NOTES FROM FORT MYERS (PART 1)

37 STRAIGHT AT HOME:

FGCU and Alico Arena are home to the nation's second-longest active home win streak at 37 consecutive victories. The last FGCU home loss occurred Dec. 11, 2022, against Duke, over two years ago (736 days). 37 is nine more than the third-best streak in the nation, Cleveland State's 28. National Champion South Carolina leads the country with 63 straight wins at home. The Eagles are 5-0 at home this season and posted a perfect 19-0 record at the nest a season ago, which included their eighth straight ASUN Tournament Championship run.

ALL-TIME VS MONTANA STATE/BIG SKY:

FGCU will square off against the Bobcats for the first time in program history Monday. The Eagles are 2-1 all-time against current members of the Big Sky Conference with wins over Northern Colorado and Montana. The last time FGCU faced off against a Big Sky team was 2016, eight years ago as FGCU suffered a 77-74 defeat to Northern Colorado out in Greeley, Colorado. Monday will mark just the second time a Big Sky opponent has made the trip down to the City of Palms.

CLASH OF THE MID-MAJOR TITANS:

Montana State has won the Big Sky regular season or tournament title in six of the last nine seasons, while FGCU has won seven straight ASUN regular seasons and eight straight ASUN Tournament titles. FGCU is third overall in wins the last three seasons with 92 victories, trailing only South Carolina (109) and UConn (94). In fact, FGCU has posted three 30-win campaigns over the last five years. As for Montana State, the Bobcats have registered five of their program's eight 20-win seasons in the last nine years. In the polls, FGCU climbed up to No. 5 in the latest CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 Poll. FGCU has not fallen lower than No. 7 this season. Montana State received 93 votes for No. 26 overall in the latest edition of the rankings.

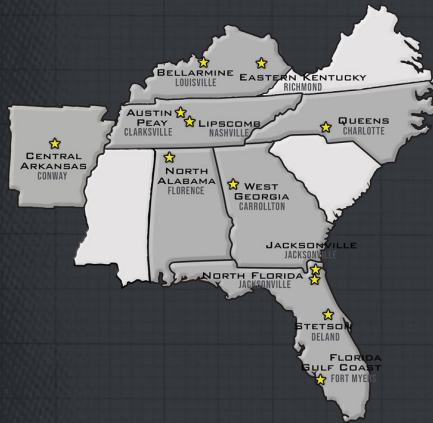

SIZE DOESN'T MATTER:

The Bobcats have 11 players listed six-foot or taller on the roster. FGCU has just two, Anna Mortag and Maca Retamales. Despite such, **the Eagles possess a top-10 scoring defense**, ranking No. 8 overall in the category by allowing just 51.7 points per game. FGCU has held its last two opponents to under 50 points and has limited eight of its nine opponents to under 60 points this season, which includes a P4 and Big East victory.

#RAINING3s FROM THE EAST TO THE WEST:

Threes will be flying Monday as **both FGCU and Montana State are top 25 in 3-point attempts per game**. FGCU averages 8.4 made threes per game, while Montana State has hit 8.3 per outing. FGCU has knocked down 300 or more made threes for 15 straight seasons, leading the country in made threes in five out of the last seven years. The Eagles produced 325 treys a season ago, placing sixth overall in the nation. In 2018, The Green and Blue set the NCAA record for the most made threes in a single season with 431.

UNDEFEATED LYLES:

First-year head coach Chelsea Lyles remains undefeated at the helm of the Eagles after taking over for Karl Smesko just two games into the season. Lyles has now emerged as the **ONLY** coach across the DI women's college basketball landscape to currently hold a **PERFECT** career record (**7-0**) and a **PERFECT** career winning percentage.

