1,000 POINT WATCH

FGCU has three players that have either eclipsed, or are nearing the 1,000 point mark in their careers, albeit in very different ways.

The Eagles leading scorer this season, Schadrac Casimir, has 47 points in the first four games, giving him 1,159 career points. 1,112 of those points came in NCAA Tournament campaigns at Iona

Haanif Cheatham has added 51 points in the Eagles first four games to his career total this season. He is now at 761 for his career, despite playing just five games during his junior season at Marquette

Dinero Mercurius has had one of the more interesting journey's in his quest to reach 1,000. Now at his fourth stop, Mercurius has compiled 909 combined points in his career between USF, Daytona State, and FGCU.

SHORTHANDED START

The Eagles will be without the services of 6-9, 255 lbs. Brian Thomas and 6-7, 225 lbs. RaySean Scott Jr. for the fourth straight game tonight, who are both recovering from lower leg injuries.

REDSHIRT TO BLUESHIRT

The Eagles have eight players on their 2018-19 roster who have redshirted at some point in time in their career for various reasons. That number is the fifth most nationally, trailing only Cal State-Bakersfield, UCF, Rider, and Saint Mary's who each have nine on their respective rosters this season.

EXPERIENCED, BUT NOT

FGCU returns five players that played in at least 25 games last season in Dinero Mercurius, RaySean Scott, Christian Carlyle, Ricky Doyle, and Brady Ernst. However, they lost their top three scorers from a season ago and return just 29.5% of their scoring this season overall.

MID MAJOR POLLS

The Eagles received votes in the preseason College Insider Mid Major Poll this season. Six teams on their 2018-19 schedule also received notice including South Dakota State (3), Illinois State (10), Toledo (13) Lipscomb (22), UMBC, and Liberty (RV) while potential opponents Louisiana (12) and UC-Irvine (23) were also in the poll.

In the loss, the Eagles got career highs from both Troy Baxter Jr. and Christian Carlyle, who scored 20 a piece for FGCU. Baxter got off to a hot start with seven point in the first 2:15 minutes of the game while Carlyle did his work on the back end with 18 second half points in his career night.

EARLY BIRDS

The Eagles November 6th tipoff marked FGCU's earliest season opener in program history. The previous earliest start came on November 8, 2013 when FGCU traveled to Lincoln, Nebraska to take on the Huskers in an ASUN Championship season.

TOUGH ROAD

FGCU will play one of the tougher mid-major non-conference schedules in the country in 2018-19. Each of their first five opponents of the year (Illinois St., Southeastern, Michigan State, South Dakota St., and Toledo) either won their regular season conference championship or played in their conference championship game last season. Both of their opponents this week, Michigan State and South Dakota State, played in the NCAA Tournament a year ago.

THE GROWTH OF FGCU

After starting their D-I transition with five-straight losing seasons, the Eagles have now posted six-consecutive 20-win seasons. After not finishing higher than 6th place in the ASUN the first five years, FGCU has finished no worse than a tie for 2nd each of the past five seasons.

HEAD COACH MICHAEL FLY

1st SEASON



THE FLY FILE

Michael Fly is in his eighth season on the FGCU coaching staff, with 2018-19 as his first as the head coach for the Eagles.

Fly has been a part of more than 150 wins the past seven years, six ASUN Tournament Final appearances, three NCAA Tournament victories, three ASUN Tournament titles and three ASUN Regular Season Championships, two berths in the NIT, a CIT appearance and a run to the Sweet Sixteen which captivated the nation and put the Southwest Florida campus on the national radar for good.

The only remaining member from that 2013 Sweet Sixteen squad, Fly has been an integral and loyal member of two staffs which have changed the men's basketball culture in every facet, resulting in team accomplishments and player developments to coincide with the Dunk City mantra.

A 2006 University of Kentucky alumnus, Fly is the program's fourth all-time head coach (since 2002; Division-I in 2007), joining Dave Balza (2002-11), Andy Enfield (2011-13) and Joe Dooley (2013-18).

Fly is responsible for recruiting Zach Johnson, Brandon Goodwin and Christian Terrell. Johnson scored 1,344 career points in just three years to rank 4th in program history. Goodwin holds the top-two single-season scoring campaigns in program history in his only two years with the Eagles. Terrell is the only player in program history with at least 1,300 points, 500 rebounds and 250 assists.

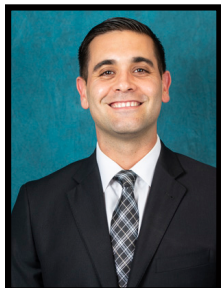
