2012-13 SEASON PREVIEW

With the Fighting Illini swimming and diving team returning 29 athletes from last year's squad and adding nine talented newcomers, it will look to improve on its 5-7 record from last year.

"As a team we continue to focus on competing better, getting faster and looking to improve on our finish at the Big Ten Championships," Illini head coach Sue Novitsky said. "For us to do that, we need to continue to take advantage of our competitions and practices throughout the year and really test our limits. Learning to handle the pressure, stay calm and perform are things that the coaches will be looking at every day."

After graduating nine athletes last season, the Illini return eight seniors, including swimmers Sarah Coady, Kimberly Kalenda, Kathleen Knight, Erin Lamb, Alyssa Petruzzello and Erin Rodriguez and divers Keri Eberhardt and Darragh McDermott.

Jessica Holz, Erica Lynn and Courtney Pope, who collectively have eight spots on Illinois' all-time fastest individuals list, lead a strong junior class for the Illini. Cara Chuang, Anne Goering, Marin Thompson, Alyssa Toland, Emily Wilkinson and Emma Williams round out the experienced group of juniors.

"I expect leadership to come from the whole team," Novitsky said. "We continue to discuss the expectations in practice, in the classroom and as a team. From there, we encourage the athletes to take responsibility for helping to maintain those expectations. It can be someone different each day. I feel that if they are being held accountable by their teammates, that is when great changes take place."

With a year of collegiate experience under their belts, the group of 12 sophomores will look to make an even bigger impact this season.

"I see the sophomores gaining that maturity and being more well balanced to handle the different demands of school and athletics," Novitsky said. "Having a year of experience, they have a better idea of what to expect and can use that to their advantage to continue to improve. As with the freshmen, we will need them to step up and fill some holes that we may have in our line-up."

The incoming freshmen will look to adjust to swimming and diving on the collegiate level and attempt to contribute to the team's success in their debut season.

"We have a talented group of freshman this year," Novitsky said. "I expect them to be competing for spots in meets and on relays. Many of them are at the top or near the top in their events on our depth chart, so they have a chance to make a big impact this year. I am going to be calling on them to step up in different events as well to help out the team."

Sprint Freestyle

Seniors Kalenda and Lamb, juniors Goering and Pope and sophomores Alison Meng and Megan Marchuk will lead the Illini in the sprint freestyle. Last season, Pope improved her personal best times in the 50 free (23.52) and 100 free (50.75) to rank ninth and fifth, respectively, on Illinois' all-time fastest individuals list. Sophomores Alexa Chavez, Sabrina Gibson and Mary Beth Howard and newcomer Kirsten Zborek will also look to contribute in the sprint-free events this season.

Middle-Distance Freestyle

The Illini will rely on Lamb as well as junior Pope and sophomores Hailey Booth, Howard and Marchuk in the middle-distance freestyle events. Pope led the Illini in the 200 free (1:49.78) last season and currently ranks seventh on Illinois' all-time fastest individuals list.

Distance Freestyle

Senior Knight, juniors Pope and Toland, and sophomores Booth and Kayla Dlugopolski will lead the group of distance freestylers. Last season, Dlugopolski was second on the team in the 1000 free (10:28.14) and 1650 free (17:11.73).

Backstroke and Breaststroke

Senior Coady, juniors Chuang, Holz and Wilkinson and sophomores Chavez and Meng will be back to compete in the backstroke along with sophomores Gibson and Howard. Last season, Meng became the fastest Illini to swim the 50 back (25.88) in school history. She also holds spots on Illinois' all-time fastest individuals list in the 100 back (55.71; third) and 200 back (2:02.71; eighth). Holz also moved up both lists, ranking fourth in the 100 back (56.39) and fifth in the 200 back (2:00.14). Joining them will be newcomers Stephanie Hein, Lori Lynn and Sloane McDermott. Returning swimmers Sarah Coady, Andrea DeAngelis, Erica Lynn and Marin Thompson will lead the Illini in the breaststroke. Erica Lynn is currently the fifth-fastest Illini to swim the 100 breast (1:04.03) and the fourth-fastest Illini to swim the 200 breast (2:16.50). Last season, Sarah Coady moved into 10th on the all-time fastest individuals list in the 200 breast (2:19.87). Joining them will be newcomers Jennifer Coady, Hein, Isabella Schamber and Hollie Smith.

Butterfly

The Illini return a veteran group of swimmers for the fly events with seniors Knight, Petruzzello and Rodriguez, juniors Thompson, Wilkinson and Williams and sophomores Booth and Meng. Last season in the 200 fly, Rodriguez became the all-time fastest Illini in the event (2:01.72), while Knight moved up to sixth (2:02.70). Meng moved up on the all-time fastest individuals list in the 50 fly (25.64; second) and 100 fly (56.02; sixth). Newcomers Lori Lynn and Sarah Sykstus will also look to contribute this season.

