Fort Hays State Individual Notes

#2 Shaquille Cooper, Junior, Running Back

-Rushed for 98 yards in the season opener, averaging 8.2 yards per carry.

-Ranks 4th in the MIAA in rushing yards per game.

-All-America Honorable Mention selection by Don Hansen in 2015.

-D2CCA All-Super Region 3 First Team at RB in 2015.

-Unanimous All-MIAA First Team selection at RB in 2015 - Only offensive player on the first team to be selected unanimously.

-Rushed for 1,441 yards and added 309 receiving yards with a total of 14 touchdowns in 2015.
-Rushed for a career-high 263 yards in Week 2 of 2015 against Northeastern State.
-Rushed for over 100 yards in 6 of 12 games in 2015.
-Had 1,753 all-purpose yards in 2015, averaging 146.1 per game.

-Ranked 2nd in the MIAA in rushing yards per game in 2015 (120.1).

-The 1,441 rushing yards in 2015 were third most for a season in school history.

-Now has 9 career 100-yard rushing games with in just 16 career games at running back.
-Has 2 career 200-yard rushing games.
-Produced a career-high 285 all-purpose yards in Week 2 of 2015 against Northeastern State. -Sat out of school for two years (2013 and 2014).

-Converted to running back the final 4 games of the 2012 season and rushed for over 100 yards in three of those four games.

-Played the first seven games of the 2012 season at defensive back, recording 10 tackles.

-Averaged 7.6 yards per carry in just four games at running back in 2012, going for 356 yards on 47 carries with four touchdowns.

#3 Kenneth Iheme, Senior, Running Back

-Rushed for 9 yards on 4 carries in the season opener.

-Missed the 2015 season due to injury.

2014

-Ranked second on the team in rushing in 2014 with 557 yards on 128 carries, averaging 4.4

Longest rush of the 2014 season was 44 yards at Nebraska-Kearney.

-Recorded 4 touchdowns in 2014, three rushing and one receiving.
-Rushed for over 100 yards in two of the last three games of the 2014 season.
-Single-game high for rushing yards was 149 at Nebraska-Kearney in 2014.

#4 Jacob Mezera, Sophomore, Quarterback

-Threw for 147 yards on 17-of-32 passing in the season opener.
-Saw action in 5 games as a reserve in 2015, completing 2-of-4 passes for 12 yards.

#5 Raheeme Dumas, Senior, Defensive Back

-Had a 25-yard interception return for a TD in the season opener

-Has 2 interception returns for TDs in his career.

-Has 3 passes defended so far this year, ranking 2nd in the MIAA.

-Ranked 2nd in the MIAA in passes defended in 2015 (4 INTs, 14 pass break-ups).

-Led FHSU in interceptions in 2015 with 4.

-Has 102 tackles, 6 interceptions, and 25 pass break-ups in his career.

#6 Doyin Jibowu, Sophomore, Defensive Back

-Recorded 11 tackles in the season opener, the 3rd 10+ tackle game of his career

-All-MIAA Third Team selection as a defensive back in 2015.

-Started all 12 games at bandit in 2015, ranking 2nd on the team in tackles with 91.

-Reached double digits in tackles in two games in 2015, producing 12 against Washburn and 15 against Missouri Western.

-Recorded a fumble recovery for a touchdown, returning the ball 8 yards against Missouri Southern in Week 10 in 2015.

-Tied for third on the team in sacks in 2015 with 3.

-Tied for second on the team in interceptions in 2015 with 2.

#8 Sie Doe, Jr., Senior, Defensive Lineman

-Recorded the team's only 2 sacks against Missouri Southern in the season opener.

-Reached a career-high 10 tackles in the season opener against Missouri Southern.

-All-MIAA Honorable Mention as a defensive lineman in 2015.

-His 15 Tackles for Loss in 2015 tied for 8th most in a single season at FHSU.

-Ranked 2nd on the team in sacks in 2015 with 6.5.

-Finished 2015 with 70 tackles to rank 6th on the team.

-As a sophomore at Butte (Calif.) College, earned all-region and all-conference first team honors, recording 58 tackles, 10 sacks and 15.5 tackles for loss.

-Had 96 tackles, 16 sacks, and 24.5 tackles for loss over 2 seasons at Butte College.

#11 Connor Shedeed, Sophomore, Defensive Back

-Recorded 33 tackles in 2015 and made 1 start in 12 contests.

#21 DeAndre James, Senior, Defensive Back/Kick Returner

-Had six tackles in the season opener against Missouri Southern. -All-MIAA Honorable Mention selection at kick returner as a freshman in 2013.

