Fort Hays State Individual Notes

#2 Shaquille Cooper, Junior, Running Back

- Leads team in rushing with 256 yards on 46 carries, averaging 5.6 yards per attempt.
- Ranks 3rd in the MIAA in rushing yards per game (85.3).

2015

- All-America Honorable Mention selection by Don Hansen in 2015.
- D2CCA All-Super Region 3 First Team at RB in 2015.
- Unanimous All-MIAA First Team selection at RB in 2015 - Only offensive player on the first team to be selected unanimously.
- Rushed for 1,441 yards and added 309 receiving yards with a total of 14 touchdowns in 2015.
- Rushed for a career-high 263 yards in Week 2 of 2015 against Northeastern State.
- Rushed for over 100 yards in 6 of 12 games in 2015.
- Had 1,753 all-purpose yards in 2015, averaging 146.1 per game.
- Ranked 2nd in the MIAA in rushing yards per game in 2015 (120.1).
- The 1,441 rushing yards in 2015 were third most for a season in school history.

Career

- Now has 9 career 100-yard rushing games with in just 17 career games at running back.
- Has 2 career 200-yard rushing games.
- Produced a career-high 285 all-purpose yards in Week 2 of 2015 against Northeastern State.
- Sat out of school for two years (2013 and 2014).

2012

- Converted to running back the final 4 games of the 2012 season and rushed for over 100 yards in three of those four games.
- Played the first seven games of the 2012 season at defensive back, recording 10 tackles.
- Averaged 7.6 yards per carry in just four games at running back in 2012, going for 356 yards on 47 carries with four touchdowns.

#3 Kenneth Iheme, Senior, Running Back

- Averaging 37.7 yards per kick return.
- Averaging 5.5 yards per rush with 122 yards on 22 attempts.
- Missed the 2015 season due to injury.

2014

- Ranked second on the team in rushing in 2014 with 557 yards on 128 carries, averaging 4.4 yards per attempt.
- Longest rush of the 2014 season was 44 yards at Nebraska-Kearney.
- Recorded 4 touchdowns in 2014, three rushing and one receiving.
- Rushed for over 100 yards in two of the last three games of the 2014 season.
- Single-game high for rushing yards was 149 at Nebraska-Kearney in 2014.

#4 Jacob Mezera, Sophomore, Quarterback

- Averaging 179.3 passing yards per game with a 52.4 percent completion percentage.
- Produced 4 total TDs in Week 3 vs UCO with 3 passing and 1 rushing.
- Threw for a season-high 250 yards against UCO in Week 3.
- Saw action in 5 games as a reserve in 2015, completing 2-of-4 passes for 12 yards.

#5 Raheeme Dumas, Senior, Defensive Back

- Had a 25-yard interception return for a TD in the season opener.
- Has 2 interception returns for TDs in his career.
- Has 4 passes defended so far this year, ranking 5th in the MIAA.
- Ranked 2nd in the MIAA in passes defended in 2015 (4 INTs, 14 pass break-ups).
- Led FHSU in interceptions in 2015 with 4.
- Has 107 tackles, 6 interceptions, and 26 pass break-ups in his career.

#6 Doyin Jibowu, Sophomore, Defensive Back

- Recorded 11 tackles in the season opener, the 3rd 10+ tackle game of his career.
- Ranked 5th on the team in tackles with 22.
- All-MIAA Third Team selection as a defensive back in 2015.
- Started all 12 games at bandit in 2015, ranking 2nd on the team in tackles with 91.
- Reached double digits in tackles in two games in 2015, producing 12 against Washburn and 15 against Missouri Western.
- Recorded a fumble recovery for a touchdown, returning the ball 8 yards against Missouri Southern in Week 10 in 2015.
- Tied for third on the team in sacks in 2015 with 3.
- Tied for second on the team in interceptions in 2015 with 2.

