2013-14 SEASON PREVIEW

After producing 27 changes to the all-time fastest individuals list last season, the Fighting Illini swimming and diving team – poised with a talented group of newcomers – will look to improve on last season's 2-8 record.

"The team is working hard towards a successful season," head coach Sue Novitsky said. "The athletes have been putting in the work in the weight room, on the deck and in the pool. As a team, we are looking to have a winning dual meet record overall and among Big Ten Conference teams."

The Illini will return a strong group of experienced swimmers and divers including six senior swimmers in Cara Chuang, Anne Goering, Jessica Holz, Erica Lynn, Courtney Pope and Alyssa Toland. Holz, Lynn and Pope collectively have eight spots on Illinois' all-time fastest individuals list.

"Our six seniors are fired up and ready to go out with a bang," Novitsky said. "There is tremendous talent and leadership among the senior class. Each one brings a different element to the team, and together, they are a very complete group."

Led by Alison Meng, the fastest in Illini history in the 50 and 100 backstroke, the juniors have a group of experienced swimmers ready to get in the pool. Hailey Booth, Andrea DeAngelis, Kayla Dlugopolski, Sabrinne Gibson, Mary Beth Howard, Megan Marchuk and Callan McDermott round out the competitive junior class.

With two-thirds of the team consisting of sophomores and juniors, progression will be key to a competitive season. The Illini have set a goal this season to see 65 lifetime best times or scores this season. The sophomore class saw a couple of swimmers move into the top-10 all-time at Illinois in Lori Lynn and Sarah Sykstus. Lynn cracked into the top-10 in the 200 back (6th), 100 fly (3rd) and 200 IM (7th), while Sykstus did the same in the 100 fly (4th), 200 fly (6th), as well as the 200 IM (5th). Jennifer Coady, Stephanie Hein, Sloane McDermott, Isabella Schamber, Hollie Smith and Kristen Zborek will also return for their second season in Orange and Blue.

The newcomers to the team might be low in number, but each athlete is eager to represent the Orange and Blue and can make a strong contribution to the team this season. Sophomore transfer Rachel Burke comes to the Illini this season after a successful freshman season at the University of Connecticut. Freshmen swimmers Alison DeAngelis, Amelia Schilling and Gabbie Stecker will look to bring their talents to collegiate competition.

"I expect to see our freshmen come in and compete and contribute to the team success right away," Novitsky said. "We have some tremendous talent in the class and they are very competitive and have been tested in pressure situations prior to coming to Illinois."

This season's schedule shows a tough slate of competition with swimmers and divers having to compete in consecutive weeks multiple times.

"We have a pretty competitive Big Ten and out-of-conference schedule with meets multiple weeks in a row," Novitsky said. "We want to get experience having to step up day after day in preparation for the Big Ten Championships."

Sprint Freestyle

Seniors Goering and Pope and juniors Meng and Marchuk will lead the Illini in the sprint freestyle. Last season, Pope led the team in both the 50 free (23.29) and 100 free (50.58), improving her personal-best times in both events. Pope currently holds the third-fastest time on the all-time individual list for both events, while Meng remains the 10th-fastest Illini in the 100 free (51.12).

Middle-Distance Freestyle

The Illini will rely on Pope and Marchuk in the middle-distance freestyle events. Marchuk led the Illini in the 200 free (1:49.63), narrowly edging out Pope (1:49.65) at Big Tens. The two rank sixth and seventh, respectively, on Illinois' all-time fastest individuals list. Juniors Hailey Booth and Kayla Dlugopolski, as well as talented duo of freshman in Amelia Schilling and Gabbie Stecker, will look to make an impact throughout the season.

Distance Freestyle

Senior Alyssa Toland and junior Dlugopolski will lead the group of distance freestylers. The two combined for nine of the ten fastest times in the 1000 freestyle last season. Booth will also look to contribute distance freestyle events.

Backstroke and Breaststroke

Senior Chuang, Holz, junior Meng and sophomore Lori Lynn will be back to compete in the backstroke. Meng returns after claiming the fastest times Illini history in both the 50 and 100 backstroke last season. Lynn will look to improve from her first-year success last season after becoming the sixth-fastest Illini to swim the 200 back with a time of 2:01.58. Returning swimmers Jennifer Coady, Andrea DeAngelis, Stephanie Hein, Erica Lynn, Isabella Schamber and Hollie Smith will lead the Illini in the breaststroke. Lynn enters her final season after a strong junior year in which she posted the fastest times on the team in the 50, 100 and 200 breaststroke. Lynn currently holds the sixth-fastest time (30.14) in the 50 breast and the fifth-fastest time (1:03.96) in the 100 breast. Newcomer Alison DeAngelis will join her sister in competing in breaststroke events.

Butterfly

The Illini return a strong veteran group of swimmers for the fly events with senior Erica Lynn, juniors Meng and Booth, and sophomores Lori Lynn and Sarah Sykstus. All five swimmers rank in the top 10 in Illinois' all-time fastest individuals list in a fly event. Last season in the 50 fly, Meng became the all-time fastest Illini in the event (25.23), while Erica Lynn moved up to ninth (26.04). In their first year of collegiate action, Lynn and Sykstus both claimed positions near the top of the all-time fastest individuals list, as Lynn swam the 100 fly in 55.38 seconds, good for third all-time, while Sykstus swam the 200 fly in 2:02.52, good for sixth all-time. Newcomer Stecker will look to try and match Lynn and Sykstus' first-year success this season.

