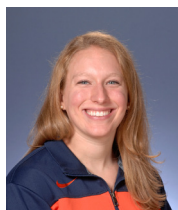

2014-15 SEASON PREVIEW

After recording the most wins in a regular season since the 1999-2000 season, the Fighting Illini swimming and diving team will look to build on last season's impressive 8-6-1 record.

"We just need to keep working on our details and control what we can control," head coach Sue Novitsky said. "We're looking to continue having a winning dual meet record and to protect our home pool come January. We want to keep improving and keep growing as athletes and as a team as a whole."

The Illini graduated six athletes from 2013-14, but will return 21 experienced swimmers and divers from last year's squad. Led by Alison Meng, the Illini record holder in the 50 and 100 backstroke, the senior class is filled with seasoned swimmers ready to step up for the Orange and Blue. Hailey Booth, Kayla Dlugopolski, Emily Fung, Sabrinne Gibson, Megan Marchuk, Callan McDermott and Erika Murphy round out the senior class. Meng and Marchuk together hold seven spots on Illinois' all-time fastest individuals list.

"You're always going to graduate some and you always have to fill their spots," Novitsky said. "I think Alison Meng is still going to be a force to contend with this season, as well as Megan Marchuk."

With over half the team consisting of upperclassmen, leadership will be the key to a successful season. The junior class leads by example, with swimmers Lori Lynn and Sarah Sykstus posting the teams' season best times in the IM events last year. Lynn recorded the fastest 200 IM of the season, which placed her at 7th on Illinois' all-time fastest individuals list. Not to be outdone, Sykstus became the third-fastest Illini all-time in the 200 fly and posted the Illini's fastest 400 IM of the season. Jessica Clifford, Jennifer Coady, Stephanie Hein, Sloane McDermott, Isabella Schamber and Kristen Zborek complete the experienced junior class.

Last year's small freshmen class made big waves in their debut season and will look to continue to do so in 2014-15. Gabbie Stecker became the fastest Illini of all-time in the 200 fly while cracking the Illini all-time top 10 in the 200 free (10th), 500 free (2nd), 1000 free (6th) and 1650 free (9th). Amelia Schilling also broke into the top 10 in the 200 free (6th), 500 free (5th) and 1650 free (7th). The two combined to claim 13 event victories over the course of the season. Alison DeAngelis and Olivia Kassouni will also return for their second season in Orange and Blue.

The Illini will add eight new athletes to the squad with a promising freshmen class that is ready to make an immediate impact. Freshmen Ashley Aegerter, Gabrielle Bethke, Nelly Casas, Raquel Corniuk, Adelaide Curry, Kaitlyn Joyce, Sascha Meyers and Samantha Stratford will all look to bring their prowess to the collegiate level.

"We have our freshmen coming in that are pretty talented and they'll get their opportunity to show what they fully can do," Novitsky said.

The Illini will face strong competition this year as their strength of schedule intensifies from last season. However, the Illini hope to have back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since the 1998-99 and 1999-2000 seasons.

"We've upped our strength of schedule, so we definitely have to keep focus for each meet," Novitsky said. "We're going to be able to put up a pretty competitive schedule overall and a pretty competitive meet lineup for whoever we're facing."

Sprint Freestyle

It will be a transition year for the Illini in the sprint freestyle events as graduated swimmers Courtney Pope and Jessica Holz have left big shoes to fill. Seniors Meng and Marchuk will lead the Illini this season in the sprint freestyle. Last season, Meng led the Illini in the 100 free (50.81), improving her personal best time in the event. Meng currently holds the sixth-fastest time in the all-time individuals list in the event. Promising freshman Sam Stratford is also set to contribute in the sprint events.

Middle-Distance Freestyle

The Illini will look to sophomores Gabbie Stecker and Amelia Schilling to lead the way in the middle-distance freestyle. The young swimmers made quite the impact last year as both broke into the top 10 all-time individuals list in both the 200 and 500 free in just their first season with the Illini. The two rank tenth and sixth in the 200 free and second and fifth in the 500 free, respectively. Marchuk will also look to contribute middle-distance freestyle events.