#8 Sie Doe, Jr., Senior, Defensive Lineman

- Leads the MIAA in sacks with 4, recording two in Week 1 and one each in Weeks 2 and 3.
- Reached a career-high 13 tackles in Week 3 against Central Oklahoma.
- Earned MIAA Co-Defensive Athlete of the Week for Week 3.
- All-MIAA Honorable Mention as a defensive lineman in 2015.
- His 15 Tackles for Loss in 2015 tied for 8th most in a single season at FHSU.
- Ranked 2nd on the team in sacks in 2015 with 6.5.
- Finished 2015 with 70 tackles to rank 6th on the team.
- As a sophomore at Butte (Calif.) College, earned all-region and all-conference first team honors, recording 58 tackles, 10 sacks and 15.5 tackles for loss.
- Had 96 tackles, 16 sacks, and 24.5 tackles for loss over 2 seasons at Butte College.

#11 Connor Shedeed, Sophomore, Defensive Back

- Reached double figures in tackles for first time in career with 11 at Central Missouri in Week 2.
- Tied for the team lead in forced fumbles with 2.
- Recorded 33 tackles in 2015 and made 1 start in 12 contests.

#21 DeAndre James, Senior, Defensive Back/Kick Returner

- All-MIAA Honorable Mention selection at kick returner as a freshman in 2013.
- Averaged 25.2 yards per kick return in 2013, 20.5 yards per return in 2014, and 24.5 yards per return in 2015.
- Had an 89-yard kickoff return for TD in season opener of 2014.
- Has 1,117 career kick return yards (3rd all-time at FHSU).
- Had 84 tackles, 2 interceptions, 2 forced fumbles, and 2 fumble recoveries in 2015.
- Has 134 tackles and 3 interceptions in his career.

#25 Jose Delgado, Sophomore, Linebacker

- Ranked 4th in the MIAA in tackles with 36, averaging 12 per game.
- Reached double figures in tackles in two games this year.
- Had 64 tackles, 1.5 sacks, and 1 interception returned 43 yards for a touchdown in 2015.
- Played in 10 games and made four starts, but sat out 2 games with injury in 2015.

#26 Bobby Stinson, Sophomore, Defensive Back

- Recorded 61 tackles and 10 pass break-ups in 2015.
- Ranked 2nd on the team in pass break-ups in 2015.

#28 Tyler Bacon, Junior, Wide Receiver

- Has a team-best 14 catches for 138 yards.
- Started 11 games in 2015 and made 10 catches for 64 yards.

#29 Malik Thomas, Redshirt-Freshman, Running Back

- Ranks 5th in the MIAA in rushing yards per game (72.5), averaging 6.9 yards per carry.
- Started the first game of 2015 but suffered a season-ending injury.

#34 Tanner Hoekman, Redshirt-Freshman, Defensive Back

- Has 17 tackles, an interception, and a fumble recovery through 3 games.

#40 Alex Schmidtberger, Senior, Defensive Back

- Ranked 2nd in MIAA in tackles with 41, averaging 13.7 per game.
- Recorded a career-best 17 tackles at Central Missouri in Week 2.
- Reached double figures in tackles in all 3 games this season.

2015

- Tied for third on the team in tackles (85) in 2015 despite playing in just nine games.
- Ranked 9th in the MIAA in tackles per game in 2015 (9.4).

Career

- Two-time All-MIAA Honorable Mention selection at linebacker (2014 and 2015).
- Has 240 career tackles and 6 career interceptions.
- Reached double figures in tackles 9 times in his career.

#47 Justin McPhail, Redshirt-Senior, Linebacker

- Has 23 tackles ranking 4th on the team, averaging 7.7 per game.

Career

- Two-time All-MIAA Third Team selection at linebacker (2013 and 2014).
- Led FHSU in tackles in 2013 (90) and 2014 (108).
- Recorded a career-high 16 tackles against Missouri Southern in 2014.
- Reached double digits in tackles in a game 7 times in his career.
- Has 230 career tackles.

#73 Mason Dickey, Senior, Offensive Lineman

- Made 36 consecutive starts on offensive line, with 34 of those at right guard.

#79 Chico Feltenberger, Senior, Offensive Lineman

- All-MIAA Honorable Mention on the offensive line in 2015.
- Started 23 games at left guard in his career.

