## Five Things to Know

1. Johns Hopkins has won a NCAA tournament game in three straight seasons, defeating Rowan (2014), Western New England (2015) and Randolph-Macon (2016).
2. The Centennial is 0-4 in the two-year history of the Centennial-MAC Bowl Series. The largest margin of victory in the four games has been five points and the combined difference is 17 points.
3. Franklin & Marshall's last postseason victory was a 38-14 win against Delaware Valley in a 2013 ECAC bowl.
4. Susquehanna's last postseason win came in 1991 when the River Hawks reached the third round of the NCAAs after victories against Dickinson (21-20) and Lycoming (31-24).
5. Muhlenberg's last postseason win was a 31-21 victory against Salisbury in the 2007 NCAA tournament.

## November 11 – Players of the Week



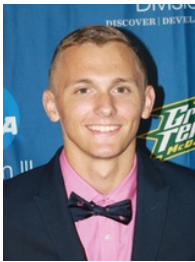
**Offensive Player of the Week**  
**Taalib Gerald, Franklin & Marshall**  
**Senior, RB, 5-6, 186**  
**Egg Harbor Township, N.J. / Holy Spirit HS / @hshsfootball1**

Gerald carried 32 times for 139 yards and scored three touchdowns as Franklin & Marshall won a share of the Centennial title for the first time since 2004 with a 51-21 win against Gettysburg. He set the school career rushing TD record with 30.



**Defensive Player of the Week**  
**James Turner, Dickinson**  
**Sophomore, LB, 6-0, 225**  
**Ridgefield, Conn. / Suffield Academy / @SATigers**

Turner recorded 12 tackles - eight solo - including a sack and another TFL as Dickinson defeated Ursinus, 40-17. The Red Devils held the Bears scoreless and allowed just 14 yards of total offense in the second half.



**Special Teams Player of the Week**  
**Matt Schleifer, McDaniel**  
**Sophomore, KR, 5-10, 165**  
**Brick, N.J. / Brick Township HS / @BrickCoachZ**

Schleifer returned a punt 92 yards for a touchdown in the Green Terror's loss to nationally-ranked Johns Hopkins. It was the first TD on a punt return by a McDaniel player since 2009. Schleifer amassed 281 return yards vs. the Blue Jays, including 186 on kickoff returns.

**CENTENNIAL, MIDDLE ATLANTIC  
CONFERENCES RENEW BOWL SERIES**

LANCASTER, Pa. – The Centennial Conference and the Middle Atlantic Conference (MAC) will continue with its postseason bowl series in 2017 for a third consecutive year. The Third Annual Centennial-MAC Bowl Series will take place on Saturday, November 18 at locations to be determined following the final weekend of regular-season action.

The Centennial-MAC Bowl Series will involve the top two teams from each conference that are not selected to the NCAA Division III Championship. The top team from each conference that is not selected to the NCAA Championship will host the second-best team from the opposing conference not moving on to NCAAs in one game of the series.

Ticket prices will be \$5 for adults and \$2 for students. Special Olympics athletes and children under the age of six are admitted for free.

"The Centennial-MAC Bowl Series has been a tremendous success in its first two seasons and we hope for even better things in 2017," said Steve Ulrich, Executive Director of the Centennial Conference. "Our conferences have set a high bar with these postseason games that other Division III conferences are attempting to emulate. The Centennial is happy to continue our partnership with our friends in the MAC."

"In the third year of the Centennial-MAC Bowl Series, we anticipate two highly contested games on November 18," said Ken Andrews, Executive Director of the MAC. "Many other conferences have followed our lead and now sponsor similar postseason challenges. As this format becomes more prevalent in Division III, our games will experience even greater support and excitement."

The MAC has won all four bowl series games to date. Delaware Valley has picked up two of the victories over Moravian (2015) and Muhlenberg (2016), while Stevenson defeated Muhlenberg in 2015 and Albright defeated Franklin & Marshall in 2016.

The two conferences will continue to support the NCAA Division III Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC) partnership with Special Olympics by donating 25 percent of ticket revenue generated during the Bowl Series to the organization. Giving back to local and regional communities not only adds to the comprehensive learning component of Division III, but also provides a venue for passion and service. The Centennial-MAC Bowl Series has raised a total of \$2,513 over two years.

NCAA rules permit a conference-sponsored postseason tournament – one between teams that are not identified until the end of the preceding regular season – not to exceed one contest for any one institution.

NOTABLE: Johns Hopkins is making its seventh straight and ninth appearance overall in the NCAA tournament. The Jays set school records for points in a quarter (35), half (49) and yards in a half (447) vs. McDaniel. Hop has won at least nine games 11 times since 2002. The JHU seniors are 42-4 in their career. When coach **Jim Margraff** took the helm, Hopkins was 61 games under .500 all-time. After Saturday's win, JHU is now 62 games OVER .500. Ten Blue Jay players earned first-team All-CC recognition. WR **Luke McFadden** was named Offensive Player of the Year. He caught 55 passes for 1,124 yards and nine TDs. QB **David Tammaro** leads the CC in passing yards (308.2), completion percentage (65.9) and total offense (336.0). PK **Jamie Sullivan** is tied for the D-III lead with 15 field goals. Johns Hopkins is outscoring its opponents, 240-69, in the first half. The Blue Jays have 73 plays of 20+ yards this season.

The Presidents are making their 25th appearance in the NCAA tournament. It is the 13th undefeated regular season in program history. W&J coach **Mike Sirianni** was named Co-Coach of the Year by the PAC. Six players earned first-team All-PAC honors: CB **O'Shea Anderson**, DE **Tom Marra**, S **Luke Merhaut**, LB **Nick Murgo**, OL **Andrew Rao** and WR **Jesse Zubik**. Zubik set PAC records for career yards and TDs and the W&J mark for catches. The two teams met in the 2012 NCAA tournament with JHU winning 42-10.

NOTABLE: This will be the first meeting between the two teams since 1982. Widener is making its first appearance in the Centennial-MAC Bowl Series, while Franklin & Marshall makes a repeat appearance after last season's loss at Albright. Eight F&M players earned first-team All-CC recognition, while **John Troxell** was named Coach of the Year for the second time. DE **Joe Granahan** was named Defensive Player of the Year after notching 13.0 sacks and 14.5 TFL. QB **Tanner Erisman** leads the CC in pass efficiency (163.0), passing TDs (26) and points responsible for (204). RB **Taalib Gerald** set a program career record for rushing TDs (30). The Diplomats won a share of the Centennial title for the first time since 2004. F&M is outscoring its opponents, 233-93, in the first half. The Diplomats have scored 41 points on their opening possession of the game this season.

- Ragland is the first Ursinus player to earn Rookie of the Year honors since the award was instituted in 2012.
- Troxell was named Coach of the Year for the second time (2009).
- Three players were unanimous first-team selections – Granahan, Speranza and Corvil.
- Caggiano, Bair, Granahan and Moffett were repeaters from the 2016 first team.
- Johns Hopkins raised its all-time first-team All-CC total to a Conference-leading 163 players, followed by Muhlenberg with 155. Franklin & Marshall is third with 134, followed by Dickinson (114), McDaniel (87), Ursinus (86), Gettysburg (75), Moravian (21), Susquehanna (19) and Juniata (8).
