THE OPENING TIP

Fairfield University Men's Basketball brings a seven-game winning streak to Leo D. Mahoney Arena, taking to their home court for the first time in 2024 on Sunday, Jan. 7 against visiting Marist. Opening tip is set for 2 p.m. with Bob Heussler and Joe DeSantis on the call for the Stags Sports Network on ESPN+.

LAST TIME OUT

Fueled by a dazzling 40-point game for Brycen Goodine - only the fourth 40-point performance in Fairfield history - the Stags rolled to a 93-69 win at Siena on Friday evening in Albany. The victory marked the seventh straight for the Stags, who also got 19 points and seven rebounds from Jalen Leach.

Goodine's 40-point day came on 13-for-18 shooting from the field, including an 8-for-12 showing from three-point range, and a 6-for-8 game at the free throw line. It was the third 40-point game in Division I this season and the 10th from a player coming off the bench since 2010-11.

As a team, the Stags shot 32-for-55 (58.2%) from the floor sparked by a blistering 19-for-17 (70.4%) performance in the second half. The scoring was supplemented by nine points from James Johns Jr. – making his first start of the campaign – with Peyton Smith and Caleb Fields each adding seven.

In addition to Leach's team-high seven rebounds, Johns hauled in six and Fields nabbed four. Fields also had five of the Stags' 14 assists and swiped a career-best six steals as a part of Siena's 15 turnovers. Fairfield protected the ball to the tune of just seven turnovers.

COACH CASEY ON THE SIENA GAME

"[Brycen] just got into a zone, and our guys recognized that, and they were looking for him. It's been different guys on different nights for us, and tonight was his night. We also really buckled down on the defensive end of the floor, we got stops when we needed them in the second half and our defensive rebounding improved after a rough start. Brycen gets the headlines tonight, and that's well deserved, but it was another full team effort by our guys to get a big conference road win."

THE MATCHUP

FAIRFIELD VS. MARIST

THE MARIST COLLEGE RED FOXES

After being the odd team out of the 11-team MAAC on Friday, Marist returns to conference play with a record of 7-4. The Red Foxes went 5-4 in the non-conference slate in addition to December wins at Iona and home to Manhattan. Marist finished 11th in the MAAC last season, but made an underdog run in Atlantic City all the way to the MAAC Championship Game on the heels of a standout weekend from Patrick Gardner, now of the G League's Long Island Nets.

LAST MEETING

Fairfield fell behind 23-8 to host Marist in the opening 10 minutes of the Feb. 17, 2023 MAAC clash in Poughkeepsie as the Red Foxes converted their first 10 attempts from the field. But the Stags' defense clamped down and the offense heated up over the ensuing 30 minutes as Caleb Fields and TJ Long each scored 21 points to lead Fairfield to a 70-61 victory. Allan Jeanne-Rose joined Fields and Long in double figures with 11 points in the road triumph.

After Marist's 10-for-10 start, the Red Foxes were 13-for-44 for the remainder of the game to land at 42.6 percent from the field. Their eight three-pointers were the most by a MAAC opponent against the Stags this season, though they shot only 28.6 percent against the top three-point defense in the conference.

The Stags shot and even 50 percent from the field at 23-for-46 and made seven three-pointers on 13 attempts. Long went 3-for-4 from deep and Fields drained all three of his triple tries.

Supreme Cook scored seven points and hauled in a game-best 11 rebounds as the Stags held a 34-26 advantage on the boards. Jalen Leach also scored seven points, with James Johns Jr. adding two and Zach Crisler rounding out the scoring with a free throw.

ALL-TIME SERIES

After last season's sweep, Fairfield owns a 42-27 lead in an all-time series that dates back to Jan. 23, 1984. The sweep ended a streak in which the stags and Red Foxes had split the home-and-home in three straight campaign. Fairfield has won three straight meetings in total. Marist has not swept the series since the 2006-07 campaign.

Brycen Goodine's 40 points in Friday's win at Siena marked the fourth 40-point game in Fairfield history. His effort came exactly seven years after Curtis Cobb's record-breaking 46 points at Manhattan.