WBCA NEXT GENERATION INSTITUTE:

Third-year assistant coach Camryn Brown was selected to participate in the WBCA Next Generation Institute, an education program specifically designed for high-level assistant coaches. Brown is one of just 32 coaches selected to the program. Brown and Coretta Brown from Eastern Kentucky are the only two representatives from the Atlantic Sun Conference. The institute will be held at the WBCA Convention April 3-6 in Tampa, Florida. Former FGCU women's basketball head coach and now head man of the Atlanta Dream Karl Smesko located and brought Brown onto the Eagles' staff in July of 2022. Since then, Brown has helped direct FGCU to a 69-11 record, a 33-1 mark in the ASUN, two ASUN tournament championships and one NCAA First Round victory over Washington State.

ASUN NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK, ALAHNA PAIGE:

Daemen University transfer Alahna Paige took home the ASUN Newcomer of the Week Award last Monday for her contributions against Ave Maria and New College of Florida. Paige hit seven triples in a season-high 23 points against Ave Maria. The award is the first of the season for the fifth-year sharpshooter. The honor also marks the first Newcomer of the Week under first-year and undefeated head coach Chelsea Lyles.

NOT SO FAST TENNESSEE:

ASUN DOMINANCE

FGCU joined the ASUN prior the 2007-08 season and immediately saw success among the ranks, winning 84 of their first 85 conference home games and have only lost just seven ASUN regular-season games since the start of the 2011-12 season. The team has won 14-of-17 regular-season championships since joining the league, while also never finishing lower than second in the final standings. If that isn't enough, the Eagles have won 10 of 12 tournament titles since earning postseason eligibility during the 2011-12 season with a current win streak of eight.

WELCOME TO THE RAINFOREST: #RAINING3S

The Eagles are one of the premier 3-point shooting teams in the nation with at least 300 made threes in each and every season over the last 15 years.

Since becoming a full-fledged Division I program in 2011-12, FGCU has made 4,771 3-point field goals. Brylee Bartram set the FGCU single-game record a season ago with 10 made triples. The team program record for the most trifectas in a single-game is 23.

FGCU has led the nation in made 3-pointers in five out of the last seven years.

The Eagles hold the NCAA record for the most made threes in a single season, sinking 431 during the 2017-18 campaign. Even Caitlin Clark and Iowa could not knock off the Eagles' record last season as the Haweyes made 426.

There has been only one game in FGCU women's basketball history in which the Eagles went without making at least one 3-pointer: Feb. 21, 2006, vs Lynn (0-for-11).

record on Saturday with 30 made threes against North Carolina Central, but the Green and Blue set the NCAA record for the most made threes in a single season with 431 in 2018. Even Caitlin Clark and Iowa could not knock off the Eagles' record last season as the Haweyes made 426. FGCU has led the country in made threes in five out of the last seven seasons. The Eagles produced 325 threes a season ago, placing sixth overall in the nation. Brylee Bartram set the FGCU single-game record a season ago with 10 made triples. The team program record for the most trifectas in a single-game is 23.

ATLANTIC SLAM CHAMPS:

FGCU took down both Georgetown and Cincinnati on Prince Edward Island in Canada during its first MTE event of the season, going 2-0 to win the title in less than a 24-hour span. FGCU drained a previous season-high 10 3-pointers against the Hoyas and added another nine against the taller Bearcats. Maddie Antenucci provided six long-ball daggers over the course of the two-day event, and first-year head coach Chelsea Lyles passed her first Big East and "Power 4" test with flying colors. Emani Jefferson was named the Atlantic Slam MVP and Dolly Cairns made the All-Tournament Team list.

A WEEK TO REMEMBER:

On Monday, Nov. 11, FGCU fell to 0-2 under 23-year head coach Karl Smesko, dropping a game at Columbia. On Tuesday, Nov. 23, Smesko notified the university that had accepted the head coaching job with the Atlanta Dream of the WNBA. Chelsea Lyles was named the head coach of the program just a day later on Wednesday, Nov. 13. On Sunday, Nov. 17, Lyles recorded her first career win over NJIT and then up to Canada. Lyles has spent the last six seasons as an associate head coach alongside Smesko. Lyles has also been a part of all 24 ASUN Championships at FGCU either as a player or on the coaching staff. "I'm going to keep his same principles," Lyles said. "The standard is still excellence, and the goals are still the goals."

