MATCHUP NOTES

34th All-Time Meeting

Fort Hays State and Missouri Southern meet for the 34th time on Saturday in Joplin with FHSU leading the all-time series with a record of 18-14-1. The series began back in 1970, with FHSU taking the inaugural matchup 36-29 in Hays. The Tigers are 9-7 when playing on the road in Joplin, and 9-7-1 in games played at home. Fort Hays State had their longest win streak of eight games snapped by Missouri Southern last season after winning each matchup from 2011 to 2021. Seven of the eight wins in the streak were by at least 11 points. MSSU won a stretch of six consecutive games against FHSU from 1983-1988. The Tigers are 8-2 in their last 10 matchups against the Lions. FHSU holds a 10-4 advantage in MIAA games between the teams, which goes back to 2006.

Last Year's Meeting

The two teams met in Week 4 of the 2022 football season in Hays with the Lions coming out victorious for their first time against the Tigers since 2010. Momentum sided with Missouri Southern early when the Lion defense forced a safety. Shortly after the defensive score, the Lions forced a Tiger fumble. Luke Sampson connected with Ezekiel Lang for a 30-yard passing touchdown to make it a 9-0 lead for MSSU. The Tigers came roaring back, scoring three unanswered touchdowns to go up 21-9 midway through the second quarter. Missouri Southern notched a field goal and rushing touchdown to make it 21-19, but the Tigers added a field goal as time expired in the first half to lead 24-19 at the break. The second half was a completely different story for both offenses. The only touchdown in the second half came by way of Missouri Southern with 1:59 left in the game. Dawson Herl delivered the game-winning touchdown through the air to Trace Willhite in the 25-24 game. FHSU drove deep into MSSU territory late, but fumbled the ball away for a fifth time which allowed the Lions to escape with victory.

Last Time in Joplin

Fort Hays State handled the Lions 42-21 back on September 25th, 2021 at Fred G. Hughes Stadium. The Tigers saw success early and often, rattling off 35 first half points. FHSU held Missouri Southern to seven points until the final eight minutes of the game when the Lions notched two late-game scores. Fort Hays rushed and passed for over 220 yards. Chance Fuller finished the day with three passing touchdowns, while Adrian Soto ran for 198 yards and two scores. Hunter Budke recorded 4 catches for 101 yards.

Scouting the Lions

The Lions come into the week ranking in the top four in the MIAA in both offensive and defensive efficiency. Luke Sampson leads the offensive unit more as a pocket passing quarterback. Sampson has eclipsed 1,100 yards through the first five games this season with nine passing touchdowns. Jaedon Stoshak is his primary target with 21 catches, 356 yards, and three scores. The Lion offense has three rushers over 150 yards so far. Drake Reese has been utilized in the kicking game and is currently 6-for-8 on field goal tries. Defensively for Missouri Southern, Colten Widner leads the team in tackles with 45. As a unit the defense has recorded seven sacks and three interceptions.

20+ Against the Lions

The Fort Hays State offense has been able to score at least 20 points in every matchup against Missouri Southern since 2008, including a 55 point outburst back in 2018 in a 55-20 road win in Joplin.

Brown Against the Lions

Coach Chris Brown has a record of 8-1 against the Lions, winning each of the first eight matchups against MSSU after taking the helm at FHSU in 2011. On the flip side, Atiba Bradley is 1-1 against FHSU.

5-Game Win Streak in Joplin

Fort Hays State has won its last 5 games in Joplin against Missouri Southern. The streak started in 2009. Missouri Southern's only win over FHSU in MIAA play in Joplin was a low-scoring 6-0 result during the 2007 season. The first 3 meetings between the teams in MIAA play were shutouts, a 10-0 contest going to FHSU in 2006 and then 6-0 and 28-0 wins by MSSU in 2007 and 2008.

