THE OPENING TIP

For the second straight Friday, Fairfield University Men's Basketball takes to the national airwaves on ESPNU. The Stags travel to Poughkeepsie to challenge Marist at 7 p.m. on Friday, March 1 with Robert Lee and Tim Welsh calling the action.

LAST TIME OUT

A season-best, sold-out crowd of 3,561 fans was on hand at Leo D. Mahoney Arena on Sunday as Fairfield turned an eight-point halftime lead into a convincing 88-64 win over visiting Siena. Jalen Leach led the scoring effort with 21 points as 11 Stags contributed to the final point total.

Leach's 21-point performance follows a 27-point effort in Friday's win at Quinnipiac. The senior guard has reached the 20-point plateau in 11 contests this season, including eight of Fairfield's 17 MAAC games to date. He was also one rebound shy of a double-double with a career-best nine boards.

Brycen Goodine, who torched Siena for 40 points at MVP Arena on Jan. 5, canned three three-pointers on his way to a 15-point performance. Caleb Field had four treys en route to 14 points, and Louis Bleechmore was just short of double figures with nine. Also in the post, Peyton Smith chipped in eight points.

Jasper Floyd scored six points and stuffed the statsheet with five rebounds, seven assists and four steals. He is only the second Stag in program history with 70 steals in a season, four short of the record 74 thefts amassed by Kyle Commodore in the 1998-99 campaign.

Matt Curtis added five points, Alexis Yetna scored four and a trio of Stags each netted two points – Birima Seck, James Johns Jr. and Luke Davidson.

COACH CASEY ON THE SIENA GAME

"In the first half, Siena did a good job of slowing us down. But we were able to push the pace more after halftime, and we're in a situation where we have more guys than they do right now, and that helped us pull away. I thought we played great basketball in the second half."

THE MATCHUP

FAIRFIELD VS. MARIST

THE MARIST COLLEGE RED FOXES

Siena has lost nine of its last 10 games to fall to 4-22 on the season with a 3-12 conference mark. The Saints are locked into a spot in the Tuesday play-in round of the upcoming MAAC Championship.

LAST MEETING

The 1,000th point of his career was just the beginning of Caleb Fields' historic afternoon on Jan. 7 at Mahoney Arena. The graduate student tied the Fairfield record with 10 three-pointers en route to a career-best 33 points as the Stags knocked off visiting Marist, 82-61, for their eighth consecutive victory.

Fields' 10 three-pointers matched the 10 triples drained by Landon Taliaferro in the Stags' upset of Texas A&M on Dec. 1, 2019. Both Fields and Taliaferro shot 10-for-18 from distance in their historic outings.

In addition to 33 points for Fields, Brycen Goodine followed up his 40-point game on Jan. 5 with 14 off the bench of 5-for-8 shooting, including three three-pointers. Eight Stags contributed to the scoring, with Jalen Leach and Louis Bleechmore each scoring eight points. Jasper Floyd had seven, Peyton Smith added six, James Johns Jr. scored four and Birima Seck netted two.

Floyd was Fairfield's top facilitator with four assists, and the trio of Fields, Goodine and Leach dropped three dimes apiece. The Stags' assisted on 17 of their 28 field goals.

The rebound effort was also a balanced performance led by six apiece for Bleechmore, Floyd and Smith as the Stags earned a 36-32 edge on the glass.

Defensively, the Stags had nine steals while pressuring the Red Foxes into 18 turnovers.

Marist was led by 15 points, five rebounds and seven assists from Jadin Collins. Javon Cooley added 10 points for the Red Foxes.

ALL-TIME SERIES

Currently riding a four-game winning streak over Marist, Fairfield owns a 43-27 lead in an all-time series that dates back to Jan. 23, 1984. Last season's sweep ended a streak in which the Stags and Red Foxes had split the home-and-home in three straight campaign.

The Stags' last winning streak of longer than four games over Marist was stretch of eight in a row from 2009-2013.

