2017-18 PRESEASON FAVORITES

FGCU is 1-10 all-time against nationally-ranked opponents, with the lone victory coming in the 2013 NCAA Tournament against #8 Georgetown (2 seed in the tournament). More info on page 2.

FGCU has uncharacteristically lost four of its last five games. The Eagles are coming off a 91-88 setback at FIU on Tuesday night - **the second opponent FGCU has allowed to score 90+ in regulation this year. In the previous four years under Joe Dooley that had only occurred two times total.** Additionally, it marked the **second time this year FGCU lost when scoring 85 or more points - something that hadn't happened even once since the first year of the program in 2002-03** (three times that season).

The Eagles held an 11-point 2nd-half lead at FIU, incredibly representing the fourth time already this year they have lost a game when possessing a double-figure lead. In the previous four years entering this season, that had only occurred four times total (more info page 25). Additionally, FGCU also had a 43-28 rebounding edge - representing the **first time in Division-I program history (since 2007-08) it has lost when having a +15 advantage on the glass.**

5 THINGS TO KNOW IN 280 OR LESS

- 1) Four of FGCU's six losses have been by five points or less, and in all four of those games it has had a chance to tie the contest in the closing seconds.
- 2) Wichita State will be the fifth matchup this year for FGCU against a team which finished in the top 40 of the RPI (29), won at least 25 games (31) and played in the postseason (NCAA) last year.
- 3) After not making double-figure 3-pointers in any of the first 10 games of the season, FGCU has made 10, 11 and 11 triples in the last three contests, respectively.
- 4) FGCU hasn't lost five of six games at any point in a season since 2010-11; it has only dropped four of five under Dooley twice previously (2013-14 and 2014-15; both eventual 20-win postseason campaigns).
- 5) The Eagles are averaging 14.5 turnovers per game. In the previous four years under Dooley, FGCU has averaged just 12.4 per outing.

In the eight games it has out-rebounded its opponent, FGCU has done so by at least a +15 margin in six of those (5-1 record in those games) ... the win over Siena on Nov. 13 marked **Joe Dooley's** 150th career victory ... **the 33-point road win (86-53) was tied for the largest victory away from home in D-I program history**, and was tied for Siena's largest home defeat in its D-I history (since 1976-77).

SCOUTING THE SHOCKERS

^ Wichita State was ranked #3 in the country last week before falling to nationally-ranked Oklahoma, 91-83. The Shockers are in their first season as a member of the American Athletic Conference after spending 72 years in the Missouri Valley Conference.

^ The Shockers are the only team in the nation that has won 30 or more games in four of the last five seasons. WSU is one of five schools in the country which has a victory in each of the last five NCAA tournaments, including a trip to the 2013 Final Four.

^ Wichita State has won 44-straight non-conference home games dating back to 2011. Under 11th-year head coach Gregg Marshall, the Shockers are 66-3 in non-conference home contests.

^ Landry Shamet leads the Shockers offensively with 16.5 points per game - one of four double-figure scorers. Wichita State is averaging 86.7 points per game - its highest in nearly four decades - and has the 6th-best offensive efficiency in the country, according to KenPom.

RECORD ROAD WINNING STREAKS --- SNAPPED EARLIER THIS YEAR ---

GONZAGA: 11 FGCU: 10

FGCU had won a program-best 10-straight road games dating back to last year - the 2nd-longest road winning streak in the country - before a last-second loss at Bowling Green on Nov. 18. Last year's national runner-up Gonzaga has the longest current streak at 12 in a row (Wichita State: 8 straight).

The Eagles finished a program-best 7-0 on the road in the ASUN last year, surpassing the previous single-season record for wins of five. FGCU is the first ASUN institution to go undefeated on the road in conference action since former league member Samford went 8-0 in 1998-99.

Overall, FGCU was a program-best 10-3 away from Alico Arena last season, with all three losses coming by single digits.

FGCU GROWTH

FGCU moved to the Division-I ranks in 2007-08, becoming post-season eligible for the 2011-12 season. After starting their D-I transition with five-straight losing seasons, the Eagles have now posted five-consecutive 20-win seasons. After not finishing higher than 6th place in the ASUN the first five years, FGCU has finished no worse than a tie for 2nd each of the past four seasons.

Brandon Goodwin was the unanimous 2017 ASUN Newcomer of the Year, in addition to being named ASUN First Team, ASUN Tournament MVP and setting a league record by securing six ASUN Newcomer of the Week honors. He was also named to the NABC All-District First Team after setting a program record by scoring 629 points. He hit three game-winning shots and led FGCU in scoring (18.5) and assists (4.1). 



