THE OPENING TIP

Fairfield University Men's Basketball returns to Leo D. Mahoney Arena to host Siena on Sunday, Feb. 25 at 2 p.m. The Hall of Fame duo of Bob Heussler and Joe DeSantis '79 will call of the action for the Stags Sports Network live on ESPN+.

LAST TIME OUT

Twenty-six days after Fairfield was on the short side of a nail-biter with Quinnipiac, the Stags returned the favor in another in-state thriller. Jalen Leach led all scorers with 27 points as Fairfield earned its first win in Hamden since 2017 with an 85-81 victory over the league-leading Bobcats live on ESPNU.

Leach's 27 points accounted for his 10th 20-point effort of the year, seven of which have come against MAAC opponents. He was 8-for-13 from the field, including four three-pointers, and converted all seven of his free throw attempts.

Caleb Fields also had four three-pointers en route to 19 points. Fields became only the seventh Stag to ever drain 80 treys in a season, boosting his total to 81 on the year.

Five Stags netted double figures in total as Brycen Goodine sank three triples on his way to 13 points, Jasper Floyd netted 11 and Louis Bleechmore had 10. The performance marks the third time this season that five Stags reach double figures in a game.

As a unit, the Stags shot 28-for-61 (45.9%) from the floor, 13-for-26 (50%) from three-point range and 16-for-20 (80%) from the free throw line. Fields was the top facilitator to the scoring effort with five assists.

COACH CASEY ON THE QUINNIPIAC GAME

"I know I said this the last time we played, but that was a great college basketball game. I'm so happy for these guys. There's still a lot left to be done, but it's great to rise to the occasion on a big stage and get an important win."

THE MATCHUP

FAIRFIELD VS. SIENA

THE SIENA COLLEGE SAINTS

Siena has lost nine of its last 10 games to fall to 4-22 on the season with a 3-12 conference mark. The Saints are locked into a spot in the Tuesday play-in round of the upcoming MAAC Championship.

LAST MEETING

Fueled by a dazzling 40-point game for Brycen Goodine – only the fourth 40-point performance in Fairfield history – the Stags rolled to a 93-69 win at Siena on Jan. 5 in Albany. The victory marked the seventh straight for the Stags, who also got 19 points and seven rebounds from Jalen Leach.

Goodine's 40-point day came on 13-for-18 shooting from the field, including an 8-for-12 showing from three-point range, and a 6-for-8 game at the free throw line.

He matched the 40 points scored by Chris Rivers on Feb. 12, 2001 in a win over Canisius. George Groom had 41 points against Assumption on March 6, 1972, and the current program record belongs to Curtis Cobb with 46 points in a win at Manhattan on Jan. 5, 2017.

As a team, the Stags shot 32-for-55 (58.2%) from the floor sparked by a blistering 19-for-17 (70.4%) performance in the second half. The scoring was supplemented by nine points from James Johns Jr. – making his first start of the campaign – with Peyton Smith and Caleb Fields each adding seven. Birima Seck had four points, Louis Bleechmore added three and Matt Curtis had a pair to round out Fairfield's highest scoring game of the season.

In addition to Leach's team-high seven rebounds, Johns hauled in six and Fields nabbed four. Fields also had five of the Stags' 14 assists and swiped a career-best six steals as a part of Siena's 15 turnovers. Fairfield protected the ball to the tune of just seven turnovers.

The turning point of the game came midway through the first half, after the Stags had fallen behind, 20-13, with 9:55 left in the frame. Fairfield outscored the Saints by a 28-8 count for the remainder of the period, with Goodine accounting for 14 of those 28, to take a 41-28 lead into the locker room.

Siena only came within single digits once in the second half, with Leach promptly scoring on back-to-back possessions to quell the threat. Goodine tallied 26 of Fairfield's 52 points after halftime as the lead grew as large as 30 in the 93-69 win.

ALL-TIME SERIES

The Stags' win last month was their second straight in the series for the Saints, who hold a 47-34 lead all-time in a series that dates back to 1959. Fairfield's best run in the series came from 1995-98, winning seven of eight encounters.