Most Points Scored By MIAA Team this Season

With 71 points last week in the win against Lincoln, Fort Hays State has now produced the most points of any MIAA team in a game this season. The three highest scoring performances have all been against Lincoln as Missouri Western scored 68 and Northwest Missouri State scored 59 against the Blue Tigers

FORT HAYS STATE GAME NOTES

Five All-MIAA Selections in 2022

Fort Hays State had five All-MIAA selections in 2022, headed by first-team selection Manny Ramsey at wide receiver. Ramsey finished the year with 732 receiving yards on 48 catches with six touchdowns. Makel Williams (LB), Myles Menges (DL), and Mason Perez (DB) were third-team selections on the defensive side of the ball. Pat Kelly was the only other offensive selection alongside Ramsey with a second-team selection on the offensive line. FHSU returned all three of its defensive all-conference selections to the team this year.

Returning Defensive Core

Fort Hays State has a quality list of players that made an impact on the defensive side of the ball last season. Along with leading tackler Makel Williams, the Tiger defense returns Myles Menges, Mason Perez, Ty Cooper, Evan Darville, Gaven Haselhorst, and Sam Brandt. Menges (DL) and Perez (DB) were All-MIAA Third Team selections alongside Williams. Perez was the second-leading tackler on the team in 2022 with 56 stops, while Menges led defensive linemen in tackles with 36. Brandt, who was the MIAA Defensive Athlete of the Week once in 2022, had 37 tackles for the season. Menges and Haselhorst are the top returners for the Tigers in sacks, each recording 1.5 last season. John Johnson, who missed most of 2022 with an injury, is also back at linebacker after ranking second on the team in tackles in 2021 with 72.

Top 10 Nationally in Interceptions

Fort Hays State currently ranks 6th in NCAA Division II for interceptions with 9 for the season. Makel Williams leads the team with 2, while seven others have 1. Emporia State leads both the MIAA and NCAA Division II in interceptions with 12, while Central Missouri and Pittsburg State are tied for third nationally with 10.

Top 20 in Turnovers Gained

Fort Hays State currently ranks 17th in NCAA Division II for turnovers gained with 12 takeaways this season. That ranks third among MIAA teams. Missouri Western is the MIAA leader with 14.

Top 15 in Pass Offense

Fort Hays State ranks 11th in NCAA Division II for passing offense, averaging 292.6 yards per game through the air. The Tigers rank third among MIAA schools behind Central Missouri (399.4) and Emporia State (349.0). Central Missouri is the national leader in the category.

Strong Scoring Defense

Fort Hays State currently leads the MIAA in scoring defense, allowing 15.4 points per game. The conference currently has 4 teams allowing less than 20 points per game, which also includes Pittsburg State (15.8), Emporia State (16.8), and Missouri Southern (19.4). The Tigers rank 16th nationally in scoring defense. FHSU has allowed less than 10 points in all 3 of its wins this season.

Standing Tall on 3rd Down

Fort Hays State owns the best percentage in the MIAA for holding opponents on 3rd down. Opponents have converted only 30.9 percent of their 3rd down opportunities against the Tigers. They rank 28th nationally in the category.

Dawson Among Top 20 in Passing Yards

Quarterback Jack Dawson ranks 20th in NCAA Division II for passing yards with 1,280 for the season. He ranks third in the MIAA behind Zach Zebrowski (1,887) of Central Missouri, who is the national leader, and Braden Gleason (1,570) of Emporia State.

Dawson Among Top 15 in Passing Touchdowns

Quarterback Jack Dawson is among the Top 15 in NCAA Division II for passing touchdowns. He ranks 15th with 13 for the season. Zach Zebrowski of Central Missouri leads the nation and MIAA with 20, while Braden Gleason of Emporia State is third nationally with 17.

Dawson Among Top 20 in Points Responsible For

Quarterback Jack Dawson is among the Top 20 in NCAA Division II in points responsible for. He ranks 16th with 90 for the season (13 passing TDs, 2 rushing TD). Patrick Shegog of Delta State is the national leader with 126, while Zach Zebrowski is the MIAA leader with 122.

Second in MIAA in Total Defense

Fort Hays State currently ranks 2nd in the MIAA for total defense, allowing just 270.8 yards per game. Pittsburg State leads the MIAA at 263.8 yards allowed per game. Missouri Southern ranks 3rd in the MIAA in total defense, allowing 317.4 yards per game.

