#2 Shaquille Cooper, Junior, Running Back
-Leads team in rushing with 643 yards on 117 carries, averaging 5.5 yards per attempt.
-Ranks 4th in the MIAA in rushing yards per game (71.4).

-All-America Honorable Mention selection by Don Hansen in 2015.

NWMSU Leads All-Time Series

Northwest Missouri State leads the all-time series with FHSU 18-12-1. FHSU had a 12-6-1 lead in the series up until 1978 before NWMSU went on its current 12-game win streak in the series. Ten of those 12 straight wins have been in MIAA play since FHSU joined the conference in 2006.

Tigers Set Rushing Record in 2015

Fort Hays State set a new single-season school record for rushing yards in a season with 3,013, eclipsing the old mark of 2,996 from 1991. Running back Shaquille Cooper and quarterback Treveon Albert combined for 2,669 of those yards, just the second 1,000-yard single-season rushing duo in Fort Hays State history. Cooper ran for 1,441 yards and Albert added 1,228 yards on the ground. The only other time FHSU had two players rush for 1,000 yards in the same season was 2004 (Reed Gottula and Jordan Hickel). As a team, FHSU averaged 251.1 rushing yards per game and rushed for over 300 yards four times in 2015.

Tigers Return 9 of 11 Defensive Starters from 2015

Fort Hays State returns nine of 11 defensive starters from last year. All four starters on the defensive line return, which includes All-MIAA selections Nathan Shepherd and Sie Doe, Jr. At linebacker, Alex Schmidtberger earned All-MIAA honors for the second straight year. Doyin Jibowu also earned All-MIAA honors as a defensive back, playing the bandit position for FHSU. DeAndre James, the starting safety, earned All-MIAA honors in 2013 as a kick returner. Two-time All-MIAA selection Justin McPhail also returns at linebacker after redshirting last year with an injury.

Keeping Opponents Under 30

FHSU won 6 of 7 games in which it held its opponent under 30 in 2015. FHSU allowed 23.9 points per game last year to rank 4th in the conference. After 8 games this year, Fort Hays State ranks 2nd in the MIAA in scoring defense allowing 22.1 points per game. FHSU has held opponents to 20 or less four times this year. Northwest Missouri State leads the MIAA, allowing just 14.9 points per game.

Tigers at Home Since Joining MIAA

Since joining the MIAA in 2006, the Tigers are 32-30 at home. The Tigers are 16-14 at home under head coach Chris Brown, including a 5-1 mark at home in 2015. They are 4-0 at home so far this season.

Tigers on the Road Since Joining MIAA

Since joining the MIAA in 2006, the Tigers are 21-36 on the road. However, the Tigers are 18-14 on the road under head coach Chris Brown. The Tigers went 3-22 on the road in their first five seasons with the conference, but have went 18-14 since.

Mezera Sets FHSU Single Game Total Offense Record at Pittsburg State

By producing 508 total yards of offense in the 54-41 win at Pittsburg State in Week 6, sophomore quarterback Jacob Mezera set the single game school record going past the old mark of 477 by Robert Long. Mezera had 446 passing and 62 rushing yards to set the record. He was just 21 yards short of the single game passing and 21 tishing yards to set the program. He was just 21 yards short of the single game passing yards record at FHSU, held by Long. The 446 yards is an NCAA Division II record at FHSU, since Long played in the NAIA era of the program. Mezera also had five passing touchdowns to tie the single game record at FHSU, and added rushing touchdown to give him a hand in six touchdowns for the game. Mezera earned MIAA Offensive Athlete of the Week for his performance. Mezera has thrown for over 300 yards in three of the last four games.

Defensive Touchdowns

Fort Hays State ranks 20th in the nation in defensive touchdowns with 3 so far this year. FHSU has 2 interception returns for touchdowns and one blocked field goal return for a touchdown. The national leader, Limestone, has 8.

Ten 100-Yard Rushing Games; Two 200-Yard Games for Cooper

Shaquille Cooper returned to FHSU in 2015 after sitting out of school for two years. Cooper converted to running back for FHSU from defensive back after seven games in 2012 and rushed for over 100 yards in three of the final four games that year. He rushed career-high 263 yards against Northeastern State in Week 2 in 2015. He has 10 100-yard games career games at running back. The 263 rushing yards against Northeastern State was fourth-most by an FHSU player in a game in school history. Cooper had two 200-plus yard rushing games in 2015, 263 against Northeastern State and 216 against Emporia State. Cooper is the 4th Tiger in history to record 10 100-yard rushing games. The school record is 13, held by Clint Bedore.

Winning the Turnover Battle

Fort Hays State ranked fourth in the MIAA in turnover margin in 2015 at +9. FHSU finished with 29 turnovers gained and 20 lost. Northwest Missouri State led the conference at +19, while Central Missouri and Emporia State both had margins of +12. So far, the Tigers are +9 in turnover margin this year. FHSU currently ranks 17th in the nation in turnover margin (+1.00) and 2nd in the MIAA behind Emporia State (+1.67). Emporia State is tied for 2nd in the nation in turnover margin ratio and is +15 in margin. The Tigers rank 13th in the nation in turnovers lost with just 10 on the season.