-Averaged 25.2 yards per kick return in 2013, 20.5 yards per return in 2014, and 24.5 yards per

return in 2015.

-Had an 89-yard kickoff return for TD in season opener of 2014.

-Has 1,048 career kick return yards (3rd all-time at FHSU).

-Had 84 tackles, 2 interceptions, 2 forced fumbles, and 2 fumble recoveries in 2015.

-Has 128 tackles and 3 interceptions in his career.

#25 Jose Delgado, Sophomore, Linebacker-Led the team in tackles in the season opener with a career-high 14, adding a forced fumble.

-Had 64 tackles, 1.5 sacks, and 1 interception returned 43 yards for a touchdown in 2015.

-Played in 10 games and made four starts, but sat out 2 games with injury in 2015.

#26 Bobby Stinson, Sophomore, Defensive Back

-Recorded 61 tackles and 10 pass break-ups in 2015.

-Ranked 2nd on the team in pass break-ups in 2015.

#28 Tyler Bacon, Junior, Wide Receiver

-Had a team-best 6 catches and 71 receiving yards in the season opener against MSSU.

-Started 11 games in 2015 and made 10 catches for 64 yards.

#29 Malik Thomas, Redshirt-Freshman, Running Back

-Had a team-best 115 rushing yards in the season opener against MSSU.
-Ranked 2nd in the MIAA in rushing yards per game.
-Leads the MIAA in yards per carry (8.8).

-Started the first game of 2015 but suffered a season-ending injury.

-Recorded three carries for 24 yards, averaging 8.0 yards per carry before his injury.

#34 Tanner Hoekman, Redshirt-Freshman, Defensive Back

-Recorded 8 tackles and 1.5 tackles for loss in his collegiate debut against Missouri Southern.

#40 Alex Schmidtberger, Senior, Defensive Back

-Recorded 13 tackles in the season opener.

2015

-Tied for third on the team in tackles (85) in 2015 despite playing in just nine games. -Ranked 9th in the MIAA in tackles per game in 2015 (9.4). -Had a career-high 14 tackles against Pittsburg State in Week 4 in 2015.

-Two-time All-MIAA Honorable Mention selection at linebacker (2014 and 2015).

-Has 223 career tackles and 6 career interceptions.

-Reached double figures in tackles 8 times in his career.

#42 Dalton Gould, Senior, Linebacker

-Has 30 tackles in 23 career games played.

#47 Justin McPhail, Redshirt-Senior, Linebacker

-Had 7 tackles in the season opener against MSSU.

-Two-time All-MIAA Third Team selection at linebacker (2013 and 2014).

-Led FHSU in tackles in 2013 (90) and 2014 (108).

-Recorded a career-high 16 tackles against Missouri Southern in 2014.

-Reached double digits in tackles in a game six times in his career.

#50 Wyatt Parker, Sophomore, Defensive Lineman

-Recorded 12 tackles and 1 interception in 2015.

#73 Mason Dickey, Senior, Offensive Lineman

-Made 34 consecutive starts on offensive line, the first 33 at right guard before moving to left tackle.

#79 Chico Feltenberger, Senior, Offensive Lineman-All-MIAA Honorable Mention on the offensive line in 2015.

-Started 21 games at left guard in his career.

#80 Kenton Ubelaker, Sophomore, Wide Receiver -Finished with 6 catches for 69 yards in 2015.

#82 Bilal Salat, Senior, Wide Receiver

-Has 25 career starts at wide receiver. -Has 15 career receptions for 264 yards, averaging 17.6 yards per catch.

#85 J.J. Lewis, Junior, Tight End

-Had 2 catches for 14 yards in the season opener. -Had 1 reception for 32 yards and a touchdown in 2015.

#89 Isaiah Maxi, Senior, Wide Receiver

-Had 3 catches for 18 yards in the season opener against MSSU.

-Recorded 11 catches for 162 yards in 2015.

-Has 22 career starts with 45 receptions for 482 yards.

#94 Noah Debban, Junior, Defensive Lineman-Recorded 5 tackles in the season opener.

-Started 6 of 12 games in 2015 and recorded 24 tackles.

#95 Andre McKinnon, Redshirt-Senior, Defensive Lineman -Recorded 5 tackles in the season opener against MSSU.

-Sat out the 2015 season. -Recorded 40 tackles and 2 sacks in 2014.

#96 Luke Wright, Junior, Defensive Lineman

-Recorded 2 tackles in the season opener against MSSU.
-Recorded 27 tackles in 2015 with a sack and 2 fumble recoveries.
-Started 11 of 12 games on the defensive line in 2015.

