#### THE OPENING TIP

Fairfield University Men's Basketball concludes the regular season on Saturday, March 9 at Mount St. Mary's. Opening tip-off from Emmitsburg is set for 4 p.m.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

Brycen Goodine put on a show for a national television audience, lighting up ESPNU and visiting Canisius for 37 points as Fairfield recorded a Senior Night win at Leo D. Mahoney Arena, 74-62. Caleb Fields added 17 points in the Stags' 19th win of the season.

Goodine's 37 points came on 14-for-19 shooting, including seven three-pointers. Coupled with his 40-point outburst on Jan. 5 at Siena, Goodine joins George Groom as the only two Stags to net 37 or more points twice in a career.

Goodine has seven of Fairfield's 10 three-pointers in addition to two from Fields on his way to 17 points. Fields has converted 91 treys this season, moving into third on Fairfield's single-season list behind Tyler Nelson's 104 and Ferron Flavors' 95 triples, both in the 2017-18 campaign.

Jalen Leach added eight points and played facilitator for the Stags with seven assists and no turnovers. Louis Bleechmore pitched in four points and five boards, and the quartet of Jasper Floyd, Peyton Smith, Alexis Yetna and James Johns Jr. netted two apiece.

#### **COACH CASEY ON THE CANISIUS GAME**

"It was great to get one for our seniors and close out our second year at Mahoney Arena win a home win. It wasn't perfect, but I'm happy with our effort and our intensity, and I thought those things carried us through the parts of the game where our execution dipped a bit. And when everything came together and we were moving the ball and executing on both ends of the floor, we looked like the team that we are capable of being. That consistency in all facets of the game and working to play to our potential for a full 40 minutes will be our focus as we prepare for a tough road trip to The Mount."

### THE MATCHUP

### FAIRFIELD VS. THE MOUNT

#### THE MOUNT ST. MARY'S UNIVERSITY MOUNTAINEERS

The Mount is 2-2 since last meeting the Stags, most recently knocking off Niagara, 91-72, in Western New York on March 3. At 9-10 in MAAC play, The Mount is locked into a spot in Tuesday's opening round of the MAAC Championship.

#### **LAST MEETING**

A program-record 18 three-pointers guided Fairfield to a 94-80 win over visiting Mount St. Mary's on Feb. 18 at Leo D. Mahoney Arena. Caleb Fields accounted for seven of those triples on his way to a game-best 26 points as the Stags netted a season-best 94 points in the triumph.

The 18 made three-pointers topped the mark of 17 attained twice in a 33-day span in 2015 at Maryland Eastern Shore and again six games later at Bucknell. At 18-for-36, the Stags shot .500 or better from three-point range for the fourth time this season.

Brycen Goodine added a 6-for-8 day from three-point range on his way to 20 points in 18 minutes off the bench. Jasper Floyd scored 16 points and just missed a double-double with a game-high nine rebounds as well as five assists and two steals. Jalen Leach was the fourth Stag in double figures with 14 points, four rebounds and a game-high six assists.

Alexis Yetna continued his comeback to the rotation with eight points and seven rebounds, Louis Bleechmore chipped six points and Birima Seck closed out the scoring with four points to go along with four rebounds and a block.

Led by Floyd's nine rebounds, the Stags held a 38-32 advantage on the glass. Fairfield also doubled-up The Mount in the turnover battle, committing seven while forcing 14 giveaways. The Stags converted those miscues into 26 points, fueling their race to 20 fast break points.

Mount St. Mary's was led by 25 points from freshman standout De'Shayne Montgomery.

### **ALL-TIME SERIES**

Prior to The Mount joining the MAAC last season, Fairfield had challenged them just once before. The 80-68 win for Mount St. Mary's on Jan. 3, 1949 was only the eighth game in the Stags' varsity history, occurring two months after incumbent Harry S Truman was re-elected President of the United States. Per the Mount St. Mary's student newspaper, the game was a home contest for the Mount despite being played in Danbury, Conn.

#### **TRENDING UPWARDS**

At 19-11 overall and 13-6 in the MAAC, Fairfield has recorded its most overall wins since recording a 19-14 campaign in the 2015-16 campaign. Fairfield's last 20-win since was a 22-15 campaign in 2011-12. Regardless of Saturday's result, the Stags will have posted their most conference wins since a 15-3 performance en route to the MAAC Regular Season Championship in 2010-11.

#### **SECOND TIME AROUND**

Fairfield has completed nine of its 10 MAAC series to date with seven of those series wrapping up as a sweep in one direction or the other. The Stags swept the season series from Manhattan, Rider, Saint Peter's, Siena and Canisius and were on the short side of both meetings with Iona and Niagara. The only splits thus far has been with Quinnipiac and Marist. The Stags have swept five MAAC home-and-home series for the first time since the 2010-11 Stags broke out the brooms six times en route to a 15-3 mark and a MAAC Regular Season Championship.

