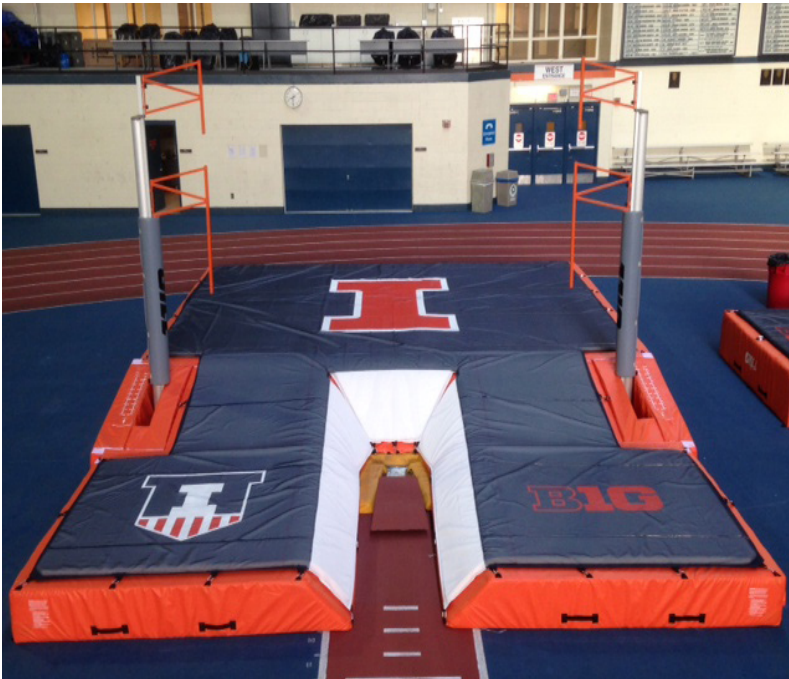

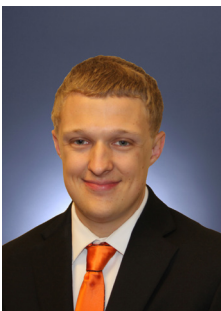

TRACK & FIELD FACILITIES

ILLINOIS TRACK AND SOCCER STADIUM

The original Illinois Track and Soccer Stadium was built in 1987 at a cost of \$2.2 million. The first meet at the stadium was the Illinois Invitational on April 18, 1987. The stadium has played host to a number of meets, including the Big Ten Outdoor Track and Field Championships in 2008, 1997 and 1990.

Major renovations began on the Illinois Track and Field Stadium in October of 1998, with phase one of the project already being completed. At a cost of \$1.2 million, JJR Architects of Chicago installed lighting for the entire stadium, built a separate throwing area for field events and adapted the grass field inside the track to facilitate soccer. A new scoreboard is the newest feature at the stadium and phase two of the renovation calls for the addition of 8,000 permanent seats, locker rooms, a press box, rest rooms and concessions.

The outdoor track is just steps away from the Bielfeldt Athletic Administration Building, where the track and field coaching offices are located.



ARMORY TRACK

Competition during the indoor season takes place at the Armory Track, adjacent to Huff Hall. The Armory, built in 1914, was originally designed to house the University ROTC programs. The center of the roof is over 100 feet off the floor and encapsulates over 62,000 square feet of open space.

Though the ROTC programs are still part of Armory Building, the Armory has become better known for its indoor track & field facility. The current track is six lanes around with 11 lanes on the straightaway.

The track & field facility underwent a \$1.2 million renovation after the 2003 season. On the track, the project included a new 13mm thick, Beynon Encapsulated Polyurethane 200m running surface and seating for over 1400 spectators. In the field, the project included two opposing long/triple jump and pole vault runways, and a shot/weight area that features a cement circle recessed into the floor.