Ground Game Gets a Boost

Fort Hays State rushed for over 200 yards in a game for the first time this season against Lincoln with 236. FHSU ranked last in the MIAA in rushing offense going into Week 5, but elevated to 10th after the big ground performance against the Blue Tigers. FHSU is now averaging 94.8 yards of rushing per game. Shane Watts is the team leader in rushing yards with 138 for the season.

Turnover Turnaround

Fort Hays State finished the 2022 season last in the MIAA in turnover margin at -0.91. The Tigers turned the ball over 22 times, but were only able to force 12 turnovers out of the opposition. The Tigers fumbled the ball away 14 times and threw 8 interceptions. The opposition threw nine interceptions, but the Tigers gained three fumbles all season. On a positive note, the Tigers went turnover free in two of the last four games of the 2022, committing no more than one in a game during the four-game stretch. So far this year, the Tigers are +4 in turnover margin. FHSU has gained more turnovers than their opponents in two games this year, holding a 5-0 advantage in the win at Northeastern State and a 3-0 advantage in the win over Lincoln. FHSU is 6th in the MIAA in turnover margin with an average of +0.80. Emporia State leads the MIAA at +1.8 per game.

Tigers at Home Since Joining MIAA

Since joining the MIAA in 2006, the Tigers are 53-42 at home. The Tigers are 39-26 at home under head coach Chris Brown, including a 30-13 mark since the start of the 2015 season.

Tigers on the Road Since Joining MIAA

Since joining the MIAA in 2006, the Tigers are 40-48 on the road. However, the Tigers are 37-26 on the road under head coach Chris Brown. The Tigers went 3-22 on the road in their first five seasons with the conference. FHSU is 1-1 in neutral site games (both were bowl games) under Brown.

When the Tigers Score 30 Under Brown

Fort Hays State is 51-5 under head coach Chris Brown when reaching 30 points in a game. The Tigers are 2-0 when reaching 30 points in a game so far this season. Three of the five losses under Brown when scoring 30 or more have happened in the past 3 seasons (twice in 2019, once in 2021).

25 All-America Selections Over Last Seven Years

Fort Hays State has seen 25 All-America selections over the last six years. Hunter Budke (TE) and Amari Angram-Boldin (OL) were the most recent All-America selections for the Tigers in 2021. Budke earned All-America First Team selections at tight end from five different entities that season.

Reaching 200 Rushing Yards Under Brown

The Tigers have a record of 35-1 since the start of 2013 when rushing for over 200 yards in a game. The last time the Tigers rushed for over 300 yards in a game was in 2021 with a 334-yard effort against Northeastern State in Tahlequah en route to a 64-6 win. The Tigers eclipsed the 200-yard rushing mark just once so far this season, occurring last week with 236 yards against Lincoln.

12 Conference Titles

Fort Hays State won its 12th conference title overall in program history in 2018. It was the first time the Tigers won back-to-back conference titles since winning three in a row back in the 1934, 1935, and 1936 seasons as members of the Central Intercollegiate Conference. The Tigers have four conference titles since joining NCAA Division II, two as members of the MIAA and two as members of the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference. FHSU went 22 years without a conference title before winning the MIAA outright in 2017. The last two conference titles have been with an 11-game conference schedule. FHSU had never won a conference title prior to that with more than a 7-game conference slate. Fort Hays State (2017), Northwest Missouri State (2015 & 2016), and Pittsburg State (2022) are the only teams to navigate the 11-game MIAA conference model undefeated. Teams are playing just a 10-game conference schedule this year with the exit of Lincoln.

Brown Holds FHSU All-Time Coaching Wins Record

With a win over Lindenwood on October 27, 2018 in Hays, head coach Chris Brown became the all-time leader in coaching wins at Fort Hays State. Brown is in his 12th year guiding the Tigers and owns a record of 77-53. He passed Bob Cortese's former record of 55 wins. Cortese had a 55-32-3 record at FHSU from 1990-97.