#### WHAT'S THE SCENARIO?

Fairfield sits in second place in the MAAC standings with one game remaining and can finish no lower than second. The Stags would move into first place with a win coupled with a Quinnipiac loss to Saint Peter's, which would also stake Fairfield to a share of its first MAAC Regular Season Championship since 2010-11.

#### **BG = BUCKETS GALORE**

With 37 points in Thursday's win over Canisius, Brycen Goodine owns the MAAC's two highest-scoring games of the season, having previously scored 40 points in the Jan. 5 at Siena. A few more notes on BG getting buckets:

- Goodine is the only player in the nation with **TWO** games score 37 or more points while attempting fewer than 20 field goals.
- His 7-for-11 showing from three-point range against the Griffs moved him into second in the nation at .490 from distance.
- Goodine and the legendary George Groom are the only two Fairfield players to score 37 or more points twice as a Stag.

# JALEN LEACH: TWO-TIME MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

With 24.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game in the recent wins over Quinnipiac and Siena, Jalen Leach collected MAAC Player of the Week honors for the second time this season. Leach hit the 20-point mark in both games with 27 and 21 tallies, respectively. He has scored 20 or more points 11 times this season, including in eight of 17 MAAC contests.

Earlier this season, Leach averaged 22.0 points per game in a 3-0 week to garner Player of the Week laurels from the conference for the first time in his career.

#### **RAINING THREES...**

Fairfield's 18 made three-pointers in the win over The Mount on Feb. 18 topped the mark of 17 attained twice in a 33-day span in 2015 at Maryland Eastern Shore and again six games later at Bucknell.

### ...POURING POINTS

Fueled by their record-setting performance from downtown, the Stags scored a season-best 94 points. The effort marked the most points scored in a game by Fairfield since a 110-55 win over Medgar Evers on Nov. 16, 2021 and the most against a Division I opponent since beating Quinnipiac, 102-98, on Feb. 17, 2018.

#### **20s ALL AROUND**

In the win over Rider on Feb. 8, Jalen Leach netted 22 points while Caleb Fields and Jasper Floyd each contributed 20. The last time a trio all hit the 20-point mark for the Stags was Jan. 4, 2016 when Marcus Gilbert scored 21 points while Tyler Nelson and Jerry Johnson Jr. each had 20 in a 97-85 win over Dartmouth.

### THE LEX EXPRESS

Alexis Yetna made his Fairfield debut on Feb. 8 against the Broncs. He scored five points with one rebound in his first game since challenging TCU as a member of Seton Hall in the First Round of the NCAA Championship on March 18, 2022.

Two days after Goodine's 40-point game, Caleb Fields made headlines by tying the Fairfield program record with 10 three-pointers in the Stags' 82-61 win over Marist at Mahoney Arena. Fields, who netted a career-high 33 points in the game including the 1,000th of his career, was the sixth Division I player to hit 10 treys in a game this season and only the second to do so against a Division I opponent. He tied the record set by Landon Taliaferro, who had 10 treys en route to 34 points in the Stags' upset win over Texas A&M on Dec. 1, 2019.

### **FACTS, FIGURES AND MORE**

#### STUFFING THE STATSHEET

Jasper Floyd is the only player in the MAAC to rank in the individual top 10 in assists per game (third, 4.6), steals per game (first, 2.50) and rebounds per game (eighth, 6.1).

#### **NOTABLE NETS**

Fairfield owns one of the MAAC's strongest non-conference wins of the season, per the most recent NET rankings. The Stags hold a Quad 2 win at #81 Yale to go along with Canisius's Quad 1 win at #75 St. Bonaventure. Fairfield's NET of 161 currently tops the MAAC.

#### TRUCKIN' UP TO BUFFALO

This season marked Fairfield's 25th proper version of the MAAC "Buffalo trip" – playing both Niagara and Canisius on the same visit to Western New York. Including this year,

Fairfield has gone 1-1 on the trip in nine seasons and earned the elusive sweep of the Purple Eagles and Golden Griffs on six occasions, most recently in the 2021-22 campaign. The Stags have come home on the short side of both ends of the Buffalo trip on 10 occasions.

#### STREAK STATS

Fairfield's eight-game winning streak was its first since 2010-11, when the Stags won 11 in a row. The Stags also won five consecutive road games during streak, matching a similar run from 2021-22.

Fairfield's last six-game road winning streak came when the Stags won 13 in a row from 1985-87, including a perfect 12-0 in true road contests during the 1985-86 MAAC Championship season.

#### -- 30 --

Brycen Goodine (40 pts. at Siena) and Caleb Fields (33 vs. Marist) posted back-to-back 30-point games for Fairfield for the first time since Marcus Gilbert had 32 points at UMES on Nov. 24, 2015 and went for 33 three days later in a win over Columbia.

The last time two different Stags had 30 in back-to-back games was in 1982, when Tony George netted 31 against Saint Joseph's (12/11/82) and Pete DeBisschop dropped 39 on Hofstra (12/18/82). DeBisschop had 30 points in the next game as well (12/21/82 at Boston College), which is the last time Fairfield had a 30-point scorer in three straight contests.