FGCU & UCONN:

Only FGCU and UConn have won 25 or more games over the last 14 seasons. In fact, FGCU has produced 30 or more wins in three out of the last five seasons. The Eagles have won 92 games over the last three campaigns, ranking third most in the nation – trailing only South Carolina (109) and UConn (94). FGCU is ahead of both LSU and Stanford at 91 wins apiece. In 2021, FGCU tamed the LSU Tigers in Baton Rouge 88-74.

WINNINGEST TEAM IN DI WBB HISTORY:

With an overall win percentage of .845, FGCU boasts the title as the winningest DI women's basketball program in the history of women's college basketball. In its young 23-year history, FGCU leads both legendary programs UConn (.799) and Tennessee (.798) as the Eagles are the only team to currently hold an .800-plus win percentage or higher as noted in the NCAA record book. FGCU has made the postseason, the NCAA Tournament or the WNIT, every year since 2012. That's 10 NCAA Tournament berths and a WNIT runner-up effort in 2016. The Eagles have won at least 20 games each season of their existence,

A new era has dawned as Chelsea Lyles has been named the second head coach in Florida Gulf Coast University women's basketball program history just two games into the 2024-25 season. 23-year head coach and legend Karl Smesko stepped down to take the head coaching role of the Atlanta Dream of the WNBA.

"Chelsea Lyles is a longtime Eagle, having played for the team as a student and risen through the coaching ranks over the past 16 years," said **FGCU President Aysgeul Timur**. "I'm very confident in Chelsea's ability to continue our team's momentum and to take us to the next level."

"It is with great enthusiasm and support that I announce Chelsea Lyles as the second head coach of FGCU women's basketball," said **Colin Hargis, FGCU director of athletics**. "Chelsea has demonstrated an unwavering commitment to FGCU and the women's basketball program over the last 16 years. She is prepared to lead the Eagles in the next chapter of our women's basketball program and I am excited for our student-athletes to learn from Coach Lyles' leadership."

"I am absolutely excited and prepared to be the next FGCU women's basketball head coach," **Lyles said**. "I am so grateful to Karl and it was my honor to work for and learn from one of the legends of college basketball. I congratulate him on his success and in his new position leading the Dream. I will be his biggest fan in his future championship endeavors."

"Being FGCU's second head coach, leading the program at my alma mater, is my dream," Lyles continued. "I want to thank Colin Hargis

and President Timur for their confidence in me to lead this incredible program. These young women are special, and we are ready to continue the Eagles' legacy, together. I'm excited and ready for the season ahead, and I am focusing on our game against NJIT this Sunday."

Lyles began her coaching career as a student assistant in 2010-11. After a one-year stint in that role, she officially joined the staff as an assistant coach in 2011, serving until being named the recruiting coordinator in the summer of 2014. She was promoted to associate head coach under Smesko in 2019. Lyles entered the 2023-24 season in her sixth year as an associate head coach with a 148-20 record.

Before her coaching career, Lyles spent two years (2008-10) as a player under the direction of Smesko. During that time, the Eagles won an Atlantic Sun Conference regular season championship and earned back-to-back WNIT automatic bids as the team wasn't eligible for the NCAA Tournament until 2011-12.

Overall, Lyles was a two-time First Team All-ASUN selection and led the team to a 50-12 record overall and a 34-6 mark in ASUN play. As a senior, she produced double-digit scoring 21 times. Including her time as a student-athlete, Lyles has been a part of all 24 combined Atlantic Sun Conference, regular season and tournament titles alongside Karl Smesko.

Florida Gulf Coast University's Karl Smesko stepped down as head women's basketball coach of the Eagles on Tuesday, Nov. 12 to take the same job with the Atlanta Dream of the WNBA.