#82 Bilal Salat, Senior, Wide Receiver

- Has 26 career starts at wide receiver.
- Has 17 career receptions for 276 yards, averaging 16.2 yards per catch.

#85 J.J. Lewis, Junior, Tight End

- Has 3 catches for 31 yards this season.
- Had 1 reception for 32 yards and a touchdown in 2015.

#89 Isaiah Maxi, Senior, Wide Receiver

- Has 6 catches for 88 yards so far this season.
- Recorded 11 catches for 162 yards in 2015.
- Has 24 career starts with 48 receptions for 552 yards.

#94 Noah Debban, Junior, Defensive Lineman

- Has 9 tackles through 3 games.
- Started 6 of 12 games in 2015 and recorded 24 tackles.

#95 Andre McKinnon, Redshirt-Senior, Defensive Lineman

- Has 9 tackles through 3 games.
- Sat out the 2015 season.
- Recorded 40 tackles and 2 sacks in 2014.

#96 Luke Wright, Junior, Defensive Lineman

- Has 4 tackles through 3 games.
- Recorded 27 tackles in 2015 with a sack and 2 fumble recoveries.
- Started 11 of 12 games on the defensive line in 2015.

#97 Nathan Shepherd, Junior, Defensive Lineman

- Has 17 tackles through 3 games with 1 sack.
- All-MIAA Third Team on the defensive line in 2015.
- Started all 12 games of the 2015 season at defensive tackle.
- Blocked 2 kicks in the win against Northeastern State in Week 2 of 2015.
- Finished with 69 tackles and 3 sacks for the 2015 season.
- Earned Mineral Water Bowl Defensive MVP Honors with 14 tackles against Minnesota-Duluth.

A Tiger Loss Would...

- Snap FHSU's 2-game win streak over NSU.

By The Numbers

30- The Tigers are 19-2 under head coach Chris Brown when reaching 30 points in a game. FHSU has won its last nine games when scoring at least 30 points, dating back to the 2013 season.

Tigers Go Over 200 Rushing Yards 8 Times In 2015; Twice So Far This Year

Fort Hays State rushed for 200 or more yards in 8 of 12 contests in 2015. The Tigers reached 375 rushing yards in a game twice in 2015, occurring in Week 2 vs. Northeastern State and Week 7 vs. Emporia State. FHSU led the MIAA in rushing yards per game (251.1) last year and currently rank 4th this season at 171.3 per game. The Tigers reached the 200-yard rushing mark twice this season, producing a season-high 225 yards last week against UCO.

All-Time Series Tied

The all-time series between FHSU and NSU is tied 2-2. FHSU has won both meetings since NSU joined the MIAA, claiming wins in 2014 and 2015. NSU won the first two meetings back in 1989 and 1990 when FHSU was still a member of the NAIA.

Tigers Set Rushing Record in 2015

Fort Hays State set a new single-season school record for rushing yards in a season with 3,013, eclipsing the old mark of 2,996 from 1991. Running back Shaquille Cooper and quarterback Treveon Albert combined for 2,669 of those yards, just the second 1,000-yard single-season rushing duo in Fort Hays State history. Cooper ran for 1,441 yards and Albert added 1,228 yards on the ground. The only other time FHSU had two players rush for 1,000 yards in the same season was 2004 (Reed Gottula and Jordan Hickle). As a team, FHSU averaged 251.1 rushing yards per game and rushed for over 300 yards four times in 2015.

Tigers Lead MIAA in Rushing Offense in 2015

Fort Hays State led the MIAA in rushing yards per game, averaging 251.1. The Tigers ranked 13th in NCAA Division II in rushing yards per game. The Tigers rushed for a season-high 375 yards twice this year, against Northeastern State in Week 2 and Emporia State in Week 7. FHSU went over 300 yards as a team four times in 2015. FHSU also led the conference in yards per carry, averaging 5.4 yards per rush. The Tigers had 2 of the top 4 rushers in the conference. Running back Shaquille Cooper was second in the MIAA at 120.1 yards per game, while quarterback Treveon Albert ranked fourth at 102.3 yards per game. Cooper ranked 9th in the nation in total rushing yards (1,441) and 16th in rushing yards per game. FHSU ranks 4th in the MIAA in rushing yards per game so far, averaging 171.3 per contest.