TRENDING UPWARDS

At 18-10 overall and 12-5 in the MAAC, Fairfield has recorded its most overall and most conference wins since recording a 19-14 campaign with a 12-8 MAAC record in the 2015-16 campaign.

SECOND TIME AROUND

Fairfield has completed seven MAAC series to date with six of those series being a sweep in one direction or the other. The Stags swept the season series from Manhattan, Rider and Saint Peter's and were on the short side of both meetings with Iona and Niagara. The only split thus far has been with Quinnipiac, with the road team winning both encounters.

The Stags have swept four MAAC home-and-home series for the first time since the 2016-17 campaign. Fairfield has not swept five or more MAAC opponents since the 2010-11 Stags broke out the brooms six times en route to a 15-3 mark and a MAAC Regular Season Championship.

WHAT'S THE SCENARIO?

Historically, 11 is the magic number to clinch a first-round bye in the MAAC Championship. No team with 11 or more conference wins (in a 20-game schedule) has ever slipped to the play-in round of the MAAC Championship. Teams that finished exactly 10-10 have snuck into the top five on two occasions, while three 10-10 squads have been left out (including one on a tiebreaker). This season could finish counter to those percentages, however, as eight of 11 MAAC teams are eligible to finish with 10 or more victories.

At the top of the standings, 16 or more conference wins has guaranteed the top seed in six of seven seasons under a 20-game MAAC schedule, with 15 wins beginning sufficient in each of the last five campaigns. Fairfield and Quinnipiac could still finish with 15 conference victories, with Saint Peter's, Marist and Niagara all alive to finish with 14.

JALEN LEACH: TWO-TIME MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

With 24.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game in the recent wins over Quinnipiac and Siena, Jalen Leach collected MAAC Player of the Week honors for the second time this season. Leach hit the 20-point mark in both games with 27 and 21 tallies, respectively. He has scored 20 or more points 11 times this season, including in eight of 17 MAAC contests.

Earlier this season, Leach averaged 22.0 points per game in a 3-0 week to garner Player of the Week laurels from the conference for the first time in his career.

RAINING THREES...

Fairfield's 18 made three-pointers in the win over The Mount on Feb. 18 topped the mark of 17 attained twice in a 33-day span in 2015 at Maryland Eastern Shore and again six games later at Bucknell.

...POURING POINTS

Fueled by their record-setting performance from downtown, the Stags scored a season-best 94 points. The effort marked the most points scored in a game by Fairfield since a 110-55 win over Medgar Evers on Nov. 16, 2021 and the most against a Division I opponent since beating Quinnipiac, 102-98, on Feb. 17, 2018.

20s ALL AROUND

In the win over Rider on Feb. 8, Jalen Leach netted 22 points while Caleb Fields and Jasper Floyd each contributed 20. The last time a trio all hit the 20-point mark for the Stags was Jan. 4, 2016 when Marcus Gilbert scored 21 points while Tyler Nelson and Jerry Johnson Jr. each had 20 in a 97-85 win over Dartmouth.

THE LEX EXPRESS

Alexis Yetna made his Fairfield debut on Feb. 8 against the Broncs. He scored five points with one rebound in his first game since challenging TCU as a member of Seton Hall in the First Round of the NCAA Championship on March 18, 2022.

SEEING THEIR SHADOW

Fairfield's loss at Iona snapped a four-game winning streak for the Stags on Groundhog Day, Feb. 2. In the spirit of the day, all five times that the Stags have played a repeat opponent on Groundhog Day, the result was the same as the meeting earlier than season.

40 FOR THE FOURTH TIME

Brycen Goodine's 40 points in the Jan. 5 win at Siena marked only the fourth 40-point game in Fairfield history. The feat came seven years to the day after Curtis Cobb's school-record 46 points at Manhattan.