Distance Freestyle

The Illini will look to Stecker and Schilling again in the distance freestyle. The two combined to set all of the teams' top 10 fastest times in the 1000 free last season and five of the top 10 fastest times in the 1650 free. Senior Kayla Dlugopolski will also look to contribute in the 1650 free after setting three of the Illini's top times last season.

Backstroke and Breaststroke

Senior Meng and junior Sloane McDermott will lead the Illini in the backstroke. Meng returns after breaking her own school records in both the 50 and 100 backstroke last season. Meng also swam nine of the season's 10 fastest times in the 100 backstroke for the Illini. McDermott will look to improve on her success last year after becoming the sixth-fastest Illini to swim the 200 back with a time of 2:01.24. Hollie Smith, Jennifer Coady, Stephanie Hein, Andrea DeAngelis and Isabella Schamber will compete for the Illini in the breaststroke. Smith enters her junior season on a positive note after claiming the sixth spot on the Illini's all-time fastest individuals list in the 100 breaststroke. Junior Isabella Schamber is poised to have a breakout year in the 100 breaststroke after claiming three of the Illini's top 10 times of the season. Newcomer Ashley Aegerter will also look to contribute in the breaststroke during her debut season with the Orange and Blue.

Butterfly

The Illini boast a strong group of swimmers in the butterfly, which includes seniors Alison Meng and Hailey Booth, juniors Lori Lynn and Sarah Sykstus and sophomore Gabbie Stecker. Meng is the current Illini record holder in the 50 butterfly and last season improved to second on the Illinois all-time fastest individuals list in the 100 butterfly with a time of 54.69. Stecker looks to follow up an impressive first season after setting the school record in the 200 butterfly with her finish of 2:00.50 at the Big Ten Championships. Sykstus also climbed Illinois' all-time fastest individual list in the 200 butterfly last season, finishing the season in third overall with a time of 2:01.94. Newcomer Nelly Casas will look to establish herself in the butterfly during her first year at the collegiate level.

Individual Medley and Relays

The Illini will also rely on Lynn and Sykstus in the individual medleys. Last season, Lynn improved to seventh fastest on Illinois' all-time fastest individuals list in the 200 IM. Several swimmers are returning for the Illini in the relays as well. Meng, Schamber, Lynn and Marchuk all return after breaking the school record in the 200 medley relay last season. Last season the Illini broke a total of three school relay records in the 800 freestyle, 200 medley and 400 medley relays, while also posting five times that rank in the top 10 in Illinois' all-time fastest list in the 200 freestyle, 400 freestyle, 800 freestyle, 200 medley and 400 medley relays.

Diving

The Illini return three NCAA Zone C Diving Championship qualifiers in Emily Fung, Erika Murphy and Olivia Kassouni. With all three divers returning to action this year, the Illini will look to continue their success this season. Last season Olivia Kassouni scored a 176.90 in platform diving, moving her to 3rd on the Illini's all-time best performances list. Joining those three on the boards are junior Jessica Clifford and newcomer Raquel Corniuk.



SUE NOVITSKY

HEAD COACH // 15TH SEASON



Sue Novitsky enters her 15th season as the head coach of the University of Illinois swimming and diving team. Novitsky, who joined the University of Illinois swimming and diving staff as a volunteer assistant coach in 1994, begins her 20th season as a part of the Illini program. After three seasons of working as the volunteer coach, Novitsky was promoted to assistant coach in the fall of 1997. In August 2000, she was hired by former Director of Athletics, Ron Guenther, as the fifth head coach in the program's history.

Novitsky's first year as head coach was filled with success as three Illini qualified for the NCAA Championships, and Jessica Aveyard repeated as an All-American in the 200 backstroke. Novitsky's swimmers continued their success at the national and international levels, as Aveyard and Ilkay Dikmen qualified to represent their native countries at the FINA World Swimming Championships in Fukuoka, Japan. Aveyard, swimming for the United States, reached the semifinals in the 200 backstroke, while Dikmen, a 2000 Olympian, competed for Turkey in the 200 breaststroke. Dikmen also swam in the 2004 Olympics in the 100 and 200 breaststroke.