Qualification to the NCAA Indoor Championships is based on descending-order list for the season and adhering to the qualifying regulations/criteria published on NCAA.org. For each individual event contested, the top 16 declared student-athletes will be accepted into the competition. For each relay event contested, the top 12 declared relay teams will be accepted into the competition. The stated maximums are absolute and will not be extended as a result of ties.

OUTDOOR - PRELIMINARY ROUND OF CHAMPIONSHIP

The NCAA Division I Men's and Women's Track and Field Committee has decided to trim the NCAA preliminary format from four regional championships to a pair of preliminary qualifying sites, eliminating the Mideast and Midwest regionals, and extend the meet from two to three days. Illinois has been placed in the West Region and will head to Lawrence, Kansas from May 26-28 for the meet. The East Preliminary Round of Championship will be hosted by the University of North Florida at Hodges Stadium in Jacksonville, Fla.

Qualification to the Preliminary Round competition of the Championship is based on the descending order list for the season, segregated by east and west sites, and prepared solely from the mandatory submission of meet results during the season and adhering to the Qualifying Regulations published in the Championship Handbook. For each individual event contested at each of the Championship Preliminary Round competitions, the top 48 declared student-athletes will be accepted into the competition. For each relay event contested at each of the Championship Preliminary Round competitions, the top 24 declared relay teams will be accepted into the competition.

Qualifying to the NCAA Outdoor Track and Field Championships is accomplished through performance in the Preliminary Round competition at each site for events contested at those competitions. Twelve competitors from each individual event and a minimum of eight teams from each relay event advance from each Preliminary Round site to the Final Championship Meet. Qualification, through competition in an event at a Preliminary Round competition, is required to participate in that event at the NCAA Outdoor Track and Field Championships. Any individual or relay team must remain eligible for advancement throughout all rounds of the Championships.

Qualification for the Heptathlon and Decathlon events of the Championship is accomplished through a student-athlete's position on the national descending order list. Based upon declarations, made before the Preliminary Round competition, twenty-four student-athletes will be accepted to the final championship meet in each event.

The 2016 NCAA Outdoor Track and Field Championships will be held June 8-11 at Hayward Field in Eugene, Ore.

RON GARNER

HEAD COACH // THIRD SEASON



Coach Garner saw his team add 15 new spots in the school's all-time top-10 list. He guided Stephanie Richartz to an indoor and outdoor Big Ten Championship in the pole vault and a third-place finish at NCAA Championships. In addition to Richartz, Bloch-Jones qualified for NAAs and six others qualified for NCAA West Prelims. Five times an Illini won Big Ten Athlete of the Week and Richartz was named Illinois' Female Athlete of the Year.

During his first season as head coach, Garner saw 18 additions to Illinois' all-time top-10 lists. The squad boasted 10 NCAA West Preliminary Round qualifiers and were represented in the discus for the first time in 10 years. Garner was also instrumental in the success of freshman high jumper Kandie Bloch-Jones. The Illinois Female Newcomer of the Year captured the indoor Big Ten title, earned second-team All-America honors at the NCAA Indoor Championships, and finished runner-up at the Big Ten Outdoor Championships.

COACHING HONORS/AWARDS

ACC Outdoor Track and Field Coach of the Year, 1999

Before returning to Illinois, Garner spent the past two seasons at the University of South Carolina as an assistant coach for the men's and women's track and field teams, specializing in sprints and relay events. He coached 20 All-Americans in 12 events during his time with the Gamecocks. In his first season at South Carolina, Garner guided sprinter Erika Rucker in becoming the SEC 2012 Indoor Freshman Runner of the Year after she finished the season as the third fastest freshman in the nation.

Garner spent one season coaching the James Madison University track and field teams in 2005, where he specialized in throwing events. With his guidance, two school records were broken, and every athlete that he coached established at least one new personal record. Garner also specialized in throwing events at the University of Virginia from 2002-2004, where he coached two 2004 US Olympic Trials qualifiers, one 2004 NCAA All-American, and three ACC Champions.