#97 Nathan Shepherd, Junior, Defensive Lineman

Fort Hays State Team Notes

Tigers Go Over 200 Rushing Yards 8 Times In 2015

Fort Hays State rushed for 200 or more yards in 8 of 12 contests in 2015. FHSU rushed for at least 200 yards as a team for eight straight contests going back to 2014 until the streak ended in Week 6 last year at Missouri Western. The Tigers reached 375 rushing yards in a game twice in 2015, occurring in Week 2 vs. Northeastern State and Week 7 vs. Emporia State. FHSU led the MIAA in rushing yards per game (251.1). In the season opener, the Tigers reached the 200-yard rushing mark once again, producing 207 yards on the ground as a team.

UCM Leads All-Time Series

Central Missouri leads the all-time series with FHSU 8-4. The Mules won the first eight contests between the teams since 2006, when FHSU joined the MIAA, but the Tigers have won the last two contests in 2014 and 2015.

Tigers Set Rushing Record in 2015

Fort Hays State set a new single-season school record for rushing yards in a season with 3,013, eclipsing the old mark of 2,996 from 1991. Running back Shaquille Cooper and quarterback Treveon Albert combined for 2,669 of those yards, just the second 1,000-yard single-season rushing duo in Fort Hays State history. Cooper ran for 1,441 yards and Albert added 1,228 yards on the ground. The only other time FHSU had two players rush for 1,000 yards in the same season was 2004 (Reed Gottula and Jordan Hickel). As a team, FHSU averaged 251.1 rushing yards per game and rushed for over 300 yards four times in 2015.

Tigers Lead MIAA in Rushing Offense in 2015

Fort Hays State led the MIAA in rushing yards per game, averaging 251.1. The Tigers ranked 13th in NCAA Division II in rushing yards per game. The Tigers rushed for a season-high 375 yards twice this year, against Northeastern State in Week 2 and Emporia State in Week 7. FHSU went over 300 yards as a team four times in 2015. FHSU also led the conference in yards per carry, averaging 5.4 yards per rush. The Tigers had 2 of the top 4 rushers in the conference. Running back . Shaquille Cooper is second in the MIAA at 120.1 yards per game, while quarterback Treveon Albert ranked fourth at 102.3 yards per game. Cooper ranked 9th in the nation in total rushing yards (1,441) and 16th in rushing yards per game. FHSU ranks 3rd in the MIAA in rushing yards per game so far with Malik Thomas ranked second individually and Cooper ranked fourth individually.

Keeping Opponents Under 30

FHSU won 6 of 7 games in which it held its opponent under 30 in 2015. FHSU allowed 23.9 points per game last year to rank 4th in the conference. After 1 game this year, Fort Hays State leads the MIAA in scoring defense after allowing just 10 points in the season opener.

Tigers at Home Since Joining MIAA

Since joining the MIAA in 2006, the Tigers are 29-30 at home. The Tigers are 14-14 at home under head coach Chris Brown, including a 5-1 mark at home in 2015. They are 1-0 at home so far this season.

Tigers on the Road Since Joining MIAA

Since joining the MIAA in 2006, the Tigers are 19-33 on the road. However, the Tigers are 16-11 on the road under head coach Chris Brown. FHSU went 5-1 on the road last year and is 3-2 so far this year. The Tigers went 3-22 on the road in their first five seasons with the conference, but have went 16-11 since.

Nine 100-Yard Rushing Games; Two 200-Yard Games for Cooper Shaquille Cooper returned to FHSU in 2015 after sitting out of school for two years. Cooper converted to running back for FHSU from defensive back after seven games in 2012 and rushed for over 100 yards in three of the final four games that year. He rushed career-high 263 yards against Northeastern State in Week 2 in 2015. He has nine 100-yard games in just 16 career games at running back. The 263 rushing yards against Northeastern State was fourth-most by an FHSU player in a game in school history. Cooper had two 200-plus yard rushing games in 2015, 263 against Northeastern State and 216 against Emporia State. Cooper looks to become the 4th Tiger in history to record 10 100-yard rushing games. The school record is 13, held by Clint Bedore.

Tigers Return 9 of 11 Defensive Starters from 2015

Fort Hays State returns nine of 11 defensive starters from last year. All four starters on the defensive line return, which includes All-MIAA selections Nathan Shepherd on the defensive line return, which includes All-MIAA selections Nation Stephera and Sie Doe, Jr. At linebacker, Alex Schmidtberger earned All-MIAA honors for the second straight year. Doyin Jibowu also earned All-MIAA honors as a defensive back, playing the bandit position for FHSU. DeAndre James, the starting safety, earned All-MIAA honors in 2013 as a kick returner. Two-time All-MIAA selection Justin McPhail also returns at linebacker after redshirting last year with an injury.