As an assistant coach, Novitsky trained several athletes, including Aveyard, who was an NCAA qualifier, All-American and World Championship semifinalist, and Anna Christiansen, who was a three-time NCAA qualifier.

In addition, Novitsky trained six former Fighting Illini athletes at the 2000 U.S. Olympic trials.

As a swimmer, Novitsky was a two-time Division II All-American at Oakland University, earning a bachelor's degree in biochemistry in 1991. She was a student assistant coach for the 1991 Division II national champion Oakland Pioneers. Novitsky also earned a master's degree in kinesiology from Michigan.

A native of Huntington Woods, Mich., Novitsky previously worked as an assistant coach for the Oakland Live Y'ers age-group team.

ALEC HAYDEN
ASSISTANT COACH // SECOND SEASON

Alec Hayden is entering his second season as an assistant swimming coach with the Fighting Illini swimming and diving program. Hayden came to Illinois from William & Mary, where he spent one season as an assistant coach.

In just one season at William & Mary, Hayden was the primary coach for swimmers who accomplished four conference records, 32 school records, 20 freshman records and 10 NCAA B cuts. His only recruiting class with the Tribe was the best in program history and included the first top-100 recruit in program history.

At the Colonial Athletic Association Championships, he coached seven individual conference champions and three relay championship teams. Tribe swimmers took home co-Swimmer of the Meet, Rookie of the Year and Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

Prior to joining the staff at William & Mary, Hayden served as the head senior coach for the Nasa Wildcat Aquatics team, which was comprised of 40 high school and eighth-grade swimmers. Under his tutelage, Wildcat swimmers set one national age group record and eight state records. He coached three swimmers who qualified for the 2012 U.S. Olympic Trials.

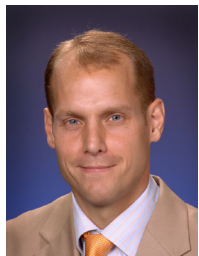
He coached four swimmers to a combined 14 state championships and also coached the 2011 50 freestyle USA Swimming Junior National runner-up. At the 2012 National Club Swimming Association Junior Nationals, he coached the Wildcat boys to an eighth-place national finish and the combined team to a 10th-place finish.

While working with the Nasa Wildcat Aquatics team, Hayden simultaneously worked as a volunteer assistant for Northwestern University. At Northwestern, Hayden worked with both the men's and women's programs, including work with an NCAA Championships finalist, two NCAA consolation finalists and five NCAA qualifiers.

Hayden started his coaching career as an assistant senior coach with Nasa Wildcat Aquatics in April of 2008. Working primarily with the sprint groups, Hayden coached athletes who set one national age group record and 11 state records. He coached three individual state champions and the U.S. Open 100 butterfly runner-up.

As an athlete, Hayden was a four-year letter winner and two-year captain as a member of the Northwestern Wildcats swimming team from 2004-2008. Hayden was an All-American at New Trier High School, and he was also a team captain and four-year All-Conference honoree.

Hayden graduated from Northwestern in June 2008 with dual degrees in Mathematical Methods in the Social Sciences and Economics.



CHRIS WATERS
DIVING COACH // NINTH SEASON

Chris Waters begins his ninth season as the Illini diving coach. Last season, Waters oversaw the training of NCAA Zone C qualifiers Emily Fung, Erika Murphy and Olivia Kassouni. In the 2013-14 season he oversaw the training for qualifiers Keri Eberhardt, Darragh McDermott and Erika Murphy.

Waters came to Illinois with a wide variety of experience as a diving coach, including stops at Tulane, Syracuse, Virginia Tech and Missouri State. At Tulane, Waters had a top-12 finisher in both the one-and three-meter diving competitions at the Conference USA Championships. Waters also coached one Syracuse diver to the NCAA Zone A Championships in 2005 and had two divers place at the Big East Conference meet.

Waters coached an honorable mention All-American in the one-and three-meter diving competitions at Division III Connecticut College in 2000 and was named Missouri Valley Conference Diving Coach of the Year in 1999 after coaching the Male Diver of the Year and the men's one-and three-meter champions at Missouri State.