String of 8-Win Seasons Snapped in 2021

When the Tigers finished 5-6 in 2021, it snapped a string of five straight seasons with eight or more wins. FHSU won eight in both 2015 and 2016, then 11 in 2017, nine in 2018, and eight in 2019. Eight wins was the single-season school record before the 2017 team won 11 to shatter the record. The Tigers went past the 8-win mark for just the second time in school history in 2018, finishing at 9-3 overall. The Tigers won only three games in 2022.

Williams Top Returning Tackler

Makel Williams started all 11 games a season ago for the Fort Hays State defense at linebacker. Williams led the team in total tackles with 86, averaging 7.8 per game. He finished the season ranked 8th in the MIAA in total tackles, and 6th in the conference in solo tackles with 50. He was an All-MIAA Third Team selection on defense. Williams ranks second on the team in tackles so far this year with 29. Williams had a career-high 13 tackles in Week 2 vs. Pittsburg State.

Johnson Leads in Tackles Through Three Weeks

Linebacker John Johnson is leading the team in tackles through 5 weeks of play with 37. He had a season-high 11 in Week 3 against Northwest Missouri State. He has led the team in tackles in three of five games this season.

FORT HAYS STATE GAME NOTES

Dawson At QB

Quarterback Jack Dawson quickly had to slide into the starting role at quarterback last season after a Week 1 injury to Chance Fuller against Northwest Missouri State. Dawson played in 10 games, starting in nine. Despite the loss, Dawson had a strong outing in his first career start against Missouri Western, passing for 243 yards with one passing and one rushing touchdown. He finished the season 144-for-234 through the air, good for 1,722 yards and 13 touchdowns. Dawson was also a quality threat with his legs, rushing for 245 yards and five touchdowns. He is the top returning rusher on the team. So far this season, Dawson has thrown for 1,280 yards and 13 touchdowns. He had a career-high 317 passing yards in the season opener at Northeastern State. He has thrown for at least 250 yards in four of five games this season.

Heavner Still Perfect in Backup Role

Redshirt-freshman quarterback Caleb Heavner is a perfect 5-of-5 passing so far this season with 126 yards and 2 touchdowns. He also has 77 yards and 1 touchdown rushing the ball. He is averaging 25.2 yards per completion and 15.4 yards per rush. Heavner recorded his longest passing and rushing touchdowns of the season in Week 5 vs. Lincoln with a 61-yard pass connection with Logan Heigele and a 67-yard rush. Both of Heavner's touchdown passes have been to Logan Heigele, which are Heigele's only two catches of the season. Heigele has 91 receiving yards on his 2 TD catches from Heavner, averaging 45.5 yards per catch.

Tiger Receivers

Fort Hays State receivers have scored 15 of the team's 22 touchdowns this season. Trevor Watts is the team leader in receptions (26), while Jayden Horace leads in receiving yards (334). Horace also leads the team in touchdown receptions with 5. Watts, Horace, Bryson Smith, and Hosia Stokes all have at least 140 receiving yards for the season, while tight end Cale Cormaney is off to a good start with 196 yards on 14 catches. The 15 touchdown receptions have been spread among 8 different players.

QB Company

Sophomore Ethan Forrester and redshirt-freshman Caleb Heavner could also be names to watch for at quarterback this season. Forrester saw action in eight games a season ago, throwing for 372 yards and two touchdowns. The Land O'Lakes, Fla. native also carried the ball for 148 yards and two touchdowns. Heavner spent last season as a redshirt, but finished his prep career as the all-time leading passer in school history at Denison High School in Denison, Texas. He threw for 4,234 yards and rushed for over 1,000 yards during his high school career.

Balanced Production Among Defensive Front

Fort Hays State has five players along its defensive line with 13 or more tackles this season. Parrish Terry leads the group with 19 tackles, followed by Jason Wallace (16), Myles Menges (15), Demetri Scott (14), and Evan Darville (13). Wallace leads the team in sacks with 2.0, while Terry leads the team in tackles for loss with 6.0.

