.

Casey's assistant coaching career began as a part of the first two Division I seasons in Central Connecticut State history from 1986-88. After a return to his alma mater Western Connecticut State for one season, he reentered the Division I ranks with stops at St. Francis

and Saint Peter's.

Following his stint as head coach at Rutgers-Newark, Casey rejoined the staff at CCSU from 2001-06. He was a part of the Blue Devils' 2002 NEC Championship squad and was recognized as an AFLAC National Assistant Coach of the Year in 2003. In 2006, he moved on to Norm Roberts' staff at St. John's for a four-year tenure that included a trip to the 2010 National Invitation Tournament.

Casey graduated from Western Connecticut State in 1986 with a degree in Business Administration. He earned a Master's in Education Administration from Central Connecticut State in 1993.