### **BRYCEN GOODINE: MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

On the heels of his historic 40-point performance on Jan. 5 at Siena, Brycen Goodine was named the MAAC Player of the Week. For the week as a whole, averaged 27.0 points in 29.5 minutes per game off the bench. Goodine's 40-point showing came on 13-for-18 shooting from the field, including an 8-for-12 outing from beyond the arc, and a 6-for-8 day at the free throw line.

In the Jan. 7 win over Marist, Goodine added 14 points on an efficient 5-for-8 shooting day to round out his week at 27.0 points per game, firing at .692 (18-26) from the floor, .647 (11-17) from three-point range and .778 (7-9) at the free throw line.

### **CALEB FIELDS: MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

After netting a then-career-high 27 points in the Dec. 30 win over Le Moyne, Caleb Fields was named the MAAC Player of the Week for the first time as a Stag. Fields knocked down four three-pointers and canned all seven of his free throw attempts to fuel his 27-point day against Le Moyne. He also tallied five rebounds, four assists and three steals in the victory.

#### **FIVE YEARS IN THE MAKING**

Fields' 27 points on Dec. 30, 2023 surpassed his previous career high of 24 points established exactly five years prior on Dec. 30, 2018 at UT Martin in his freshman season at Bowling Green. He has since upped his career standard to 33 points as a part of his 10 three-pointer performance in the win over Marist on Jan. 7, 2024.

### **NON-CONFERENCE NOTABLES**

Fairfield's 11-game non-conference schedule included members of eight different conferences. With the exception of the Division III Skyline Conference, the longest drought that the Stags ended this season was against the Atlantic Sun when they tangled with Queens on Nov. 18. Fairfield had not played an A-Sun opponent since meeting Jacksonville during the 2017-18 campaign.

#### **LOW SCORING WINS**

The 63-51 win over Wagner marked Fairfield's lowest scoring total in a victory this season, surpassing the 67-57 triumph at Sacred Heart just eight days prior. Not coincidentally, Fairfield posted its two best defensive efforts against Division I competition in those back-to-back wins.

#### **PLAYING FAVORITES**

The Dec. 9 win at Sacred Heart marked the third straight road victory for Fairfield against a team that was tabbed by to win its conference in the preseason. The Stags dispatched MAAC preseason favorite Rider (88-81), Ivy League presumptive favorite Yale (75-71) and the NEC preseason #1 Pioneers (67-57).

### **HOME 'DOGS**

Prior to Fairfield's Dec. 6 win at Yale, the Bulldogs had won 12 consecutive games against Connecticut opponents. The Stags' victory also concluded a 100-game stretch in which Yale owned an 83-17 record in games played at the John J. Lee Amphitheater.

### PEYTON SMITH: MAAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

After scoring in double figures in all three games on the week of Nov. 13, Peyton Smith was selected as the MAAC Rookie of the Week. Smith averaged 13.0 points per game in the Stags' three contests against MSMC, Drexel and Queens, shooting .692 from the floor. The 6-10 freshman filled out his statline with 5.7 rebounds per contest.

#### **STAGS VS. NEW ENGLAND**

The Stags are 166-183 all-time against the current Division I basketball programs in New England. Fairfield has never lost to regional foes Dartmouth (4-0), Merrimack (4-0) and Sacred Heart (10-0). The only two Division I teams in New England that the Stags have never defeated both reside in the Ocean State. Fairfield is 0-6 against Rhode Island and has never played Bryant, which joined the Division I ranks in 2008.

# INTERIM HEAD COACH CHRIS CASEY

FIRST SEASON • WESTERN CONN. '86

College basketball veteran Chris Casey was named the interim head coach of Fairfield University Men's Basketball prior to the 2023-24 season. Casey most recently served as an assistant with the Stags for the last four campaigns and previously led the programs at Niagara, LIU Post and Rutgers-Newark.

As a head coach, Casey was a part of the MAAC for six years at Niagara from 2013-19. His tenure in Western New York included a 19-win campaign in 2017-18 that saw the Purple Eagles finish 12-6 in the MAAC as the third-seeded team in the conference. He joined Niagara after a three-year stretch at LIU Post highlighted by back-to-back East Coast Conference Championships and NCAA postseason appearances. Casey's first head-coaching stop was at Division III

Rutgers-Newark from 1998-2001.

Casey's assistant coaching career began as a part of the first two Division I seasons in Central Connecticut State history from 1986-88. After a return to his alma mater Western Connecticut State for one season, he reentered the Division I ranks with stops at St. Francis

and Saint Peter's.

Following his stint as head coach at Rutgers-Newark, Casey rejoined the staff at CCSU from 2001-06. He was a part of the Blue Devils' 2002 NEC Championship squad and was recognized as an AFLAC National Assistant Coach of the Year in 2003. In 2006, he moved on to Norm Roberts' staff at St. John's for a four-year tenure that included a trip to the 2010 National Invitation Tournament.

Casey graduated from Western Connecticut State in 1986 with a degree in Business Administration. He earned a Master's in Education Administration from Central Connecticut State in 1993.