FGCU is the only D-I team in the state of Florida which has posted four-straight 20-win seasons (five-consecutive for the Eagles). As FGCU has moved among some of the preeminent teams in the state, it has done so with Florida talent. Last year, Florida natives were responsible for 80 percent of FGCU's points and 75 percent of the Green and Blue's rebounds and assists.

This season, eight of FGCU's 13 scholarship players hail from the Sunshine State, and including walk-ons there are 11 total players from Florida on the 2017-18 roster.

RETWEETS

- 1) The Eagles scored 70+ points in each of their first 11 games, coming one performance short of matching the 2003-04 team for most consecutive games to start a season (12) with scoring 70 or more points.
- 2) After not shooting better than 30 percent from 3-point range in any of the first four games of the year, FGCU has connected at better than a 34-percent rate in each of the last nine games.
- 3) The 92 points FGCU allowed to FAU were tied for the most in a regulation game under Joe Dooley (92 at Lipscomb on Feb. 27, 2014).
- 4) The 83-64 loss at home to Oral Roberts on Saturday was tied for the worst home non-conference loss in the program's D-I history (77-58 vs. Drexel on Nov. 14, 2007).
- 5) The Eagles shot 50.7 percent from the floor against FAU - their 2nd-highest shooting percentage in a loss in D-I non-conference history (61.4 percent at TCU on Nov. 11, 2011).

BY THE NUMBERS

58 Since the start of the 2012-13 season, FGCU boasts a 58-20 (.744) record in ASUN regular-season games - 10 more wins than any other team in the league (North Florida, 48).

262 FGCU has made at least one 3-pointer in 262 straight games (Jan. 8, 2010).

98 The 98 points against Illinois State this year were the most in a season opener in program history. The previous high was 90 in the program's first-ever game in 2002-03 versus Puerto Rico-Bayamon.



RANKINGS RUNDOWN

In the Associated Press and/or USA Today Coaches Poll, Wichita State is ranked #11 in the country, while Rhode Island is receiving votes.

Additionally, in Joe Lunardi's latest ESPN Bracketology, FGCU is predicted as a 15 seed in this year's NCAA Tournament. Along with the Eagles, Lunardi also has Wichita State (2 seed), Rhode Island (9), UT Arlington (11) and Middle Tennessee (12) all included in his third Bracketology of the young season.



BUILDING A TRADITION

FGCU is believed to be the only men's D-I program in NCAA history to make five postseason appearances in its first six years of eligibility (2013: NCAA; 2014: NIT; 2015: CIT; 2016: NCAA; 2017: NCAA).

The Eagles are also one of just 23 teams in the nation to have won at least 20 games and made postseason appearances in each of the past five seasons. Of those 23 teams, only six are mid-major schools, as FGCU joins Vermont, Belmont, New Mexico State, Iona and UC Irvine to hold that distinction.

NATION'S ELITE

FGCU is one of only seven schools in the country which has had its men's and women's teams win at least 20 games in five-straight seasons, joining:



Additionally, with both the men's and women's teams winning at least 26 games last season, FGCU is one of only three non-Power 5 schools in the nation to boast that claim along with Gonzaga and Bucknell. In total, only nine schools had both its men's and women's basketball teams record at least 26 victories a year ago:



With its win over Fairleigh Dickinson in the 2016 First Four, FGCU secured its third NCAA Tournament victory in four years (at the time). **The Eagles are the only current ASUN member which has won an NCAA Tournament game, and are responsible for three of the league's seven all-time NCAA Tournament victories, dating back to the ASUN's initial appearance in March Madness in 1981.**



LOCKING IN ON D



Since Dooley took over FGCU in 2013-14, FGCU has held 40 teams to 60 points or fewer. The Sweet Sixteen team in 2012-13 held 13 opponents to 60 points or fewer, but prior to that - in five seasons of D-I history - FGCU teams had only held opponents to 60 points or fewer 20 times.

The Eagles have led the ASUN in scoring defense in three of Dooley's four years with FGCU and finished 2nd in the other season. Last year, the Eagles paced the conference by holding opponents to just 69.3 points per game - exactly six points better than any other team.

At just 5-foot-2-inches, freshman **Darnell Rogers** is by far the smallest D-I player in the nation. The next smallest player is Mount St. Mary's Junior Robinson at 5-5.


Rogers is believed to be the smallest scholarship D-I men's basketball player in history. While not confirmed due to many teams not being able to verify early-year rosters, only one player has been confirmed as smaller than 5-2, and that was Dayton's Keith Braswell at exactly 5 foot. However, Braswell was a walk-on during his one season with the Flyers in 1994-95.

