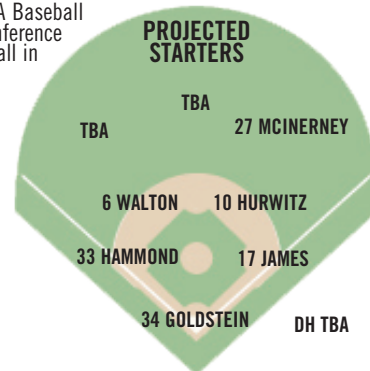

NOTES

- Illinois was picked to finish fifth in the Big Ten by the league's coaches, a year removed from winning the program's 30th conference title. Michigan, Maryland, Indiana and Iowa ranked in the top four spots. SS Adam Walton, RHP Cody Sedlock and C Jason Goldstein were selected for the Big Ten Players to Watch List by the league's coaches.
- Three Illini that were drafted last season elected to return to school » SS Adam Walton, C Jason Goldstein, RHP Nick Blackburn.
- Six current Illini have been drafted including freshmen RHP/1B Luke Shilling, INF Jalin McMillan and INF Bren Spillane.
- Illinois returns three of its four coaches from 2015, including head coach Dan Hartleb, pitching coach Drew Dickinson and volunteer Kyle Hudson. Adam Christ was hired from Minnesota State to replace Spencer Allen, who took the head coach position at Northwestern.
- Although Illinois lost a bulk of its pitching staff to the MLB Draft, junior Cody Sedlock returns and looks to headline this year's arms. Sedlock is a potential first-round pick and has been named a top 40 prospect by Baseball America and D1Baseball.com. Both publications rated him as the No. 3 prospect in the Big Ten for the 2016 MLB Draft.
- C Jason Goldstein (No. 14) and SS Adam Walton (No. 16) were ranked among the top 20 prospects in the Big Ten by D1Baseball.com.
- Freshman RHP/1B Luke Shilling was predicted to be the Big Ten Freshman of the Year by Perfect Game.
- Illinois is coming off its first-ever NCAA Regional title in 2015, going 3-0 while hosting the first NCAA Champaign Regional at Illinois Field.
- The Illini played in the Super Regional for the first time in school history and earned their highest final ranking in program history (No. 7 - Perfect Game).
- The Fighting Illini are coming off their 30th Big Ten Championship, which ranks second all-time in conference history behind Michigan (35).
- Illinois (50-10-1) set the school record with 50 victories, breaking the mark of 49 wins from 1982.
- Illinois was one of two Big Ten teams (Maryland) to reach a Super Regional. Big Ten schools have advanced to a Super Regional seven times since the NCAA Tournament format was changed in 1999.
- Illinois earned the No. 6 overall seed in the 2015 NCAA Baseball Championship, becoming the second Big Ten team in conference history to earn a national seed. Indiana was No. 4 overall in 2014.
- Illinois was one of a conference-record five Big Ten teams (Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Maryland, Michigan) that was selected for the NCAA tournament.
- A school-record nine Illini were selected in the 2015 MLB Draft, including Tyler Jay (No. 6 overall, Minnesota Twins) as the highest draft pick in school history. John Kravetz also signed a free agent contract with the Toronto Blue Jays.
- Illinois swept the top three Big Ten individual awards in 2015 for the first time in school history: David Kerian (Player of the Year), Tyler Jay (Pitcher of the Year) and Dan Hartleb (Coach of the Year).
- Three Illini - Tyler Jay (first team), Kevin Duchene (second team) and David Kerian (second team) - were named All-Americans by multiple publications. It was the first time Illinois had three All-America players in one season in program history.
- Illinois posted a Big Ten record 27-game winning streak from March 30-May 20, which was the longest streak in the country in 2015.
- The 2015 Illini pitching staff (2.55 ERA) shattered the school's ERA record (3.25), set in 2014. The 2015 Illini (449 K) also broke the school record for strikeouts from 1998 (419 K).
- The Illini won their second conference title in the last five years (2011) and first outright title since 2005.
- During the 2015 season, head coach Dan Hartleb signed a five-year extension to remain the Illini's head coach through 2020.
