Florida A&M returns to Moore-Kittles Field to face Troy as they begin a nine-game home stand after being swept on the road by MEAC foe North Carolina Central this past weekend. The Rattlers enter Wednesday's contest having lost eight straight since starting the season 7-7. FAMU's offense went cold over the weekend as they only managed two runs in the three-game series in Durham. The Trojans are 4-11 in their last 15 games and fell 8-1 to Jacksonville State on Tuesday night. Troy is led by Senior 1B Trevin Hall who leads Troy in batting average (.384), hits (33), doubles (6) and home runs (3). Troy's pitching staff comes in with a 4.51 ERA and a 2/1 strikeout to walk ratio with 142 strikeouts and 73 walks on the year.

### Marlon Gibbs Heating Up

LF Marlon Gibbs recorded a hit in 10 of 11 games leading up to the series at NC Central (3/21-22) and hit .478 over that span. Gibbs raised his season batting average from .280 to .382 in the last six games of those 11 games and was named MEAC Player of the Week on March 16. In those six games, Gibbs recorded three hits in four different games and multi-hits in five of the six games.

### Pounding the Bears

AJ Elkins and Marlon Gibbs have had a lot of success this season in the matchup against the Mercer Bears. In the three games against Mercer, Elkins is batting .625 (5-8) with a double, four runs scored and a .750 SLG%. Marlon Gibbs is hitting .500 (7-14) with a double, four runs scored and eight RBI.

### Have Yourself A Week Jared Walker

Jamey Shouppe enters his second season at the helm of the Florida A&M baseball program after earning 2014 MEAC Coach of the Year honors in his first season.

The Rattlers 26-26 record in 2014 was the first time FAMU finished the regular season with a .500 or better record since 2003. Florida A&M closed out the regular season on a season-high five-game winning streak and won 11 straight games decided by one run. The 26 wins on the year were the most since the Rattlers won 24 in 2009. Florida A&M won a program best 14 games in the MEAC and finished in a first place tie in the Southern Division with Bethune-Cookman. The 14 conference wins is just the third time in program history with double digit MEAC wins.

One of the biggest highlights of Shouppe's first season was a 4-3 win over then No. 6 Florida in Gainesville, arguably the biggest win for the MEAC in 2014. The win marked the first over the Gators in the history of the Florida A&M baseball program. FAMU also ended long losing streaks over Jacksonville (20), North Florida (13) and Bethune-Cookman (13) during the season.

Shouppe came to Florida A&M after spending 21 years as the Pitching Coach at Florida State. Taking over a program coming off back-to-back seven win seasons and over 45 losses, this was a prized catch for the Rattler program.

As the Pitching Coach/Recruiting Coordinator at Florida State he produced 10 ACC team ERA pitching titles, coached 63 pitchers that were drafted including six first round picks, coached 26 first team All-Americans and made nine College World Series appearances.

Shouppe is also currently serving as a coach with USA Baseball. In 2012 and 2013, he was the pitching coordinator for the 18-up Summer league baseball.

Professionally, he played with the Houston Astros from 1982-1985, where he was drafted in the eighth round of the 1982 draft.

A Florida State graduate with a degree in Physical Education, Shouppe also earned a master's degree from Nova University in Fort Lauderdale. A Chattahoochee, FL native, Jamey and his wife Karen, a former Florida State cheerleader, have three children: Jake, Kasey and Jared.