Individual Medley and Relays

The Illini will have a blend of experience in the individual medley, with upperclassmen Sarah Coady, Erica Lynn, Rodriguez, Thompson, Wilkinson and Williams joining sophomores Booth, Chavez, DeAngelis and Callan McDermott and freshman Jennifer Coady, Hein, Lori Lynn and Sloane McDermott. Chuang, Holz, Lamb, Meng and Pope all return to help solidify the relay teams for the Illini. Last season, Meng and Pope were part of the 200 medley relay team that swam the fastest time (1:41.94) in Illini history. Pope and Holz helped break the school record in the 400 free relay (3:21.83) as well.

Diving

The Illini return two NCAA Zone C Diving Championship qualifiers in seniors Keri Eberhardt and Darragh McDermott, who will look to build on last year's achievements.

"With Britni and Tessa leaving, Keri and Darragh now have their chance to shine," diving coach Chris Waters said. "They are very aware that their roles on the team have changed, but they have each other. They're roommates, synchro partners and really complement each other very well. It's going to be nice to see them step out into the limelight a little this year."

Last season, McDermott set career highs in both the one-meter dive (266.45) and three-meter dive (274.35) last season.

"Our goal is pretty simple and that is to qualify for Zones once again," Waters said. "We need to continue to stay healthy yet push them beyond their current comfort zones by increasing the difficulty of their dive lists."

Joining Eberhardt and Darragh McDermott are sophomores Emily Fung and Erika Murphy and newcomer Jessica Clifford.

"Emily and Erika are now over a year removed from their ACL surgeries and have certainly benefited from a summer of strong training," Waters said. "Erika is incredibly talented and a very hard worker. Despite the surgery, she has made incredible progress and should have a terrific year. Our lone freshman Jessica is very new to the sport, and the goal is to provide her a better base in our sport, so she can contribute to the team in the future."

SUE NOVITSKY

HEAD COACH // 13TH SEASON



Sue Novitsky enters her 13th season as the head coach of the University of Illinois swimming and diving team. Novitsky, who joined the University of Illinois swimming and diving staff as a volunteer assistant coach in 1994, begins her 19th season as a part of the Illini program. After three seasons of working as the volunteer coach, Novitsky was promoted to assistant coach in the fall of 1997. In August 2000, she was hired by former Director of Athletics, Ron Guenther, as the fifth head coach in the program's history.

Novitsky's first year as head coach was filled with success as three Illini qualified for the NCAA Championships, and Jessica Aveyard repeated as an All-American in the 200 backstroke. Novitsky's swimmers continued their success at the national and international levels, as Aveyard and Ilkay Dikmen qualified to represent their native countries at the FINA World Swimming Championships in Fukuoka,

Japan. Aveyard, swimming for the United States, reached the semifinals in the 200 backstroke, while Dikmen, a 2000 Olympian, competed for Turkey in the 200 breaststroke. Dikmen also swam in the 2004 Olympics in the 100 and 200 breaststroke.

As an assistant coach, Novitsky trained several athletes, including Aveyard, who was an NCAA qualifier, All-American and World Championship semifinalist, and Anna Christiansen, who was a three-time NCAA qualifier.

In addition, Novitsky trained six former Fighting Illini athletes at the 2000 U.S. Olympic trials.

As a swimmer, Novitsky was a two-time Division II All-American at Oakland University, earning a bachelor's degree in biochemistry in 1991. She was a student assistant coach for the 1991 Division II national champion Oakland Pioneers. Novitsky also earned a master's degree in kinesiology from Oakland.

A native of Huntington Woods, Mich., Novitsky previously worked as an assistant coach for the Oakland Live Y'ers age-group team.

Steve Farnau begins his 13th season at the University of Illinois as the associate head coach. Farnau serves as the primary recruiting coordinator in addition to fulfilling his on-deck coaching duties as the sprint coach. Farnau oversaw the training of honorable mention All-American Barbie Viney, NCAA- and school-record holders Christina Brunka, Meghan Farrell and Becca Poetz, as well as school-record holders Ashley Braun and Astrid Matthias.

Prior to coming to Illinois, Farnau was the head coach and aquatics director for the Patriot Aquatics Swim Team at the Longwood Aquatic Club in Orlando, Fla., where he designed and oversaw daily workouts for senior and age-group swimmers.

Before that, Farnau was the assistant women's swimming and diving coach at Southern Illinois University from 1996-99. Farnau was the primary recruiter for the Saluki squad, guiding them to back-to-back conference championships.

Farnau began his coaching career at Kentucky. From 1990-96, he was the head age-group coach for Wildcat Aquatics, directing a squad of more than 150 athletes.

Farnau swam at Georgia from 1988-90 and later earned a bachelor's degree in health and physical education/sport administration from Kentucky in 1994. In 1998, he earned his master's degree in sport management from Southern Illinois University.

Farnau resides in Champaign with his wife, Dee.

DIVING COACH // SEVENTH SEASON

Chris Waters begins his seventh season as the Illini diving coach. Last season, Waters oversaw the training of NCAA Zone C qualifiers Britni Fisher, Tessa Adams, Keri Eberhardt and Darragh McDermott

Waters came to Illinois with a wide variety of experience as a diving coach, including stops at Tulane, Syracuse, Virginia Tech and Missouri State. At Tulane, Waters had a top-12 finisher in both the one-and three-meter diving competitions at the Conference USA Championships. Waters also coached one Syracuse diver to the NCAA Zone A Championships in 2005 and had two divers place at the Big East Conference meet.