"Coach Smesko's legacy at FGCU is not just about winning games," said FGCU president Aysegul Timur. "It's about the students and employees he has mentored along the way, providing them with opportunities for growth and success on and off the court. Now, it's his turn to soar, and we are so proud of him.

"There is joy and sadness with the departure of Karl Smesko," said FGCU director of athletics Colin Hargis. "As the founding Head Coach of our Women's Basketball program, Karl has led this team to national prominence. He orchestrated the rise of a start-up to a destination program. I am excited for Karl and grateful for his contributions to this department and University. We look forward to seeing what lies ahead and the impact he will make at his next position in the WNBA."

"I had a great experience at FGCU," Smesko said. "I'm very thankful for all of the former players, assistants and administrators who have helped make it a great experience for so many years."

Smesko arrived in Fort Myers in 2002 tasked with building the FGCU women's basketball program from the ground up. In his first year, he led fledgling Division II FGCU to a 30-1 record. Smesko stayed to oversee FGCU's jump from the

Division II ranks into a full-fledged NCAA Division I program, joining the Atlantic Sun Conference in 2007. The Eagles continued to see unmatched success, winning 84 of their first 85 conference home games.

Smesko won 20 or more games each season at FGCU, and also posted seven 30-win campaigns with the Eagles. Under his 23-year leadership, FGCU earned the distinction as the winningest D-I program in the history of college basketball with a .845 all-time winning percentage.

Smesko's 26-year resume as a head coach sits among the best in all of women's college basketball. He spent one year at Walsh and then two at Purdue Fort Wayne before coming to FGCU. He leaves FGCU eighth overall in total wins (672-139, .829) in NCAA D-I and was fourth overall in winning percentage among all active D-I women's basketball head coaches.

Smesko engineered FGCU into a mid-major power with its long-range offensive attack. The Eagles led the nation in made 3-pointers per game five out of the last seven years. Since 2012, FGCU has led the nation in the category six times and has finished no lower than sixth. FGCU broke the NCAA record for the most threes in a single season, sinking 431 in 2017-18. The style of play brought 14 ASUN regular season titles to Fort Myers, 10 NCAA Tournament berths and four NCAA Tournament victories.

FGCU defeated seven Associated Press Top 25 opponents with Smesko at the helm and produced seven undefeated seasons in the ASUN. The team has won 14-of-17 regular-season championships since joining the ASUN, while also never finishing lower than second in the final standings. FGCU emerged as the winningest 12-seed in NCAA Tournament history, taking down Missouri in 2018, Virginia Tech in 2022 and Washington State in 2023. Smesko also guided FGCU to WNIT runner-up status in 2016. FGCU posted its highest finish in the AP Poll during the 2014-15 season at No. 21 overall.

Smesko is a 13-time ASUN Coach of the Year selection and coached 10 ASUN Player of the Year award winners. Throughout the years, he hired 24 former players through his stellar player-to-coach pipeline. Smesko also developed two WNBA draft picks during his time with FGCU. In 2022, Kierstan Bell was selected as the 11th overall pick by the Las Vegas Aces, becoming the first-ever Eagle to be selected in the First Round and the highest draft pick in program history. Bell is now a two-time WNBA Champion with the Aces.

Success on the court for FGCU women's basketball is nearly matched by its success in the classroom. Nine student-athletes have been named to the Division I-AAA Athletic Directors Association Scholar-Athlete team at least once or earn a post-graduate scholarship from the organization. Smesko has coached 16 student-athletes that have received ASUN All-Academic

Team honors since the award was created in the 2011-12 season. Seven times, FGCU women's basketball players were named the ASUN Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

Long-time associate head coach Chelsea Lyles has been named the second head coach in FGCU program history. A 2010 graduate of FGCU, Lyles is former player for Smesko who has risen through the ranks on the FGCU coaching staff from student assistant all the way to her new position as the program's leader.