More recently, Malcolm Reid - a 5-2 walk-on at Southeastern Louisiana in 2015-16 - matched Rogers' height, but he once again was also a walk-on. Darnell's father, Shawnta, stood at 5-4 and put together a heralded career at George Washington, ultimately culminating in him winning Atlantic 10 Conference Player of the Year in 1999.



FGCU has a pair of players related to Naismith Basketball Hall of Famers in Michael Gilmore and walk-on Ryan McAdoo. Gilmore is the nephew of Artis Gilmore, a six-time NBA All-Star, while McAdoo is the son of Bob McAdoo, a five-time NBA All-Star and NBA MVP in 1975.

FGCU is one of only two active ASUN members (North Florida, 2015) to have won an ASUN Tournament Championship. FGCU won its third title in six years, with the three championships being tied already for the 3rd-most in ASUN history (since 1979). Only Belmont (five titles from 2006-12) and UCF (four titles from 1994-05) have more.



PROTECTING THE ROCK



FGCU set the single-season program record with nine games of single-digit turnovers in 2015-16, surpassing the previous record of eight from 2014-15. Eight single-digit turnover games is exactly how many the Eagles had in their entire pre-D-I history. In 2013-14, FGCU had six single-digit turnover games. **Under Dooley, the Eagles have posted 32 of the program's 38 single-digit turnover games in the D-I era.**

D-I IMPROVEMENT

Coinciding with taking care of the ball better, FGCU has steadily improved its D-I record nearly every season, and has increased its winning percentage under each of its now three D-I era coaches.

LOOKING AHEAD & BACK

The Eagles are the defending ASUN regular-season and two-time defending tournament champions. FGCU is installed as the preseason ASUN favorites, predicted to return to the NCAA Tournament for a third-straight year and fourth time in the past six seasons.

Last season, FGCU claimed its first outright ASUN regular-season title (12-2) and second overall. **The Eagles set a program D-I regular-season record with 23 wins and tied the all-time victory mark of 26,** finishing one triumph shy of matching the program's all-time mark. FGCU set D-I program single-season records in points per game (79.4), rebound margin (+5.4) and field goal percentage (.499) - 5th-best in the nation.

The Eagles made their third NCAA Tournament appearance in five years (six seasons of eligibility) and earned a program-best No. 14 seed. Despite losing its leading rebounder and shot blocker in Demetris Morant early in the 2nd half with an ankle injury, FGCU went on to fall to 3rd-seeded Florida State - the second-tallest team in the nation - by just six points, 86-80.

HOME SUCCESS



FGCU is 80-17 at Alico Arena since 2012-13. FGCU is 5-3 this year, went 16-3 last season, 16-4 in 2015-16, 13-4 in 2014-15, 15-2 in 2013-14 and 15-1 in 2012-13.



Versus ASUN foes during the regular season since 2012-13, FGCU is 34-5 at The Nest.

Despite only becoming Division-I postseason eligible for the 2011-12 season, FGCU has already claimed an impressive 17 wins in the postseason.

ASUN 14-3 NCAA 3-3 NIT 0-1

FGCU is the only FGCU reached the Sweet Sixteen as a No. 15 seed in 2013 when the Eagles defeated No. 2 Georgetown and No. 7 San Diego State en route to capturing the nation and earning the #DunkCity moniker. The Green and Blue lost to No. 3 Florida in the next round before going 1-1 in 2015-16 and 0-1 last year.

The Eagles received a No. 8 seed in the NIT in 2014 and traveled to No. 1 Florida State, falling just short (58-53) to the eventual NIT semifinalists.

CIT 0-1

FGCU made its first appearance in the CIT in 2015, falling at home to Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, 75-69.



FGCU TRADITION

FGCU has made five postseason appearances in only six years of D-I eligibility: 2013 NCAA, 2014 NIT, 2015 CIT, 2016 NCAA, 2017 NCAA. FGCU is believed to be the only D-I program in NCAA history to make five postseason appearances in its first six years of eligibility.

2007-08

FGCU's first D-I season and first year as a member of the ASUN. The Eagles defeat North Florida, 70-67, in their first-ever league game and finish the year 6-10 in the ASUN (T-8th of 12 teams).

2008-09

The Eagles don't win a road game all season (0-14) and finish 7-13 in the ASUN (9th of 11 teams).

2009-10

The team wins its fewest ASUN games in single-season program history with just five en route to a 5-15 record (T-10th of 11 teams).

2010-11

FGCU starts 0-7 in league play, but begins to set the tone for a drastic shift in program history by finishing 7-6 on its way to a 7-13 ASUN record (7th of 11 teams).

