THE OPENING TIP

Fairfield University Men's Basketball heads to Hamden for a return meeting with the first-place Quinnipiac Bobcats. The game will be televised live on ESPNU at 9 p.m. with Robert Lee and Tom Crean calling the action.

LAST TIME OUT

A program-record 18 three-pointers guided Fairfield to a 94-80 win over visiting Mount St. Mary's on Sunday at Leo D. Mahoney Arena. Caleb Fields accounted for seven of those triples on his way to a game-best 26 points as the Stags netted a season-best 94 points in the triumph.

The 18 made three-pointers topped the mark of 17 attained twice in a 33-day span in 2015 at Maryland Eastern Shore and again six games later at Bucknell. At 18-for-36, the Stags shot .500 or better from three-point range for the fourth time this season.

Brycen Goodine added a 6-for-8 day from three-point range on his way to 20 points in 18 minutes off the bench. Jasper Floyd scored 16 points and just missed a double-double with a game-high nine rebounds as well as five assists and two steals. Jalen Leach was the fourth Stag in double figures with 14 points, four rebounds and a game-high six assists.

Alexis Yetna continued his comeback to the rotation with eight points and seven rebounds, Louis Bleechmore chipped six points and Birima Seck closed out the scoring with four points to go along with four rebounds and a block.

COACH CASEY ON THE MOUNT GAME

"Intensity and tenacity can go up and down over the course of a long season. But today, we came out with intensity right from the opening tip, and that helped get us into a flow where we got open looks and took advantage of them. We're not always going to make 18 three-pointers, but we can control our intensity and tenacity, so we need to continue to play with and for each other to keep those intangibles as high as possible heading down the stretch."

THE MATCHUP

FAIRFIELD VS. QUINNIPIAC

THE QUINNIPIAC UNIVERSITY BOBCATS

Quinnipiac is coming off of back-to-back losses for the first time this season to stand at 19-6 overall and 11-3 in the MAAC. The Bobcats are in first place by two games in the loss column over Fairfield, Niagara (both 10-5) and Marist (9-5).

In addition to MAAC opponents, both Fairfield and Quinnipiac played instate foe Yale in a five-day span. The Stags defeated the Bulldogs in New Haven on Dec. 6 while the Bobcats lost to Yale at home on Dec. 11.

LAST MEETING

After seven ties and 13 lead changes on Jan. 28 at Mahoney Arena, the last bucket of the day went to visiting Quinnipiac as the Bobcats clipped Fairfield, 66-64. Caleb Fields and Jalen Leach shared the game high in scoring with 18 points apiece for the Stags.

The Stags trailed by as many as seven points, last occurring on an Alexis Reyes three-pointer with 7:08 left that put the Bobcats on top, 55-48. At that point, the Stags embarked on a 12-0 run featuring five points from Fields and punctuated by a thunderous breakaway dunk plus the foul for Leach.

The teams traded buckets with Fields adding a three-pointer and a layup to keep Fairfield in front, 62-59 as the clock ticked under two minutes. The equalizer for Quinnipiac came on a Rihards Vavers three-pointer in transition to knot the game at 62-62 with 1:52 left.

The Stags responded with a Brycen Goodine tip-in for the last of his 11 points. Quinnipiac against got the bucket they needed to tie the game as Matt Balanc drove and scored with 52 seconds left. Fairfield was unable to convert on its next trip, giving Balanc and the Bobcats a chance to take the lead. The fifth-year guard ran the clock down and made a tough layup with 3.5 seconds left to tip the game towards the visitors, 66-64. Fairfield got a good look at the horn, but Leach's wing three-pointer drew iron at the horn as Quinnipiac escaped with a two-point decision.

Fields scored 10 of Fairfield's final 14 points to round out his 17 points. Leach was 7-for-16 to net his 18. Goodine supplemented his 11 points with six rebounds, two blocked shots and three steals. The fourth Stag in double figures was Jasper Floyd, who was just short of a double-double with 10 points, nine rebounds and four assists.

