Today, FAU serves more than 30,000 undergraduate and graduate students across six campuses located along the southeast Florida coast. FAU is an energetic and dynamic institution, determined to propel itself to the forefront of innovation and scholarship. In recent years, the University has doubled its research expenditures and outpaced its peers in student achievement rates. 

Interim President of Florida Atlantic University

Stacy A. Volnick, Ph.D., was unanimously approved by the FAU Board of Trustees as interim president on Sept. 19, 2022, and confirmed by the Florida Board of Governors on Nov. 9, 2022.

Dr. Volnick is responsible for the operation and administration of the entire University within the framework of policies provided by the Board of Trustees in keeping with the laws of the State of Florida and the Board of Governors. She makes recommendations for policies and decisions that will enable the University to run smoothly and effectively at all levels. She also collaborates with the Board of Trustees and other stakeholders to determine priorities and accomplish the many objectives of the University.

In addition to her role as interim president, Dr. Volnick serves as an affiliate clinical professor for the Department of Educational Leadership and Research Methodology in the College of Education.

Previously, Dr. Volnick served as chief operating officer and vice president for administrative affairs. In this role, Dr. Volnick provided oversight for the university's administrative and operational units including Public Safety, Facilities Management, Environmental Health & Safety, Human Resources, Business Services, Emergency Management, Board of Trustee Operations, President's Office Operations, the Eleanor R. Baldwin House presidential residence, Real Estate Development, the University Ombudsman, as well as the Offices of the Inspector General and University Compliance. She also served as interim vice president for institutional advancement, interim vice president for financial affairs and chief financial officer, interim oversight over public affairs, and interim inspector general.

A three-time Owl and a proud first-generation college graduate, Dr. Volnick received her bachelor's degree in communication, and her master's and doctoral degrees in educational leadership, from Florida Atlantic. She became a member of the University's administrative staff in 1991 and has more than 30 years of experience in higher education administration.

Stephen Engle studies and teaches the political and economic evolution of the 19th Century American Republic at FAU. His research in this period has focused on the study of the American Civil War and Reconstruction Era, and his books examine the ethnic dimensions of the period, civil-military relations during the war and the politics of power. He has written several books and his recent work, *Gathering to Save a Nation: Lincoln and the Union's War Governors* received the 55th Annual Barondess-Lincoln Award for 2017. Engle is currently working on a biography of Massachusetts abolitionist and governor John Albion Andrew.

Engle has been the recipient of several research and teaching honors and spent the year (1995-1996) as a Fulbright Scholar in Germany teaching at Martin Luther University as well as at the American History Institute in Wittenberg, Germany. In 2016 was named the Distinguished Teacher of the Year at Florida Atlantic University. In 2018, he was appointed NCAA Faculty Athletic Representative for FAU.

A native of the Lower Shenandoah Valley, Steve grew up near Harpers Ferry, West Virginia. He received his Ph.D. in American History from Florida State University in 1989. Engle joined the faculty at Florida Atlantic University in 1990 and in his time at FAU he has served as the Director of Graduate Programs (1997-2002), and as Department Chair (2002-2007). He is currently the Director of the Department's Symposia Series.

VICE PRESIDENT & DIRECTOR OF ATHLETICS

Brian White



Brian White was named Florida Atlantic University Vice President and Director of Athletics on March 3, 2018. Since that time White has wasted no time initiating the culture of #WinningInParadise in Boca Raton while helping the program grow in stature and national prominence.

White oversees an athletics department that is committed to Winning for Life, providing student-athletes with all the tools necessary to be successful in competition, in the classroom, in the community and in their lives after sports.

He was instrumental in one of the more influential changes to FAU Athletics in the fall of 2021, when FAU announced it would accept an invitation to join the American Athletic Conference, which took effect on July 1, 2023.

Athletics reached new heights in 2022-23. In the fall of 2022, a national football head coaching search spearheaded by White culminated with the hiring of Tom Herman, an elite winning program builder. Just months after Herman joined the staff, Dusty May, White's first hire, and his basketball team led Florida Atlantic, the Boca Raton Community and the nation on a run to the Final Four. That run united FAU faithful and exposed the world to a program that exuded an unmatched togetherness, drive and spirit.

White then completed a contract extension that secured May, the 2023 CBS Coach of the Year, to "Paradise for the next 10 years". That same time span saw Brandon Shepherd garner CCSA Men's Diver of the Year honors, Alicia Mora gained a berth in the NCAA National Swimming Championship, and Aniya Hubbard was named the Conference USA Freshman of the Year. In May of 2023, the beach volleyball team made their second-consecutive trip to the NCAA postseason tournament after capturing their first Conference USA title. First year head softball coach Jordan Clark, who White hired from Ohio State, finished with a 35-20 record in 2023 and mentored the C-USA Pitcher of the Year in Gabby Sacco, who also garnered NFCA All-Region honors.

All attention then turned to the 2023 MLB draft, where C-USA Player of the Year, Nolan Schanuel, was taken in the first round by the Angels and was the 11th pick overall. Schanuel, a five-time All-American as well as an Academic All-American, became the highest FAU student-athlete draftee in any sport.

AMERICAN
ATHLETIC CONFERENCE



The American Athletic Conference, which has established itself as a preeminent NCAA Division I Football Bowl Subdivision conference, enters its second decade poised to continue its remarkable ascension to national prominence.

