NOTES

- Illinois is on a four-game winning streak, its best run of the season.
- The Illini have won six of their last eight and seven of their last 10.
- The Illini are 14-1 when leading after five innings, but 0-9 in one-run games.
- Illinois ranks 24th in the nation in strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.66).
- Nearly half (49%) of the team's hits have been by players that had not started a game before this year.
- Illinois swept Saint Louis over the weekend. The Illini played a nonconference series in the middle of Big Ten play because of the conference's unbalanced schedule. There are thirteen Big Ten schools that support baseball programs. Wisconsin dropped baseball in 1991.
- Over 4,000 fans came out to the three games at Illinois Field between the Fighting Illini and Saint Louis April 15-17. It was the 10th-best attendance for a weekend series in program history and the highest for a nonconference set.
- Tuesday's 7-1 win over Illinois State marked the start of five straight nonconference games for the Illini. Jason Goldstein had four RBIs and Michael Hurwitz, Dan Rowbottom and Doran Turchin added two hits apiece.
- Freshman centerfielder Doran Turchin and redshirt-junior shortstop Adam Walton are the only Illini to start every game at their respective positions.
- Illinois dropped two of three games at Iowa in its last Big Ten series, its second straight series loss after winning its previous nine Big Ten series dating back to 2014.
- The Illini set a season high with 10 runs on the power of three home runs in their lone win in Iowa City. Jason Goldstein and Trent Hammond hit two-run homers and Doran Turchin blasted a grand slam as eight of Illinois' 10 runs were scored on home runs.
- Cody Sedlock set career highs with 8.0 innings and 11 strikeouts in a 4-3 loss at Iowa in Game 1 of a doubleheader April 9. The Friday game was moved to Saturday to avoid cold weather and high winds.
- Michael Hurwitz has been on fire...
 - .514 (19-37), nine runs, six RBIs during current nine-game hitting streak
 - Average has gone up 125 points (.179-.304) since March 26
 - Seven multi-hit games during nine-game hitting streak
 - Second in the Big Ten with a .438 batting average in conference games
 - Fourth in the Big Ten with a .513 on-base percentage in conference games
- Nebraska ended the Fighting Illini's streak of nine straight Big Ten series won with come-from-behind wins April 2-3.
- The Illini set a season high with 16 hits in a 9-7 win over Eastern Illinois April 5 at Illinois Field. Doran Turchin and Anthony Drago had three hits and Jason Goldstein added three RBIs.
- The Illini's 5-3 loss to Penn State on March 26 snapped a 22-game Big Ten regular season winning streak. Illinois won 20 straight Big Ten regular season games to end the 2015 season and won its first two of 2016.
- Illinois is 20-7 in Big Ten regular season road games since the start of 2014 with four of those losses coming at Nebraska (two in 2014, two in 2016). Illinois is 18-3 on the road against the rest of the Big Ten field since 2014.
- Illinois is 18-1 in its last 19 Big Ten games at Illinois Field dating back to 2014. Penn State won at Illinois Field on March 26 to snap an 18-game Illini winning streak.
- Doug Hayes put up one of the best Illinois pitching performances in recent years by throwing only 94 pitches in a one-hitter against Penn State March 26, as the Illini cruised to a 6-1 win. Hayes induced 18 groundouts, while facing one batter over the minimum. It was the Fighting Illini's first one-hitter since since Mike Stankiewicz at Northwestern in 2007. Both Hayes and Stankiewicz were former walk-ons.
- Opponents batting averages during Big Ten series: Penn State .170, Nebraska .346, Iowa .275
- Freshman Cole Bellair became the first Illinois true freshman to start a Big Ten game since May 24, 2013 when Ryan Castellanos got the ball against Minnesota. He has been the Sunday starter during the Big Ten schedule.
- Last season, Illinois set a program record with 50 wins, including a Big Ten record 27-game winning streak. The Illini won the NCAA Champaign Regional on its way to the program's first NCAA Super Regional. Eventual national runner-up Vanderbilt ended the Illini's season in the NCAA Champaign Super Regional.
