FAIRLEIGH DICKINSON VS. RUTGERS ALL-TIME SERIES

- Tonight is the 14th meeting on the hardwood between the Knights and Scarlet Knights
- The team's first met back on Nov. 27, 1981 (RU W, 74-72)
- Rutgers leads the all-time series 11-2, including wins in each of the last two seasons
- Last season, on December 23, the Scarlet Knights came away with a 72-64 victory.
- The Scarlet Knights were led by 21 points from Corey Sanders. FDU led 35-28 early in the second half before Rutgers came from behind to earn the win. The Knights were led by 15 points from Stephan Jiggetts and 13 from Mike Holloway.

FAIRLEIGH DICKINSON LAST TIME OUT

- Despite a career-high 33 points from Darian Anderson, which included his 1,000th career point, FDU was edged 90-87 by Towson University at SECU Arena on Saturday afternoon.
- The Knights held the Tigers without a single 3-point field goal (0-7) but the home team countered by amassing 52 points in the paint.

- The Knights finished 27-of-60 (45%) overall, 12-of-28 (43%) from 3-point land, and 21-31 (68%) from the line. Towson totaled a 27-for-57 (47%) performance from the field and a 36-of-53 (68%) clip from the line.
- Stephan Jiggetts netted 25 points on just five made field goals as he did most of his damage at the line where he was 12-of-15 and from 3-point range where he knocked down three of his four tries.

HERENDA'S TAKE

- "We played really hard and really well for long segments of that game but in the second half, Towson was just too big and too strong for us. I am very proud of our effort tonight -- you can see our team coming together on a daily basis and it is only a matter of time before we gel into a very solid group in our conference."
- "It was great for Darian, Steph and Earl to come back to their home state and to perform the way that they did. For Darian to get his 1,000th point in front of his family and friends was just awesome. I am so proud of Darian and the great thing is -- he has many more chapters to write at Fairleigh Dickinson."

Newest Member: With his 24th point against Towson on Saturday, Darian Anderson became the latest Knight to join the career 1,000 point club. Anderson finished with a new career-high 33 points to go along with a career-best six made 3-pointers. As a team, the Knights knocked down a season-high 12 trifectas in the loss.

Homecoming: In their return to their home state, Darian Anderson, Stephan Jiggetts and Earl Potts Jr. tallied 71 of the Knights' 87 points at Towson on Saturday.

No Threes: In the loss to Towson, the Knights held the Tigers to 0-for-7 from 3-point range. It's the first time the Knights have prevented an opponent from making a three since Army went 0-1 against FDU back on 12/13/08.

Working His Way Back: After missing the Knights' first seven games with an injury, junior swingman Earl Potts Jr. returned to a full workload in the game against Towson. Potts Jr., who was a preseason All-NEC selection, led the Knights with six rebounds on Saturday.

Herenda History: In his first season at the helm of the Knights, head coach Greg Herenda became the first head coach in the Garden State since December 1987 to defeat both Rutgers and Seton Hall in the same season. The only other coach to accomplish the feat was Pete Carrell at Princeton.

New Jersey Teams: Rutgers is the fourth New Jersey opponents the Knights have faced this season. FDU suffered losses to Seton Hall and St. Peter's, while earning a win against FDU-Florham.

Tough Sledding: For the second straight game, the Knights will face one of the toughest defenses in the nation. Towson entered Saturday 19th nationally in field goal defense, while Rutgers holds opponents to just 36.9% from the floor, which is 13th in Division I.

Bishop's Rising Freshman forward Kaleb Bishop tallied 11 points and eight rebounds in his first collegiate start against B10 powerhouse Ohio State. The freshman forward followed that performance with a career-high 13 points against Iona in the Knights' next outing.

Turn Them Over: The Knights have won the turnover battle in six of their nine games this season. Unfortunately, that has only resulted in a 2-4 record in such games.