Tigers Second in MIAA in Pass Defense Efficiency

Fort Hays State currently ranks second among MIAA teams in pass defense efficiency with a rating of 98.0. Emporia State leads the MIAA at 95.8. FHSU ranks 19th nationally in the stat category.

Most Kicking Points in a Game Among MIAA Teams

Fort Hays State produced the most kicking points in a game by an MIAA team this season in Week 5 against Lincoln. The Tigers had 15 kicking points in the game with 9 PATs and 2 field goals.

Most Yards Per Play in a Game Among MIAA Teams

With 582 total yards in 56 plays against Lincoln in Week 5, Fort Hays State produced the most yards per play in a game by an MIAA team this season. The Tigers averaged 10.4 yards per play, the only team to average better than 10 per play in a game this season.

Longest Punt Return Among MIAA Teams

Trevor Watts had a 52-yard punt return in the 71-3 win over Lincoln in Week 5. That is the longest punt return among MIAA players this season, topping the previous mark of 31 yards.

Heavner's Scamper

Caleb Heavner's 67-yard touchdown run against Lincoln in Week 5 is the longest rush from scrimmage by an MIAA player this season. It topped the 65-yard run by Christian Davis of Washburn, produced in Week 4.

Kansas Talent

With the high school talent level continuing to grow, the Tigers have made it a point to recruit close to home. The Tigers have 70 in-state members listed on this year's roster.

Chris Brown - Head Football Coach

Chris Brown enters his 12th season as head coach at Fort Hays State in 2023. He is the all-time coaching wins leader in program history, now with a record of 74-51. The program has a record of 52-29 over the last seven seasons, winning at least eight games in five of the seven seasons. He has guided the Tigers to two conference championships and four postseason appearances.

Brown is a two-time MIAA Coach of the Year, earning the honor in both 2017 and 2018. In 2017, Brown led the program to its first-ever Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association Championship and first appearance in the NCAA Division II Playoffs since 1995. By leading the Tigers to their most successful season in program history with a record of 11-1, including an undefeated 11-0 mark in the regular season, Brown earned 2017 MIAA Coach of the Year and Don Hansen Football Committee Super Region 3 Coach of the Year honors. The Tigers backed that with another MIAA Championship in 2018, going 9-2 in the regular season to net Brown a second-straight MIAA Coach of the Year honor. The team finished at 9-3 after falling in the opening round of the NCAA Playoffs, but it was the first

time the program reached the NCAA Playoffs in back-to-back seasons.

Fort Hays State played postseason games four straight years under Brown's guidance from 2015 to 2018. Going 11-0 in 2017 during the regular season and setting a new school record for wins in a season to win a conference title, the Tigers earned the No. 1 seed in Super Region 3 of the NCAA Playoffs. Fort Hays State hosted Ferris State (Mich.) in the Super Region Semifinals and finished the year 11-1, but ended a 22-year absence from the playoffs in the process. The conference title was also the program's first since 1995. The following year in 2018, FHSU went 9-2 in the regular season for its second-straight conference championship and finished at 9-3 after facing University of Indianapolis in Super Region 3 of the NCAA Playoffs. In 2016, Fort Hays State claimed its first-ever postseason game win by defeating Eastern New Mexico in the Heart of Texas Bowl to finish 8-4 overall. The 2015 team also finished 8-4 overall, making an appearance in the Mineral Water Bowl against University of Minnesota-Duluth.

After finishing with a 4-7 mark in Brown's first year (2011), the Tigers finished 5-6 in 2012, 6-5 in 2013, and 7-4 in 2014. In 2015, the Tigers went 8-4 overall with an appearance in the Mineral Water Bowl, but in 2016 went 8-4 again and won the Heart of Texas Bowl. The program saw a huge leap in 2017 with an overall record of 11-1, setting the new school record for wins in a season by three. The Tigers enjoyed seven consecutive winning seasons from 2013 to 2019, their longest streak since joining NCAA Division II. The Tigers have accomplished the feat as members of the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, arguably the nation's premier Division II football conference that has produced the national champion five times in the last 12 years. FHSU joined the MIAA in 2006.