Balanc's four points in the final minute gave him a team-high 13 for Quinnipiac. Amarri Tice finished with 12 points and 11 boards as the MAAC's top rebounding team gained a 40-35 advantage on the glass.

ALL-TIME SERIES

Including this season, Quinnipiac has won four of the last five meetings to lead 14-8 in the 22 all-time meetings between the two programs. Thirteen of the 22 encounters have been decided by 1-2 possessions (or in overtime) with an overall average margin of 6.6 points.

TRENDING UPWARDS

At 16-10, Fairfield has recorded its most overall wins since going 17-16 en route to a MAAC Championship Game appearance in 2017-18. The Stags have reached double-digit conference wins for the first time since going 11-9 in the 2016-17 campaign.

RAINING THREES...

Fairfield's 18 made three-pointers against The Mount topped the mark of 17 attained twice in a 33-day span in 2015 at Maryland Eastern Shore and again six games later at Bucknell. At 18-for-36 against Mount St. Mary's, the Stags shot .500 or better from three-point range for the fourth time this season.

...POURING POINTS

Fueled by their record-setting performance from downtown, the Stags scored a season-best 94 points. The effort marked the most points scored in a game by Fairfield since a 110-55 win over Medgar Evers on Nov. 16, 2021 and the most against a Division I opponent since beating Quinnipiac, 102-98, in double overtime on Feb. 17, 2018. That season is also the last time the Stags scored 90-plus points in three MAAC games, topping 100 in the home wins over QU, Iona and Niagara.

WHAT'S THE SCENARIO?

While the MAAC standings remain too close to call, with the second through eighth place teams all within three games of each other, history says that 11 is the magic number to clinch a first-round bye. No team with 11 or more conference wins (in a 20-game schedule) has ever slipped to the play-in round of the MAAC Championship. Teams that finished exactly 10-10 have snuck into the top five on two occasions, while three 10-10 squads have been left out (including one on a tiebreaker).

At the top of the standings, 16 or more conference wins has guaranteed the top seed in six of seven seasons under a 20-game MAAC schedule, with 15 wins beginning sufficient in each of the last five campaigns.

SECOND TIME AROUND

Fairfield has completed five MAAC series to date and, in all five, the results has been the same the second time around. The Stags swept the season series from Manhattan, Rider and Saint Peter's and were on the short side of both meetings with Iona and Niagara. The Stags have swept three MAAC home-and-home series for the third straight season. The last time Fairfield swept four conference opponents in the regular season was in the 2016-17 campaign.

STUFFING THE STATSHEET

Jasper Floyd is the only player in the MAAC to rank in the individual top 10 in assists per game (third, 4.6), steals per game (first, 2.46) and rebounds per game (10th, 6.2).

Nationally, he is one of just four players to average 10 points, six rebounds, four assists and two steals per game.

20s ALL AROUND

In the win over Rider on Feb. 8, Jalen Leach netted 22 points while Caleb Fields and Jasper Floyd each contributed 20. The last time a trio all hit the 20-point mark for the Stags was Jan. 4, 2016 when Marcus Gilbert scored 21 points while Tyler Nelson and Jerry Johnson Jr. each had 20 in a 97-85 win over Dartmouth at Alumni Hall.

THE LEX EXPRESS

Alexis Yetna made his Fairfield debut on Feb. 8 against the Broncs. He scored five points with one rebounds - the 700th of his collegiate career - while appearing in his first game since challenging TCU as a member of Seton Hall in the First Round of the NCAA Championship on March 18, 2022.

SEEING THEIR SHADOW

Fairfield's loss at Iona snapped a four-game winning streak for the Stags on Groundhog Day, Feb. 2. In the spirit of the day, all five times in program history that the Stags have played a repeat opponent on Groundhog Day, the result was the same as the meeting earlier than season.

JALEN LEACH: MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

After averaging 22.0 points per game in a 3-0 week, Jalen Leach was named the MAAC Player of the Week on Jan. 22. The senior added 3.7 rebounds and 4.7 assists per game in the Stags' trio of victories over Canisius, Saint Peter's and Manhattan.