"It is with great enthusiasm that I announce Chelsea Lyles as the second head coach of the FGCU women's basketball program," Hargis said. "Chelsea has demonstrated an unwavering commitment to FGCU and the women's basketball program over the last 16 years. She is prepared to lead the Eagles in the next chapter of our women's basketball program and I am excited for our student-athletes to learn from Coach Lyles' leadership."

"Chelsea will do an outstanding job," Smesko stated. "There couldn't be anybody more ready for this opportunity."

with 14 straight years of 25 or more wins and a current active streak of eight straight ASUN Tournament titles.

5TH-SEED NIGHTMARE:

The Green and Blue (29-5) secured their eighth consecutive ASUN Tournament title last season to earn a 12-seed in the March Madness field. Prior to last year's tournament, FGCU had advanced to the Round of 32 two straight years, eyeing a third. FGCU took fifth-seeded Oklahoma to the wire, but ultimately fell 73-70 in Bloomington, Indiana. FGCU took down No. 5 Virginia Tech in 2022 and No. 5 Washington State in 2023. Three of its four NCAA Tournament wins have come as a No. 12 seed, the winningest 12th seed in NCAA Tournament history.

ASUN PLAYER(S) OF THE YEAR:

Emani Jefferson and Skyer Gill were named the Atlantic Sun Conference's Preseason Player and Co-Defensive Player of the Year as FGCU was picked to finish first in both the coaches and media poll. FGCU earned all 12 and 45 first-place votes in both polls. Jefferson is the defending ASUN Newcomer, Player and Defender of the Year. Retunee Dolly Cairns was also named preseason All-Conference.

NOTABLE NEWCOMERS:

FGCU attracted Laurn Taylor, Alahna Paige and Skyer Gill to the City of Palms. Taylor broke the NCAA record for the most rebounds in a single game last year with 43. Paige drained more than 100 threes a year ago, and Gill is a former two-time ASUN Defensive Player of the Year honoree.

RECEIVING VOTES, USA TODAY:

The Eagles grabbed the attention of national voters this preseason with four votes in the USA Today's preseason Top 25 Coaches Poll.

37 STRAIGHT AGAINST ASUN:

FGCU has won 37 straight games against ASUN members, the nation's third longest active conference winning streak. South Carolina and South Dakota State are tied for the lead at 38 apiece. FGCU went a perfect 16-0 last season in conference play, winning all 16 games by double digits for its seventh undefeated conference season in program history. The last FGCU loss to an ASUN opponent occurred back in 2023, a 78-88 loss in overtime at Liberty. Liberty is now a member of the C-USA.

2X WNBA CHAMPION

After a two-year banner career with nationally-ranked FGCU, **Kierstan Bell** was selected as the 11th overall pick by the Las Vegas Aces in the 2022 WNBA Draft. The junior, who declared early for the WNBA Draft, became the first-ever Eagle to be selected in the First Round and the highest draft pick overall in program history - and now a two-time WNBA Champion with the Aces.



Bell is the second player from FGCU to be taken in the WNBA Draft. Whitney Knight was selected as the No. 15 pick overall in the second round of the 2016 draft by the Los Angeles Sparks. Bell is a two-time winner of the Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year Award.

One of the most decorated players in program history, Bell helped the Eagles reach the NCAA Tournament Second Round in 2021-22 after a thrilling win over fifth-seed/No. 16 ranked Virginia Tech in the First Round. The Green & Blue also claimed both the ASUN regular-season and ASUN Tournament Championship titles en route to a 30-3 overall record.



Bell averaged 23.6 points, 9.0 rebounds, 2.6 assists, 2.0 steals and 2.0 blocks per game during her career at FGCU. She finished her collegiate career with 1,505 points in three seasons between FGCU and Ohio State along with 583 rebounds, 178 assists, 136 steals and 130 blocks. She scored 1,179 points in her two years with the Green and Blue through 50 games.