Tigers Return 9 of 11 Defensive Starters from 2015

Fort Hays State returns nine of 11 defensive starters from last year. All four starters on the defensive line return, which includes All-MIAA selections Nathan Shepherd and Sie Doe, Jr. At linebacker, Alex Schmidtberger earned All-MIAA honors for the second straight year. Doyin Jibowu also earned All-MIAA honors as a defensive back, playing the bandit position for FHSU. DeAndre James, the starting safety, earned All-MIAA honors in 2013 as a kick returner. Two-time All-MIAA selection Justin McPhail also returns at linebacker after redshirting last year with an injury.

Keeping Opponents Under 30

FHSU won 6 of 7 games in which it held its opponent under 30 in 2015. FHSU allowed 23.9 points per game last year to rank 4th in the conference. After 3 games this year, Fort Hays State ranks 2nd in the MIAA in scoring defense allowing 21.3 points per game. Northwest Missouri State leads the MIAA, allowing just 11.7 points per game.

Tigers at Home Since Joining MIAA

Since joining the MIAA in 2006, the Tigers are 30-30 at home. The Tigers are 15-14 at home under head coach Chris Brown, including a 5-1 mark at home in 2015. They are 2-0 at home so far this season.

Tigers on the Road Since Joining MIAA

Since joining the MIAA in 2006, the Tigers are 19-34 on the road. However, the Tigers are 16-12 on the road under head coach Chris Brown. The Tigers went 3-22 on the road in their first five seasons with the conference, but have went 16-12 since.

Nine 100-Yard Rushing Games; Two 200-Yard Games for Cooper

Shaquille Cooper returned to FHSU in 2015 after sitting out of school for two years. Cooper converted to running back for FHSU from defensive back after seven games in 2012 and rushed for over 100 yards in three of the final four games that year. He rushed career-high 263 yards against Northeastern State in Week 2 in 2015. He has nine 100-yard games career games at running back. The 263 rushing yards against Northeastern State was fourth-most by an FHSU player in a game in school history. Cooper had two 200-plus yard rushing games in 2015, 263 against Northeastern State and 216 against Emporia State. Cooper looks to become the 4th Tiger in history to record 10 100-yard rushing games. The school record is 13, held by Clint Bedore.

Winning the Turnover Battle

Fort Hays State kicked fourth in the MIAA in turnover margin in 2015 at +9. FHSU finished with 29 turnovers gained and 20 lost. Northwest Missouri State led the conference at +19, while Central Missouri and Emporia State both had margins of +12. So far, the Tigers are +4 in turnover margin this year.

Kick Return Success

Fort Hays State led the MIAA in kick return average last year, averaging 22.5 yards per return. FHSU was the only team in the MIAA with 2 kick returns for touchdowns in 2015. The Tigers are averaging 23.7 yards per return so far this year, which ranks 2nd in the MIAA.

Doe, Jr. Leads MIAA Lead in Sacks

Defensive end Sie Doe, Jr., is leading the MIAA lead in sacks after 3 weeks of play. He has 4 overall after 2 in the season opener and one each in Weeks 2 and 3. Doe ranks 2nd in the MIAA in tackles for loss with 5.5 so far.

Brown Solid in the Kicking Game

Fort Hays State kicker Brandon Brown is perfect on field goal attempts so far this season at 6-of-6. His season long is 40 yards. He has also been impressive on kickoffs, producing 11 touchbacks on 17 kickoffs. He averages 64.5 yards per kickoff, just a half yard under the maximum possible. FHSU by far leads the MIAA in kickoff coverage with a net average of 58.4. Missouri Southern is 2nd in that category at 49.6. Brown ranks 5th in the MIAA in scoring, averaging 8.3 points per game.