As the head coach of the Clemson women's track and field and cross country programs, Garner led the track and field team to the 1999 ACC Outdoor title, the first in 8 years. That year, the team finished at number four on the final USTFCCA National "Dual Meet" Team Power Rankings. For his success, Garner was named the 1999 ACC Outdoor Track and Field Coach of the Year.

At the University of Illinois, Garner was responsible for coaching the horizontal jumps and throwing events, and also assisted with the sprints, hurdles, and relays. During his time at Illinois, Garner helped the team produce six Big Ten Team Conference titles in six years, as well as two consecutive fourth place finishes at the NCAA Championships in 1995 and 1996. He contributed to the development of Olympic Bronze Medalist Tonja Buford-Bailey, and as the recruitment coordinator, he brought in three top-three nationally ranked recruiting classes.

Garner was an assistant coach for Clemson University from 1986-1991, where he assisted in the development of Olympic Gold Medalist Kim Graham. He established and coached the first women's track and field team in program history, and won the program's first ACC Conference title in 1991. Garner began his career at Christopher Newport University in 1983.

A 1982 graduate of Christopher Newport University with a degree in Leisure Studies and Physical Education, Garner received a master's degree in education from Clemson University. He founded the Inside Track Racing Team, where he coached track and field athletes aged 10-18. Garner coached the three fastest 4x100m relays ever run by a 17-18 yr. age group club team, and produced nineteen junior All-Americans. He is married to

ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH

SECOND SEASON

Randy Gillon is in his second season as associate head coach of the Illinois women's track and field team. A former Illini hurdler, Gillon returns to Champaign after an eight-year stint as an assistant for Michigan State. He primarily worked with the Spartans' sprinters and hurdlers, and assisted with the multi-events and middle-distance.

While at Michigan State, Gillon served as an assistant coach for both the men's and women's track & field teams. He coached nine NCAA Championship qualifiers, 30 NCAA Regional qualifiers and helped Spartan sprinters and hurdlers set 18 new school records.

Prior to his time at Michigan State, Gillon served as an assistant coach at Illinois State for two years. His coaching resume also includes one year as a volunteer assistant with the Illini women's track & field team.

A former Illini runner himself, Gillon was a three-time letterman for the Orange and Blue. When he graduated, Gillon held the eighth-fastest time in the 110m hurdles.

Gillon graduated from Illinois in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in Kinesiology. In 2002, he earned his master's degree in Biomechanics from Illinois.

Randy is married to former Illini track & field standout Nicole Whitman, who holds the school record in the triple jump. She was an All-American and Big Ten champ in the event in 2002 and also garnered All-American status in the 400-meter relay. Randy and Nicole have been married since 2008 and have two daughters, Nia and Imani.



SCOTT JONES

ASSISTANT COACH - DISTANCE

THIRD SEASON

Jones's second season at the helm saw the Orange and Blue place ninth at Big Ten championships in Iowa City, Iowa with Hanna Winter leading the way with a time of 21:08.1. At the NCAA West Regional, Alyssa Schneider finished 33rd overall as the top Illini performer as Illinois finished in 10th place. During the indoor track season, the distance medley relay team of

Britten Petrey, Samone Thompson, Lindsey Rakosnik, and Alyssa Schneider placed sixth at Big Ten Indoor Championships. Outdoors, the distance medley relay team of Nicole Choquette, Samone Thompson, Amanda Duvendack, and Alyssa Schneider took fifth-place at the Drake Relays under Jones' watch.

In his first season as head coach in 2013, Jones led the Illinois women's cross country team to its first Illini Challenge title since 2006. The team placed ninth at the Big Ten Championships and eighth at the NCAA Midwest Regional. For the first time since 2009, the Illini were represented at the NCAA Championships as Alyssa Schneider competed at the national meet for the first time in her career. During the 2014 indoor track season, the distance medley relay team of Stephanie Morgan, Kymbriana Taylor, Chloe Schmidt and Alyssa Schneider placed third at the Big Ten Championships with the third-fastest time in school history. Outdoors, Jones guided Alyssa Schneider in cracking Illinois' all-time top-10 list in three different distance events.