Darian's Scoring Prowess: Anderson currently ranks second in the NEC in points per game at 19.4 ppg. The junior guard let the Knights in scoring last season but has improved his efficiency this season, including an 87.5 free throw percentage.

The Iron Knight: Anderson has started every game for the Knights since arriving in Hackensack for the 2014-15 season. The junior guard's streak stands at 71 games.

Jiggetts the Distributor: Stephan Jiggetts leads the NEC in assists per game at 5.1 apg. The junior point guard is averaging a career-high scoring average as well, tallying 13.1 ppg.

NABC Nominee: In early December, Tyrone O'Garro was announced as a nominee for the NABC Good Works Team for his work in the community and service off of the court. O'Garro was the lone NEC student-athlete and the only student-athlete from a New Jersey school to be nominated for the prestigious award.

Steph's Big Night: Jiggetts' triple-double against Lipscomb (Nov. 19) was the first by an NEC player since Quinnipiac's James Feldeine did it against Monmouth back on February 25, 2010.

Crash the Boards: The Knights dominated on the glass against FDU-Florham (Nov. 15), nabbing a program single-game high 54 rebounds.

Number 300: The Nov. 15 game against FDU-Florham was Greg Herenda's 300th as a college basketball head coach.

Youth Prevails: Featuring the third-youngest team in the nation, the Knights claimed the NEC title last season and returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2005.

Familiar Faces: The young Knights are back for another run this season with 11 players returning from last year's 13-man roster, including four of the team's five starters.

Quite a Turnaround: The Knights experienced a 10-win improvement by winning 18 games last season after an 8-21 record in 2014-15. It was the first winning record for the program since the 2005-06 season (20-12).

Road Success: Last season, the Knights were 9-8 in road contests, which marked the team's first winning record away from home since 1997-98.

Back-to-Back Academic Achievements: After earning the NEC Team GPA Award for the first time in program history in 2014-15, the Knights captured the award again last season. Additionally, the team's work in the classroom also resulted in the program's first (NABC) Team Academic Excellence Award.

Challenging Non-Conference Slate: This season the Knights visit last year's Big East Champion Seton Hall along with road tilts at Ohio State, Cincinnati, Army West Point, Rutgers, Towson and Fordham. Nine of the team's 11 non-conference games are away from home with the two home dates against FDU-Florham (Nov. 15) and Iona (Dec. 7) and a pair of neutral-site games against Lipscomb and Saint Peter's at Fordham.

Scoring Surge: The Knights averaged 77.5 points per game last season, which was tops in the NEC. It's the first time FDU has led the conference in scoring since the 2005-06 season.

Potts from Downtown: Last season, Earl Potts Jr. knocked down 66 three-pointers -- seventh most by a Knight in a season. The junior swingman found the touch from long range last year after making just 14 trifectas as a freshman.

Darting Darian: Junior guard Darian Anderson wreaked havoc on opposing ballhandlers with 60 steals last season. The 60 thefts rank 5th all-time in Knights' single-season history. He entered the season, 11th in school history with 114 steals. At 1.82 spg, Anderson ranked second in the NEC last season.

Anderson's Ascent: Entering the 2016-17 campaign, Anderson is 166 points shy of 1,000 for his career. The third-year guard has averaged 13.5 points per game and started all 62 games for the Knights since his arrival in Hackensack. With 304 made baskets over his first two seasons, Anderson is on pace to finish in the top three all-time in field goals at FDU.

Local Flavor: With newcomer Nadi Beciri (Maywood, N.J.) entering the fold, the Knights now have three Bergen County student-athletes on the roster. Beciri joins fellow Jerseymates Mike Schrobach (Hasbrouck Heights, N.J.) and Dondre Rhoden (Ridgefield Park, N.J.).

Hurley's Influence: Kaleb Bishop comes to FDU from the perennial New Jersey powerhouse St. Anthony's. Bishop played for the venerable head coach Bob Hurley, who has won more than 1,000 games and claimed 28 state titles. In his senior season at St. Anthony's, Bishop helped the team to a perfect 32-0 record, including another New Jersey state championship.