Winning the Turnover Battle

Fort Hays State ranked fourth in the MIAA in turnover margin in 2015 at +9. FHSU finished with 29 turnovers gained and 20 lost. Northwest Missouri State led the conference at +19, while Central Missouri and Emporia State both had margins of +12. So far, the Tigers are +2 in turnover margin this year.

Kick Return Success

Fort Hays State led the MIAA in kick return average last year, averaging 22.5 yards per return. FHSU was the only team in the MIAA with 2 kick returns for touchdowns in 2015. The Tigers are averaging 26 yards per return so far this year to rank 2nd in the MIAA

Doe, Jr. Tied for MIAA Lead in Sacks

Defensive end Sie Doe, Jr., is tie for the MIAA lead in sacks after the first week of play. He had two in the season opener and is tied with Spenser Matthews of Washburn.

Tigers Reach the Upper Half Two Years in a Row

Now in its 11th season as members of the MIAA, Fort Hays State has finished in the top five of the conference standings in each of the last 2 years. The Tigers posted their highest-ever finish in the MIAA in 2015 in 3rd place at 8-3. Prior to 2014, the their nighest-ever finish in the MiAA in 2015 in 3rd place at 8-3. Prior to 2014, the Tigers' highest finish was sixth, occurring in 2009 and 2011. They have finished last twice, ninth twice and eighth twice. Since 1998, the Tigers have finished higher than fifth in a conference (RMAC or MIAA) just four times. Fort Hays State has not reached the NCAA playoffs since 1995, but made its first postseason game appearance since then last year in the Mineral Water Royal. appearance since then last year in the Mineral Water Bowl.

Continued Improvement Under Brown

Fort Hays State has seen a one-win improvement over the last four seasons under head coach Chris Brown. After going 4-7 in his first year (2011), the Tigers went 5-6 in 2012, 6-5 in 2013, 7-4 in 2014, and 8-4 in 2015. FHSU tied the school record for wins in a season last year with eight.

13 All-MIAA Selections in 2015

Fort Hays State had 13 players selected to the All-MIAA Team this year. Earning first team honors were running back Shaquille Cooper, defensive back Daniel Lindsey, and offensive lineman Matt Erbert. Earning second team honors were linebacker Brock Long and quarterback Treveon Albert. Third team honors went to defensive lineman Nathan Shepherd and defensive back Doyin Jibowu. Honorable mention selections went to Luke Edney (OL), Chico Feltenberger (OL), Sie Doe, Jr., (DL), Alex Schmidtberger (LB), Drew O'Brien (K), and Jordon Stangler (P).

Chris Brown - Head Football Coach

Chris Brown enters his sixth season as head coach at Fort Hays State in 2016. He has guided FHSU to 30 wins in five years and coached Fort Hays State to a bowl appearance in 2015 with an 8-4 mark, tying the school record for wins in a season.

Brown guided FHSU to its highest placing in the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association in 2015 with an 8-3 mark, finishing third in the standings. The Tigers earned a spot in the Mineral Water Bowl in Excelsior Springs, Mo. It marked the first postseason game for FHSU Football since the 1996 season.

The Tigers have shown steady progress under Brown, posting a one-win improvement in each of his seasons at the helm. After finishing with a 4-7 mark in his first year (2011), the Tigers finished 5-6 in 2012, 6-5 in 2013, 7-4 in 2014, and 8-4 in 2015. The most impressve feat of the eight-win 2015 season was all wins were in MIAA play, arguably the nation's premier Division II conference. FHSU joined the conference in 2006 and the MIAA has produced the national champion in NCAA Division II football four of the last seven seasons.

Brown, now 30-26 overall, came to Fort Hays State from Washburn University, where he served as the defensive coordinator and defensive secondary coach from 2002-2010 and assistant head coach in 2010.

FHSU enjoyed its most All-MIAA selections under Brown in 2015 with 13. Brown has now coached 53 All-MIAA selections at Fort Hays State, including seven first-team selections.

Brown has coached eight All-Americans at FHSU. That list includes linebacker Alex Whitehill, punter Ethan Kosjer, safety Micheal Jordan, linebacker Brock Long, running back Shaquille Cooper, quarterback Treveon Albert, offensive lineman Matt Erbert, and safety Daniel Lindsey. Three of the eight (Whitehill, Kosjer, and Long) have earned first team honors. Whitehill and Kosjer earned All-America honors in Brown's first year at the helm in 2011, while Jordan earned his honor in 2014. Long, Cooper, Albert, Erbert, and Lindsey all gained All-America status in 2015, the most selections in a season during Fort Hays State's NCAA Division II era. Whitehill is also one of two players to earn CoSIDA Academic All-America honors in Brown's tenure. Jesse Trent was a three-time Academic All-America selection from 2012-14.