As of July 1, 2023, The American consists of 15 prestigious institutions: the University of Alabama at Birmingham, the University of North Carolina Charlotte, East Carolina University, Florida Atlantic University, the University of Memphis, the United States Naval Academy (in football only), the University of North Texas, Rice University, the University of South Florida, Southern Methodist University, Temple University, the University of Texas at San Antonio, Tulane University, the University of Tulsa, and Wichita State University (in basketball and Olympic sports).

Under the leadership of commissioner Mike Aresco, The American has fashioned an impressive list of accomplishments in the competitive arena, in the classroom and in support of student-athlete welfare. The American is firmly entrenched among the elite conference thanks to its collection of national team and individual championships, its football and basketball postseason victories, its expansive media rights contract with ESPN, and its commitment to providing the highest levels of support for student-athletes.

The league has produced four NCAA championship teams in addition to a College Football Playoff semifinalist, four New Year's Six bowl champions, two NCAA Men's Final Four participants, six Women's Final Four teams, an NIT champion, 15 NCAA individual championships, and a Rhodes Scholar. Additionally, American Athletic Conference teams have advanced to the College World Series, qualified for the match play round of the NCAA Men's Golf Championship and registered multiple top-10 finishes at the NCAA Cross Country and Outdoor Track and Field championships.

In the 2023-24 season, The American will be the only Division I conference to have a New Year's Six bowl winner (Tulane) and an NCAA Men's Final Four participant (Florida Atlantic) in its ranks.

The American has seen a member school claim a spot in a New Year's Six bowl eight times in the league's first 10 football seasons, including the 2022 campaign, when Tulane capped the biggest one-year turnaround in major college football history with a thrilling win against USC in the Goodyear Cotton Bowl Classic.

Individual teams in The American have enjoyed some of their best football seasons in program history as members of the conference. Tulane went 12-2 and earned a top-10 final ranking in 2022. Navy won a program-record 11 games in 2015, its first season in the conference, and matched that mark with its 2019 campaign. Memphis, which had not won 10 games in a season since 1938, has registered three 10-win seasons in the last eight years (2015, 2017, 2019), including a school-record 12 wins in 2019. Temple enjoyed its first 10-win season in school history in 2015. South Florida finished in the top 25 for the first two times in program history (2016, 2017). SMU returned to national prominence in 2019 with a 10-win season, during which the Mustangs were ranked as high as No. 14 nationally. Tulsa returned to the top 25 for the first time in 11 years in 2020. East Carolina earned a top-20 ranking in 2014.

Since the conference's reconstitution in 2013-14, teams from The American have registered top-10 national rankings in football, men's basketball, women's basketball, baseball, men's soccer, women's soccer, women's lacrosse, men's golf, women's rowing, men's tennis,

women's tennis, men's cross country, men's track and field, and women's track and field.

American Athletic Conference student-athletes have distinguished themselves in all facets of intercollegiate athletics. Memphis quarterback Brady White was the 2020 winner of the National Football Foundation's James V. Campbell Trophy as the top scholar-athlete in college football. Temple linebacker Tyler Matakevich won the Bednarik Award and the Nagurski Trophy as the nation's top defensive player in 2015, while Tulsa linebacker Zaven Collins repeated that feat in 2020. The American has had four top-10 Heisman Trophy finishes including Navy quarterback Keenan Reynolds, who was fifth in 2015. Reynolds was also selected as the winner of the 2016 AAU James E. Sullivan Award as the nation's top amateur athlete.

Additionally, SMU's Avery Acker was chosen as the Division I women's volleyball Academic All-America of the Year in 2015, South Florida star Georgina Corrick was the Division I softball Academic All-America of the Year in 2022, while Tulsa cross country standout Kirk Smith was chosen as a Rhodes Scholar in the fall of 2016.

American Athletic Conference alumni have made their mark in professional and international sports as well. A number of American Athletic Conference athletes have been selected in the first round of the professional entry drafts in football, basketball, baseball and soccer, including former Memphis center James Wiseman, who was the No. 2 pick in the 2020 NBA Draft, and former Wichita State third-baseman Alec Bohm, the No. 3 selection in the 2018 Major League Baseball Draft. Former SMU standout Bryson DeChambeau, who was the 2014 American Athletic Conference individual champion, went on to win the 2015 NCAA Championship and the 2015 US Amateur before enjoying a remarkable pro career that has included the 2020 U.S. Open title. Former Memphis tennis player Joe Salisbury, a 2014 all-conference selection, has gone on to win five Grand Slam championships in men's doubles and mixed doubles. Former Tulane standout Dominik Koepfer has earned a top-50 world ranking in men's tennis and reached the fourth round of the US Open in 2019.

The American announced a lucrative and comprehensive media rights extension with ESPN in May of 2019, providing the conference with a stronger and more extensive presence on ESPN's primary television networks (ABC, ESPN, ESPN2, ESPNU). Since the extension took effect in the 2020-21 academic year, a minimum of 40 regular-season football telecasts and 60 regular-season men's basketball games per season will appear on those primary networks. Nearly every conference-controlled game in all sports will appear either on an ESPN network or on ESPN+.

The first eight American Athletic Conference Football Championships were televised by ABC as part of Championship Saturday. Subsequent championship games will appear on either ABC or ESPN through the duration of the 12-year extension.

Away from the competitive arena, The American has established itself as a leader in the area of student-athlete wellness, both through the adoption of NCAA autonomous legislation on matters including full cost of attendance and nutrition. The conference, in conjunction with its Student-Athlete Advisory Committee has also launched the Powerful Minds campaign to improve awareness and education on mental health issues and recognize the scholarly achievements of the conference's student-athletes.