Waters coached an honorable mention All-American in the one-and three-meter diving competitions at Division III Connecticut College in 2000 and was named Missouri Valley Conference Diving Coach of the Year in 1999 after coaching the Male Diver of the Year and the men's one-and three-meter champions at Missouri

State.

A member of the United States Diving and the Professional Diving Coaches Association, Waters has coached six Academic All-Conference selectees throughout his career. He graduated from Castleton State University with a bachelor's degree in criminal justice in 1991 and earned a master's degree in health promotion and wellness management from Missouri State in 2002.

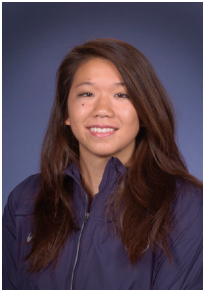

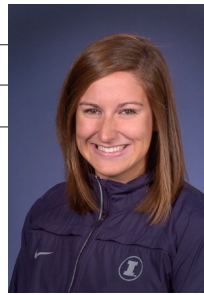

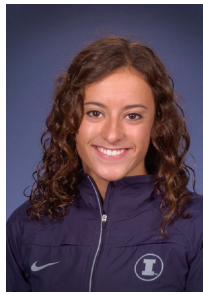

2011-12 SEASON IN REVIEW

The Fighting Illini swimming and diving team started the season strong, winning four of its first six dual meets before finishing the year 7-12 overall. Individually, the squad induced 25 changes to the all-time fastest individuals list and eight changes to the top dives list.

After losing their first two meets of the season to Northwestern and Kansas, the Orange and Blue rallied to win four straight dual meets. Three of those four wins were by more than 50 points to earn victories over Illinois-Chicago, Wisconsin-Milwaukee and Illinois State. The other win was a tough-fought event at Michigan State, where the Illini pulled out the victory, 154.5-145.5.

Illinois also had success in the Northwestern Invitational, where it finished second of eight after a thrilling battle for second place with Iowa State. It came down to the 400 free relay, where the Fighting Illini finished four hundredths of a second ahead of Iowa State to take second place by one point.

Unfortunately, Illinois could not maintain its momentum and lost five of its next six dual meets. Four of the five losses came to Big Ten foes, including then-No. 15 Minnesota, No. 19 Wisconsin, Purdue and Iowa.

At the Big Ten Championships, the Illini placed 10th, though four school records were broken at the event. The 400 free relay team of Courtney Pope, Kristen Manias, Jessica Holz and Brittany McGowan shattered the school record with a time of 3:21.83. The other school record breakers included Alison Meng, April McKee, McGowan and Pope in the 200 medley relay (1:41.94), Erin Rodriguez in the 200 fly (2:01.72) and Alison Meng in the 50 back (25.88).

Sophomore Holz led Illinois with seven first-place finishes and posted the team's best time in the 200 back (2:00.14) to rank fifth on the all-time fastest individuals list. Junior Kathleen Knight, sophomore Erica Lynn and freshman Meng each had two individual first-place finishes on the season.

Meng had a breakout campaign and led the Illini in the 50 (25.88) and 100 (55.71) back, in which she currently ranks first and third, respectively, on the all-time fastest individuals list. Meng also ranks second in the 50 fly (25.64) and sixth in the 100 fly (56.02) on the all-time fastest individuals list. The Lodi, Wis., native took home the team's Newcomer of the Year title for her effort.

Sophomore Pope moved up on the all-time fastest individuals list in the 100 (5th; 50.75) and 200 (7th; 1:49.78) free, while senior McGowan led the team in the 100 free (3rd; 50.64) and 50 fly (1st; 25.49) to rank on the top-10 list as well.

Senior Torrey Loper showed her consistency by leading Illinois in the 500 (4:57.03), 1000 (10:21.04) and 1650 (16:57.62) free for the second consecutive season. Loper currently has spots on the all-time fastest individuals list in the 1000 (10th; 10:14.27) and 1650 (9th; 16:57.62) free.

On the boards, senior Britni Fisher and juniors Tessa Adams, Keri Eberhardt and Darragh McDermott qualified for the NCAA Zone C Diving Championships. This marked Fisher's fourth and Adams' third zone diving appearances. Fisher led the Illini divers with four first-place finishes on the season while breaking school records in the one-meter dive (298.27) and three-meter dive (319.65).

In the classroom, the Illini swimmers and divers continued the program's tradition of excellence, earning the Fighting Illini Outstanding Team GPA Award with the highest grade point average (3.48) of any varsity team at Illinois. Individually, senior McKee and junior Erin Lamb each earned the highest GPAs among all Illini female athletes in their respective classes.

Additionally, Illinois earned the Fall 2012 Scholar All-America Team Award with the ninth-highest GPA (3.48) among women's Division I swimming and diving teams and earned the spring award as well, ranking 23rd with a 3.47 GPA. The swimmers and divers led all Illini sports with 23 selectees on the 2011-12 Winter Academic All-Big Ten list and boasted 11 Big Ten Distinguished Scholars.
