NOTES

- Illinois had won two straight series (Saint Louis, Ohio State) before dropping two of three to No. 19 Minnesota last weekend at Illinois Field.
- Illinois and Minnesota played a doubleheader Friday and the series finale Sunday due to rain on Saturday.
- Doug Hayes threw his first career shutout last Friday in Illinois' lone win in the series against No. 19 Minnesota. Hayes scattered eight hits and struck out six. It was his second career complete game after firing a one-hitter vs. Penn State earlier this season.
- Illinois has won eight of its last 11 games, starting with a season-long six-game winning streak April 12-22.
- The Illini went 10-5 in April after starting the month with a 10-12 overall record.
- The Illini are 17-1 when leading after five innings and 20-1 when leading after eight innings.
- Illinois is 2-9 in one-run games but 12-12 in games decided by two or fewer runs.
- The Illini are 10-1 in night games.
- Illinois has held opponents to .177 (17-96) with runners in scoring position over the last 10 games.
- The Illini rank 25th in the nation in strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.59) and 26th in walks allowed per nine innings (2.92).
- The Illini's top two pitchers - Cody Sedlock and Doug Hayes - have combined for 44.1 innings and a 1.84 ERA in the last 10 games (3 starts each).
- 49% (171/349) of the Illini's hits have been by players that had not started a game before this year.
- Michael Hurwitz is on a 19-game reached base streak, but snapped his 15-game hitting streak by going 0 for 4 on Sunday. Hurwitz hit .429 (27-63) with 12 runs, six RBIs and nine multi-hit games during his 15-game hitting streak. His batting average went from .200 to .304.
- Freshman centerfielder Doran Turchin is the only Illini to start every game at his respective position.
- Cody Sedlock was named Illinois' first ever National Pitcher of the Week April 26. Sedlock set career highs with 10.2 innings pitched and 14 strikeouts April 22 against Ohio State. He had six 1-2-3 innings in the longest outing in Division I baseball this season.
- Jason Goldstein was named one of 10 finalists for the prestigious Senior CLASS Award, it was announced Tuesday. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.
- Nebraska ended the Illinois' streak of nine straight Big Ten series won by taking two of three April 1-3 in Lincoln.
- The Illini's 5-3 loss to Penn State on March 26 snapped a 22-game Big Ten regular season winning streak. Illinois won 20 straight Big Ten regular season games to end the 2015 season and won its first two of 2016.
- Illinois is 20-7 in Big Ten regular season road games since the start of 2014 with four of those losses coming at Nebraska (two in 2014, two in 2016). Illinois is 18-3 on the road against the rest of the Big Ten field since 2014.
- Illinois is 21-4 in its last 25 Big Ten games at Illinois Field dating back to 2014. Penn State won at Illinois Field on March 26 to snap an 18-game Illini winning streak.
- Freshman Cole Bellair became the first Illinois true freshman to start a Big Ten game since May 24, 2013 when Ryan Castellanos got the ball against Minnesota. He has been the Sunday starter during the Big Ten schedule.
- Last season, Illinois set a program record with 50 wins, including a Big Ten record 27-game winning streak. The Illini won the NCAA Champaign Regional on its way to the program's first NCAA Super Regional. Eventual national runner-up Vanderbilt ended the Illini's season in the NCAA Champaign Super Regional.
- Three Illini that were drafted last season elected to return to school » SS Adam Walton, C Jason Goldstein, RHP Nick Blackburn.
- Six current Illini have been drafted including freshmen RHP/1B Luke Shilling, INF Jalin McMillan and INF Bren Spillane. Illinois is one of four Big Ten teams with 5+ previously drafted players on its roster (Nebraska 8, Michigan 7, Maryland 7).