Fairfield is vying for its first sweep of Siena since 2017-18 as well as three straight wins over the Saints for the first time in a decade.

TRENDING UPWARDS

At 17-10, Fairfield has recorded its most overall wins since going 17-16 en route to a MAAC Championship Game appearance in 2017-18. The Stags are 11-5 in the MAAC, their most conference wins since going 11-9 in the 2016-17 campaign.

SECOND TIME AROUND

Fairfield has completed six MAAC series to date with five of those series being a sweep in one direction or the other. The Stags swept the season series from Manhattan, Rider and Saint Peter's and were on the short side of both meetings with Iona and Niagara. The only split thus far has been with Quinnipiac, with the road team winning both encounters.

The Stags have swept three MAAC home-and-home series for the third straight season. The last time Fairfield swept four conference opponents in the regular season was in the 2016-17 campaign.

RAINING THREES...

Fairfield's 18 made three-pointers in the win over The Mount on Feb. 18 topped the mark of 17 attained twice in a 33-day span in 2015 at Maryland Eastern Shore and again six games later at Bucknell.

...POURING POINTS

Fueled by their record-setting performance from downtown, the Stags scored a season-best 94 points. The effort marked the most points scored in a game by Fairfield since a 110-55 win over Medgar Evers on Nov. 16, 2021 and the most against a Division I opponent since beating Quinnipiac, 102-98, in double overtime on Feb. 17, 2018. That season is also the last time the Stags scored 90-plus points in three MAAC games, topping 100 in the home wins over QU, Iona and Niagara.

WHAT'S THE SCENARIO?

Historically, 11 is the magic number to clinch a first-round bye in the MAAC Championship. No team with 11 or more conference wins (in a 20-game schedule) has ever slipped to the play-in round of the MAAC Championship. Teams that finished exactly 10-10 have snuck into the top five on two occasions, while three 10-10 squads have been left out (including one on a tiebreaker). This season could severely flip the percentages, as eight of 11 MAAC teams could finish with 10 or more victories.

At the top of the standings, 16 or more conference wins has guaranteed the top seed in six of seven seasons under a 20-game MAAC schedule, with 15 wins beginning sufficient in each of the last five campaigns.

STUFFING THE STATSHEET

Jasper Floyd is the only player in the MAAC to rank in the individual top 10 in assists per game (third, 4.5), steals per game (first, 2.44) and rebounds per game (ninth, 6.1).

Nationally, he is one of just four players averaging 10 points, six rebounds, four assists and two steals per game.

20s ALL AROUND

In the win over Rider on Feb. 8, Jalen Leach netted 22 points while Caleb Fields and Jasper Floyd each contributed 20. The last time a trio all hit the 20-point mark for the Stags was Jan. 4, 2016 when Marcus Gilbert scored 21 points while Tyler Nelson and Jerry Johnson Jr. each had 20 in a 97-85 win over Dartmouth at Alumni Hall.

THE LEX EXPRESS

Alexis Yetna made his Fairfield debut on Feb. 8 against the Broncs. He scored five points with one rebounds - the 700th of his collegiate career - while appearing in his first game since challenging TCU as a member of Seton Hall in the First Round of the NCAA Championship on March 18, 2022.

SEEING THEIR SHADOW

Fairfield's loss at Iona snapped a four-game winning streak for the Stags on Groundhog Day, Feb. 2. In the spirit of the day, all five times in program history that the Stags have played a repeat opponent on Groundhog Day, the result was the same as the meeting earlier than season.

JALEN LEACH: MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

After averaging 22.0 points per game in a 3-0 week, Jalen Leach was named the MAAC Player of the Week on Jan. 22. The senior added 3.7 rebounds and 4.7 assists per game in the Stags' trio of victories over Canisius, Saint Peter's and Manhattan.

