NOTES

- The series is Thursday-Saturday in order to give adequate rest before the Big Ten Tournament.
- Illinois is one game out of eighth place, the cutoff line for the Big Ten Tournament. The Illini own the tiebreaker over Penn State and Maryland, the two teams tied for the seventh and eighth spots.
- Illinois is 21-4 in its last 25 Big Ten games at Illinois Field dating back to 2014. Penn State won at Illinois Field on March 26 to snap an 18-game Illini winning streak.
- The Illini are 11-4 at Illinois Field in 2016, including a 5-4 mark during Big Ten games at home.
- Illinois has held opponents to .172 (29-169) with runners in scoring position over the last 20 games.
- The Illini are 19-1 when leading after five innings and 23-1 when leading after eight innings.
- Illinois is 4-9 in one-run games but 16-14 in games decided by two or fewer runs.
- The Illini are 12-1 in night games (12 straight wins after dropping the season opener at Tulane).
- The Illini rank 28th in the nation in walks per nine innings (3.00), 33rd in strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.50) and 45th in ERA (3.59).
- Illinois has outscored opponents 28-19 in the first inning and 209-208 overall.
- 48% (196/405) of the Illini's hits have been by players that had not started a game before this year.
- The Illini's top two pitchers - Cody Sedlock and Doug Hayes - have combined for 75.2 innings, a 2.02 ERA and 67 strikeouts in their last five starts. Sedlock: 40.2 IP, 7 ER, 46 K; Hayes: 35.0 IP, 10 ER, 21 K
- Michael Hurwitz snapped a 26-game reached base streak on Sunday. Hurwitz hit .363 (37-102) with 20 runs, nine doubles a .451 slugging percentage and .431 on-base percentage during the streak.
- For the first time in a month, Illinois did not win the Big Ten Pitcher of the Week award. Cody Sedlock (2) and Doug Hayes (1) combined to win three straight, making Illinois the first team to win three straight Pitcher of the Week honors against three Big Ten opponents since Purdue from March 26-April 9, 2012.
- Doug Hayes was named Big Ten Pitcher of the Week after his first career shutout in Illinois' lone win in the series against No. 19 Minnesota. Hayes scattered eight hits and struck out six. It was his second career complete game after firing a one-hitter vs. Penn State earlier this season.
- Cody Sedlock was named Illinois' first ever National Pitcher of the Week April 26. Sedlock set career highs with 10.2 innings pitched and 14 strikeouts April 22 against Ohio State. He had six 1-2-3 innings in the longest outing in Division I baseball this season.
- Jason Goldstein was named one of 10 finalists for the prestigious Senior CLASS Award, it was announced Tuesday. The award honors achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.
- The Illini's 5-3 loss to Penn State on March 26 snapped a 22-game Big Ten regular season winning streak. Illinois won 20 straight Big Ten regular season games to end the 2015 season and won its first two of 2016.
- Last season, Illinois set a program record with 50 wins, including a Big Ten record 27-game winning streak. The Illini won the NCAA Champaign Regional on its way to the program's first NCAA Super Regional. Eventual national runner-up Vanderbilt ended the Illini's season in the NCAA Champaign Super Regional.
- Three Illini that were drafted last season elected to return to school » SS Adam Walton, C Jason Goldstein, RHP Nick Blackburn.
- Illinois is 23-10 in Big Ten regular season road games since the start of 2014 with four of those losses coming at Nebraska (two in 2014, two in 2016). Illinois is 21-5 on the road against the rest of the Big Ten since 2014.

What Happens If...

Illinois stands in ninth place of the Big Ten standings, one game back of Penn State and Maryland for the eighth and final spot in the Big Ten tournament. With three games remaining against Michigan, here are the scenarios for the Fighting Illini to qualify for the tournament:

Illinois 3-0 vs. Michigan

If the Illini sweep Michigan, they will qualify for the tournament. Illinois would pass at least Michigan for eighth place or higher depending on other results.

Illinois 2-1 vs. Michigan

Michigan would clinch a spot in the Big Ten Tournament with one win over Illinois. Rutgers would be eliminated with one Illinois victory. There would be five teams alive (Michigan State, Maryland, Penn State, Illinois, Iowa) for three spots.

If Illinois goes 2-1 and Michigan State goes 3-0 against Maryland, Illinois would be in (ahead of Maryland on head-to-head tiebreaker). The Penn State/Iowa series winner would also qualify.

If Illinois goes 2-1 and Michigan State goes 2-1 against Maryland, Illinois would be in (ahead of Maryland on head-to-head tiebreaker). The Penn State/Iowa series winner would also qualify.

If Illinois goes 2-1 and Michigan State goes 1-2 against Maryland, Illinois would be out (behind Maryland and Michigan State). The Penn State/Iowa series winner would also qualify.

If Illinois goes 2-1 and Michigan State goes 0-3 against Maryland, Illinois would be in (ahead of Michigan State on record against common Big Ten opponents). There is a chance four-team tie at 12-12 between the Illini, Michigan State, Penn State and Iowa, which would result in Iowa and Illinois qualifying due to their 2-1 records against Maryland, the teams' only common Big Ten opponent. Penn State and Michigan State would have losing series against Maryland.

Illinois 1-2 vs. Michigan

The only way Illinois would qualify for the Big Ten Tournament after going 1-2 vs. Michigan is if Maryland and Penn State both went 0-3. That would put Illinois, Maryland and Penn State in a three-way tie for the eighth and final spot. Illinois owns the tiebreaker with series wins over both teams.

Illinois 0-3 vs. Michigan

Illinois would not qualify for the Big Ten Tournament with a 10-14 conference record.

OTHER BIG TEN TOURNAMENT SCENARIOS

Michigan

The Wolverines clinch a spot with one win over Illinois. It is also possible for Michigan to make the tournament if they are swept at Illinois.

Michigan State

The Spartans clinch a spot with one win over Maryland.

Maryland

The Terrapins clinch a spot with two wins over Michigan State.

Penn State

The Nittany Lions clinch a spot with two wins over Iowa.

Iowa

The Hawkeyes clinch a spot with three wins over Penn State.

Rutgers

The Scarlet Knights need to go 3-0 and have Penn State, Michigan and Michigan State all go 3-0 in order to qualify for the Big Ten Tournament.

Note: These scenarios assume all remaining games are played. The standings are determined by winning percentage. The scenario results were not approved by the Big Ten Conference.

ILLINOIS BIG TEN TOURNAMENT NOTES

- » Illinois has qualified for three straight Big Ten Tournaments, last missing the tournament in 2012.
- » Illinois has qualified for the Big Ten Tournament in eight of Dan Hartleb's 10 years as head coach. The Illini missed the tournament in 2010 and 2012.
- » Illinois last won the Big Ten Tournament in 2011, when it swept three straight games (Ohio State, Michigan State, Michigan State) in Columbus, Ohio.
- » Illinois has won 30 Big Ten championships, second only to Michigan's 35. The conference champion is determined by the regular season standings.
- » Illinois has qualified for an NCAA Regional in three of the past five seasons (2011, 2013, 2015).