O Canada: This preseason, the Knights spent parts of six days in Montreal -- practicing, playing exhibition games and enjoying the sights and culture of Montreal. The team played a pair of exhibitions against McGill University and Brookwood Elite. It was the first time an FDU basketball team had traveled north of the border.

Hardwork Pays Off: Junior guard Mike Schrobach, who joined the Knights as a walk on his freshman year, was awarded a scholarship by Coach Herenda and the team this summer. Schrobach grew up less than 10 miles from the FDU campus in Hasbrouck Heights, N.J.

Al and Jim: This year's recipient of the Al LoBalbo award was Naismith Basketball Hall of Famer and champion UConn head coach Jim Calhoun. Calhoun was presented the award by Greg Herenda. Each year the award is given to a person like Al, whose selfless service, tireless dedication and education through sport made significant contributions that transcend competition for the betterment of athletics and all who are involved.

Herenda Bullets:

Selection Committee Opens Doors: After capturing the NEC title last season, the Knights were the first team in NCAA history to be welcomed into the NCAA Selection room in New York City.

Constantly Improving: Last season, Earl Potts Jr. became the first Knight since Sidney Sanders Jr. to take home the NEC Most Improved Player Award.

Big Mike: As a freshman last year, Mike Holloway averaged 9.5 ppg with 5.7 rpg and started 30 of the team's 32 contests. The 6'7" 250 pound Holloway was named All-NEC Rookie Team and two-time NEC Rookie of the Week. The Knights' big man showed off his potential with three double-doubles, including a monster 19-point, 17-rebound performance in the NEC Semifinals against Mount St. Mary's.

Townes Transfers: Despite being a key contributor to the team's NEC Championship run last season, Marques Townes decided to transfer to Loyola University Chicago in the offseason. Townes started all 33 games for the Knights and averaged 11.5 points per game, which was third best on the squad.

Turn up the Heat: The Knights' speed and quickness put consistent pressure on opponents all season long last year. The team finished 19th in the nation in caused turnovers, forcing opponents to hand over the rock 15.5 times per game.

Protect the Ball: In addition to their penchant for taking the ball away, the Knights ranked 30th in the country in turnover margin with a +2.6 differential per contest.

NCAA Appearance: After capturing the NEC Championship, FDU was placed in the tournament's East Region as a #16 seed and sent to Dayton, Ohio to play fellow #16 seed Florida Gulf Coast in the First Four with the winner then traveling to play #1 seed North Carolina. The Knights and the eagles squared off in front of more than 13,000 fans at UD Arena and a national television audience on TruTV.

Underclassmen Points: Of the Knights' 2,558 points last season 96 percent (2,467) came from sophomores or freshmen, including all 65 points scored in the NCAA First Four game against FGCU.

Balanced Attack: What made the FDU offense so strong last season was balance. The Knights had five players average in double figures during conference play and four overall.

Score and Win: As simple as it sounds, when the Knights pile points up they win. Last season they were 14-3 in games where they scored at least 75 points and 9-1 in games where they scored 86 points or more.

The Only One: In 2015-16 the Knights were the only team in the country that lead their conference in field goal percentage, three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage in conference play. On the season overall, FDU lead the NEC in field goal percentage, three-point field goal percentage and was third in free throw percentage.

Coming Soon: The Knights announced the signing of ultra-quick point guard Jahliil Jenkins from Virginia Academy (Ashburn, Va.) to next year's squad.

HEAD COACH GREG HERENDA

Greg Herenda is set for his fourth season at the helm of the Fairleigh Dickinson men's basketball program

Last season, featuring the third youngest roster in the nation, Herenda guided one of the biggest turnarounds in the NCAA. The Knights finished with an 18-15 overall record, captured the NEC Tournament title and earned a berth in the 2016 NCAA Tournament. The 18 victories marked a 10-win improvement from the previous season.