Tigers Reach the Upper Half of MIAA Two Years in a Row

Now in its 11th season as members of the MIAA, Fort Hays State has finished in the top five of the conference standings in each of the last 2 years. The Tigers posted their highest-ever finish in the MIAA in 2015 in 3rd place at 8-3. Prior to 2014, the Tigers' highest finish was sixth, occurring in 2009 and 2011. They have finished last twice, ninth twice and eighth twice. Since 1998, the Tigers have finished higher than fifth in a conference (RMAC or MIAA) just four times. Fort Hays State has not reached the NCAA playoffs since 1995, but made its first postseason game appearance since then last year in the Mineral Water Bowl.

Continued Improvement Under Brown

Fort Hays State has seen a one-win improvement over the last four seasons under head coach Chris Brown. After going 4-7 in his first year (2011), the Tigers went 5-6 in 2012, 6-5 in 2013, 7-4 in 2014, and 8-4 in 2015. FHSU tied the school record for wins in a season last year with eight.

13 All-MIAA Selections in 2015

Fort Hays State had 13 players selected to the All-MIAA Team this year. Earning first team honors were running back Shaquille Cooper, defensive back Daniel Lindsey, and offensive lineman Matt Erbert. Earning second team honors were linebacker Brock Long and quarterback Treveon Albert. Third team honors went to defensive lineman Nathan Shepherd and defensive back Doyin Jibowu. Honorable mention selections went to Luke Edney (OL), Chico Feltenberger (OL), Sie Doe, Jr., (DL), Alex Schmidtberger (LB), Drew O'Brien (K), and Jordon Stangler (P).

Chris Brown - Head Football Coach

Chris Brown enters his sixth season as head coach at Fort Hays State in 2016. He has guided FHSU to 30 wins in five years and coached Fort Hays State to a bowl appearance in 2015 with an 8-4 mark, tying the school record for wins in a season.

Brown guided FHSU to its highest placing in the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association in 2015 with an 8-3 mark, finishing third in the standings. The Tigers earned a spot in the Mineral Water Bowl in Excelsior Springs, Mo. It marked the first postseason game for FHSU Football since the 1996 season.

The Tigers have shown steady progress under Brown, posting a one-win improvement in each of his seasons at the helm. After finishing with a 4-7 mark in his first year (2011), the Tigers finished 5-6 in 2012, 6-5 in 2013, 7-4 in 2014, and 8-4 in 2015. The most impressive feat of the eight-win 2015 season was all wins were in MIAA play, arguably the nation's premier Division II conference. FHSU joined the conference in 2006 and the MIAA has produced the national champion in NCAA Division II football four of the last seven seasons.

Brown, now 30-26 overall, came to Fort Hays State from Washburn University, where he served as the defensive coordinator and defensive secondary coach from 2002-2010 and assistant head coach in 2010.

FHSU enjoyed its most All-MIAA selections under Brown in 2015 with 13. Brown has now coached 53 All-MIAA selections at Fort Hays State, including seven first-team selections.

Brown has coached eight All-Americans at FHSU. That list includes linebacker Alex Whitehill, punter Ethan Kosjer, safety Micheal Jordan, linebacker Brock Long, running back Shaquille Cooper, quarterback Treveon Albert, offensive lineman Matt Erbert, and safety Daniel Lindsey. Three of the eight (Whitehill, Kosjer, and Long) have earned first team honors. Whitehill and Kosjer earned All-America honors in Brown's first year at the helm in 2011, while Jordan earned his honor in 2014. Long, Cooper, Albert, Erbert, and Lindsey all gained All-America status in 2015, the most selections in a season during Fort Hays State's NCAA Division II era. Whitehill is also one of two players to earn CoSIDA Academic All-America honors in Brown's tenure. Jesse Trent was a three-time Academic All-America selection from 2012-14.

Brown also coached two players at FHSU that have signed with NFL teams, which includes safety Nathan Lindsey and wide receiver Ed Williams. Williams has spent two seasons with the Green Bay Packers, signing with the team once again in 2016.