Leach's 22.0 points per game came on 24-for-42 (.571) shooting from the floor, including five three-pointers. He was also 13-for-15 (.867) from the free throw line. After netting 14 points with six assists in the Monday win at Canisius, Leach went off for a career-best 29 points in Fairfield's 76-67 win over previously-unbeaten Saint

Peter's. He also pulled down eight rebounds and dished out four assists against the Peacocks. Leach wrapped up the week on Sunday with 23 points, four assists and five steals in the 82-75 victory at Manhattan.

40 FOR THE FOURTH TIME

Brycen Goodine's 40 points in the Jan. 5 win at Siena marked only the fourth 40-point game in Fairfield history. The feat came seven years to the day after Curtis Cobb's school-record 46 points at Manhattan.

FACTS, FIGURES AND MORE

NOT TO BE OUTDONE

Two days after Goodine's 40-point game, Caleb Fields made headlines by tying the Fairfield program record with 10 three-pointers in the Stags' 82-61 win over Marist at Mahoney Arena. Fields, who netted a career-high 33 points in the game including the 1,000th of his career, was the sixth Division I player to hit 10 treys in a game this season and only the second to do so against a Division I opponent.

He tied the record set by Landon Taliaferro, who had 10 treys en route to 34 points in the Stags' upset win over Texas A&M on Dec. 1, 2019.

NOTABLE NETS

Fairfield owns one of the MAAC's strongest non-conference wins of the season, per the most recent NET rankings. The Stags hold a Quad 2 win at #86 Yale to go along with Canisius's Quad 2 win at #78 St. Bonaventure.

TRUCKIN' UP TO BUFFALO

This season marked Fairfield's 25th proper version of the MAAC "Buffalo trip" – playing both Niagara and Canisius on the same visit to Western New York. Including this year, Fairfield has gone 1-1 on the trip in nine seasons and earned the elusive sweep of the Purple Eagles and Golden Griffs on six occasions, most recently in the 2021-22 campaign. The Stags have come home on the short side of both ends of the Buffalo trip on 10 occasions.

STREAK STATS

Fairfield's eight-game winning streak was its first since 2010-11, when the Stags won 11 in a row. The Stags also won five consecutive road games during streak, matching a similar run from 2021-22. Fairfield's last six-game road winning streak came when the Stags won 13 in a row from 1985-87, including a perfect 12-0 in true road contests during the 1985-86 MAAC Championship season.

Brycen Goodine (40 pts. at Siena) and Caleb Fields (33 vs. Marist) posted back-to-back 30-point games for Fairfield for the first time since Marcus Gilbert had 32 points at UMES on Nov. 24, 2015 and went for 33 three days later in a win over Columbia.

The last time two different Stags had 30 in back-to-back games was in 1982, when Tony George netted 31 against Saint Joseph's (12/11/82) and Pete DeBisschop dropped 39 on Hofstra (12/18/82). DeBisschop had 30 points in the next game as well (12/21/82 at Boston College), which is the last time Fairfield had a 30-point scorer in three straight contests.

BRYCEN GOODINE: MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

On the heels of his historic 40-point performance on Jan. 5 at Siena, Brycen Goodine was named the MAAC Player of the Week. For the week as a whole, averaged 27.0 points in 29.5 minutes per game off the bench. Goodine's 40-point showing came on 13-for-18 shooting from the field, including an 8-for-12 outing from beyond the arc, and a 6-for-8 day at the free throw line.

In the Jan. 7 win over Marist, Goodine added 14 points on an efficient 5-for-8 shooting day to round out his week at 27.0 points per game firing at .692 (18-26) from the floor, .647 (11-17) from distance and .778 (7-9) at the free throw line.

A NEW YEAR'S NOTE

Fairfield began the calendar year against Siena for the second straight season. And Siena began its calendar year against Fairfield for the third straight year. The Jan. 5, 2024 win in Albany was Fairfield's first win in the first game of January since defeating Iona at Webster Bank Arena on Jan. 2, 2017.

CALEB FIELDS: MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

After netting a then-career-high 27 points in the Dec. 30 win over Le Moyne, Caleb Fields was named the MAAC Player of the Week for the first time as a Stag. Fields knocked down four three-pointers and canned all seven of his free throw attempts to fuel his 27-point day against Le Moyne. He also tallied five rebounds, four assists and three steals.