Furthermore, the 18 wins and 11 NEC victories are the most by an FDU squad since the 2005-06 season, while the NEC Tournament title and NCAA Tournament berths were the first for FDU since the 2005 season. Additionally, the team posted its first winning road record in 19 seasons.

Sophomores Darian Anderson and Earl Potts Jr. garnered Second Team All-NEC honors following the season, while freshman Mike Holloway earned a place on the NEC All-Rookie Team. Potts also became the second FDU player in Herenda's tenure to garner NEC Most Improved Player honors.

Under Herenda's guidance, the Knights have achieved tremendous success in the classroom. After earning the NEC Team GPA Award for the first time in program history in 2014-15, the Knights captured the award again last season. Additionally, the team's work in the classroom last season also resulted in the programs first National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Team Academic Excellence Award.

Herenda was introduced as the seventh head coach in program history on Friday, April 26, 2013. He came to FDU after serving as the head coach at UMass Lowell from 2008-2013, where he posted a record of 95-56 (.629) en route to becoming the program's all-time winningest coach. In ten seasons overall, Herenda is 161-138 (.538) as a head coach.

During his first year in Hackensack, Herenda returned the Knights to the Northeast Conference Tournament for the first time since 2010. He tripled FDU's conference win total during his first season and became the first head coach in the Garden State since December 1987 to defeat both Rutgers and Seton Hall in the same season. The only other coach to accomplish the feat was Pete Carrell at Princeton.

Herenda also developed Sidney Sanders Jr. into the most improved player in the nation after the Knights' co-captain saw his scoring average rise from 4.6 points per game as a junior to 19.1 points per game, the second-highest increase in the NCAA. For his efforts, Sanders Jr. was FDU's first All-NEC First Team performer since 2007 and earned All-NABC and All-Met accolades. He was also the first FDU men's basketball player to earn the NEC Most Improved Player Award before Earl Potts Jr. received the honor in 2015-16.

In his second season, Herenda and the Knights opened with an upset victory at Saint Joseph's on a late basket by senior, and Philadelphia native, Mustafa Jones. The team would follow with notable non-conference victories against intrastate rival Princeton and Colonial Athletic Association members Towson and Delaware.

Throughout Herenda's time at FDU he has maintained a strong relationship with the Boys and Girls Club of Hackensack/Lodi. He has also worked hard to develop relationships with alumni and in association with an alumni commitment he began the Revitalization of the Alumni Basketball Suite in the Rothman Center.

Off the court, Herenda developed and stars on The Greg Herenda Show on WFDU which features premiere guests and sports personalities such as Hall of Fame Coaches Jim Calhoun and John Calipari, former NBA player Kerry Kittles and numerous other guests.

"I cannot tell you how excited my family and I are to be coming back to New Jersey and to be the head coach at Fairleigh Dickinson University," Herenda said. "This is a dream come true. This will be my 30th year of coaching college basketball, and the road has taken me all over the country and the world. It's incredible that I start my Division I career at home."

The 55-year-old Herenda, who is a native of North Bergen, N.J. and played for legendary coach Jerome Halligan at St. Peter's Prep in Jersey City, N.J., has a coaching path that has taken him to the Big East, Conference USA, the Ivy League and the Patriot League through the years, and his teams have won multiple conference championships, as well as appearing in both the NCAA and NIT Tournaments.

"I cannot thank David Langford and (former Metropolitan Campus Provost) Dr. Joseph Kiernan, as well as the entire committee that selected me," Herenda said. "Everyone cares so much about the University and the basketball program."

"When I was a young boy I saw Al LoBalbo coach at FDU, and I remember just what a legend he was," Herenda said. "I have known Tom Green for years and all the success he had. Now it is my turn to reenergize the program, and I cannot wait to get to work."

Herenda took over at UMass Lowell in 2008, inheriting a 12-win squad from the year before. In his first season, he was named the Northeast Conference-10 and NABC East Region Coach of the Year after leading the Division II school to a 21-8 record, which started a stretch of three straight 20-win seasons and four straight trips to the NCAA Tournament. During that time, Herenda led UMass Lowell to a NE-10 Tournament title in 2009-10, a semifinal appearance in 2010-11 and another championship game appearance in 2011-12.

