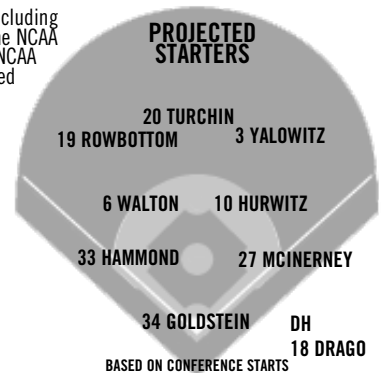

NOTES

- Illinois dropped two of three games at Iowa last weekend, its second straight series loss after winning its previous nine Big Ten series dating back to 2014.
- The Illini set a season high with 10 runs on the power of three home runs in their lone win in Iowa City. Jason Goldstein and Trent Hammond hit two-run homers and Doran Turchin blasted a grand slam as eight of Illinois' 10 runs were scored on home runs.
- Cody Sedlock set career highs with 8.0 innings and 11 strikeouts in a 4-3 loss at Iowa in Game 1 of a doubleheader on Saturday. The Friday game was moved to Saturday to avoid cold weather and high winds.
- Michael Hurwitz led the Illini with eight hits at Iowa last weekend. He went 8 for 14 (.571) with a double and two RBIs. Hurwitz is batting a team-best .447 (17-38) in the last 10 games.
- Illinois picked up a midweek win over Eastern Illinois last Tuesday after dropping two of three at Nebraska last weekend. The Huskers ended the Fighting Illini's streak of nine straight Big Ten series won with come-from-behind wins on Saturday and Sunday.
- The Illini set a season high with 16 hits in a 9-7 win over Eastern Illinois Tuesday night at Illinois Field. Doran Turchin and Anthony Drago had three hits and Jason Goldstein added three RBIs.
- The Illini's 5-3 loss to Penn State on March 26 snapped a 22-game Big Ten regular season winning streak. Illinois won 20 straight Big Ten regular season games to end the 2015 season and won its first two of 2016.
- Illinois is 20-7 in Big Ten regular season road games since the start of 2014 with four of those losses coming at Nebraska (two in 2014, two in 2016). Illinois is 18-3 on the road against the rest of the Big Ten field since 2014.
- Illinois is 18-1 in its last 19 Big Ten games at Illinois Field dating back to 2014. Penn State won at Illinois Field on March 26 to snap an 18-game Illini winning streak.
- Nearly half of the Illini's hits (49%, 122/249) have been by players who never started a game before 2016.
- The Illini are 11-1 when leading after five innings.
- Illinois is 0-9 in one-run games.
- Doug Hayes put up one of the best Illinois pitching performances in recent years by throwing only 94 pitches in a one-hitter against Penn State March 26, as the Illini cruised to a 6-1 win. Hayes induced 18 groundouts, while facing one batter over the minimum. It was the Fighting Illini's first one-hitter since since Mike Stankiewicz at Northwestern in 2007. Both Hayes and Stankiewicz were former walk-ons.
- Cody Sedlock matched career highs March 25 with 7.0 innings pitched and 10 strikeouts to lead Illinois to a 5-0 win over Penn State in the Big Ten and home opener.
- Two Illini hitters batted .400 or better during the Nebraska series: Michael Hurwitz .500 (4-8, 3 BB) and Dan Rowbottom .400 (4-10, 5 BB).
- Three Illini hitters batted over .400 during the Penn State series: Anthony Drago .455 (5-11), Jason Goldstein .444 (4-9) and Pat McInerney .417 (5-12). Drago and Goldstein both homered.
- Opponents batting averages during Big Ten series: Penn State .170, Nebraska .346, Iowa .275
- Freshman Cole Bellair became the first Illinois true freshman to start a Big Ten game since May 24, 2013 when Ryan Castellanos got the ball against Minnesota. He has been the Sunday starter during the Big Ten schedule.
- Illinois ranks 45th in the nation in double plays per game (0.93). The Illini turned four double plays against FGCU Feb. 26 and four against Villanova March 6.
- Freshman centerfielder Doran Turchin and redshirt-junior shortstop Adam Walton are the only Illini to start every game at their respective positions. Only Walton, the leadoff hitter, has started in the same spot in the batting order.
- Last season, Illinois set a program record with 50 wins, including a Big Ten record 27-game winning streak. The Illini won the NCAA Champaign Regional on its way to the program's first NCAA Super Regional. Eventual national runner-up Vanderbilt ended the Illini's season in the NCAA Champaign Super Regional.
- Illinois was picked to finish fifth in the Big Ten by the league's coaches, a year removed from winning the program's 30th conference title. Michigan, Maryland, Indiana and Iowa ranked in the top four spots.
- Three Illini that were drafted last season elected to return to school » SS Adam Walton, C Jason Goldstein, RHP Nick Blackburn.
- Six current Illini have been drafted including freshmen RHP/1B Luke Shilling, INF Jalin McMillan and INF Bren Spillane. Illinois is one of four Big Ten teams with 5+ previously drafted players on its roster (Nebraska 8, Michigan 7, Maryland 7).
