2014-15 SEASON IN REVIEW

There were a number of highlights for the Illini in 2014-15, as Coach John Groce's third Illini squad battled through injuries and adversity throughout the season to record 19 victories – including two RPI top-10 wins – and post a .500 record in conference play.

The injury bug hit early, with starting point guard Tracy Abrams suffering a torn ACL during a September workout, sidelining him for the season.

The Fighting Illini started off the regular season on fire, recording four home wins by an average of 32.3 points. The offense was rolling, as Illinois recorded 114 points against Coppin State – the UI's highest point total in a game in 21 seasons – and drained 15 three-pointers to equal its record at State Farm Center. The Orange and Blue also reached the century mark with 106 points against Austin Peay while hitting 14 treys. The combined 29 threes marked the most made in consecutive games in school history.

Illinois closed out the season's opening month by winning the Las Vegas Invitational. Following another high-scoring win over Indiana State in the semifinal round, the Illini won it with defense by defeating Baylor in the title game, 62-54. Rayvonte Rice was named MVP of the event while Malcolm Hill and Nnanna Egwu were selected to the All-Tournament Team. The Illini improved to 21-0, meanwhile, in the month of November under Groce.

Fresh off of winning the Las Vegas Invite, the Illini appeared in the national rankings, at No. 24 by the AP and No. 25 by the Coaches poll. The UI suffered its first loss at 15th-ranked Miami in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge, but responded with a 15-point home win over reigning NCAA Tournament participant American.

A challenging week followed with games against Villanova in New York City and Oregon at the United Center. Malcolm Hill made his first splash

on the national scene, scoring a game-high 20 points against 7th-ranked Villanova at Madison Square Garden. But it wasn't enough as the Wildcats pulled away from a 50-all tie with 8:30 remaining to win the Jimmy V Classic game. The Illini then had a five-point second-half lead slip away in falling to Oregon in Chicago.

The UI wrapped up non-conference play with three straight wins, highlighted by a thrilling victory over Missouri in the annual Braggin' Rights game. Illinois had final possession of a game that was tied at 59, setting up the last-second heroics. Rayvonte Rice drained a stepback, fadeaway 3-pointer from the top of the key as time expired, sending the Illini bench rushing onto the court to celebrate a second-straight victory over the Tigers.

Illinois entered Big Ten play with record of 10-3 and had a challenging start to the conference race with four of its first five games on the road. The Illini were unable to hold on to a late lead in the opener in Ann Arbor, falling to Michigan in overtime before also dropping a game at No. 20 Ohio State.

Illinois was dealt another setback when leading scorer Rayvonte Rice suffered a broken right hand in practice on the eve of its first conference home game. Despite those circumstances, the Illini showed great fight to defeat No. 11 Maryland at State Farm Center behind Malcolm Hill's career-high 28-point performance.

With Rice sidelined for nine games, other players began to step up. Following a loss at Nebraska, it was sophomore Kendrick Nunn who took center stage in the win at Northwestern, scoring a career-high 25 points.

Nunn continued his torrid shooting the following game with 24 points and a career-high six 3-pointers, but it was not enough as the Illini were unable to hold on to a late five-point lead in dropping its first home game of the season to Indiana.

A new hero emerged the following contest, as freshman Leron Black registered 15 points and a career-high 13 rebounds in a victory over Purdue, with Black becoming the first Illini in 28 seasons to notch a double-double in his first career start. Nnanna Egwu, meanwhile, set a milestone by becoming Illinois' all-time leader in blocked shots during the Purdue win.

Following a loss at Minnesota, the Illini closed out the month of January by defeating Penn State on Malcolm Hill's game-winning layup with 4.4 seconds remaining. Hill finished one shy of his career high, earning Big Ten Co-Player of the Week accolades behind his 27-point performance.

Illinois then defeated Rutgers at home by double figures, carrying momentum into its next road trip. And the Orange and Blue followed with arguably its most impressive feat of the season in East Lansing, defeating eventual Final Four participant Michigan State on its home court.

The largest crowd in State Farm Center history of 17,087 watched Illinois extend its winning streak to four in a row with an impressive come-from-

behind victory over Michigan. Trailing by seven with less than three minutes remaining, the Illini scored the last seven points of regulation and then dominated overtime by outscoring the Wolverines in the extra session, 14-2.

A trip to 5th-ranked Wisconsin began a three-game skid. But the Illini looked to be back on track, closing out its home schedule with a dominating win over Northwestern followed by a 12-point victory over Nebraska on Senior Night. The Illini finished with a 14-2 record at State Farm Center, its best home mark under Groce.

After closing the regular season with a loss at Purdue, the Illini finished 9-9 in Big Ten play, totaling its most conference wins since 2011.

Illinois entered the Big Ten Tournament with its sights set on securing an NCAA berth. But after falling in the second round to Michigan, the Illini received a No. 3 seed in the NIT. Due to the renovation schedule at State Farm Center, Illinois drew a road game despite being a higher seed. The season came to a close in the first round at No. 6 seed Alabama.