Before leading UMass Lowell, Herenda was the head coach at Cabrini College for one season (2007-08), Division III school in Radnor, Pa. While coaching at Cabrini, Herenda doubled as a lead analyst and color commentator for YES Network's Ivy League basketball telecasts.

Herenda started his head coaching career at Elgin Community College in Elgin, Ill., in 2006. He turned around a six-win team from the previous year into a squad that finished 18-11, won the Skyway Conference championship and reached the Region IV District B Junior College championship game for the first time in school history during his only season at the helm.

In his last three head coaching jobs, Herenda has improved his teams' win total by an average of 9.33 games in his first year with each of the programs.

Prior to becoming a head coach, Herenda was the associate head coach at East Carolina (2000-05), and an assistant coach at Yale (1997-99), Seton Hall (1994-97), Holy Cross (1989-94), his alma mater Merrimack (1985-89) and UMass Lowell (1983-85).

Herenda returned home to the Garden State in 1994 to become an assistant coach at Seton Hall under Head Coach George Blaney. Before making the move to Seton Hall, Herenda was an assistant coach at Holy Cross for five seasons. He helped lead the Crusaders (23-7, 12-2 Patriot League) to the 1993 NCAA Tournament after the team earned an NIT bid in 1990 during his first season.

While an assistant coach at Merrimack (1985-89), Herenda helped guide the Warriors (22-10, 13-5 NE-10) to the Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) Division II Championship in 1989 in his final season.

A four-year player at Merrimack, Herenda still holds the school record for assists in a game (22) and shares the record for the single-season average (9.0). He graduated in 1983 and earned his bachelor's degree in business administration and marketing.

Herenda currently resides in Bergen County with his wife, Jillene, and his son Trey.

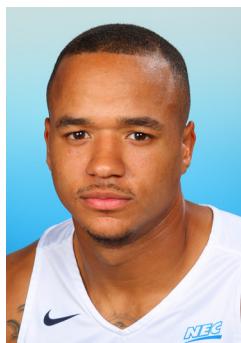

ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH BRUCE HAMBURGER

Bruce Hamburger enters his fourth season as the associate head coach for the Fairleigh Dickinson men's basketball program.

Last season, Hamburger helped guide the Knights to a 10-win turnaround as the team earned an NEC Championship and returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2005.

Hamburger came to Hackensack via Jersey City after coaching at Saint Peter's from 2010-2013. While at St. Peter's, the team made the NCAA Tournament during his first year (2010-11). Hamburger's leadership resulted in the 10th team to make the NCAA Tournament in his 16 years as an assistant coach.

"Bruce brings an incredible amount of experience and expertise to our program," Herenda said. "I am very lucky to have a coach who has not only been on a Final Four bench, but has head coaching experience and ties to the entire state of New Jersey, which will prove to be a tremendous addition to my staff."

Prior to working at Saint Peter's, Hamburger was an assistant coach at Caldwell College, after spending two seasons as an assistant coach for the New York Liberty of the WNBA.

Along with his time at Caldwell and in the WNBA, Hamburger brings over 20 years of coaching experience to the Knights' staff. He served as the head coach at Kean University for 11 years, where he is the all-time winningest coach. Hamburger coached his alma mater to four appearances in the ECAC Tournament, winning the ECAC title in 2005, and advanced to the finals again in 2006. He also led Kean to an appearance in the New Jersey Athletic Conference Tournament in 2001.

Prior to coaching at Kean, Hamburger was an assistant coach at Seton Hall under P.J. Carlesimo for nine years, beginning in 1986. The Pirates won two Big East Tournament titles and made six appearances in the NCAA Tournament during his tenure, including the 1989 run to the NCAA championship game. The team was inducted into the Seton Hall Athletic Hall of Fame in June 2014.