NOT TO BE OUTDONE

Two days after Goodine's 40-point game, Caleb Fields made headlines by tying the Fairfield program record with 10 three-pointers in the Stags' 82-61 win over Marist at Mahoney Arena. Fields, who netted a career-high 33 points in the game including the 1,000th of his career, was the sixth Division I player to hit 10 treys in a game this season and only the second to do so against a Division I opponent.

He tied the record set by Landon Taliaferro, who had 10 treys en route to 34 points in the Stags' upset win over Texas A&M on Dec. 1, 2019.

STUFFING THE STATSHEET

Jasper Floyd is the only player in the MAAC to rank in the individual top 10 in assists per game (third, 4.6), steals per game (first, 2.50) and rebounds per game (eighth, 6.1).

FACTS, FIGURES AND MORE

NOTABLE NETS

Fairfield owns one of the MAAC's strongest non-conference wins of the season, per the most recent NET rankings. The Stags hold a Quad 2 win at #84 Yale to go along with Canisius's Quad 1 win at #67 St. Bonaventure.

Fairfield's NET of 159 currently tops the MAAC.

TRUCKIN' UP TO BUFFALO

This season marked Fairfield's 25th proper version of the MAAC "Buffalo trip" – playing both Niagara and Canisius on the same visit to Western New York. Including this year, Fairfield has gone 1-1 on the trip in nine seasons and earned the elusive sweep of the Purple Eagles and Golden Griffins on six occasions, most recently in the 2021-22 campaign. The Stags have come home on the short side of both ends of the Buffalo trip on 10 occasions.

STREAK STATS

Fairfield's eight-game winning streak was its first since 2010-11, when the Stags won 11 in a row. The Stags also won five consecutive road games during streak, matching a similar run from 2021-22. Fairfield's last six-game road winning streak came when the Stags won 13 in a row from 1985-87, including a perfect 12-0 in true road contests during the 1985-86 MAAC Championship season.

Brycen Goodine (40 pts. at Siena) and Caleb Fields (33 vs. Marist) posted back-to-back 30-point games for Fairfield for the first time since Marcus Gilbert had 32 points at UMES on Nov. 24, 2015 and went for 33 three days later in a win over Columbia.

The last time two different Stags had 30 in back-to-back games was in 1982, when Tony George netted 31 against Saint Joseph's (12/11/82) and Pete DeBisschop dropped 39 on Hofstra (12/18/82). DeBisschop had 30 points in the next game as well (12/21/82 at Boston College), which is the last time Fairfield had a 30-point scorer in three straight contests.

BRYCEN GOODINE: MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

On the heels of his historic 40-point performance on Jan. 5 at Siena, Brycen Goodine was named the MAAC Player of the Week. For the week as a whole, averaged 27.0 points in 29.5 minutes per game off the bench. Goodine's 40-point showing came on 13-for-18 shooting from the field, including an 8-for-12 outing from beyond the arc, and a 6-for-8 day at the free throw line.

In the Jan. 7 win over Marist, Goodine added 14 points on an efficient 5-for-8 shooting day to round out his week at 27.0 points per game, firing at .692 (18-26) from the floor, .647 (11-17) from three-point range and .778 (7-9) at the free throw line.

A NEW YEAR'S NOTE

Fairfield began the calendar year against Siena for the second straight season. And Siena began its calendar year against Fairfield for the third straight year. The Jan. 5, 2024 win in Albany was Fairfield's first win in the first game of January since defeating Iona at Webster Bank Arena on Jan. 2, 2017.

CALEB FIELDS: MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

After netting a then-career-high 27 points in the Dec. 30 win over Le Moyne, Caleb Fields was named the MAAC Player of the Week for the first time as a Stag. Fields knocked down four three-pointers and canned all seven of his free throw attempts to fuel his 27-point day against Le Moyne. He also tallied five rebounds, four assists and three steals.

