NOTES

- For the second time in three weeks, Illinois will play the Big Ten leader (Minnesota, April 29-May 1).
- Illinois' remaining schedule is the seventh toughest in the NCAA based on opponent winning percentage (.681).
- Illinois is back to .500 in conference play (9-9) and one game out of eighth place, the cutoff line for the Big Ten Tournament.
- The Illini own the head-to-head tiebreaker over all three teams that are tied for sixth-eight (Penn State, Ohio State and Maryland).
- Illinois is 22-8 in Big Ten regular season road games since the start of 2014 with four of those losses coming at Nebraska (two in 2014, two in 2016). Illinois is 20-3 on the road against the rest of the Big Ten field since 2014.
- Illinois has won three of its last four series (Saint Louis, Ohio State, Maryland), with its only series loss in the last month coming to No. 19 Minnesota.
- Illinois has won 12 of its last 16 games, starting with a season-long six-game winning streak April 12-22.
- Illinois has held opponents to .164 (23-140) with runners in scoring position over the last 16 games.
- The Illini went 10-5 in April after starting the month with a 10-12 overall record. Illinois is 4-2 in May
- The Illini are 19-1 when leading after five innings and 23-1 when leading after eight innings.
- Illinois is 3-9 in one-run games but 15-13 in games decided by two or fewer runs.
- The Illini are 11-1 in night games.
- The Illini rank 37th in the nation in strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.46) and 32nd in walks per nine innings (3.03).
- Illinois has outscored opponents 27-16 in the first inning.
- 49.4% (193/391) of the Illini's hits have been by players that had not started a game before this year.
- The Illini's top two pitchers - Cody Sedlock and Doug Hayes - have combined for 60.1 innings, a 1.94 ERA and 52 strikeouts in their last four starts. Sedlock: 31.1 IP, 6 ER, 34 K; Hayes: 29.0 IP, 7 ER, 18 K
- Michael Hurwitz is on a 24-game reached base streak and a five-game hitting streak. He snapped a 15-game hitting streak by going 0 for 4 May 1 vs. Minnesota. Hurwitz hit .429 (27-63) with 12 runs, six RBIs and nine multi-hit games during his 15-game hitting streak. His batting average went from .200 to .304.
- Cody Sedlock is the reigning Big Ten Pitcher of the Week, his second time winning the award in the last three weeks. The Illini became the first team to win three straight Pitcher of the Week honors against three Big Ten opponents since Purdue from March 26-April 9, 2012.
- Doug Hayes was named Big Ten Pitcher of the Week after his first career shutout in Illinois' lone win in the series against No. 19 Minnesota. Hayes scattered eight hits and struck out six. It was his second career complete game after firing a one-hitter vs. Penn State earlier this season.
- Hayes gave Illinois the conference's first back-to-back Pitchers of the Week from one school since Maryland's Mike Shawaryn won April 14 and April 20, 2015. Cody Sedlock won the week prior after shutting out Ohio State in 10.2 innings.
- Cody Sedlock was named Illinois' first ever National Pitcher of the Week April 26. Sedlock set career highs with 10.2 innings pitched and 14 strikeouts April 22 against Ohio State. He had six 1-2-3 innings in the longest outing in Division I baseball this season.
- Jason Goldstein was named one of 10 finalists for the prestigious Senior CLASS Award, it was announced Tuesday. The award honors achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.