Hamburger began his coaching career in 1984 at Trenton State, where he was an assistant coach under Kevin Bannon for two seasons.

"I am excited to join the FDU family. I look forward to working with Coach Herenda and the rest of the coaching staff and players, and making the FDU program successful," Hamburger said. "Having worked with Greg (Herenda) at Seton Hall, I know the passion and commitment that he will put into making the FDU program excel both on and off the court. I am eager to contribute any way I can."

Hamburger graduated from Kean in 1984 with a Bachelor of Arts degree in physical education. He also holds a Master's degree in Counseling Education from Seton Hall.

Saint Peter's head coach John Dunne on Coach Hamburger: "Bruce is the ultimate professional. He brings knowledge in all areas for a program. Fairleigh Dickinson is getting a guy that has a wealth of different experiences to share while having the energy level of a first-year assistant."



ASSISTANT COACH DWAYNE LEE

Dwayne Lee enters his fourth year as an assistant coach at FDU on Greg Herenda's staff.

Last season, Lee played an integral part in the Knights' 10-win turnaround as the team earned an NEC Championship and returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2005.

Prior to joining the Knights' staff, Lee served as the graduate manager at Northeast Conference rival Wagner in 2012-13, where the Seahawks finished 19-12 (12-6 NEC) and made the semifinals in the NEC Tournament for the second year in a row.

"Dwayne brings a wealth of winning playing experience to our program and has played for some of the games great coaches," Herenda said. "Dwayne will immediately help with player development and will serve as a terrific role model for all of our players. Dwayne will undoubtedly become a rising

star in the coaching ranks very quickly."

Lee earned four letters while playing in two NCAA Tournaments for Saint Joseph's from 2002-2006. Over his first two years on Hawk Hill, the Jersey City native served as a back-up point guard to 2004 National Player of the Year and Orlando Magic All-Star guard Jameer Nelson. As a sophomore, Lee helped the Hawks to a perfect regular season, 30 wins and a berth in the Elite Eight.

He then made the seamless transition to starter for his final two years with the Hawks, guiding the Philadelphia-based school to the finals of the National Invitational Tournament (NIT) as a junior and a pair of Atlantic 10 Tournament championship game appearances. All told, Lee was a part of 96 wins, the second best total for a four-year class in school history, while finishing 11th with 371 assists.

Additionally, Lee was named to the Atlantic 10 All-Defensive Team as a junior, while earning Most Improved Player honors from the Philadelphia Big 5. Following his time at Saint Joseph's, Lee played professionally for the Sellbytel Baskets in Germany's top division, before helping the Vermont Frost Heaves to the ABA Championship. He then concluded his playing career with Etha Basketball in the first division of the Cyprus League.

Lee played prep ball at St. Anthony High School, under the direction of legendary Hall of Fame coach Bob Hurley, helping the Friars to two straight New Jersey State Tournament of Champions titles and a No. 2 National Ranking by USA Today.

"I am very excited to be joining the staff here at FDU," Lee said. "Coach Herenda is a well-respected coach in this business, and I am excited to be part of what he has planned for this program going forward. I am going to bring tons of energy, excitement and the experience of coaching in the NEC last season. I am looking forward to big things in the near future."

Lee graduated from Saint Joseph's in 2006 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

St. Anthony head coach Bob Hurley on Coach Lee: "First of all, I am very excited to see Greg (Herenda) take over as coach at FDU because he has been a friend of mine for decades, and was a camper at my basketball camps growing up. I am even more excited by his hire of Dwayne Lee. Dwayne is one of my favorite kids I have ever been associated with. The hiring of Dwayne was a great move for the University and a terrific opportunity for Dwayne. I know this will be a relationship that will get FDU back in the running in the NEC."

Saint Joseph head coach Phil Martelli on Coach Lee: "In the long and proud tradition of Saint Joseph's University, no one has brought more honor to his family name, this program and this University than Dwayne Lee. His future in the coaching profession is bright and without limit."