Brown also coached two players at FHSU that have signed with NFL teams, which includes safety Nathan Lindsey and wide receiver Ed Williams. Williams has spent two seasons with the Green Bay Packers, signing with the team once again in 2016.

Before coming to Hays, Brown helped Washburn compile a 62-41 record in his nine-year span with the program, which included two NCAA playoff appearances and two bowl wins. In his time at Washburn, Brown coached the 2009 and 2006 MIAA Most Valuable Defensive Players and guided two players selected in the NFL Draft (defensive tackle Trey Lewis-6th round 2007, and cornerback Cary Williams-7th round 2008). Brown also coached six All-Americans, 20 all-region and 41 All-MIAA selections at Washburn. His defense led the MIAA in turnovers gained in three of his final four seasons there, including a school record-tying 23 interceptions in 2007.

Brown joined the Washburn coaching staff after spending three years as the secondary coach at Liberal High School where he helped the team to a mark of 37-5 in his time.

Brown, a native of Liberal, Kansas, is a 1996 graduate of Pittsburg State University where he recorded 470 tackles in 43 starts in his career at free safety. He is one of only three Gorillas to earn All-American honors three times. He was a unanimous All-American First Team selection his senior season and was named the CNN Division II National Player of the Year in 1995. He was also named to the NCAA Quarter Century Team for all players from 1975 to 1999 at free safety. He had a record 21 tackles in the NCAA Division II National Championship as a freshman against Jacksonville State. Brown was inducted into the Pittsburg State Athletic Hall of Fame in 2006 and the MIAA Hall of Fame in 2015. He and his wife, Daphne, have two sons, Hunter and Hayden.



Game Recap

HAYS, Kan. - Fort Hays State knocked off No. 20 ranked Central Missouri 28-14 on Saturday (Nov. 14) at Lewis Field Stadium. The Tigers moved to 8-3 and tied Central Missouri, also 8-3, for third in the MIAA standings.

A strong wind played a big factor in yet another win over a ranked team in Hays this season. The same conditions were present when FHSU knocked off No. 13 Emporia State earlier in the year. The Tiger defense limited the MIAA's top offensive attack to just 268 yards. Meanwhile, the Tigers racked up 441 yards of total offense with another strong performance rushing the ball.

The Tigers dominated the run game, going for 326 yards as a team on the ground. Shaquille Cooper led the attack with 158 yards, while Treveon Albert added 89 and Derek Kendall-Campbell had 72. The Mules were held to just 75 yards rushing after averaging better than 200 per game on the ground.

The defense pressured the Mules all day, recording five sacks, four interceptions, and one fumble. Sie Doe, Jr., gave the Mules fits up front as he recorded three sacks in the game. Dovin Jibowu was all over for the Tigers with two interceptions, a sack, and five tackles. Daniel Lindsey provided the game-sealing interception late in the fourth quarter, while recording seven tackles. Raheeme Dumas also had an interception in the game. Brock Long led the Tigers with 14 tackles.

The Tigers held a 14-7 advantage at halftime. A 23-yard touchdown pass from Albert to Kendall-Campbell with 13 seconds remaining in the first quarter put the Tigers up 7-0. At 6:44 in the second quarter, Garrett Holle hauled in a pass from Albert and went 44 yards for a touchdown to make it 14-0. A 34-yard touchdown reception by Jaylen Zachery at 2:42 in the second quarter cut the lead in half for UCM.

The third quarter was key as the Tigers had the strong south wind at their back. FHSU had a pair of touchdown runs by Albert from one and 17 yards to take a 28-7 lead. The fourth quarter was a bit tense early as the Mules used a short field to cut the lead in half again, 28-14, on a Garrett Fugate pass to Kyle Echols from 13 yards out. An interception by Doyin Jibowu with 7:00 remaining in the game changed the momentum back in the Tigers' favor, picking the pass off at the FHSU 9-yardline. The Tigers chewed up a lot of clock with the ground game and kept the UCM offense from having a good chance late.

Fort Hays State reached eight wins in a season for the first time since 1995, the last time it made the postseason. The Tigers are hoping that number is good enough again to end the 20-year drought from postseason play.

Fort Hays State's win over Central Missouri was the first in Hays since 1965. The Mules had won five straight in Hays, all in MIAA play since the Tigers joined the conference in 2006. FHSU has now won two straight against UCM after losing eight straight.