Doe, Jr. Leads MIAA Lead in Sacks, 4th in Nation

Defensive end Sie Doe, Jr., is leading the MIAA lead in sacks. He has 13 overall and produced a season-high 2.5 in Week 4 at Northeastern State. Doe also leads the MIAA in tackles for loss with 14.5 so far. Doe ranks 3rd in the nation in sacks per game (1.44) and 27th in tackles for loss per game (1.6). Doe set a new single season school record for sacks after recording one at Emporia State. He passed the old mark of 12 by Trevell Smittick in 1998. He is just 2 shy of the career record of 21.5, also held by Smittick.

Two of Four Top Tacklers in MIAAFort Hays State linebackers Jose Delgado and Alex Schmidtberger are among the top four in the MIAA in tackles. Schmidtberger ranks third with 108, while Delgado ranks fourth with 84. Schmidtberger ranks 5th nationally in tackles per game (12.0), while Delgado ranks 17th (10.5).

Schmidtberger Reaches Career High in Tackles vs MWSU

Senior linebacker Alex Schmidtberger produced a career-high 21 tackles in the 35-27 win over Missouri Western two weeks ago. With the effort, he passed 300 career tackles, just the fourth player in the NCAA Division II era at FHSU to pass that mark. Schmidtberger now has 318 career tackles.

Delgado Reaches Career High in Tackles at ESU

Sophomore linebacker Jose Delgado recorded a career-high 16 tackles at Emporia State last week, just a week after stiting out a game due to injury. He still ranks fourth in the MIAA in tackles with 84, despite playing just eight games so far.

Tigers 2nd in MIAA in Total Defense

Fort Hays State ranks second as a team in the MIAA in total defense. The Tigers are allowing 377.9 yards per game. Northwest Missouri State leads the conference by far, allowing just 257.7 yards per game.

Passing Attack Becoming Stronger

Fort Hays State has thrown for over 300 passing yards in three of the last four games. Quarterback Jacob Mezera threw for a new program record in the Division II era with 446 yards at Pittsburg State in Week 6, then backed it up with 354 yards at Washburn and 309 against Missouri Western.

Brown Solid in the Kicking Game

Fort Hays State kicker Brandon Brown has been solid on field goal attempts so far this season at 15-of-19, averaging an MIAA-best 1.67 field goals per game (4th in the nation). His season long is 49 yards. He has also been impressive on kickoffs, producing 28 touchbacks on 53 kickoffs. He averages 59.6 yards per kickoff to lead the MIAA. FHSU leads the MIAA in kickoff coverage with a net average of 51.9. Missouri Southern is 2nd in that category at 49.5. Brown leads the MIAA in scoring overall with 75 points. His 78.9 percent success rate on field goals ranks him 18th in the nation.

Tigers Reach the Upper Half of MIAA Two Years in a Row
Now in its 11th season as members of the MIAA, Fort Hays State has finished in the
top five of the conference standings in each of the last 2 years. The Tigers posted their
highest-ever finish in the MIAA in 2015 in 3rd place at 8-3. Prior to 2014, the Tigers' highest finish was sixth, occurring in 2009 and 2011. They have finished last twice, ninth twice and eighth twice. Since 1998, the Tigers have finished higher than fifth in a conference (RMAC or MIAA) just four times. Fort Hays State has not reached the NCAA playoffs since 1995, but made its first postseason game appearance since then last year in the Mineral Water Bowl.

Continued Improvement Under Brown

Fort Hays State has seen a one-win improvement over the last four seasons under head coach Chris Brown. After going 4-7 in his first year (2011), the Tigers went 5-6 in 2012, 6-5 in 2013, 7-4 in 2014, and 8-4 in 2015. FHSU tied the school record for wins in a season last year with eight.

Chris Brown - Head Football Coach

Chris Brown enters his sixth season as head coach at Fort Hays State in 2016. He has guided FHSU to 30 wins in five years and coached Fort Hays State to a bowl appearance in 2015 with an 8-4 mark, tying the school record for wins in a season.

Brown guided FHSU to its highest placing in the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association in 2015 with an 8-3 mark, finishing third in the standings. The Tigers earned a spot in the Mineral Water Bowl in Excelsior Springs, Mo. It marked the first postseason game for FHSU Football since the 1996 season.

The Tigers have shown steady progress under Brown, posting a one-win improvement in each of his seasons at the helm. After finishing with a 4-7 mark in his first year (2011), the Tigers finished 5-6 in 2012, 6-5 in 2013, 7-4 in 2014, and 8-4 in 2015. The most impressve feat of the eight-win 2015 season was all wins were in MIAA play, arguably the nation's premier Division II conference. FHSU joined the conference in 2006 and the MIAA has produced the national champion in NCAA Division II football four of the last seven seasons.

Brown, now 30-26 overall, came to Fort Hays State from Washburn University, where he served as the defensive coordinator and defensive secondary coach from 2002-2010 and assistant head coach in 2010.

FHSU enjoyed its most All-MIAA selections under Brown in 2015 with 13. Brown has now coached 53 All-MIAA selections at Fort Hays State, including seven first-team selections.