While at Akron, Jones was a two-time MAC Women's Cross Country Coach of the Year and coached two conference champion teams. He also assisted with 10 MAC Indoor and Outdoor Track and Field Championship teams, as his distance runners contributed to eight of the last nine conference titles. Jones has coached two All-Americans and 22 All-MAC cross country runners, as well as 25 individual MAC Indoor and Outdoor Track and Field champions.

In his first stint at Illinois, Jones helped produce three Big Ten team titles, as well as consecutive fourth-place finishes at the NCAA Championships in 1995 and 1996. Jones began his career as a volunteer assistant coach at Cornell

University, where he assisted with teams that finished fourth at the NCAA Cross Country





BRYAN CARREL

POLE VAULT COACH

12TH SEASON

Bryan Carrel enters his 12th season as a volunteer coach for the Illinois women's track and field team, working with the pole vaulters. Carrel also has spent 12 years as a volunteer assistant for the Illini men's program. He also coached Stephanie Richartz to a successful season, winning the Big Ten pole vault title outdoors and finishing runner-up indoors as well as setting the school record in both seasons. She also qualified for the NCAA Indoor Championships, finished third in the event at 2015 outdoors, and was also an Olympic Trials qualifier in the event. The year prior, she scored in the top four for both indoor and outdoors as well as qualified for nationals. Sophomore Elizabeth Eitzen also scored marks which sit in the top-10 all-time.

In 2008, on the woman's side, Pintaro and Ziegler both set career-best indoor marks of 12-7 1/2 at the Carle/Health Alliance Invitational.

During the 2007 season, Carrel guided three Illini pole vaulters, Amanda Pintaro, Jackie Ziegler and Ashley Whittaker, to the NCAA Mid-east Regional Championships, as all three also scored for Illinois at the Big Ten Outdoor Championships.

Prior to his time at Illinois, Carrel enjoyed nine years in the coaching profession, spending eight seasons at Indiana State as a pole vault and jumps coach and one season at Central Michigan.

A four-time national qualifier in the pole vault during his collegiate career at Indiana State, Carrel is still the ISU outdoor school record holder in the event and was ranked among the top pole vaulters in the country during both his prep and collegiate careers. Carrel is a 1996 graduate of Indiana State with a degree in education.

Prior to his enrollment at Indiana State, Carrel spent four years with the United States Marine Corps and is a veteran of the Persian Gulf War. In addition to his coaching duties, Carrel also is a Technical Sales Representative of pole vault equipment for Gill Athletics.

Carrel and his wife, Lori, have two sons, Brandon and Tyler. Brandon is currently a member of the Illinois track team.

2015 SEASON IN REVIEW

In his second year, Ron Garner's Fighting Illini women's track and field team ended the 2014-15 season with two individual Big Ten titles, three NCAA Championships qualifiers, a pair of first-team All-America honors, and numerous additions to the program's all-time top-10 lists.

Stephanie Richartz starred for the Illini in 2014-15 by winning the Big Ten pole vault indoor and outdoor titles, taking third at the NCAA Championships, being named a first-team All-American, and being honored with the Dike Eddleman Award. Over the course of her career at Illinois, she set the Big Ten Indoor Championships pole vault record at indoor conference, set a Big Ten indoor conference record at NCAA Indoor Championships, and had five combined indoor and outdoor Big Ten pole vault titles, which is also a conference record.

Indoor Season

Illinois began the 2015 campaign at the EIU Early Bird on December 5 where the team collected five individual event titles. Kandie Bloch-Jones' 1.71m high jump was good enough to garner Big Ten Field Athlete of the Week honors.

To begin 2015, the Fighting Illini split the inaugural Border Battle Duals, beating the No. 24 Missouri Tigers and taking the loss against Iowa. Breeana Coleman led the way for the Illini as she collected titles in the 200m and 60m hurdles.