FIVE YEARS IN THE MAKING

Fields' 27 points on Dec. 30, 2023 surpassed his previous career high of 24 points established exactly five years prior on Dec. 30, 2018 at UT Martin in his freshman season at Bowling Green. He has since upped his career standard to 33 points as a part of his 10 three-pointer performance in the win over Marist on Jan. 7, 2024.

NON-CONFERENCE NOTABLES

Fairfield's 11-game non-conference schedule included members of eight different conferences. With the exception of the Division III Skyline Conference, the longest drought that the Stags ended this season was against the Atlantic Sun when they tangled with Queens on Nov. 18. Fairfield had not played an A-Sun opponent since meeting Jacksonville during the 2017-18 campaign.

LOW SCORING WINS

The 63-51 win over Wagner marked Fairfield's lowest scoring total in a victory this season, surpassing the 67-57 triumph at Sacred Heart just eight days prior. Not coincidentally, Fairfield posted its two best defensive efforts against Division I competition in those back-to-back wins.

PLAYING FAVORITES

The Dec. 9 win at Sacred Heart marked the third straight road victory for Fairfield against a team that was tabbed by to win its conference in the preseason. The Stags dispatched MAAC preseason favorite Rider (88-81), Ivy League presumptive favorite Yale (75-71) and the NEC preseason #1 Pioneers (67-57).

HOME 'DOGS

Prior to Fairfield's Dec. 6 win at Yale, the Bulldogs had won 12 consecutive games against Connecticut opponents. The Stags' victory also concluded a 100-game stretch in which Yale owned an 83-17 record in games played at the John J. Lee Amphitheater.

PEYTON SMITH: MAAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

After scoring in double figures in all three games on the week of Nov. 13, Peyton Smith was selected as the MAAC Rookie of the Week. Smith averaged 13.0 points per game in the Stags' three contests against MSMC, Drexel and Queens, shooting .692 from the floor. The 6-10 freshman filled out his statline with 5.7 rebounds per contest.

STAGS VS. NEW ENGLAND

The Stags are 166-183 all-time against the current Division I basketball programs in New England. Fairfield has never lost to regional foes Dartmouth (4-0), Merrimack (4-0) and Sacred Heart (10-0). The only two Division I teams in New England that the Stags have never defeated both reside in the Ocean State. Fairfield is 0-6 against Rhode Island and has never played Bryant, which joined the Division I ranks in 2008.

INTERIM HEAD COACH CHRIS CASEY

FIRST SEASON • WESTERN CONN. '86

College basketball veteran Chris Casey was named the interim head coach of Fairfield University Men's Basketball prior to the 2023-24 season. Casey most recently served as an assistant with the Stags for the last four campaigns and previously led the programs at Niagara, LIU Post and Rutgers-Newark.

As a head coach, Casey was a part of the MAAC for six years at Niagara from 2013-19. His tenure in Western New York included a 19-win campaign in 2017-18 that saw the Purple Eagles finish 12-6 in the MAAC as the third-seeded team in the conference. He joined Niagara after a three-year stretch at LIU Post highlighted by back-to-back East Coast Conference Championships and NCAA postseason appearances. Casey's first head-coaching stop was at Division III

Rutgers-Newark from 1998-2001.

Casey's assistant coaching career began as a part of the first two Division I seasons in Central Connecticut State history from 1986-88. After a return to his alma mater Western Connecticut State for one season, he reentered the Division I ranks with stops at St. Francis and Saint Peter's.

Following his stint as head coach at Rutgers-Newark, Casey rejoined the staff at CCSU from 2001-06. He was a part of the Blue Devils' 2002 NEC Championship squad and was recognized as an AFLAC National Assistant Coach of the Year in 2003. In 2006, he moved on to Norm Roberts' staff at St. John's for a four-year tenure that included a trip to the 2010 National Invitation Tournament.

Casey graduated from Western Connecticut State in 1986 with a degree in Business Administration. He earned a Master's in Education Administration from Central Connecticut State in 1993.