Of the 67 40-point games in NCAA Division I since the start of the 2021-22 season, only two were achieved in fewer minutes that Goodine's 31 on Friday night (total minutes played in the game, not minutes played when the 40th point was scored).

It was the most points scored by a MAAC player since 2018-19, when Quinnipiac's Cam Young had a MAAC-record 55 points and Siena's Jalen Pickett netted 46 in the same game.

Goodine is also the 10th player to come off the bench to score 40 points in NCAA Division I since 2010-11.

Goodine's eight three-pointers were the most conversions by a MAAC player in a conference game since his former teammate Jake Wojcik also canned eight against Iona at Webster Bank Arena on Jan. 11, 2022.

The Fairfield record for points in back-to-back games belongs to George Groom. Groom had 38 (one shy of the then-program record) against Holy Cross on March 4, 1972. Two days later, he set the record with 41 against Assumption.

JUST FOR FUN

Fairfield Women's Basketball's Sabra Wrice scored a then-program record 36 points, also in a reserve role, on Feb. 19, 2007. However, the Hall of Famer Wrice started every game that season except for that one, graciously ceding her place in the starting lineup to an older teammate on Senior Night.

The Jan. 5, 2024 win in Albany was Fairfield's first win in the first game of January since defeating Iona at Webster Bank Arena on Jan. 2, 2017.

AN NEC STRETCH

Le Moyne was the last of four straight Northeast Conference opponents on the docket to round out Fairfield's non-league slate. The run featured wins over Sacred Heart, Wagner, FDU and the Dolphins.

CALEB FIELDS: MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

After netting a career-high 27 points in Saturday's 78-72 win over Le Moyne, Caleb Fields was named the MAAC Player of the Week. Fields earned the honor for the first time as a Stag.

Fields knocked down four three-pointers and canned all seven of his free throw attempts to fuel his 27-point day against Le Moyne. He also tallied five rebounds, four assists and three steals.

FIVE YEARS IN THE MAKING

Fields' 27 points on Dec. 30, 2023 surpassed his previous career high of 24 points established exactly five years prior on Dec. 30, 2018 at UT Martin in his freshman season at Bowling Green.

On Nov. 24 against New Hampshire, posting 23 points, five rebounds, five assists and six steals. Floyd is one of only 10 players in the nation to tally 20+ points and 5+ rebounds, assists and steals in a game against a Division I opponent this season. Floyd's six steals were also the most by a Stag since Colin Nickerson had six swipes at Milwaukee on Feb. 18, 2012. Caleb Fields has since matched him with six steals in the Jan. 5 win at Siena.

In Dec. 30 win over Le Moyne, Floyd had his first career double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds along with five assists and five steals. He is one of only four players in the country with a "point-rebounds" double-double and 5+ assists and steals in the same game.

SETTING THE TONE... AND THEN SOME

Fairfield's 56-26 lead at halftime of the eventual 92-69 win at FDU on Dec. 21 marked the Stags' largest halftime lead over a Division I opponent since taking a 47-14 advantage into the break against Canisius on Jan. 28, 2005. The Stags closed out that game at Webster Bank Arena by a final tally of 82-65.

A HIGH SCORING HALF

The FDU win also featured the Stags' second 56-point half of the campaign. The Stags previously netted 56 points in the second half of the Nov. 9 outing at Rhode Island.

Fairfield last scored more than 56 points in a half (against a Division I opponent) in the 2017-18 season, when they poured in 58 points before the break en route to a 104-85 win over Niagara.

SECOND HALF STAGS

Fairfield is outscoring its opponents by an average of 4.5 points per game after halftime. The Stags have outscored 10 of 14 opponents to date in the second half.

NON-CONFERENCE NOTABLES

Fairfield's 11-game non-conference schedule included members of eight different conferences. With the exception of the Division III Skyline Conference, the longest drought that the Stags ended this season was against the Atlantic Sun when they tangled with Queens on Nov. 18. Fairfield had not played an A-Sun opponent since meeting Jacksonville during the 2017-18 campaign.