A week later, the Fighting Illini cruised to an Illini Classic victory with Stephanie Richartz and Jennifer DeBellis leading the way in the pole vault, finishing first and second respectively. Coleman continued her success in the 60m hurdles by grabbing her third consecutive title to start the season.

At the Rod McCravy Memorial Meet, Richartz broke her own school record by clearing 4.33m, .08m better than her previous best, finishing third among collegiate competitors.

The Notre Dame Mevo Invite saw the Illini record 11 season-bests. The most impressive performance came from Nicole Choquette who finished first among collegiate competitors in the 600m with a time of 1:30.47, and moved from 10th to third on the Illinois event performance list.

The Iowa State Classic saw the Fighting Illini finish in the top-10 in seven events. Additionally, Schneider topped her second-fastest 5,000m time in school history with a time of 16:29.43.

A week later, the team took home the Orange and Blue Open title, winning 12 individual events. Richartz continued her dominance in the pole vault this season by breaking her own school record of 4.33m by clearing 4.38m. The standout performance on the track came from Coleman who took home two event titles, winning the 60m and marking her season-best time of 8.30 in the 60m hurdles.

At the end of February, the Fighting Illini took 10th at the Big Ten Indoor Championships in Geneva, Ohio. The Illini were led by Richartz's who won her second indoor pole vault title with a mark of 4.39, which broke her own school record of 4.38m. DeBellis topped her personal best in the pole vault as well, clearing 4.09m and taking fourth place. On the track, Choquette won the 600m with a time of 1:29.48. The mark was good for third on the school's all-time list.

Two weeks later, Richartz represented the Fighting Illini at the NCAA Indoor Championships and, once again, topped her school record pole vault mark by clearing 4.45m, taking home a third-place finish.

Outdoor Season

Illinois traveled to Arizona to begin their outdoor season at the Baldy Castillo Invitational. The Illini nabbed 14 top-10 finishes and took sixth place. Richartz (pole vault) and Choquette (800m) earned second-place finishes and each took home Big Ten Athlete of the Week honors.

In Nashville, the Illini competed in the Vanderbilt Black & Gold Invitational. The Illini finished the weekend with 28 top-10 performances, including event titles from Bloch-Jones (high jump), DeBellis (pole vault), Jazuan Wallace-Sipp (discus), and Amanda Duvendack (800m).

Next, the Illini took fourth place in the EIU Big Blue Classic. The best performance came from the 4x800m relay team as it set the EIU Big Blue Classic meet record with a time of 8:52.06. Britten Petrey had the strongest individual performance as she finished first in the 3,000m steeplechase with a personal-best time of 10:33.08.

In the Jim Click Shootout, which included No. 7 USC and No. 15 LSU, the Fighting Illini finished fifth overall with three event winners: Petrey (3,000m steeplechase), Kandie Bloch-Jones (high jump), and Richartz (pole vault).

The Illini returned home to take second-place in the Illini Twilight meet, earning five event victories. Richartz led the team by establishing a new school and Illinois Soccer and Track Stadium record with a clearance of 4.36m. DeBellis shined in the pole vault as well as she moved into second place all-time in the Illinois record book with a clearance of 4.03m.

The Fighting Illini traveled to Des Moines, Iowa for the annual Drake Relays where the team finished 11th in the 20 team field. Richartz earned the lone Illini event title as she cleared 4.30m in the pole vault.

The Orange and Blue finished out the regular season at Purdue where the team grabbed seven event titles and 23 top-10 finishes. Choquette broke the tape in the 800m at 2:06.70, setting a new lifetime-best. Bloch-Jones won the high jump with a mark of 1.84m, second best in Illini history, and earned Big Ten Field Athlete of the Week honors.

