THE OPENING TIP

Fairfield University Men's Basketball brings a three-game winning streak back to Leo D. Mahoney Arena to host Niagara on Friday, Feb. 16 at 7 p.m. The Hall of Fame duo of Bob Heussler and Joe DeSantis '79 will be on the call for the Stags Sports Network on ESPN+.

LAST TIME OUT

For the third time in as many games, Fairfield went into the half facing a deficit and flipped that margin into a win. Last Saturday in Jersey City, that outcome was in doubt until the final horn as a Saint Peter's layup rimmed out to send the Stags to a 64-62 victory.

Caleb Fields and Jalen Leach paced the Fairfield scoring with 17 points apiece.

Fields' 17 points including four three-pointers for the MAAC's leader from beyond the arc. Leach supplemented his 17-point day with a game-best seven rebounds. James Johns Jr. joined them in double figures with 11 points, including a free throw in the closing seconds to help ice the conference road victory.

Jasper Floyd was just short of double figures with nine points, adding two assists and three steals. Fields also came away with three steals as a part of the Peacocks' 17 turnovers.

To round out the Fairfield scoring, Birima Seck and Louis Bleechmore each scored five points.

Roy Clarke led all scorers with 21 points for Saint Peter's, and Marcus Randolph hit four three-pointers on his way to 19.

THE MATCHUP

FAIRFIELD VS. NIAGARA

THE NIAGARA UNIVERSITY PURPLE EAGLES

Niagara most recently saw a furious comeback at Iona fall just short in a 74-71 loss, slipping to 12-11 on the season and 8-5 in the MAAC. The Purple Eagles had won five of six prior to last Thursday in New Rochelle.

Niagara is currently tied with Marist for third place in the MAAC at 8-5, with Iona just behind them in the loss column at 7-5. A win on Friday would move the Purple Eagles into second place as current owners of the tiebreakers over both Fairfield and Marist.

LAST MEETING

Fairfield was unable to overcome a hot shooting night for host Niagara, as the Purple Eagles claimed an 96-72 win on their home court back on Jan. 12. The loss ended the Stags' eight-game winning streak.

Caleb Fields led the Stags' offense with 19 points, including three of the squad's eight three-pointers, as the Stags shot 8-for-22 (.364) from deep as a part of a 24-for-58 (.414) overall shooting mark. Louis Bleechmore added 17 points, and Peyton Smith notched 12 from the post on 5-of-6 shooting.

Supplementing the offense were James Johns Jr. with nine points, six from Jasper Floyd, five for Brycen Goodine, three by Jalen Leach and one from Birima Seck.

Floyd led the Stags on the glass with seven rebounds, with Smith and Leach each collecting four. Floyd also nabbed a pair of steals and distributed three assists. Leach had the team lead with four helpers.

Despite committing only eight turnovers, the Stags were on the short side of that battle as Niagara was guilty of only six miscues.

The Purple Eagles blistered the home nets at 34-for-55 shooting (61.8%) including a 10-for-15 (.667) clip from three-point range. Ahmad Henderson II led all scorers with 20 points for Niagara, and Luke Bumbalough shot 4-for-5 from distance en route to 14 points along with seven assists.

ALL-TIME SERIES

The January win for Niagara moved the Purple Eagles' lead in the all-time series to 48-37 since 1966. Each team has put together a six-game streak in the series, with Niagara winning a half-dozen in a row from 1991-93, and the Stags winning six consecutively from 2010-12. Currently, the Purps have won the last three meetings.

SECOND TIME AROUND

Fairfield has completed four MAAC series to date and, in all four, the results has been the same the second time around. The Stags swept the season series from Manhattan, Rider and Saint Peter's and was on the short side of both meetings with Iona.

The Stags have swept three MAAC home-and-home series for the third straight season. The last time Fairfield swept four conference opponents in the regular season was in the 2016-17 campaign.

FACTS, FIGURES AND MORE

WHAT'S THE SCENARIO?

While the MAAC standings remain up for grabs, with seven teams boasting a winning conference record, history says that 11 is the magic number to clinch a first-round bye. No team with 11 or more conference wins (in a 20-game schedule) has ever slipped to the play-in round of the MAAC Championship. Teams that finished exactly 10-10 have snuck into the top five on two occasions, while three 10-10 squads have been left out (including one on a tiebreaker).

At the top of the standings, 16 or more conference wins has guaranteed the top seed in six of seven seasons under a 20-game MAAC schedule, with 15 wins beginning sufficient in each of the last five campaigns.