Mount Saint Mary College and Queens were the only two first-time opponents on the Fairfield schedule. Additionally, the Stags met Division I newcomer Le Moyne for the first time since 1955.

WIRE-TO-WIRE

The Stags scored the first seven points of the Dec. 17 win over Wagner and maintained that lead for the duration of the 63-51 victory. The triumph marked Fairfield's first wire-to-wire win against a Division I opponent since a 73-53 win over Niagara on Feb. 12, 2022.

LOW SCORING WINS

The 63-51 win over Wagner marked Fairfield's lowest scoring total in a victory this season, surpassing the 67-57 triumph at Sacred Heart just eight days prior. Not coincidentally, Fairfield posted its two best defensive efforts against Division I competition in those back-to-back wins.

PLAYING FAVORITES

The Dec. 9 win at Sacred Heart marked the third straight road victory for Fairfield against a team that was tabbed by to win its conference in the preseason. The Stags dispatched MAAC preseason favorite Rider (88-81), Ivy League presumptive favorite Yale (75-71) and the NEC preseason #1 Pioneers (67-57).

THE HEARTBREAK KIDS

With the Dec. 9 win at the Pitt Center, Fairfield improved to 10-0 all-time against Sacred Heart.

BIRIMA'S BACK

Birima Seck made his Fairfield debut in the win at Sacred Heart. In six minutes, Seck scored one point with one rebounds, one assist and one block. Twelve days later, Seck, who previously played at the University of New Mexico, set a new career best with 13 points on 6-for-7 shooting in the Dec. 21 win at FDU.

LAST RUN, FAST RUN

Trailing 61-51 with 5:42 to play at Yale, Fairfield embarked on a 19-3 run over the ensuing 5:15 to flip the score to 70-64 with just 27 seconds remaining. The Stags converted their free throws down the stretch to ice the comeback in a 75-71 victory.

NEWS & NOTES FACTS, FIGURES AND MORE

HOME 'DOGS

Prior to Fairfield's Dec. 6 win at Yale, the Bulldogs had won 12 consecutive games against Connecticut opponents. The Stags' victory also concluded a 100-game stretch in which Yale owned an 83-17 record in games played at the John J. Lee Amphitheater.

STAGS VS. NEW ENGLAND

The Stags are 165-182 all-time against the current Division I basketball programs in New England.

Fairfield has never lost to regional foes Dartmouth (4-0), Merrimack (4-0) and Sacred Heart (10-0). The only two Division I teams in New England that the Stags have never defeated both reside in the Ocean State. Fairfield is 0-6 against Rhode Island and has never played Bryant, which joined the Division I ranks in 2008.

PEYTON'S PLACE

Peyton Smith recorded his first career double-double on Dec. 3 with 16 points and 10 rebounds, also adding five blocks in the win at Rider. Smith is one of only two true freshmen in the nation to post a double-double plus five blocks in a game this season.

FIVE IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Jalen Leach's 22 points on Dec. 3 at Rider led five Stags scoring in double figures. Peyton Smith (16), Jasper Floyd (15), Caleb Fields (11) and Brycen Goodine (10) all joined Leach in double figures in the victory. Prior to that game, the last time the Stags had five scorers in double figures was on Nov. 16, 2021, when seven players reached 10 or more points in the 110-55 rout of Medgar Evers. Five Stags had not scored in double figures in the same game against a Division I opponent since Jan. 27, 2019 in an 80-68 win over Iona at Alumni Hall.

FREE IS FOR ME

Fairfield shot 27-for-32 from the free throw line (.844) in the win at Rider. The performance marked season highs in free throws made, attempted, and in free throw percentage (min. 10 attempts).

Fairfield exceeded an .844 free throw percentage with at least 20 attempts twice last season, going 25-for-29 (.862) against Niagara on Jan. 6 and 24-for-28 (.857) in the Feb. 12 overtime win over The Mount.

The Stags last met that standard with at least 30 attempts from the charity stripe on Dec. 14, 2004, when they posted the same 27-for-32 line in a 68-53 win over Harvard.

