## 2013 FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

### Fort Hays State Notes

**First Meeting:** This is the first-ever meeting between Fort Hays State and William Jewell in football. This is the first of two non-conference games for FHSU this season. The Tigers won their only non-conference game last season at South Dakota Mines, a team the Tigers meet again later this year in non-conference play. The Tigers have won their last two non-conference games dating back to 2011, when they started the string at Central Oklahoma. However, the Tigers lost their last home non-conference game, which was in 2011 against Southwest Baptist by a score of 30-28.

**About William Jewell:** William Jewell enters this contest at 1-3 overall. The lone win was on the road at Valparaiso by a score of 36-34. Last week, the Cardinals lost to South Dakota Mines in non-conference play at home by a score of 70-48. A member of the Great Lakes Valley Conference, William Jewell is 0-1 in conference play so far after a 29-24 loss at home to McKendree.

**Gauntlet of Ranked Opponents Over:** The Tigers played their fourth consecutive opponent that has been referenced in the AFCA Top 25 poll this year to open the season. When the Tigers played Emporia State and Washburn, both teams were unranked, but this week Washburn is No. 15 and Emporia State is No. 24. The last two weeks, FHSU lost to No. 3 Northwest Missouri State and No. 6 Missouri Western. The same happened last year as the Tigers played the same four teams to open the year and all were eventually ranked in the Top 25 at some point of the year.

**One All-MIAA Selection from 2012 Returns:** Fort Hays State had seven All-MIAA selections in 2012, but only one of those seven returns in 2013. Junior defensive back Micheal Jordan is the only all-conference player to return from that group, earning honorable mention honors. He ranked second on the team in tackles with 87 in 2012. The other six from that group were seniors. After receiving a medical hardship last year from an early season injury, 2011 All-MIAA running back Andre Smith returns as a senior in 2013.

**1-2 Punch in the Backfield:** Fort Hays State literally has a 1-2 punch in the backfield this year as Andre Smith wears #2 and Edward Smith wears #1. Both backs received medical hardships in 2012 with early season-ending injuries, but the pair combined for 1,711 yards in 2011. Andre Smith rushed for 963 yards on 177 carries and Edward Smith rushed for 748 yards on 136 carries in 2011. Andre Smith averaged 5.4 yards per carry and Edward Smith averaged 5.5 yards per carry. Andre Smith also had 134 receiving yards and 295 kick return yards that year to average 126.5 all-purpose yards per game. Edward Smith was second on the team in all-purpose yards averaging 77.9 per game. So far this year, the duo has combined for 295 rushing yards, Andre Smith with 257 yards on 54 attempts and Edward Smith with just 38 yards on 14 attempts.

**Athletic Quarterback:** Sophomore Treveon Albert takes over the starting role at quarterback in 2013 after seeing time on the field as a wide receiver, running back and kick returner in 2012 as a redshirt-freshman. Albert averaged 58.1 all-purpose yards per game, finishing with a total of 142 receiving yards, 230 rushing yards, and 209 kick return yards. He did have the opportunity to throw the ball once on a trick play at Truman that resulted in a 53-yard touchdown pass, making him a perfect 1-of-1 passing for the season. Albert was recruited to Fort Hays State as a quarterback in 2011. He took over the starting job in spring practice of 2013 and remained in front of back-up sophomore transfer Edin Kovac for the starting job in fall camp. So far over four games, Albert is completing passes at a 55.4% rate, 67-of-121 for the season with 721 yards and five touchdowns. However, he has thrown eight interceptions for the season with four against Washburn in week two. He had two against Emporia State and Missouri Western, with Northwest Missouri as the only opponent he did not throw an interception against so far. He has only taken two sacks this season.

**Trio of Experienced Receivers:** Fort Hays State has a trio of wide receivers that combined for 54 catches and 676 receiving yards in 2012. Headlining that group is senior Tanner Hageman, who finished second on the team in catches (31) and receiving yards (388) in 2012. He averaged 12.5 yards per catch and had four touchdowns last season. Junior Ed Williams had a solid first year with the Tigers after transferring from the University of Toledo. He had 17 catches for 220 yards. Keaton Callins battled a nagging injury through 2012 to still manage six catches for 68 yards. Callins has three of the nine Tiger touchdowns through three games with 19 catches and 183 yards. Hageman has 150 receiving yards on 10 catches with one touchdown. Williams did not play in the first four games of the season.