Individual Medley and Relays

The Illini will also rely on Lori Lynn and Sykstus in the individual medley. Last season, Sykstus and Lynn climbed to fifth and seventh, respectively, on the all-time fastest individuals list in the 200 IM. Several swimmers are back for relays as well, including Holz, Erica Lynn, Meng, Marchuk and Pope. Last season the Illini posted the fastest 400 medley relay and 800 freestyle relay times in Illini history, while also posting times that rank in the top five in Illinois' all-time individual list in the 200 freestyle relay, 400 freestyle relay and 200 medley relay.

Diving

The Illini return one NCAA Zone C Diving Championship qualifier in Erika Murphy, who looks to improve in difficulty level this season.

Joining Murphy is junior Emily Fung, sophomore Jessica Clifford and freshmen Olivia Kassouni. Last season, Fung and Murphy set career highs in both the one-meter and three-meter dives. Clifford will look to do the same this season in hopes for numerous appearances from the Illini in the Zone C Championships this season.

"Our goal is to have three divers, hopefully four, in the Zone C Championships this season," diving coach Chris Waters said. "We want to try and keep our numbers up at the Zone C Championships."

The Illini sent three divers to the event last and will look to continue that success this season.

Kassouni comes to Illini with two individual diving state championships and two team state championships. Kassouni comes to the Illini in good form.

HEAD COACH // 14TH SEASON



Sue Novitsky enters her 14th season as the head coach of the University of Illinois swimming and diving team. Novitsky, who joined the University of Illinois swimming and diving staff as a volunteer assistant coach in 1994, begins her 20th season as a part of the Illini program. After three seasons of working as the volunteer coach, Novitsky was promoted to assistant coach in the fall of 1997. In August 2000, she was hired by former Director of Athletics, Ron Guenther, as the fifth head coach in the program's history.

Novitsky's first year as head coach was filled with success as three Illini qualified for the NCAA Championships, and Jessica Aveyard repeated as an All-American in the 200 backstroke. Novitsky's swimmers continued their success at the national and international levels, as Aveyard and Ilkay Dikmen qualified to represent their native countries at the FINA World Swimming Championships in Fukuoka, Japan. Aveyard, swimming for the United States, reached the semifinals in the 200 backstroke, while Dikmen, a 2000 Olympian, competed for Turkey in the 200 breaststroke. Dikmen also swam in the 2004 Olympics in the 100 and 200 breaststroke.



As an assistant coach, Novitsky trained several athletes, including Aveyard, who was an NCAA qualifier, All-American and World Championship semifinalist, and Anna Christiansen, who was a three-time NCAA qualifier.

In addition, Novitsky trained six former Fighting Illini athletes at the 2000 U.S. Olympic trials.

As a swimmer, Novitsky was a two-time Division II All-American at Oakland University, earning a bachelor's degree in biochemistry in 1991. She was a student assistant coach for the 1991 Division II national champion Oakland Pioneers. Novitsky also earned a master's degree in kinesiology from Michigan.

A native of Huntington Woods, Mich., Novitsky previously worked as an assistant coach for the Oakland Live Y'ers age-group team.

ALEC HAYDEN
ASSISTANT COACH // FIRST SEASON

Alec Hayden is entering his first season as an assistant swimming coach with the Fighting Illini swimming and diving program. Hayden comes to Illinois from William & Mary, where he spent one season as an assistant coach.

In just one season at William & Mary, Hayden was the primary coach for swimmers who accomplished four conference records, 32 school records, 20 freshman records and 10 NCAA B cuts. His only recruiting class with the Tribe was the best in program history and included the first top-100 recruit in program history.

At the Colonial Athletic Association Championships, he coached seven individual conference champions and three relay championship teams. Tribe swimmers took home co-Swimmer of the Meet, Rookie of the Year and Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

Prior to joining the staff at William & Mary, Hayden served as the head senior coach for the Nasa Wildcat Aquatics team, which was comprised of 40 high school and eighth-grade swimmers. Under his tutelage, Wildcat swimmers set one national age group record and eight state records. He coached three swimmers who qualified for the 2012 U.S. Olympic Trials.

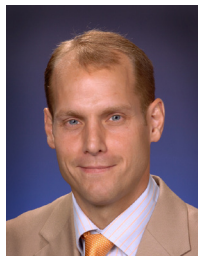
He coached four swimmers to a combined 14 state championships and also coached the 2011 50 freestyle USA Swimming Junior National runner-up. At the 2012 National Club Swimming Association Junior Nationals, he coached the Wildcat boys to an eighth-place national finish and the combined team to a 10th-place finish.

While working with the Nasa Wildcat Aquatics team, Hayden simultaneously worked as a volunteer assistant for Northwestern University. At Northwestern, Hayden worked with both the men's and women's programs, including work with an NCAA Championships finalist, two NCAA consolation finalists and five NCAA qualifiers.