PEYTON SMITH: MAAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

After scoring in double figures in all three games on the week of Nov. 13, Peyton Smith was selected as the MAAC Rookie of the Week. Smith averaged 13.0 points per game in the Stags' three contests against MSMC, Drexel and Queens, shooting .692 from the floor. The 6-10 freshman filled out his statline with 5.7 rebounds per contest.

OPENING STATEMENTS

The 22 points for Brycen Goodine on Nov. 6 at Boston College marked the most for a Stag in a season opener since Tyler Nelson poured in 30 in a win over Penn to begin the 2017-18 season. Michael Rogan's 18 points against the Eagles were the most points by a Stag in their collegiate debut since that same Penn game, with Wassef Methnani scoring 20 in his first action in a Fairfield uniform. Finally, Peyton Smith's 12 points were the most for a true freshman in his Fairfield debut since James Johns Jr. netted 13 last season at New Hampshire.

BENCH MOB

In addition to Chris Casey assuming the role of Interim Head Coach, Fairfield has welcomed a new roster of assistant coaches and support staff for 2023-24. Casey's new assistant coaches are Glenn Braica -- most recently the head coach at St. Francis Brooklyn -- and former Stags' standout Taj Benning. Rounding out the Fairfield staff are Director of Operations Matt Knezovic and Graduate Assistant Chuck Asetta.

ATLANTIC COAST CHALLENGES

Fairfield opened against an ACC foe for the second straight season, visiting Boston College this November after challenging Wake Forest in Winston-Salem to begin last season. The Stags also played BC during the 2021-22 campaign, making it three consecutive years with ACC competition on the ledger.

The Stags are 1-21 all-time against ACC opponents. The lone victory was an 89-83 win over Boston College at Mohegan Sun Arena in 2016. Fairfield also earned a win over Miami in the 1985-86 campaign, but the Hurricanes were a Division I independent at that time.

FACTS, FIGURES AND MORE

THE 2022-23 SEASON AT A GLANCE

Fairfield went 13-18 overall and 9-11 in the MAAC to claim the conference's seventh seed last season. The Stags were led by 13.1 points and 8.5 rebounds per game from Supreme Cook on his way to All-MAAC Third Team laurels. Caleb Fields also averaged double figures with 11.7 points per game and was the Stags' leading assist man with 2.4 per contest.

UP NEXT

Fairfield hits the road for the MAAC's infamous "Buffalo Trip" on Jan. 12-14. Action returns to Leo D. Mahoney Arena for the first game of the 2024 spring semester on Friday, Jan. 19 against Saint Peter's.



INTERIM HEAD COACH CHRIS CASEY

FIRST SEASON • WESTERN CONN. '86

College basketball veteran Chris Casey was named the interim head coach of Fairfield University Men's Basketball prior to the 2023-24 season. Casey most recently served as an assistant with the Stags for the last four campaigns and previously led the programs at Niagara, LIU Post and Rutgers-Newark.

As a head coach, Casey was a part of the MAAC for six years at Niagara from 2013-19. His tenure in Western New York included a 19-win campaign in 2017-18 that saw the Purple Eagles finish 12-6 in the MAAC as the third-seeded team in the conference. He joined Niagara after a three-year stretch at LIU Post highlighted by back-to-back East Coast Conference Championships and NCAA postseason appearances. Casey's first head-coaching stop was at Division III

Rutgers-Newark from 1998-2001.

Casey's assistant coaching career began as a part of the first two Division I seasons in Central Connecticut State history from 1986-88. After a return to his alma mater Western Connecticut State for one season, he

reentered the Division I ranks with stops at St. Francis and Saint Peter's.

Following his stint as head coach at Rutgers-Newark, Casey rejoined the staff at CCSU from 2001-06. He was a part of the Blue Devils' 2002 NEC Championship squad and was recognized as an AFLAC National Assistant Coach of the Year in 2003. In 2006, he moved on to Norm Roberts' staff at St. John's for a four-year tenure that included a trip to the 2010 National Invitation Tournament.

Casey graduated from Western Connecticut State in 1986 with a degree in Business Administration. He earned a Master's in Education Administration from Central Connecticut State in 1993.