Leach's 22.0 points per game came on 24-for-42 (.571) shooting from the floor, including five three-pointers. He was also 13-for-15 (.867) from the free throw line. After netting 14 points with six assists in the Monday win at Canisius, Leach went off for a career-best 29 points in Fairfield's 76-67 win over previously-unbeaten Saint

Peter's. He also pulled down eight rebounds and dished out four assists against the Peacocks. Leach wrapped up the week on Sunday with 23 points, four assists and five steals in the 82-75 victory at Manhattan.

NOT TO BE OUTDONE

Two days after Goodine's 40-point game, Caleb Fields made headlines by tying the Fairfield program record with 10 three-pointers in the Stags' 82-61 win over Marist at Mahoney Arena. Fields, who netted a careerhigh 33 points in the game including the 1,000th of his career, was the sixth Division I player to hit 10 treys in a game this season and only the second to do so against a Division I opponent.

He tied the record set by Landon Taliaferro, who had 10 treys en route to 34 points in the Stags' upset win over Texas A&M on Dec. 1, 2019.

NOTABLE NETS

Fairfield owns one of the MAAC's strongest non-conference wins of the season, per the most recent NET rankings. The Stags hold a Quad 2 win at #82 Yale to go along with Canisius's Quad 1 win at #69 St. Bonaventure.

Including this year, Fairfield has gone 1-1 on the trip in nine seasons and earned the elusive sweep of the Purple Eagles and Golden Griffs on six occasions, most recently in the 2021-22 campaign. The Stags have come home on the short side of both ends of the Buffalo trip on 10 occasions.

STREAK STATS

Fairfield's eight-game winning streak was its first since 2010-11, when the Stags won 11 in a row. The Stags also won five consecutive road games during streak, matching a similar run from 2021-22. Fairfield's last six-game road winning streak came when the Stags won 13 in a row from 1985-87, including a perfect 12-0 in true road contests during the 1985-86 MAAC Championship season.

Brycen Goodine (40 pts. at Siena) and Caleb Fields (33 vs. Marist) posted back-to-back 30-point games for Fairfield for the first time since Marcus Gilbert had 32 points at UMES on Nov. 24, 2015 and went for 33 three days later in a win over Columbia.

The last time two different Stags had 30 in back-to-back games was in 1982, when Tony George netted 31 against Saint Joseph's (12/11/82) and Pete DeBisschop dropped 39 on Hofstra (12/18/82). DeBisschop had 30 points in the next game as well (12/21/82 at Boston College), which is the last time Fairfield had a 30-point scorer in three straight contests.

BRYCEN GOODINE: MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

On the heels of his historic 40-point performance on Jan. 5 at Siena, Brycen Goodine was named the MAAC Player of the Week. For the week as a whole, averaged 27.0 points in 29.5 minutes per game off the bench. Goodine's 40-point showing came on 13-for-18 shooting from the field, including an 8-for-12 outing from beyond the arc, and a 6-for-8 day at the free throw line.

In the Jan. 7 win over Marist, Goodine added 14 points on an efficient 5-for-8 shooting day to round out his week at 27.0 points per game firing at .692 (18-26) from the floor, .647 (11-17) from distance and .778 (7-9) at the free throw line.

A NEW YEAR'S NOTE

Fairfield began the calendar year against Siena for the second straight season. And Siena began its calendar year against Fairfield for the third straight year. The Jan. 5, 2024 win in Albany was Fairfield's first win in the first game of January since defeating Iona at Webster Bank Arena on Jan. 2, 2017.

CALEB FIELDS: MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

After netting a then-career-high 27 points in the Dec. 30 win over Le Moyne, Caleb Fields was named the MAAC Player of the Week for the first time as a Stag. Fields knocked down four three-pointers and canned all seven of his free throw attempts to fuel his 27-point day against Le Moyne. He also tallied five rebounds, four assists and three steals.

FIVE YEARS IN THE MAKING

Fields' 27 points on Dec. 30, 2023 surpassed his previous career high of 24 points established exactly five years prior on Dec. 30, 2018 at UT Martin in his freshman season at Bowling Green. He has since upped his career standard to 33 points as a part of his 10 three-pointer performance in the win over Marist on Jan. 7, 2024.