SECOND HALF STAGS

Fairfield has trailed at the half in each game of its current three-game winning streak. The Stags also headed to the intermission facing a deficit in the back-to-back victories over Yale and Sacred Heart in December.

20s ALL AROUND

In the win over Rider on Feb. 8, Jalen Leach netted 22 points while Caleb Fields and Jasper Floyd each contributed 20. The last time a trio all hit the 20-point mark for the Stags was Jan. 4, 2016 when Marcus Gilbert scored 21 points while Tyler Nelson and Jerry Johnson Jr. each had 20 in a 97-85 win over Dartmouth at Alumni Hall.

THE LEX EXPRESS

Alexis Yetna made his Fairfield debut on Thursday against the Broncs. He scored five points with one rebounds - the 700th of his collegiate career - while appearing in his first game since challenging TCU as a member of Seton Hall in the First Round of the NCAA Championship on March 18, 2022.

SHUFFLING STARTERS

Fairfield broke a string on Thursday of five consecutive games with a different starting lineup. In total, nine different Stags have made at least one start. No player had started every game, and Jasper Floyd is the only Stag to have played in all 24 contests to date. Floyd came off the bench in the Jan. 28 game against Quinnipiac, marking his only game as a non-starter this season. Peyton Smith has started in every game in which he was active, but has not played in the last three due to injury after 21 straight starts to begin his career.

SEEING THEIR SHADOW

Fairfield's loss at Iona snapped a four-game winning streak for the Stags on Groundhog Day, Feb. 2. In the spirit of the day, all five times in program history that the Stags played a repeat opponent on Groundhog Day, the result was the same as the meeting earlier than season.

JALEN LEACH: MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

After averaging 22.0 points per game in a 3-0 week, Jalen Leach was named the MAAC Player of the Week on Jan. 22. The senior added 3.7 rebounds and 4.7 assists per game in the Stags' trio of victories over Canisius, Saint Peter's and Manhattan.

Leach's 22.0 points per game came on 24-for-42 (.571) shooting from the floor, including five three-pointers. He was also 13-for-15 (.867) from the free throw line. After netting 14 points with six assists in the Monday win at Canisius, Leach went off for a career-best 29 points in Fairfield's 76-67 win over previously-unbeaten Saint Peter's. He also pulled down eight rebounds and dished out four assists against the Peacocks. Leach wrapped up the week on Sunday with 23 points, four assists and five steals in the 82-75 victory at Manhattan.

40 FOR THE FOURTH TIME

Brycen Goodine's 40 points in the Jan. 5 win at Siena marked the fourth 40-point game in Fairfield history.

NOT TO BE OUTDONE

Two days after Goodine's 40-point game, Caleb Fields made headlines by tying the Fairfield program record with 10 three-pointers in the Stags' 82-61 win over Marist at Mahoney Arena. Fields, who netted a career-high 33 points in the game including the 1,000th of his career, was the sixth Division I player to hit 10 treys in a game this season and only the second to do so against a Division I opponent.

He tied the record set by Landon Taliaferro, who had 10 treys en route to 34 points in the Stags' upset win over Texas A&M on Dec. 1, 2019.

NOTABLE NETS

Fairfield owns one of the MAAC's strongest non-conference wins of the season, per the most recent NET rankings. The Stags hold a Quad 2 win at #83 Yale to go along with Rider's Quad 2 win at #135 Delaware and Canisius's Quad 1 win at #68 St. Bonaventure.

TRUCKIN' UP TO BUFFALO

This season marked Fairfield's 25th proper version of the MAAC "Buffalo trip" – playing both Niagara and Canisius on the same visit to Western New York. Including this year, Fairfield has gone 1-1 on the trip in nine seasons and earned the elusive sweep of the Purple Eagles and Golden Griffs on six occasions, most recently in the 2021-22 campaign. The Stags have come home on the short side of both ends of the Buffalo trip on 10 occasions.

STREAK STATS

Fairfield's eight-game winning streak was its first since 2010-11, when the Stags won 11 in a row. The Stags also won five consecutive road games during streak, matching a similar run from 2021-22. Fairfield's last six-game road winning streak came when the Stags won 13 in a row from 1985-87, including a perfect 12-0 in true road contests during the 1985-86 MAAC Championship season.