Before coming to Hays, Brown helped Washburn compile a 62-41 record in his nine-year span with the program, which included two NCAA playoff appearances and two bowl wins. In his time at Washburn, Brown coached the 2009 and 2006 MIAA Most Valuable Defensive Players and guided two players selected in the NFL Draft (defensive tackle Trey Lewis-6th round 2007, and cornerback Cary Williams-7th round 2008). Brown also coached six All-Americans, 20 all-region and 41 All-MIAA selections at Washburn. His defense led the MIAA in turnovers gained in three of his final four seasons there, including a school record-tying 23 interceptions in 2007.

Brown joined the Washburn coaching staff after spending three years as the secondary coach at Liberal High School where he helped the team to a mark of 37-5 in his time.

Brown, a native of Liberal, Kansas, is a 1996 graduate of Pittsburg State University where he recorded 470 tackles in 43 starts in his career at free safety. He is one of only three Gorillas to earn All-American honors three times. He was a unanimous All-American First Team selection his senior season and was named the CNN Division II National Player of the Year in 1995. He was also named to the NCAA Quarter Century Team for all players from 1975 to 1999 at free safety. He had a record 21 tackles in the NCAA Division II National Championship as a freshman against Jacksonville State. Brown was inducted into the Pittsburg State Athletic Hall of Fame in 2006 and the MIAA Hall of Fame in 2015. He and his wife, Daphne, have two sons, Hunter and Hayden.

Game Recap

HAYS, Kan. - On an odd Thursday night (Sept. 10) at Lewis Field Stadium in Hays, Fort Hays State endured a two-hour weather delay and overcame several miscues to escape with a 27-13 win on its home field against Northeastern State. Tied 13-13 in the fourth quarter, a 93-yard touchdown run by Shaquille Cooper with 2:19 remaining in the game proved to be the winning score, lifting the Tigers to a 2-0 start to the season.

Cooper had a monster game at running back, rushing for 263 yards on 29 carries and one touchdown - the 93-yard dash to put the Tigers in front for the first time all night. He averaged 9.1 yards per carry on the night. Cooper also collected 22 yards of receiving for a total of 285 all-purpose yards in the game. He had 195 all-purpose in week one against Central Oklahoma with 163 rushing yards and 32 receiving yards. Cooper now has 426 rushing yards in the first two games of the season, averaging 8.5 yards per carry.

Derek Kendall-Campbell was also key in the rushing game, filling in for a cramping Cooper in the third and fourth quarters when Cooper needed rest. Kendall-Campbell found the endzone twice, scoring with 10:09 remaining in the third from 10 yards out to help FHSU tie the game 13-13, then the game sealer with 1:02 remaining to push the FHSU lead to 27-13.

The Tigers chewed off 375 yards rushing as a team. Tremon Albert added to that attack with 58 yards. His arm was seldom utilized in the game, going just 6-of-14 passing for 37 yards. Andrew Flory was the top receiver with 18 yards on three catches.

Outside of the massive Tiger rushing attack, execution lacked at times as the Tigers gave away three fumbles on the night, leaving the RiverHawks in the game. But FHSU made up for it on special teams by blocking three kicks on the night. Daniel Lindsey blocked a field goal in the first quarter and Nathan Shepherd tallied two blocked kicks, one on a field goal and the other on an extra point. His blocked field goal in the fourth quarter was key to keeping the game tied with 8:34 remaining.

Northeastern State led early with a first quarter touchdown, then extended its lead to 13-3 in the second quarter. A pair of Drew O'Brien field goals (36 and 19 yards) in the first half kept the Tigers within striking distance at the break before the Tigers made their comeback in the second half.

Kevin Pantastico led Northeastern State at quarterback, throwing for 192 yards on 23-of-43 passing. Garrett Powell had 100 yards of receiving and Joel Rockmore had 86 yards on the ground for the RiverHawks.

Defensively, Tiger linebackers Brock Long and Alex Schmidtberger tied with a team-high 13 tackles. Long recorded two sacks, while Schmidtberger had 1.5 sacks. The Tigers had a total of five sacks in the game. Raheeme Dumas had a 40-yard interception late in the game.

The Tigers started 2-0 for the first time since the 2010 season. FHSU also claimed a win in a home opener for the first time since 2011.