NON-CONFERENCE NOTABLES

Fairfield's 11-game non-conference schedule included members of eight different conferences. With the exception of the Division III Skyline Conference, the longest drought that the Stags ended this season was against the Atlantic Sun when they tangled with Queens on Nov. 18. Fairfield had not played an A-Sun opponent since meeting Jacksonville during the 2017-18 campaign.

WIRE-TO-WIRE

The Stags scored the first seven points of the Dec. 17 win over Wagner and maintained that lead for the duration of the 63-51 victory. The triumph marked Fairfield's first wire-to-wire win against a Division I opponent since a 73-53 win over Niagara on Feb. 12, 2022.

LOW SCORING WINS

The 63-51 win over Wagner marked Fairfield's lowest scoring total in a victory this season, surpassing the 67-57 triumph at Sacred Heart just eight days prior. Not coincidentally, Fairfield posted its two best defensive efforts against Division I competition in those back-to-back wins.

PLAYING FAVORITES

The Dec. 9 win at Sacred Heart marked the third straight road victory for Fairfield against a team that was tabbed by to win its conference in the preseason. The Stags dispatched MAAC preseason favorite Rider (88-81), Ivy League presumptive favorite Yale (75-71) and the NEC preseason #1 Pioneers (67-57).

HOME 'DOGS

Prior to Fairfield's Dec. 6 win at Yale, the Bulldogs had won 12 consecutive games against Connecticut opponents. The Stags' victory also concluded a 100-game stretch in which Yale owned an 83-17 record in games played at the John J. Lee Amphitheater.

PEYTON SMITH: MAAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

After scoring in double figures in all three games on the week of Nov. 13, Peyton Smith was selected as the MAAC Rookie of the Week. Smith averaged 13.0 points per game in the Stags' three contests against MSMC, Drexel and Queens, shooting .692 from the floor. The 6-10 freshman filled out his statline with 5.7 rebounds per contest.

STAGS VS. NEW ENGLAND

The Stags are 165-183 all-time against the current Division I basketball programs in New England. Fairfield has never lost to regional foes Dartmouth (4-0), Merrimack (4-0) and Sacred Heart (10-0). The only two Division I teams in New England that the Stags have never defeated both reside in the Ocean State. Fairfield is 0-6 against Rhode Island and has never played Bryant, which joined the Division I ranks in 2008.

INTERIM HEAD COACH CHRIS CASEY

FIRST SEASON • WESTERN CONN. '86

College basketball veteran Chris Casey was named the interim head coach of Fairfield University Men's Basketball prior to the 2023-24 season. Casey most recently served as an assistant with the Stags for the last four campaigns and previously led the programs at Niagara, LIU Post and Rutgers-Newark.

As a head coach, Casey was a part of the MAAC for six years at Niagara from 2013-19. His tenure in Western New York included a 19-win campaign in 2017-18 that saw the Purple Eagles finish 12-6 in the MAAC as the third-seeded team in the conference. He joined Niagara after a three-year stretch at LIU Post highlighted by back-to-back East Coast Conference Championships and NCAA postseason appearances. Casey's first head-coaching stop was at Division III

Rutgers-Newark from 1998-2001.

Casey's assistant coaching career began as a part of the first two Division I seasons in Central Connecticut State history from 1986-88. After a return to his alma mater Western Connecticut State for one season, he

reentered the Division I ranks with stops at St. Francis and Saint Peter's.

Following his stint as head coach at Rutgers-Newark, Casey rejoined the staff at CCSU from 2001-06. He was a part of the Blue Devils' 2002 NEC Championship squad and was recognized as an AFLAC National Assistant Coach of the Year in 2003. In 2006, he moved on to Norm Roberts' staff at St. John's for a four-year tenure that included a trip to the 2010 National Invitation Tournament.

Casey graduated from Western Connecticut State in 1986 with a degree in Business Administration. He earned a Master's in Education Administration from Central Connecticut State in 1993.