After a week off, the Illini competed in the Big Ten Outdoor Track and Field Championships in East Lansing, finishing 11th. Richartz came away with the pole vault title as she cleared 4.37m, a new Big Ten Outdoor Track and Field Championships meet record. This was Richartz third Big Ten Outdoor Championship pole vault crown, the most in conference history.

After Big Tens, eight Illini qualified for the NCAA West Preliminary Round in Austin, Texas. Bloch-Jones and Richartz both earned NCAA Championships qualification with Bloch-Jones finishing eighth in the high jump and Richartz tying for fourth in the pole vault.

To conclude the 2015 track campaign, the Fighting Illini sent Richartz and Bloch-Jones to the NCAA Championships in Eugene, Oregon from June 10-13. Once there, Richartz cleared 4.45m to finish third and break the Illinois and Big Ten pole vault record one final time. Bloch-Jones concluded her season by finishing 20th in the high jump with a clearance of 1.72m.

After NAAs, Richartz competed for the final time in Orange and Blue at the United States Outdoor Track and Field Championships, finishing tied for 14th with a clearance of 4.25m.

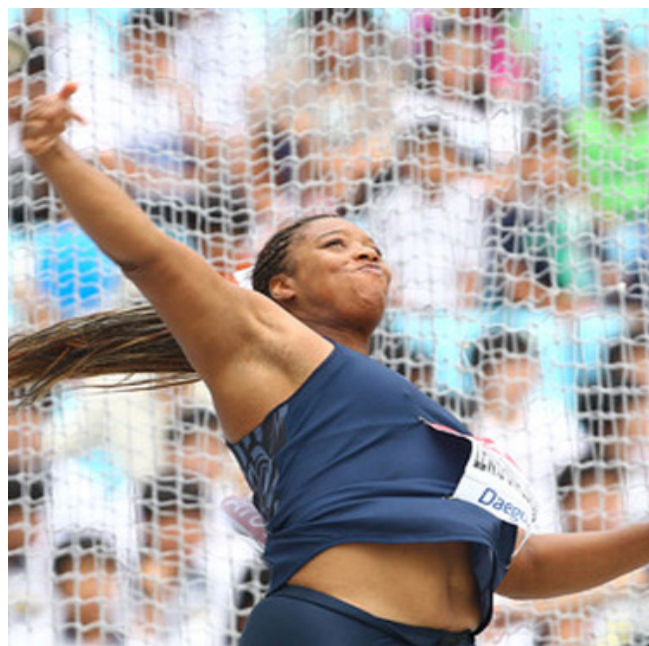

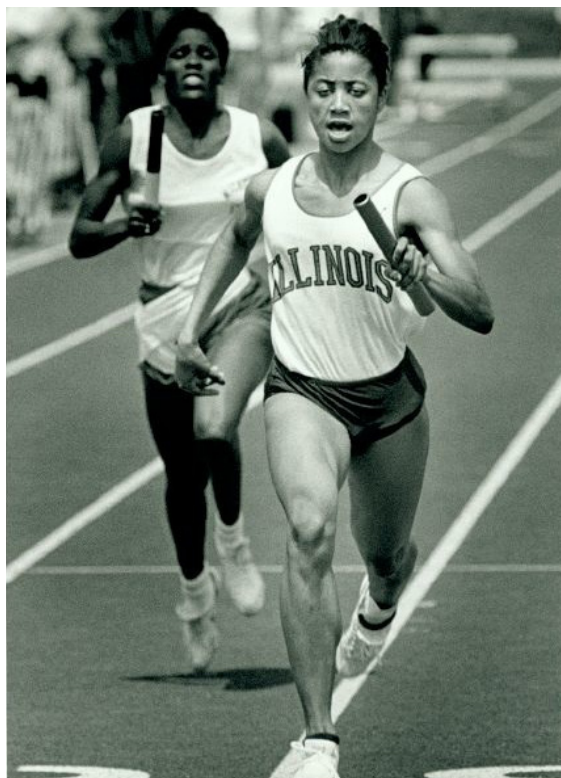