Brycen Goodine (40 pts. at Siena) and Caleb Fields (33 vs. Marist) posted back-to-back 30-point games for Fairfield for the first time since Marcus Gilbert had 32 points at UMES on Nov. 24, 2015 and went for 33 three days later in a win over Columbia.

The last time two different Stags had 30 in back-to-back games was in 1982, when Tony George netted 31 against Saint Joseph's (12/11/82) and Pete DeBisschop dropped 39 on Hofstra (12/18/82). DeBisschop had 30 points in the next game as well (12/21/82 at Boston College), which is the last time Fairfield had a 30-point scorer in three straight contests.

BRYCEN GOODINE: MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

On the heels of his historic 40-point performance on Jan. 5 at Siena, Brycen Goodine was named the MAAC Player of the Week. For the week as a whole, averaged 27.0 points in 29.5 minutes per game off the bench. Goodine's 40-point showing came on 13-for-18 shooting from the field, including an 8-for-12 outing from beyond the arc, and a 6-for-8 day at the free throw line.

In the Jan. 7 win over Marist, Goodine added 14 points on an efficient 5-for-8 shooting day to round out his week at 27.0 points per game firing at .692 (18-26) from the floor, .647 (11-17) from distance and .778 (7-9) at the free throw line.

A NEW YEAR'S NOTE

Fairfield began the calendar year against Siena for the second straight season. And Siena began its calendar year against Fairfield for the third straight year. The Jan. 5, 2024 win in Albany was Fairfield's first win in the first game of January since defeating Iona at Webster Bank Arena on Jan. 2, 2017.

THE NEC STRETCH

Le Moyne was the last of four straight Northeast Conference opponents on the docket to round out Fairfield's non-league slate. The run featured wins over Sacred Heart, Wagner, FDU and the Dolphins.

CALEB FIELDS: MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

After netting a then-career-high 27 points in the Dec. 30 win over Le Moyne, Caleb Fields was named the MAAC Player of the Week for the first time as a Stag. Fields knocked down four three-pointers and canned all seven of his free throw attempts to fuel his 27-point day against Le Moyne. He also tallied five rebounds, four assists and three steals.

FIVE YEARS IN THE MAKING

Fields' 27 points on Dec. 30, 2023 surpassed his previous career high of 24 points established exactly five years prior on Dec. 30, 2018 at UT Martin in his freshman season at Bowling Green.

He has since upped his career standard to 33 points as a part of his 10 three-pointer performance in the win over Marist on Jan. 7, 2024.

STUFFED STAT SHEETS

Jasper Floyd has posted a pair of rare statlines this season. On Nov. 24 against New Hampshire, posting 23 points, five rebounds, five assists and six steals. Floyd is one of only 14 players in the nation to tally 20+ points and 5+ rebounds, assists and steals in a game against a Division I opponent this season.

In the Dec. 30 win over Le Moyne, Floyd had his first career double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds along with five assists and five steals. He is one of only six players in the country with a "point-rebounds" double-double and 5+ assists and steals in the same game.

SETTING THE TONE... AND THEN SOME

Fairfield's 56-26 lead at halftime of the eventual 92-69 win at FDU on Dec. 21 marked the Stags' largest halftime lead over a Division I opponent since taking a 47-14 advantage into the break against Canisius on Jan. 28, 2005. The Stags closed out that game at Webster Bank Arena by a final tally of 82-65.

A HIGH SCORING HALF

The FDU win also featured the Stags' second 56-point half of the campaign. The Stags previously netted 56 points in the second half of the Nov. 9 outing at Rhode Island.

Fairfield last scored more than 56 points in a half (against a Division I opponent) in 2018 when they poured in 58 points before the break en route to a 104-85 win over Niagara.

NON-CONFERENCE NOTABLES

Fairfield's 11-game non-conference schedule included members of eight different conferences. With the exception of the Division III Skyline Conference, the longest drought that the Stags ended this season was against the Atlantic Sun when they tangled with Queens on Nov. 18. Fairfield had not played an A-Sun opponent since meeting Jacksonville during the 2017-18 campaign.

WIRE-TO-WIRE

The Stags scored the first seven points of the Dec. 17 win over Wagner and maintained that lead for the duration of the 63-51 victory. The triumph marked Fairfield's first wire-to-wire win against a Division I opponent since a 73-53 win over Niagara on Feb. 12, 2022.