2011-12

FGCU's first season of D-I postseason eligibility. The Eagles go 8-10 in the ASUN (T-6th of 11 teams) and earn the No. 6 seed in the conference tournament. FGCU defeats No. 3 USC Upstate, 71-61, upsets host and No. 2 Mercer in the semifinals, 62-58, before falling short in the title game to top-seeded Belmont, 83-69, after holding a 42-39 halftime lead.

2014-15

FGCU goes 11-3 in the ASUN (2nd of 8 teams) and receives the No. 2 seed, but falls at home in the ASUN semifinals to No. 3 USC Upstate, 63-62.

By reaching the ASUN Championship Final Game in each of its first three seasons of eligibility, FGCU became the only school in NCAA history to accomplish that feat.

2016-17



After claiming its first outright regular-season crown with a 12-2 record, FGCU beat Stetson by 30 points in the quarterfinals, knocked off Kennesaw State in the semifinals and then used a big 2nd half to run away from rival North Florida in the final to cut down the nets for the third time in five years.

2012-13



In just its second season of D-I postseason eligibility, FGCU goes 13-5 in the ASUN, earns the No. 2 seed in the conference tournament and for the second-straight year defeats Mercer on its home court -- this time in the final -- to earn an NCAA Tournament berth. The Eagles went on to become the only team in NCAA history to advance to the Sweet Sixteen as a 15 seed.

2013-14



FGCU wins its first ASUN regular-season championship with a record of 14-4 and earns the top seed in the ASUN tournament. But this time, No. 2-seeded Mercer defeats the Eagles on their home court in the title game, 68-60, and goes on to knock off Duke in the NCAA Tournament as a 14 seed.

2015-16



FGCU won its 2nd ASUN Tournament Championship in four years with an 80-78 overtime win over 7th-seeded Stetson. The Eagles tied for 2nd in the league, but received the 4th seed and defeated 5th-seeded Kennesaw State, 74-64, before dominating at top-seeded North Florida, 89-56, in the semifinals - the largest loss a top seed has ever suffered in the A-Sun Championship (since 1979).

FGCU used five 2nd-half dunks and a 21-2 run to turn a 31-31 game at the 17:27 mark into a 52-33 Eagles' lead by the 12:30 mark. With Georgetown trying to mount a comeback in the closing two minutes, sophomore point guard Brett Comer threw a brazen one-handed alley-oop to Chase Fieler, who finished with one hand and Georgetown never got closer than five the rest of the night.


Leading 54-52 with 11:30 left, FGCU went on a 17-0 run to open up a 71-54 advantage with less than four minutes remaining. The 10-point final margin was the closest SDSU would get in the final eight minutes. After not having any dunks in the 1st half against Georgetown, the Eagles finished with 10 in the closing 60 minutes - the Georgetown 2nd half and entire SDSU game.



AVERAGE SAT SCORE




AVERAGE ACT SCORE



The national exposure from the Eagles' run to the Sweet Sixteen as a No. 15 seed in 2013 has had far-reaching impacts throughout the university and Southwest Florida:

>>> A 27-percent increase in freshman applications the next year, allowing the school to become more selective in its admission. The average high school GPA of admitted students has increased every year from 3.35 in Fall 2012 to 3.81 in Fall 2016.

>>> The university's fundraising office doubled its number of alumni donors in a year.

>>> The Athletic Department posted a record \$4.8 million in external revenues during the 2016 fiscal year, up from \$4.4 million in 2015 and a significant jump from only \$3.1 million in 2013 prior to the run to the Sweet Sixteen.

>>> Since 2013-14, FGCU has been responsible for roughly one-third of the entire ASUN's home attendance over that time.

>>> Last year, supporters filled Alico Arena to an average of nearly 4,000 fans per game - 92 percent capacity of The Nest's 4,333 seats. In terms of percentage capacity, that ranked 31st in the nation - ahead of Miami, UConn, Notre Dame, UCLA and many other marquee programs.



Entering this season - in four years under Doolley - FGCU had surrendered a double-figure lead and lost a game just four times. Already this year, the Eagles have lost four double-figure leads. The four double-figure leads lost through just 13 games are already the most in a single season since the 2012-13 team surrendered five such advantages, including an 11-point edge in the Sweet Sixteen against Florida. FGCU lost consecutive double-figure point leads against Middle Tennessee and FAU. It's just the third time in program history (2002-03, 2012-13) that the Eagles have given up back-to-back double-figure point leads.

Through the first eight games of the year, the Eagles were +43 in second-chance points, but in the last five-contests they are -41.

PAINT EMPHASIS

FGCU led the country in points in the paint per game last year at **41.3**. Included in that average were a pair of then-D-I program record performances of 68 points in the paint versus Ave Maria and Florida National.