Fort Hays State enjoyed its most All-MIAA selections under Brown in 2017 with 21. Brown has now coached 137 All-MIAA selections at Fort Hays State, including 28 first-team selections. Fort Hays State boasted the MIAA Defensive Player of the Year three straight years (2016-2018), Sie Doe, Jr. in 2016, Nathan Shepherd in 2017, and Jose Delgado in 2018. The New York Jets selected Shepherd in the third round of the 2018 NFL Draft, the first NCAA Division II player selected in the draft. Shepherd became Fort Hays State's first player taken in the NFL Draft since 1987. FHSU also had a player claim the MIAA Special Teams Player of the Year honor three straight years (2017-2019), kickers Brandon Brown (2017) and Dante Brown (2018 and 2019). Dante Brown was the Don Hansen Football Committee National Special Teams Player of the Year in both 2018 and 2019.

Brown has coached 28 All-Americans at FHSU. Eleven of the 28 have received first team honors, which includes Alex Whitehill (linebacker) and Ethan Kosjer (punter) in 2011, Brock Long (linebacker) in 2015, Sie Doe, Jr. (defensive lineman) and Raheeme Dumas (defensive back) in 2016, and Nathan Shepherd (defensive lineman) and Travis Talley (offensive lineman) in 2017, Jose Delgado (linebacker) in 2018, Dante Brown (kicker) in 2018 and 2019, and Hunter Budke (tight end) in 2021. Fort Hays State enjoyed eight All-America selections in 2017, the most for a season in the program's history. Doe was the D2CCA Super Region 3 Defensive Player of the Year, the first in program history, in 2016. Two years later in 2018, Jose Delgado earned the same honor. Whitehill is one of five players to earn CoSIDA Academic All-America honors in Brown's tenure. Defensive lineman Jesse Trent was a three-time Academic All-America selection from 2012-14. Defensive back Doyin Jibowu (2017), defensive back Connor Shedeed (2018), and special teamer Alex Schremmer (2022) were Academic All-America selections as well.

Brown also coached four players at FHSU that have signed with NFL teams, the most recent being Doyin Jibowu in 2019 with the Chicago Bears as an undrafted free agent. The New York Jets selected Nathan Shepherd in the third round of the 2018 NFL Draft and he recorded 15 tackles in his rookie season. Safety Nathan Lindsey (Detroit Lions) and wide receiver Ed Williams (Green Bay Packers) also signed with NFL teams in 2015 as undrafted free agents. Williams spent two seasons with the Packers.

Brown came to Fort Hays State from Washburn University, where he served as the defensive coordinator and defensive secondary coach from 2002-2010 and assistant head coach in 2010. Brown helped Washburn compile a 62-41 record in his nine-year span with the program, which included two NCAA playoff appearances and two bowl wins. In his time at Washburn, Brown coached the 2009 and 2006 MIAA Most Valuable Defensive Players and guided two players selected in the NFL Draft (defensive tackle Trey Lewis-6th round 2007, and cornerback Cary Williams-7th round 2008). Brown also coached six All-Americans, 20 all-region and 41 All-MIAA selections at Washburn. His defense led the MIAA in turnovers gained in three of his final four seasons there, including a school record-tying 23 interceptions in 2007.

Brown joined the Washburn coaching staff after spending three years as the secondary coach at Liberal (Kan.) High School where he helped the team to a mark of 37-5 in his time.

A native of Liberal, Kansas, Brown is a 1996 graduate of Pittsburg State University where he recorded 470 tackles in 43 starts in his career at free safety. He is one of only three Gorillas to earn All-American honors three times. He was a unanimous All-American First Team selection his senior season and was named the CNN Division II National Player of the Year in 1995. He was also named to the NCAA Quarter Century Team for all players from 1975 to 1999 at free safety. He had a record 21 tackles in the NCAA Division II National Championship as a freshman against Jacksonville State. Brown was inducted into the Pittsburg State Athletic Hall of Fame in 2006 and the MIAA Hall of Fame in 2015. He and his wife, Daphne, have two sons, Hunter and Hayden.