Brown has coached eight All-Americans at FHSU. That list includes linebacker Alex Whitehill, punter Ethan Kosjer, safety Micheal Jordan, linebacker Brock Long, running back Shaquille Cooper, quarterback Treveon Albert, offensive lineman Matt Erbert, and safety Daniel Lindsey. Three of the eight (Whitehill, Kosjer, and Long) have earned first team honors. Whitehill and Kosjer earned All-America honors in Brown's first year at the helm in 2011, while Jordan earned his honor in 2014. Long, Cooper, Albert, Erbert, and Lindsey all gained All-America status in 2015, the most selections in a season during Fort Hays State's NCAA Division II era. Whitehill is also one of two players to earn CoSIDA Academic All-America honors in Brown's tenure. Jesse Trent was a three-time Academic All-America selection from 2012-14.

Brown also coached two players at FHSU that have signed with NFL teams, which includes safety Nathan Lindsey and wide receiver Ed Williams. Williams has spent two seasons with the Green Bay Packers, signing with the team once again in 2016.

Before coming to Hays, Brown helped Washburn compile a 62-41 record in his nine-year span with the program, which included two NCAA playoff appearances and two bowl wins. In his time at Washburn, Brown coached the 2009 and 2006 MIAA Most Valuable Defensive Players and guided two players selected in the NFL Draft (defensive tackle Trey Lewis-6th round 2007, and cornerback Cary Williams-7th round 2008). Brown also coached six All-Americans, 20 all-region and 41 All-MIAA selections at Washburn. His defense led the MIAA in turnovers gained in three of his final four seasons there, including a school record-tying 23 interceptions in 2007.

Brown joined the Washburn coaching staff after spending three years as the secondary coach at Liberal High School where he helped the team to a mark of 37-5 in his time.

Brown, a native of Liberal, Kansas, is a 1996 graduate of Pittsburg State University where he recorded 470 tackles in 43 starts in his career at free safety. He is one of only three Gorillas to earn All-American honors three times. He was a unanimous All-American First Team selection his senior season and was named the CNN Division II National Player of the Year in 1995. He was also named to the NCAA Quarter Century Team for all players from 1975 to 1999 at free safety. He had a record 21 tackles in the NCAA Division II National Championship as a freshman against Jacksonville State. Brown was inducted into the Pittsburg State Athletic Hall of Fame in 2006 and the MIAA Hall of Fame in 2015. He and his wife, Daphne, have two sons, Hunter and Hayden.

Game Recap

MARYVILLE, Mo. – A flurry of early turnovers and miscues led to a 35-7 halftime deficit and eventually a 45-24 loss for Fort Hays State to No. 3 Northwest Missouri State on Saturday (Oct. 24).

Consecutive interceptions on Fort Hays State's first two drives of the game led to a quick 14-0 deficit. The first gave NWMSU a 25-yard field to score, then the second went 42 yards to the endzone for a touchdown. It all happened in a matter of the first 3:22 of the game.

Eventually, Northwest Missouri State stretched its lead to 35-0 by the 1:53 mark of the second quarter before FHSU finally showed signs of life. Daniel Lindsey returned a kickoff 85 yards for a touchdown with 1:39 remaining in the first half to get FHSU on the board.

The Tigers quickly gained momentum in the second half when DeAndre James picked off at the FHSU 37-yardline and returned it 46 yards to the NWMSU 17-yardline. Treveon Albert found the endzone on a 3-yard rush to make it 35-14 with 13:03 remaining in the third quarter. The FHSU defense had a solid effort on the next NWMSU series and the Tigers got the ball back at their own 42-yardline moments later.

After a pair of good runs, the momentum FHSU built all of the sudden vanished as Albert fumbled the ball on a rush at the NWMSU 37-yardline. The Bearcats went on to score a touchdown off the turnover and seized control of the game once again, leading 42-14. Fort Hays State finished with four turnovers in the game. NWMSU capitalized on all four, scoring 24 points off turnovers.

The Tigers did not have enough time for a comeback from that point. Albert found Evan Jennings on a 44-yard touchdown pass at 2:27 in the third quarter to make it 42-21, then Drew O'Brien had a field goal at 6:31 in the fourth quarter for the eventual final of 45-24.

The Bearcats held FHSU to 277 yards of total offense and a season-low 182 rushing yards. Albert led the Tigers in rushing with 74 yards, Derek Kendall-Campbell had 62 yards, and Shaquille Cooper added 47. Albert was just 6-of-18 passing for 86 yards with three interceptions.

Brady Bolles threw for 329 yards and three touchdowns for the Bearcats. Phil Jackson racked up 150 rushing yards and two touchdowns. Brock Long led the Tiger defense once again with 17 tackles, including six for loss, and two sacks. DeAndre James had 10 tackles to go with his

The loss dropped the Tigers into a fourth-place tie with Pittsburg State in the MIAA standings, both at 5-3. Central Missouri, now 6-2, pulled into third alone with a win over Northeastern State. Emporia State remained in second at 7-1 with a win over Missouri Western.