**New Look O-Line:** Fort Hays State has a new look on the offensive line this year. Both returning starters from last year that returned have each sustained injuries so far in 2013. Four players that started in the season opener had never started a game prior at FHSU. Tomasi Moles, who started the year with the defensive line, could be converting to the offensive line this week after returning from a preseason injury.

**Three Straight Years of 61 Points for Kickers:** For three straight years, Fort Hays State's top kicker has finished with 61 points on the season. In each of the last two years, that has led the team in scoring. Tyler Kimbrough scored 61 points in both 2010 and 2011 and last year Drew O'Brien had 61 points. O'Brien finished 12-of-17 on field goal attempts and 25-of-29 on extra point attempts in 2012 in his true freshman season. So far this year, O'Brien has eight points with five extra-points and one field goal.

**Lack of Sacks:** Fort Hays State struggled last year to generate sacks on defense, finishing with just 16 for the season. That ranked 13th in the MIAA, only ahead of Lincoln (12) and Northeastern State (11). The Tigers were last in the MIAA in sacks in 2011 with just 14. Basil Bandy was the leader in sacks for FHSU in 2012 with just three. The lack of pressure led to Fort Hays State allowing 259.3 passing yards per game, the second worst average in the conference, only better than Nebraska-Kearney (278.5). Fort Hays State also finished last in the MIAA in total defense, allowing 442.8 yards per game. In 2011, Fort Hays State finished second to last in total defense, allowing 472.5 yards per game. So far this year, Fort Hays State has four sacks through four games, led by Justin McPhail with two. The Tigers are 7th in the MIAA in passing defense, allowing 257.5 yards per game.

## 2013 FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

**Improvement Made in Brown's Second Year:** After going 4-7 overall in Chris Brown's first season as head coach at Fort Hays State in 2011, the Tigers improved by one win in Brown's second year at 5-6. Fort Hays State started 2012 off at 0-4 before finishing 5-2 in its final seven games last year. The Tigers look to continue their improvement in the MIAA after tying their highest amount of wins in the MIAA since joining the conference in 2006 with four last year. That tied the mark set by the 2009 team.

**Looking for the Upper Half:** Fort Hays State is now in its eighth season as members of the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association. The Tigers have yet to finish in the top five of the conference standings, with sixth being the highest finish in 2009 and 2011. They have finished last twice, ninth twice and eighth once. Last year the conference expanded to 15 teams from 11 and FHSU finished in a tie for ninth, despite matching its most wins in conference play since joining the conference. Since 1998, the Tigers have finished higher than fifth in a conference (RMAC or MIAA) just twice. Fort Hays State has not reached the NCAA playoffs since 1995 and has never been to a bowl game at the NCAA Division II level.

**Reaching 23 Points:** Over the first two seasons under Chris Brown, the Tigers averaged 23.1 points per game. The Tigers averaged 23.2 points in 2011, scoring 255 for the season, and averaged 23.0 in 2012, scoring 253 for the season. In all nine wins for Fort Hays State under Brown, the Tigers scored at least 23 points. In all but two of 17 losses under Brown, the Tigers scored less than 23. The only two games in which the Tigers scored more than 23 and loss were back-to-back games in 2011, a 36-31 loss to Truman and 30-28 loss to Southwest Baptist. The points allowed by the Tigers improved from 34.7 per game in 2011 to 29.3 per game in 2012. So far in 2013, teams are averaging 49.5 points against the Tigers. The fewest points allowed in a loss under Chris Brown was 14 in a 14-12 loss to Central Missouri in 2012.

**1,000 Career Yards Watch:** Fort Hays State running back Andre Smith went over the 1,000-yard rushing mark for his career at FHSU in week 2 against Washburn. He now has 1,225 in his career at FHSU. Edward Smith is nearing the 1,000-yard rushing mark for his career, now at 930 yards.

**Early Season First Half Struggles:** Fort Hays State scored three or less points in the first half of its first four games last year. The Tigers were shutout in the first half of the season opener against Emporia State and scored just seven in both weeks two and three. Last week, the Tigers put up their most points in a first half so far this season with 14. A touchdown in the first quarter marked the first first-quarter points of the season for FHSU and its first lead of the season, going up 7-0. So far, the Tigers are averaging only 7.0 points in the first half of games this season.