LOW SCORING WINS

The 63-51 win over Wagner marked Fairfield's lowest scoring total in a victory this season, surpassing the 67-57 triumph at Sacred Heart just eight days prior. Not coincidentally, Fairfield posted its two best defensive efforts against Division I competition in those back-to-back wins.

PLAYING FAVORITES

The Dec. 9 win at Sacred Heart marked the third straight road victory for Fairfield against a team that was tabbed by to win its conference in the preseason. The Stags dispatched MAAC preseason favorite Rider (88-81), Ivy League presumptive favorite Yale (75-71) and the NEC preseason #1 Pioneers (67-57).

THE HEARTBREAK KIDS

With the Dec. 9 win at the Pitt Center, Fairfield improved to 10-0 all-time against Sacred Heart.

LAST RUN, FAST RUN

Trailing 61-51 with 5:42 to play at Yale, Fairfield embarked on a 19-3 run over the ensuing 5:15 to flip the score to 70-64 with just 27 seconds remaining. The Stags converted their free throws down the stretch to ice the comeback in a 75-71 victory.

HOME 'DOGS

Prior to Fairfield's Dec. 6 win at Yale, the Bulldogs had won 12 consecutive games against Connecticut opponents. The Stags' victory also concluded a 100-game stretch in which Yale owned an 83-17 record in games played at the John J. Lee Amphitheater.

PEYTON'S PLACE

Peyton Smith recorded his first career double-double on Dec. 3 with 16 points and 10 rebounds, also adding five blocks in the win at Rider. Smith is one of only two true freshmen in the nation to post a double-double plus five blocks in a game this season.

FREE IS FOR ME

Fairfield shot 27-for-32 from the free throw line (.844) in the win at Rider. The performance marked season highs in free throws made, attempted, and in free throw percentage (min. 10 attempts). Fairfield exceeded an .844 free throw percentage with at least 20 attempts twice last season, going 25-for-29 (.862) against Niagara on Jan. 6 and 24-for-28 (.857) in the Feb. 12 overtime win over The Mount. The Stags last met that standard with at least 30 attempts from the charity stripe on Dec. 14, 2004, when they posted the same 27-for-32 line in a 68-53 win over Harvard.

PEYTON SMITH: MAAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

After scoring in double figures in all three games on the week of Nov. 13, Peyton Smith was selected as the MAAC Rookie of the Week. Smith averaged 13.0 points per game in the Stags' three contests against MSMC, Drexel and Queens, shooting .692 from the floor. The 6-10 freshman filled out his statline with 5.7 rebounds per contest.

STAGS VS. NEW ENGLAND

The Stags are 165-183 all-time against the current Division I basketball programs in New England. Fairfield has never lost to regional foes Dartmouth (4-0), Merrimack (4-0) and Sacred Heart (10-0). The only two Division I teams in New England that the Stags have never defeated both reside in the Ocean State. Fairfield is 0-6 against Rhode Island and has never played Bryant, which joined the Division I ranks in 2008.



INTERIM HEAD COACH CHRIS CASEY

FIRST SEASON • WESTERN CONN. '86

College basketball veteran Chris Casey was named the interim head coach of Fairfield University Men's Basketball prior to the 2023-24 season. Casey most recently served as an assistant with the Stags for the last four campaigns and previously led the programs at Niagara, LIU Post and Rutgers-Newark.

As a head coach, Casey was a part of the MAAC for six years at Niagara from 2013-19. His tenure in Western New York included a 19-win campaign in 2017-18 that saw the Purple Eagles finish 12-6 in the MAAC as the third-seeded team in the conference. He joined Niagara after a three-year stretch at LIU Post highlighted by back-to-back East Coast Conference Championships and NCAA postseason appearances. Casey's first head-coaching stop was at Division III

Rutgers-Newark from 1998-2001.

Casey's assistant coaching career began as a part of the first two Division I seasons in Central Connecticut State history from 1986-88. After a return to his alma mater Western Connecticut State for one season, he reentered the Division I ranks with stops at St. Francis and Saint Peter's.

Following his stint as head coach at Rutgers-Newark, Casey rejoined the staff at CCSU from 2001-06. He was a part of the Blue Devils' 2002 NEC Championship squad and was recognized as an AFLAC National Assistant Coach of the Year in 2003. In 2006, he moved on to Norm Roberts' staff at St. John's for a four-year tenure that included a trip to the 2010 National Invitation Tournament.

Casey graduated from Western Connecticut State in 1986 with a degree in Business Administration. He earned a Master's in Education Administration from Central Connecticut State in 1993.