ASSISTANT COACH WINSTON SMITH

Winston Smith rejoined the Fairleigh Dickinson coaching staff last season and immediately had a major impact.

Smith helped guide the Knights to a 10-win turnaround, an NEC Championship and the team's first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2005.

Smith came to FDU after spending eight seasons on the men's basketball staff at Drexel University. Prior to Drexel, he spent time as a member of longtime FDU head coach Tom Green's staff.

On returning to FDU Smith said, "I want to thank Coach Herenda for giving me this opportunity to come back to Fairleigh Dickinson and be a part of his coaching staff," Smith said on Thursday. "I am looking forward to working with Coach Herenda and sharing my coaching experiences with the entire coaching staff. My goal is to help each of our players grow as people, as well as becoming the best possible student-athletes and basketball players. The future is bright for Fairleigh Dickinson and I'm excited to be a part of it."

"Winston Smith is another great addition to our staff and to our program," Herenda said when announcing the addition. "I recruited him when he was a terrific player at St. Pat's and now he has matured into a high level basketball coach. Winston will be a tremendous resource for all of our big men."

"I also love the fact that Winston further entrenches our staff into the high school and AAU programs in our home state."

Smith previously worked at FDU under head coach Tom Green. During that time, he worked a season as the assistant director of basketball operations (2001-02) before being promoted to an assistant coach for the 2002-03 campaign. With the Knights, Smith served as the director of the Fairleigh Dickinson Basketball Camps and oversaw film exchange, which included editing and breaking down opponent game tape.

Most recently, Smith spent the last eight seasons as Drexel's coordinator of basketball operations. In that role he was responsible for coordinating team travel, organizing team purchases, assisting with on-campus recruiting and monitoring the basketball program. He also ran the Drexel University All-Star Camp. He helped the Dragons to a 29-7 record during the 2011-12 season as Drexel reached the third round of the NIT. The 29 wins are the highest total in the history of Drexel basketball. The Dragons also had a 19-game winning streak during that season.

Prior to that, Smith spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Northeast Conference member Saint Francis U. He also had stops as an assistant women's basketball coach at Hofstra, helping the Pride to its first NCAA Division I postseason appearance, and Youngstown State.

Smith played for Bruiser Flint, whom he worked under at Drexel, as an undergraduate student-athlete at UMass. He was the team captain as a senior and earned the Top Defender Award and the Mr. Hustle Award during his days in Amherst. The Minutemen made three postseason appearances with Smith on the team, including a pair of trips to the NCAA Tournament.

A native of Summit, N.J., Smith graduated from UMass with a Bachelor of Science degree in sociology in 2001. He married his wife, Allison Levy Smith, on August 15, 2015.

Pete Lappas enters his third season as the Director of Basketball Operations at FDU. In his role, Lappas is responsible for arranging the Knights' travel arrangements.

"Pete Lappas is a tremendous addition to our staff," Herenda said. "He has extensive experience for someone of his age. There is a lot of basketball in his blood."

Lappas comes to FDU after serving two years as a graduate assistant manager at Temple. During his first year in Philadelphia, the Owls finished 24-10 (11-5 Atlantic 10) and made the NCAA Tournament, where they defeated NC State, before falling to Indiana by four points in the third round. Lappas graduated from Temple last spring with a master's degree in Sport and Recreation Management.

A 2012 graduate of Boston College, with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Communications, Lappas has coached at some prestigious summer camps, including Jim Calhoun's camp at Connecticut, Gary Williams' camp at Maryland, Mike Rice's camp at Rutgers and Jay Wright's camp at Villanova.

An intern with the Philadelphia 76ers during the summer of 2011, Lappas has also worked as an administrative assistant at multiple Hoop Group camps as well as an assistant to camp directors at the Reebok All-American Camp.

Lappas is the son of Steve Lappas, who was the former head coach at Villanova (1992-2001) and Massachusetts (2001-05) and now current college basketball analyst for CBS Sports Network.