**Struggling in Total Offense and Defense:** Following the third week of the season, Fort Hays State finds itself second-to-last in total offense and 12th in total defense in the MIAA. The Tigers are averaging just 312.2 yards of total offense and allowing 507.2 total yards per game.

**Time of Possession Issues:** Fort Hays State is second-to-last in the MIAA in time of possession, holding the ball for an average of 26:28. Nebraska-Kearney is lowest in time of possession at 25:09. Fort Hays State is 12th in first downs per game, averaging just 18.0 per contest. The Tigers had 24 first downs against Missouri Western last week, a season high.

**McPhail Emerging at Linebacker:** Sophomore Justin McPhail leads the team in tackles through four games with 36. He is also tied for the team lead in tackles for loss (3.0) with Jesse Trent and leads the team in sacks (2.0). He had a career high in tackles against Emporia State in the season opener with 14. He eclipsed his entire tackle total for the 2012 season (9) by five in one game. McPhail is currently tied for seventh in the MIAA in tackles per game (9.0), tied for 14th in tackles for loss per game (0.75), and tied for fourth in sacks per game (0.5).

**Struggling with Turnovers:** Fort Hays State has forced just three turnovers this year in four games and has given the ball away 14 times. The Tigers are tied for last in the MIAA in turnover margin at -11 with Nebraska-Kearney. The Tigers are one of four teams in the MIAA currently negative in turnover margin.

**Avoiding Sacks:** Even though the Fort Hays State offensive line is fairly inexperienced in regards number of previous games played prior to the start of the year, the Tigers are tied for first in the MIAA in fewest sacks allowed with just two this year. The Tigers are currently tied with Washburn, Missouri Southern, and Northwest Missouri State.

**Needing to Stop Opponents on 3rd Down:** Fort Hays State is allowing third down conversions at a 55.7 percent rate, which is last in the MIAA. Opponents have converted 34 of 61 third down opportunities. The Tigers are second-to-last in opponent fourth down conversion rate at 85.7 (6-of-7).

## 2013 FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

### Chris Brown - Head Football Coach



Chris Brown enters his third season as head coach of Fort Hays State in 2013. Brown came to Fort Hays State from Washburn University, where he served as the defensive coordinator and defensive secondary coach from 2002-2010 and assistant head coach in 2010.

In 2012, Brown guided Fort Hays State to a record of 5-6 overall, including a 4-6 mark in MIAA play. The Tigers saw an improvement in wins from 2011, when it finished 4-7 overall and 3-6 in the MIAA.

Brown has coached 16 All-MIAA selections at Fort Hays State. The Tigers had seven All-MIAA selections in 2012, headlined by second-team offensive lineman Hawk Rouse, and nine All-MIAA selections in 2011, headlined by first-team selections - senior linebacker Alex Whitehill and senior punter Ethan Kosjer. Whitehill led NCAA Division II and set a new Fort Hays State single-season record with 164 tackles, which was just five short of the Division II single-season record. Whitehill also earned several All-American honors and was a CoSIDA/Capital One Academic All-American. Kosjer led Super Region 4 and ranked third in NCAA Division II in punting after averaging 44.4 yards per punt. He set new single-season (44.4) and career (41.4) records at FHSU for punting average and was named to three different All-America teams.

Before coming to Hays, Brown helped Washburn compile a 62-41 record in his nine-year span with the program, which included two NCAA playoff appearances and two bowl wins. In his time at Washburn, Brown coached the 2009 and 2006 MIAA Most Valuable Defensive Players and guided two players selected in the NFL Draft (defensive tackle Trey Lewis-6th round 2007, and cornerback Cary Williams-7th round 2008). Brown also coached six All-Americans, 20 all-region and 41 All-MIAA selections at Washburn. His defense led the MIAA in turnovers gained in three of his final four seasons there, including a school record-tying 23 interceptions in 2007.

Brown, a native of Liberal, Kan., is a 1996 graduate of Pittsburg State University where he recorded 470 tackles in 43 starts in his career at free safety. He is one of only three Gorillas to earn All-American honors three times. He was a unanimous All-American First Team selection his senior season and was named the CNN Division II National Player of the Year in 1995. He was also named to the NCAA Quarter Century Team for all players from 1975 to 1999 at free safety. He had a record 21 tackles in the NCAA Division II National Championship as a freshman against Jacksonville State. Brown was inducted into the Pittsburg State Athletic Hall of Fame in 2006.

He and his wife, Daphne, have two sons, Hunter and Hayden.