A member of the United States Diving and the Professional Diving Coaches Association, Waters has coached six Academic All-Conference selectees throughout his career. He graduated from Castleton State University with a bachelor's degree in criminal justice in 1991 and earned a master's degree in health promotion and wellness management from Missouri State in 2002.

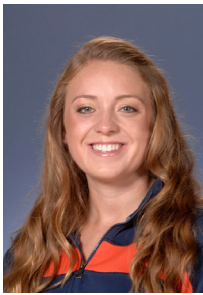

2013-14 SEASON IN REVIEW

The Fighting Illini swimming and diving team put together the most wins in a season since the 1999-2000 season, finishing with a dual meet record of 8-6-1. Individually, the squad prompted 17 changes to the all-time fastest individuals list.

The Orange and Blue got off to a solid start, defeating five of its first seven dual opponents. During that stretch the Illini defeated Eastern Michigan, Michigan State, Liberty, Illinois State and Kansas while dropping meets to Northwestern and Oakland on the road.

Illinois' success was not limited to dual meets, as the Illini finished second of eight in the Miami (OH) Invitational and claimed victory at the 16-team 10ma Copa Coqui Invitational in Puerto Rico during winter training.

The Illini continued to ride their momentum into Senior Day when they tied Rutgers (150-150), remaining unbeaten at home. A week later the Illini would secure another dual victory on the road over Iowa State.

The early-season success hit a bump in the road at the Iowa Triple Dual Meet, where the Illini fell to then-No. 21 Missouri, No. 11 Indiana and Iowa. The Illini would recover with home victories over Olivet Nazarene and Southern Illinois before dropping their last dual meet of the season to Nebraska on the road. The Illini would complete the season with an impressive unbeaten record at home finishing 4-0-1 at the ARC Pool.

At the Big Ten Championships, the Illini finished 12th, but the Orange and Blue qualified swimmers to seven event finals, recorded two NCAA B standards and broke six school records. Junior Alison Meng topped her own school records in both the 50 back (25.02) and 100 back (53.94). Meng also played a role in two of the three relay events to set new school records. The 200 medley relay team of Meng, Isabella Schamber, Lori Lynn and Megan Marchuk clocked an all-time best (1:41.90), while the 400 medley relay group of Meng, Erica Lynn, Lori Lynn and Courtney Pope, achieved a program best (3:42.21). In the 800 freestyle relay, Pope, Stecker, Mary Beth Howard and Marchuk swam an all-time best time of 7:18.82, besting the previous mark by over two seconds. Freshman Gabbie Stecker was the other Illini to take down an individual school record. Stecker's prelim time of 2:00.50 in the 200 butterfly beat the previous record set by Erin Rodriguez (2:01.72) in 2012.

Along with her several record-breaking performances, Meng became the first Illini to earn points in an individual event of the 2014 Big Ten Championships with her 10th place finish in the 100 back (53.94). It was the first points Meng has earned individually at the Big Ten Championships in her collegiate career. Meng, the Most Valuable Swimmer of the Year team award winner, led the Illini with fastest times of the season in the 100 free (50.81), 100 fly (54.69) and the 100 back (53.94).

Talented freshmen Gabbie Stecker and Amelia Schilling made a big splash in their first collegiate season. The two combined to claim 13 event victories over the course of the season. Stecker would go on to swim the fastest 200 butterfly (2:00.50), 500 (4:48.53) and 1000 (10:10.11) freestyles for the Illini this season. Schilling led the Illini with the fastest 200 (1:49.18) and 1650 (16:53.20) freestyles this season.

Other notable swimmers who led the Illini with fastest times this season include Jessica Holz in the 50 free (23.66) and 200 back (2:00.21), Lori Lynn in the 200 IM (2:04.21) and Sarah Sykstus in the 400 IM (4:27.58).

On the boards, juniors Erika Murphy, Emily Fung and freshman Olivia Kassouni each qualified for the NCAA Zone C Diving Championships. Kassouni led the Illini with the top three-meter dive with a score of 283.87, while Murphy led with the top one-meter dive (276.30). Kassouni's platform dive score of 176.90 placed her third on the all-time top dives list.