FIVE YEARS IN THE MAKING

Fields' 27 points on Dec. 30, 2023 surpassed his previous career high of 24 points established exactly five years prior on Dec. 30, 2018 at UT Martin in his freshman season at Bowling Green. He has since upped his career standard to 33 points as a part of his 10 three-pointer performance in the win over Marist on Jan. 7, 2024.

NON-CONFERENCE NOTABLES

Fairfield's 11-game non-conference schedule included members of eight different conferences. With the exception of the Division III Skyline Conference, the longest drought that the Stags ended this season was against the Atlantic Sun when they tangled with Queens on Nov. 18. Fairfield had not played an A-Sun opponent since meeting Jacksonville during the 2017-18 campaign.

LOW SCORING WINS

The 63-51 win over Wagner marked Fairfield's lowest scoring total in a victory this season, surpassing the 67-57 triumph at Sacred Heart just eight days prior. Not coincidentally, Fairfield posted its two best defensive efforts against Division I competition in those back-to-back wins.

PLAYING FAVORITES

The Dec. 9 win at Sacred Heart marked the third straight road victory for Fairfield against a team that was tabbed by to win its conference in the preseason. The Stags dispatched MAAC preseason favorite Rider (88-81), Ivy League presumptive favorite Yale (75-71) and the NEC preseason #1 Pioneers (67-57).

HOME 'DOGS

Prior to Fairfield's Dec. 6 win at Yale, the Bulldogs had won 12 consecutive games against Connecticut opponents. The Stags' victory also concluded a 100-game stretch in which Yale owned an 83-17 record in games played at the John J. Lee Amphitheater.

PEYTON SMITH: MAAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

After scoring in double figures in all three games on the week of Nov. 13, Peyton Smith was selected as the MAAC Rookie of the Week. Smith averaged 13.0 points per game in the Stags' three contests against MSMC, Drexel and Queens, shooting .692 from the floor. The 6-10 freshman filled out his statline with 5.7 rebounds per contest.

STAGS VS. NEW ENGLAND

The Stags are 166-183 all-time against the current Division I basketball programs in New England. Fairfield has never lost to regional foes Dartmouth (4-0), Merrimack (4-0) and Sacred Heart (10-0). The only two Division I teams in New England that the Stags have never defeated both reside in the Ocean State. Fairfield is 0-6 against Rhode Island and has never played Bryant, which joined the Division I ranks in 2008.

INTERIM HEAD COACH CHRIS CASEY

FIRST SEASON • WESTERN CONN. '86

College basketball veteran Chris Casey was named the interim head coach of Fairfield University Men's Basketball prior to the 2023-24 season. Casey most recently served as an assistant with the Stags for the last four campaigns and previously led the programs at Niagara, LIU Post and Rutgers-Newark.

As a head coach, Casey was a part of the MAAC for six years at Niagara from 2013-19. His tenure in Western New York included a 19-win campaign in 2017-18 that saw the Purple Eagles finish 12-6 in the MAAC as the third-seeded team in the conference. He joined Niagara after a three-year stretch at LIU Post highlighted by back-to-back East Coast Conference Championships and NCAA postseason appearances. Casey's first head-coaching stop was at Division III

Rutgers-Newark from 1998-2001.

Casey's assistant coaching career began as a part of the first two Division I seasons in Central Connecticut State history from 1986-88. After a return to his alma mater Western Connecticut State for one season, he reentered the Division I ranks with stops at St. Francis and Saint Peter's.

Following his stint as head coach at Rutgers-Newark, Casey rejoined the staff at CCSU from 2001-06. He was a part of the Blue Devils' 2002 NEC Championship squad and was recognized as an AFLAC National Assistant Coach of the Year in 2003. In 2006, he moved on to Norm Roberts' staff at St. John's for a four-year tenure that included a trip to the 2010 National Invitation Tournament.

Casey graduated from Western Connecticut State in 1986 with a degree in Business Administration. He earned a Master's in Education Administration from Central Connecticut State in 1993.
