Budget Status

FAMU Athletics is currently in the peak of the Investing in Champions Campaign. So far this year \$919,655 has come into the program.

- \$462,055 has been collected by FAMU Athletics
- \$457,650 will be collected by payroll deduction and financed payments
- We need a minimum of \$1 million in INC this year, which leaves you, the Rattler Nation to help us find a way to put at least another \$100,000 on top of all of our past renewals.



Right-Size Athletic Staffing


Major Issue: FAMU Athletics has been trying to work too few to do too many tasks.