Hayden started his coaching career as an assistant senior coach with Nasa Wildcat Aquatics in April of 2008. Working primarily with the sprint groups, Hayden coached athletes who set one national age group record and 11 state records. He coached three individual state champions and the U.S. Open 100 butterfly runner-up.

As an athlete, Hayden was a four-year letter winner and two-year captain as a member of the Northwestern Wildcats swimming team from 2004-2008. Hayden was an All-American at New Trier High School, and he was also a team captain and four-year All-Conference honoree.

Hayden graduated from Northwestern in June 2008 with dual degrees in Mathematical Methods in the Social Sciences and Economics.



CHRIS WATERS
DIVING COACH // EIGHTH SEASON

Chris Waters begins his eighth season as the Illini diving coach. Last season, Waters oversaw the training of NCAA Zone C qualifiers Keri Eberhardt, Darragh McDermott and Erika Murphy. In 2012 he oversaw the training for qaulifiers Britni Fisher, Tessa Adams, Keri Eberhardt and Darragh McDermott.

Waters came to Illinois with a wide variety of experience as a diving coach, including stops at Tulane, Syracuse, Virginia Tech and Missouri State. At Tulane, Waters had a top-12 finisher in both the one-and three-meter diving competitions at the Conference USA Championships. Waters also coached one Syracuse diver to the NCAA Zone A Championships in 2005 and had two divers place at the Big East Conference meet.

Waters coached an honorable mention All-American in the one-and three-meter diving competitions at Division III Connecticut College in 2000 and was named Missouri Valley Conference Diving Coach of the Year in 1999 after coaching the Male Diver of the Year and the men's one-and three-meter champions at Missouri State.

A member of the United States Diving and the Professional Diving Coaches Association, Waters has coached six Academic All-Conference selectees throughout his career. He graduated from Castleton State University with a bachelor's degree in criminal justice in 1991 and earned a master's degree in health promotion and wellness management from Missouri State in 2002.

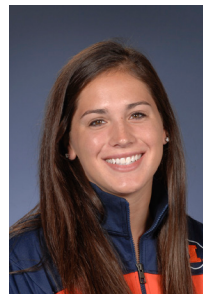

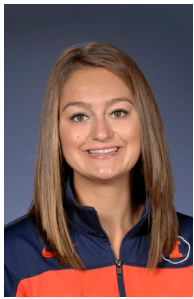

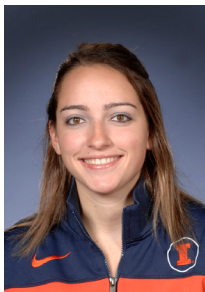

2012-13 SEASON IN REVIEW

The Fighting Illini swimming and diving team finished the year 2-8 overall. Individually, the squad induced 27 changes to the all-time fastest individuals list.

After losing their first meet of the season to Northwestern, the Orange and Blue bounced back to defeat Michigan State by six points to start the season 1-1 at home. The Illini would then drop its first road meet against in-state rival Illinois State before heading into the TYR Invitational. The Illini had success at the Invitational held in Evanston, where it finished second of six after entering the final day in first. The Illini's second and last win of the season would come at the hands of Iowa State, 194-106.

Unfortunately, Illinois could not maintain its momentum and lost its last five dual meets on the season. All of the losses came to Big Ten foes, including Iowa, Nebraska, Minnesota, Wisconsin and Purdue.

At the Big Ten Championships, the Illini placed 11th, though four school records were broken at the event. The 400 medley relay team of Alison Meng, Erica Lynn, Kathleen Knight and Megan Marchuk shattered the school record with a time of 3:43.73. The other school record breakers included Marchuk, Lamb, Howard and Courtney Pope in the 800 free relay (7:20.87) and Alison Meng in the 50 back (25.57) and 100 back (55.11).

Sophomore Meng had a breakout campaign earning the Most Valuable Swimmer award for the season. She led the Illini in the 50 and 100 back, as well as the 50 fly, which she broke the school record at the TYR Invitational with a time of 25.23. The Lodi, Wis., native also ranks 10th on the all-time fastest individuals list in the 100 free (51.12).

Junior Pope moved up on the all-time fastest individuals list in the 50 free (3rd; 23.29), 100 free (3rd; 50.58) and 200 free (7th 1:49.63), while junior Erica Lynn led the team in the 50 breast (6th; 30.14) and 100 breast (5th; 1:03.96) to rank on the top-10 list as well. Lynn also led the team in the 200 breast.

The sophomore class saw a couple of swimmers move into the top 10 all-time at Illinois in Lori Lynn and Sarah Sykstus. Lynn cracked into the top-10 in the 200 back (6), 100 fly (3) and 200 IM (7), while Sykstus did the same in the 100 fly (4), 200 fly (6), as well as the 200 IM (5).

On the boards, seniors Keri Eberhardt and Darragh McDermott and sophomore Erika Murphy qualified for the NCAA Zone C Diving Championships. McDermott led the Illini divers with highest one-meter dive (273.66), while Eberhardt had the highest three-meter dive (273.30).
